### CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### COASTAL CAROLINA OFFENSIVE LINE

Coastal's offensive line of **CHAD HAMILTON** (LT), **JAMEY CHEATWOOD** (LG), **KEVIN HART** (C), **MO ASHLEY** (RG) and **DREW HERRING** (RT) helped the Chanticleers roll up a school-record 652 yards of offense (355 rush, 297 pass) and average 7.5 yards per play in CCU's 53-28 win at Elon -- the third-highest offensive output against an FCS opponent in Big South history. The line paved the way for running back **LORENZO TALIAFERRO**, who rushed for 205 yards and three scores, and did not allow a sack as quarterback **ALEX ROSS** amassed 382 yards of offense and accounted for four touchdowns. Coastal scored on eight of its 14 possessions at Elon and surpassed 50 points, 300 rushing yards and 500 offensive yards for the third consecutive game.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### WILL HUNT • DE • R-Senior Charleston Southern • Greenville, S.C.

Hunt had five tackles, a sack and caused a fumble to lift the Buccaneers to a 27-24 win at Appalachian State. He recorded a key third down sack that forced a punt in the first quarter, and CSU scored on the ensuing drive to tie the game. Hunt was part of a defense that held the Mountaineers to 3-of-8 on third down and 0-of-2 on fourth down attempts.

### SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### MARK DEBOY • PK • R-Sophomore Charleston Southern • Fort Myers, Fla.

Deboy made a career-high two field goals in CSU's win at Appalachian State -- his first attempts of the season. His 32-yard field goal with 31 seconds remaining in the first half tied the game at 17-17, and his 21-yarder with 5:38 remaining in the third quarter gave the Bucs a 20-17 lead.

### THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

#### MATTHEW NICHOLSON • WR • Freshman VMI • Front Royal, Va.

Nicholson caught a career-high five passes for 86 yards and two touchdowns in VMI's double-overtime loss to Robert Morris. His two scores rallied the Keydets both times, as his first touchdown grab was a 10-yarder that tied the game at 7-7 in the first quarter. Nicholson's last-second Hail Mary 39-yard touchdown catch forced overtime and brought VMI back from a 31-24 deficit.

**BIG SOUTH SCORES RECORD NON-LEAGUE FCS WINS**

The Big South is 14-5 through 19 games against FCS opponents -- the most victories against non-Conference FCS foes in the League's 12-year football history. The previous best was 13 wins in 2006. The Big South has also assured itself of its first winning record against out-of-conference FCS members, as six non-Conference FCS games remain in the regular-season. The Big South is 6-1 against the SoCon this season, another all-time win mark and bests the previous high of four in 2006.

**AFTER FURTHER REVIEW**

The Big South is one of three FCS conferences utilizing video instant replay, as the League will use the technology during its final eight ESPN3 broadcasts. Replay was used for the first time this past Saturday in the Charlotte-Presbyterian game. Three calls were reviewed, and each confirmed the ruling on the field. The next replay game will be Gardner-Webb at Coastal Carolina game on Oct. 12.

**CHADWELL, TWO 5-0 TEAMS ALSO LEAGUE FIRSTS**

Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern each are 5-0 -- the first time in Big South football history that two teams opened the season 5-0 in the same year. In fact, the Big South is currently the only FCS Conference with two 5-0 teams among the five nationally (CSU, CCU, Towson, Sacred Heart and Fordham). It is third and fourth time that a Big South member has opened 5-0 -- and the second for Charleston Southern. The Chanticleers are 5-0 for the first time in school history, while the Buccaneers are 5-0 for the first time since opening the 2006 campaign with a 9-0 mark. In addition, new CSU head coach **JAMEY CHADWELL** is the first head coach to start 5-0 in his first season in the Big South.

**HIGH TIDE ALONG THE COAST**

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 6 this week in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 9 in *The Sports Network* ranking -- the highest for the Big South at this point in the season in League history. It is also the League's highest ranking in the Coaches poll, as the previous best was No. 8 (Coastal in 2005 and Stony Brook in 2012). In addition, Coastal Carolina is now the second team in Big South history to be ranked in BOTH polls each of the first six weeks of the regular-season (including preseason). The Chanticleers join former member Stony Brook, which was ranked in the Top 25 every week of the 2012 campaign. The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 26 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24).

