CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LORENZO TALIAFERRO • RB • Senior
 Coastal Carolina • Yorktown, Va.

Taliaferro rushed 17 times for 174 yards and three touchdowns in Coastal's 51-32 win at No. 25 Eastern Kentucky -- which entered the game third in the nation in rushing defense. He averaged 10.2 yards per rush and had touchdown runs of 45, 5 and 11 against the Colonels. Eight of his rushes went for either a first down or touchdown and five of his attempts were for more than 10 yards. Taliaferro gave Coastal an early 14-0 lead, had 114 rushing yards in the first half and added a 44-yard scamper on 3rd-and-14 in the third quarter that led to an eventual TD.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

CHAD GETER • OLB • Sophomore
 Gardner-Webb • Irmo, S.C.

Geter had a career-high 10 tackles (four solo, six assisted) with 1.5 tackles-for-loss and one sack for minus-11 yards to lead Gardner-Webb in its 12-10 win over No. 11/15 Richmond. He helped the GWU defense hold Richmond to just 10 net rushing yards on 20 attempts as well as 4-of-13 on third down conversions and 0-of-2 on fourth down. Geter had eight of his tackles in the second half and five stops in the decisive fourth quarter. With the Runnin' Bulldogs clinging to a 9-3 lead with 8:32 left, his sack on 4th-and-4 at the GWU 19-yard line ended a scoring opportunity for the Spiders.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

JORDAN DAY • PK/P • Senior
 Gardner-Webb • Marvin, N.C.

Day accounted for all of Gardner-Webb's 12 points in its 12-10 win over nationally-ranked Richmond. The senior walk-on -- in his first year after playing soccer for GWU -- tied the Big South single-game record with four field goals, hitting from 39, 37, 29 and 30 yards, the last being the game-winner with 25 seconds left. Day, who last attempted a field goal in 2008 as a high school senior, also punted six times for a 40.3 average and limited the Spiders to only one return for three yards.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

SAMSON BALDWIN • CB • R-Freshman
 Coastal Carolina • Greenville, S.C.

Baldwin had two tackles, two pass break-ups and an interception in Coastal's win at Eastern Kentucky. With CCU down 24-14 and EKU on offense following a Coastal fumble, Baldwin intercepted a pass three plays into the ensuing series and returned it 22 yards to the Colonels' 9-yard line. The Chants would score two plays later to start their run of 37 unanswered points. Baldwin recorded his pass break-ups in the first and fourth quarters to help Coastal set a school-record with 12 PBUs in the game.

WAS THAT A NINER I JUST HEARD?

The Big South is 9-2 through 11 games against FCS opponents, extending the Conference's best start against FCS competition in League history. It is the most non-Conference FCS wins since the 2008 season when the Big South collected 11 victories. Among the nine wins this season are triumphs over the Colonial Athletic Association and the Southern Conference, marking the first time since 2008 that the Big South has recorded regular-season wins against the CAA and SoCon in the same year.

BIG SOUTH SCORES LEAGUE FIRST WITH TWO WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS IN SAME WEEK

For the first time in League history, the Big South defeated two nationally-ranked teams in the same week of the regular-season as Gardner-Webb upset No. 11/15 Richmond and No. 21/21 Coastal Carolina won at No. 25 Eastern Kentucky on Saturday. It was the second time overall in the Conference record book, as the Chants and former member Stony Brook achieved the feat in the first round of the 2012 FCS Playoffs. GWU also handed Richmond its first non-conference FCS loss since 2005 -- ending the Spiders' 17-game win streak in such games. Meanwhile, the Chants' win at EKU improved the Big South to 4-7 all-time when a ranked Big South team plays a nationally-ranked non-Conference opponent.

CHADWELL, TWO 3-0 TEAMS ALSO LEAGUE FIRSTS

Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern each are 3-0 -- the first time in Big South football history that two teams opened the season 3-0 in the same year. The Chanticleers are 3-0 for the first time in school history, while the Buccaneers are 3-0 for the first time since opening the 2006 campaign with a 9-0 mark. In addition, new CSU head coach **JAMEY CHADWELL** is first head coach to start 3-0 in his first season in the Big South.