**RED STORM RISING**

Gardner-Webb is nationally-ranked for the second consecutive week, as the Runnin' Bulldogs are No. 24/25. It is the first time in 11 seasons that GWU has appeared in the national polls, as the last time was in the 2003 *USA Today*/ESPN Coaches Poll (No. 25 in preseason/Week 1). It is Gardner-Webb's first appearance in *The Sports Network* Top 25 since the 2002 campaign. Coupled with Coastal Carolina's national ranking, it is the earliest that the Big South has had two teams ranked in the same week, as well as the third-straight year and fourth time overall in League history that two Big South teams were ranked at the same time.

**REAL ESTATE ACQUISITION**

Coastal Carolina surpassed 500 yards of offense for the third consecutive week with a school-record 652 at Elon this past Saturday -- becoming the third team in Big South history to achieve this feat. The Chants had 631 total offensive yards in Week 3 at Eastern Kentucky and 511 against Hampton in Week 4. Coastal joins Gardner-Webb (Sept. 3-24, 2005) and Stony Brook (Nov. 1-15, 2008) as the only Big South members with three consecutive 500-yard games. Meanwhile, Coastal's season average of 507.6 yards of offense is pacing way ahead of the Big South single-season record of 468.1 established by the Chanticleers in 2006.

**RECORD ROAD WARRIORS**


The Big South has won eight of its 14 FCS games on the road this season -- a League record. Charleston Southern has collected four of those wins in succession, a school-record and tied for the second-longest road winning streak in League history. That record is five, which was established by Liberty from Oct. 20, 2007 to Oct. 4, 2008. Coastal Carolina has won three-straight FCS road games and seven of its last eight.

**BLUE SWARM**

Charleston Southern leads the Big South with a +7 turnover margin, as the Buccaneers have forced a League-high eight fumbles (tied with Coastal) while recovering seven miscues and intercepting three passes. The Bucs have also recorded 30 tackles-for-loss, tied for second in the Big South.

**HOME RUNS**

Liberty and Charleston Southern have the League's top two longest active home win streaks. Liberty has won seven consecutive games at Williams Stadium, which is the Flames' longest since winning 10-straight home games from Oct. 3, 2009 to Sept. 17, 2011. The Buccaneers' run stands at five-straight, which is their longest since winning seven consecutive home games from Sept. 27, 2008 to Oct. 3, 2009.

**BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL "GAME OF THE WEEK" RETURNS IN TWO WEEKS**

The Big South Conference is televising nine football games exclusively on ESPN3 this season as part of its "Game of the Week" package. The next broadcast will be next Saturday's Gardner-Webb at Coastal Carolina game. Overall, the Big South will appear on television every week of the season for the second consecutive year as a total of 23 games will be televised. The nine-game ESPN3 package included two televised non-Conference match-ups for the first time.

**TEN-TAMOUNT**

Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** is the first player in Big South history to score 10 touchdowns in his team's first five games. He leads the League with 11 TDs (10 rushing and one receiving), becoming the fastest player to reach double-digits in touchdowns. Taliaferro has scored a touchdown in every game this season, the second-straight year a Big South player has reached the end zone in each of his team's first five games (Stony Brook's **MIGUEL MAYSONET**). Taliaferro owns a streak of three consecutive multi-TD games, the longest in the Big South since Maysonet's League-record streak of six consecutive games with at least two scores in 2012.

**REYES OF SUNSHINE**

Charleston Southern RB **CHRISTIAN REYES** is second in the Big South with 516 rushing yards. It is the highest rushing total by a Buccaneer rusher after five games since the before the League began football in 2002. In fact, Reyes' total is 60 yards away from matching the Bucs' leading rushing total from last season (576 - **TEDDY ALLEN**), and he has already surpassed CSU's top individual rusher from 2006-11. The last Buccaneer to rush for more than 600 yards in a season was **ANDRE COPELAND** in 2005 (721).

**BUC-ING THE TREND**

Charleston Southern completed its three-game road swing with a perfect 3-0 mark and has won a school-record four consecutive road games. It was the third consecutive season that the Buccaneers played three-in-a-row away from home and the fifth time in the last six years -- including twice in 2008.

**KEEPING TALLIES ON TALIAFERRO**

Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** has rushed for 691 yards through the Chanticleers' first five games, the second-most in Big South history after a team's first five contests. The record is 800, set by Stony Brook's **MIGUEL MAYSONET** last season. Taliaferro's 138.2 rushing yards per game is pacing ahead of **PATRICK HALL**'s school record of 100.6 during the 2004 season, which Hall finished with a school record 1,107 rushing yards.

**50-50 PROPOSITION**

Coastal Carolina is the first team in Big South history to score 50 points in three consecutive games against non-Conference FCS opponents. The streak began with 51 at Eastern Kentucky in Week 3, followed by 50 points against Hampton in Week 4, and 53 at Elon this past Saturday. The Chants have tied the Big South mark for most consecutive 50-point games, joining Gardner-Webb (Nov. 20, 2004 - Sept. 10, 2005) and Liberty (Oct. 31 - Nov. 14, 2009). The Elon contest was also Coastal's 14th 50-point game in program history, the second-most in Big South annals. Liberty holds that record with 16.

**POINT OF ORDER**

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 90, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (21). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's active leader for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 34, the third-longest streak in Big South history. That record is 45 games, established by the Flames from Sept. 23, 2006 - Sept. 18, 2010.

**HIGH RATE OF RETURN**

Coastal Carolina has rushed for more than 300 yards in three consecutive games (358.7 average in that span), the first Big South member since Stony Brook in 2011 to surpass the threshold in three-straight contests, and the fourth time overall. Coastal Carolina is 10-1 in its last 11 games when rushing for more than 200 yards, including 4-0 this season. The Chanticleers have rushed for more than 200 yards 54 times in its history, and are 49-5 (=.907) when reaching 200 rushing yards.

**PRESS ON**

Gardner-Webb senior DE **PRESTON PEMASA** is second in Big South history with 41.5 career tackles-for-loss -- the second player in League history with at least 40 career stops behind the line of scrimmage. Pemasa, who has recorded a TFL in all five games this season, is also eighth in the Conference record book with 13.5 quarterback sacks and is 4.0 sacks shy of moving into second in that category. Former Gardner-Webb All-American **BRIAN JOHNSTON** is the Big South's all-time leader in both categories with 53.5 TFL and 20.5 sacks.

**THAT 70's SHOW**

Liberty defeated Kentucky Wesleyan, 73-7 this past Saturday, the fourth-straight year a Big South member has lit the scoreboard for 70 points. It is tied for the third-most points in a game in League history, as the Flames also tallied 73 points against VMI on Nov. 10, 2007. Saturday's output was the sixth 70-point game in the Big South record book.

**BIG TIME RUSH**

Charleston Southern rushed for 298 yards this past Saturday at Appalachian State, the first time the Buccaneers have gained 200 yards on the ground in three consecutive games against non-Conference FCS opponents since the Big South began football in 2002. CSU has rushed for more than 200 yards in a game eight times since the start of the 2012 season, and has gone 7-1 in those contests.

**BUYING STOCK IN KORDENBROCK**

VMI quarterback **ERIC KORDENBROCK** tallied his third 300-yard passing game of the season with 359 against Robert Morris this past Saturday. It is the most 300-yard passing games in a season since Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** had four last year. Kordenbrock now has four career 300-yard passing games, tied with Beatty for third-most in League history. Meanwhile, Kordenbrock's efforts this season include back-to-back 300-yard passing games -- the first Keydet QB with two-straight 300-yard passing games since 1986 when **DAVE BROWN** threw for 422 yards against Appalachian State and followed with 390 yards the next week at East Tennessee State.

**SPEAKING OF BEATTY...**

Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** was 21-of-25 passing this past Saturday against Point, and his 84.0 completion percentage is the second-highest in a single-game in Big South history based on 20-29 completions. Beatty owns the record with his 84.4 percentage on 27-of-32 passing at Liberty last season on Oct. 6.