TALIAFERRO'S RUSHING TALLY NOT SEEN IN BIG SOUTH IN 10 SEASONS

Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** has rushed for 387 yards through the Chanticleers' first three games, the highest rushing total after the first three games of a season since former Liberty RB **EUGENE GOODMAN** rushed for 388 yards in the Flames' first three games of the 2004 campaign. Last season, Walter Payton Award finalist **MIGUEL MAYSONET** rushed for 382 yards through Stony Brook's first three contests. Taliaferro's total is the most after three games in school history.

CSU'S SEASON STARTS WITH DIXON

Charleston Southern dual-threat QB **MALCOLM DIXON** is the first quarterback in Big South history with back-to-back games of 100 yards rushing and 100 yards passing. He rushed for 135 yards and passed for 140 this past Saturday at Campbell after gaining 102 rushing yards and 123 passing yards against Shorter in Week 2. Now the fifth quarterback in Big South history with two career 100-yard rushing and passing games, Dixon is the second quarterback in League annals to rush for 100 yards in consecutive contests. The first was VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008.

COASTAL CAROLINA SETS BIG SOUTH SCORING RECORDS AGAINST A RANKED TEAM

Coastal Carolina's 51 points at No. 25 Eastern Kentucky was the most scored by a Big South member against a nationally-ranked non-Conference opponent in League history. The previous high was 35 by the Chanticleers in last season's playoff loss at Old Dominion. Coastal's 19-point victory over the Colonels is the Big South's second-largest margin of victory against a ranked non-Conference team, just after Liberty's 23-point win over No. 12 Elon in 2008.

DAY'S BIG DAY

Gardner-Webb PK **JORDAN DAY** tied the Big South single-game record with his four field goals against No. 11/15 Richmond, as he scored all 12 points in the Runnin' Bulldogs' 12-10 victory. Day is the eighth different kicker in League history to make four field goals in a game, and the first since former GWU kicker **TREVER AUSTIN** on Oct. 22, 2011 against Coastal Carolina.

BEWARE OF THE DOG


Gardner-Webb held No. 11/15 Richmond to just 10 net rushing yards this past Saturday, the second-fewest allowed against a non-Conference FCS opponent in League history. The fewest net rushing yards allowed by a Big South member to a non-Conference FCS foe is minus-4 -- VMI vs. St. Francis (Pa.) on Sept. 6, 2008.

BIG SOUTH'S STREAK OF NATIONALLY-RANKED PROGRAMS CONTINUES

With Coastal Carolina ranked No. 15 this week in both the FCS Coaches poll and *The Sports Network* ranking, the Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 24 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24).

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 88, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (19). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's active leader for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 32, the third-longest streak in Big South history. That record is 45 games, established by the Flames from Sept. 23, 2006 - Sept. 18, 2010.

WHISTLING DIXON

Charleston Southern QB **MALCOLM DIXON**, who became the sixth quarterback in the Conference record books to surpass 1,000 career rushing yards, is sixth on the list with 1,162 and 21 yards shy of moving past Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** (1,182) for fifth-place. Meanwhile, Dixon needs 417 passing yards to become just the fourth QB in League annals with 1,000 career rushing yards and 3,000 career passing yards.

HOME RUNS

Liberty and Charleston Southern have the League's top two longest active home win streaks. Liberty has won six consecutive games at Williams Stadium, which is the Flames' longest since winning 10-straight home games from Oct. 3, 2009 to Sept. 17, 2011. The Buccaneers' run stands at five-straight, which is their longest since winning seven consecutive home games from Sept. 27, 2008 to Oct. 3, 2009.

COMBO MEAL

Coastal Carolina (631) and Eastern Kentucky (477) combined for 1,108 yards this past Saturday. The combined yardage is the sixth-highest total in Big South history, and the Chanticleers have been involved in three of the top six. Coastal has the top spot (1,212 with Old Dominion on Dec. 2, 2012) and also the third-highest (1,143 with Gardner-Webb on Nov. 3, 2012).