**THIS SECONDARY IS ON FIRE**

Liberty intercepted four passes and returned them for 148 yards this past Saturday against Kentucky Wesleyan, the fourth-highest interception return yards in a single-game in Big South history. The Flames now own three of the top four defensive efforts. Meanwhile, DB **KEVIN FOGG** is now eighth all-time in League annals with 134 career interception return yards and needs two picks to become the ninth player with 10 career INTs.

**TONIGHT ON 20/20**

Coastal Carolina has scored at least 20 points in 13 consecutive games, dating back to last season -- the longest current streak in the Big South and the Chanticleers' longest such streak since scoring 20 points in 20 consecutive contests from Sept. 24, 2005 to Nov. 25, 2006. Coastal's 53 points at Elon this past week was its most scored against a non-Conference FCS foe since scoring 66 points vs. Savannah State on Nov. 4, 2006.

**KORDENBROCK IS LOCKED IN**

VMI senior QB **ERIC KORDENBROCK** needs 262 passing yards to become the seventh quarterback in Big South history with 6,000 career passing yards. He is third all-time in the Conference record book with 541 completions and 1,000 attempts, and is chasing former Gardner-Webb QB **NICK ROBERTS** for second in both categories. Roberts had 597 completions and 1,007 attempts during his career from 2002-05. Kordenbrock's 5,738 career yards is seventh all-time in League annals, and with 30 career TD passes, he is two shy of cracking the Top 10 in that category.

**FOGG ALERT**

Liberty redshirt-senior **KEVIN FOGG** recorded a 29-yard pick-6 against Monmouth in Week 2 -- his sixth career return touchdown and first interception return TD. He is the first player in Big South history with return touchdowns on an interception (1), fumble (1), punt (1) and kickoff (3). Fogg is tied as the Big South's all-time leader for most kickoff return touchdowns, and coupled with his one career punt return score, he is second in League history with four kick return TDs. He needs one to tie the all-time mark of five, set by former Liberty WR **DOMINIC BOLDEN** (3 KR, 2 PR) from 2005-08.

**WHISTLING DIXON**

Charleston Southern QB **MALCOLM DIXON**, who became the sixth quarterback in the Conference record books to surpass 1,000 career rushing yards, is fifth on the list with 1,262 and is 25 yards shy of moving past VMI's **KYLE HUGHES** (1,286) for fourth-place. Meanwhile, Dixon needs 236 passing yards to become just the fourth QB in League annals with 1,000 career rushing yards and 3,000 career passing yards.

**ROSS FOR MORE**

In his last three games, Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is 53-of-78 passing for 713 yards and three touchdowns with a 171.78 quarterback efficiency. He has also rushed 30 times for 214 yards (7.1 average) and three scores, generating 309.0 yards of offense in that span.

**GARDNER-WEBB SCORES LEAGUE FIRST -- BACK-TO-BACK WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS**

Gardner-Webb blanked No. 8/10 Wofford, 3-0, in Week 4 -- becoming the first team in Big South history to defeat nationally-ranked opponents in consecutive weeks. The Runnin' Bulldogs knocked off then-No. 11/15 Richmond in Week 3 (12-10), also without a touchdown. The Wofford win gave the Big South a League-record three wins over ranked teams in 2013. Meanwhile, GWU won its first road game against a non-Conference foe since Sept. 12, 2009 at Western Carolina, and the Wofford win was Gardner-Webb's first over a ranked team on the road since a 38-35 win at No. 23 New Hampshire on Nov. 11, 2000.

**BEWARE OF THE DOG**

Gardner-Webb held No. 8/10 Wofford to 144 net rushing yards, 97 yards below the Terriers' season average of 241.7. The Runnin' Bulldogs have held its three FCS opponents to 10.3 points, 81.3 rushing yards and 233.3 yards of total offense per game thus far in 2013. GWU limited Richmond to just 10 net rushing yards in Week 3, the second-fewest allowed against a non-Conference FCS opponent in League history. The fewest net rushing yards allowed by a Big South member to a non-Conference FCS foe is minus-4 -- VMI vs. St. Francis (Pa.) on Sept. 6, 2008.