BIG TIME RUSH

Charleston Southern rushed for 327 yards this past Saturday at Campbell, its highest rushing total against an FCS opponent since gaining 307 against VMI last season. In addition, the Bucs had two players rush for 100 yards (**MALCOLM DIXON** - 135, **CHRISTIAN REYES** - 105) against the Camels, the first time CSU had two 100-yard rushers in the same game since Sept. 17, 2011 when Dixon rushed for 163 yards and **TEDDY ALLEN** gained 125 against Jacksonville.

RETURN ON INVESTMENT

Coastal Carolina is 8-1 in its last nine games when rushing for more than 200 yards, including 2-0 this season. The Chanticleers have rushed for more than 200 yards 52 times in its history, and is 47-5 (=.904) when reaching the 200-rushing yard threshold.

HEY YOU... I KNOW YOU, I KNOW YOU

Richmond Spiders and former Liberty head coach **DANNY ROCCO** is facing his old team for the first time since taking over the UR program in 2012. Rocco, who is coaching against the Big South for the third time in the first four weeks of this season, is 3-1 against the Big South as Richmond's head coach, including 1-1 this year. Rocco spent six seasons in the Big South as the Flames' leader from 2006-11, and directed his teams to a 26-5 Conference record and 47-20 overall mark.

MORE FAMILIAR FOES

In addition to Richmond, the Big South will face two additional FCS opponents at least three times during the regular-season. The Big South went 2-1 in its three games against Furman, and will play start-up program Charlotte four times in 2013.

TONIGHT ON 20/20

Coastal Carolina has scored at least 20 points in 11 consecutive games, dating back to last season – the longest current streak in the Big South and the Chanticleers' longest such streak since scoring 20 points in 20 consecutive contests from Sept. 24, 2005 to Nov. 25, 2006. Coastal's 51 points at Eastern Kentucky this past Saturday was its most scored against a non-Conference FCS foe since scoring 66 points vs. Savannah State on Nov. 4, 2006. It was also the Chants' 12th 50-point game in program history, the second-most in Big South annals.

PRESS ON

Gardner-Webb senior DE **PRESTON PEMASA** is tied for second in Big South history with 38.0 career tackles-for-loss and needs just 0.5 TFL for sole possession on the list. He is also eighth in the Conference record book with 13.5 quarterback sacks and is 4.0 sacks shy of moving into second in that category. Former Gardner-Webb All-American **BRIAN JOHNSTON** is the Big South's all-time leader in both categories with 53.5 TFL and 20.5 sacks.

MEMBERS ONLY

Coastal Carolina junior LB **QUINN BACKUS** became the 39th player in Big South history with 200 career tackles when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday at Eastern Kentucky. His career total now stands at 203, which includes 106 solo stops. Last week, Presbyterian College junior LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** became the 38th player in the 200-tackle club. His career numbers are 209 tackles and 110 solo hits.

MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR THIS ONE

Coastal Carolina and Liberty will meet this season in Lynchburg on Oct. 19 for the 11th time. The series is tied at 5-5, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship eight times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Coastal won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2012 as well as 2010.

THREE BILLS

VMI quarterback **ERIC KORDENBROCK** threw for a career-high 369 yards this past Saturday against North Greenville -- his second consecutive 300-yard passing game. He is the first Big South quarterback with back-to-back 300-yard passing games since Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** last season on Oct. 27 and Nov. 3. Kordenbrock is the first Keydet QB with two-straight 300-yard passing games since 1986 when **DAVE BROWN** threw for 422 yards against Appalachian State and followed with 390 yards the next week at East Tennessee State.

MASTRO OF THE UNIVERSE

Coastal Carolina senior **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO** is the Big South's all-time leader for punt returns (67) and punt return yards (582). He is the third player in Big South history with at least 100 combined kickoff/punt returns in a career, as he is third all-time with 114 (47 KR, 67 PR). He needs 14 returns to break the Conference record of 127, which is held by former VMI standout **TIM MAYPRAY**. Maypray returned 98 kickoffs and 29 punts in his career from 2006-09. Meanwhile, Mastromatteo is the only player in the Conference record books with two punt returns of at least 80 yards.

KORDENBROCK IS LOCKED IN

VMI senior QB **ERIC KORDENBROCK** became the 10th player in Big South history with 5,000 career passing yards when he eclipsed the milestone this past Saturday, and currently ranks eighth with 5,341. He is also fourth with 498 completions and third with 922 attempts. Kordenbrock needs two completions to become the fourth Big South QB with 500 and 88 attempts to become with third with 1,000. He is 659 yards shy of becoming the seventh quarterback with 6,000 career passing yards.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO ESPN3 IN TWO WEEKS

The Big South Conference is televising nine football games exclusively on ESPN3 this season as part of its "Game of the Week" package. The next broadcast will be Charlotte at Presbyterian College on Sept. 28 -- the second of two non-Conference games the Big South is televising this season for the first time. Overall, the Big South will appear on television every week of the season for the second consecutive year as a total of 23 games will be televised. The first League game on ESPN3 will be the Oct. 12 Gardner-Webb at Coastal Carolina contest.

FOGG ALERT

Liberty redshirt-senior **KEVIN FOGG** recorded a 29-yard pick-6 against Monmouth in Week 2 -- his sixth career return touchdown and first interception return TD. He is the first player in Big South history with return touchdowns on an interception (1), fumble (1), punt (1) and kickoff (3). Fogg is tied as the Big South's all-time leader for most kickoff return touchdowns, and coupled with his one career punt return score, he is second in League history with four kick return TDs. He needs one to tie the all-time mark of five, set by former Liberty WR **DOMINIC BOLDEN** (3 KR, 2 PR) from 2005-08.

EYES ON HAZEL

Coastal Carolina senior WR and Big South Preseason Offensive Player of the Year **MATT HAZEL** is the Big South's active career leader with 127 receptions (T-12th in League history), 1,729 receiving yards (17th) and 19 touchdowns (tied for 7th). He has also been named to the 2014 Senior Bowl Watch List as well as the South Carolina Football Hall of Fame College Player of the Year Award Watch List.

COMING ATTRACTIONS

The Big South Conference will welcome **MONMOUTH UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2014 and start-up program **KENNESAW STATE UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2015. Monmouth's addition will maintain the League's membership at six squads, while KSU's addition returns the Big South to seven members, which was the total from 2008-12. The Hawks got an early taste of League play with their 45-15 defeat at Liberty in Week 2. The Big South is 3-0 against Monmouth, with Coastal Carolina also earning wins in 2008 and 2009.

MOVING ON

VMI is playing its final campaign in the Big South this season, as the Keydets are rejoining the Southern Conference next fall. The Big South bid farewell to Stony Brook following the 2012 campaign with the Seawolves' move to the CAA after five years as an associate member.

* Coastal Carolina scored the first 14 points in its win at Eastern Kentucky. The Colonels then scored the next 24 to lead 24-14 with 10:14 left in the 2nd quarter. Coastal responded by scoring the final 17 points of the first half -- to lead 31-24 at the break -- and a total of 37 unanswered to lead 51-24 before EKU scored (and converted a 2-point play) with 40 seconds left in the game.

* Coastal rolled up 631 yards of total offense at EKU -- second-most in CCU history. In four starts as QB, **ALEX ROSS** has led CCU to two of its four best single-game offensive outputs.

* The Chants set a school record with 12 PBU, while junior **DENZEL RICE** tied a CCU record with four pass break-ups in the win over Eastern Kentucky.

* Coastal had 339 rushing yards at EKU. The Colonels were third in the nation in rush defense (66.5) through its first two games, including holding Louisville to just 78 yards in Week 2.

* Coastal improved to 6-10 when playing a ranked opponent.