**THREE-AND-IN**

Gardner-Webb's 3-0 victory over No. 8/10 Wofford established the Big South record for lowest scoring game. It was the Conference's first shutout of a non-League FCS opponent since 2008 when VMI defeated St. Francis (Pa.), 49-0 in the season opener. It was Gardner-Webb's first shutout since a 65-0 victory over Southern Virginia in 2009 (a span of 41 games) and its first shutout of an FCS opponent since blanking Savannah State, 66-0, in 2007. The shutout of Wofford was Gardner-Webb's seventh as a Big South member -- tied with Liberty for the most in League annals.

**BIG SOUTH SCORES LEAGUE FIRST WITH TWO WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS IN SAME WEEK**

For the first time in League history, the Big South defeated two nationally-ranked teams in the same week of the regular-season as Gardner-Webb upset No. 11/15 Richmond and Coastal Carolina won at No. 25 Eastern Kentucky in Week 3. It was the second time overall in the Conference record book, as the Chants and former member Stony Brook achieved the feat in the first round of the 2012 FCS Playoffs. GWU also handed Richmond its first non-conference FCS loss since 2005 -- ending the Spiders' 17-game win streak in such games. Meanwhile, the Chants' win at EKU improved the Big South to 4-7 all-time when a ranked Big South team plays a nationally-ranked non-Conference opponent.

**COASTAL CAROLINA SETS BIG SOUTH SCORING RECORDS AGAINST A RANKED TEAM**

Coastal Carolina's 51 points at No. 25 Eastern Kentucky was the most scored by a Big South member against a nationally-ranked non-Conference opponent in League history. The previous high was 35 by the Chanticleers in last season's playoff loss at Old Dominion. Coastal's 19-point victory over the Colonels is the Big South's second-largest margin of victory against a ranked non-Conference team, just after Liberty's 23-point win over No. 12 Elon in 2008.

**MASTRO OF THE UNIVERSE**

Coastal Carolina senior **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO** is the Big South's all-time leader for punt returns (70) and punt return yards (605). He is the third player in Big South history with at least 100 combined kickoff/punt returns in a career, as he is third all-time with 117 (47 KR, 70 PR). He needs 11 returns to break the Conference record of 127, which is held by former VMI standout **TIM MAYPRAY**. Maypray returned 98 kickoffs and 29 punts in his career from 2006-09. Meanwhile, Mastromatteo is the only player in the Conference record books with two punt returns of at least 80 yards.

**INSIDE THE TACKLE BOX**

Coastal Carolina junior LB **QUINN BACKUS** became the 39th player in Big South history with 200 career tackles when he surpassed the milestone at Eastern Kentucky in Week 3. His career total now stands at 215, which includes 114 solo stops, and needs 45 tackles to enter the League's all-time Top 20. Presbyterian College junior LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** became the 38th player in the 200-tackle club during Week 2, and his career numbers stand at 209 tackles and 110 solo hits.

**MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR THIS ONE**

Coastal Carolina leads the League in scoring offense and is fourth in the nation at 43.2 points, while Liberty tops the Conference in scoring defense at 15.8 points allowed to rank eighth nationally. The two teams will meet this season in Lynchburg on Oct. 19 for the 11th time. The series is tied at 5-5, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship eight times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Coastal won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2012 as well as 2010.

**COAST-TO-COAST**

Coastal Carolina ran 91 plays against Hampton in Week 4, the fifth-most in a single-game in Big South history. It was the most offensive plays run by a Big South team since Gardner-Webb's 94 against Western Carolina on Sept. 18, 2010. Coastal's 91 plays vs. the Pirates included a school-record 69 rushes -- tied for the third-most in a single-game in the League record book. The Chanticleers also amassed a Big South single-game record 27 rushing first downs, bettering the old mark of 26 by Stony Brook against Iona on Nov. 8, 2008. The Chants tallied 34 total first downs against Hampton, the second-most in a game and the most-ever against an FCS opponent.

**CSU'S SEASON STARTS WITH DIX-ON**

Charleston Southern dual-threat QB **MALCOLM DIXON** became the first quarterback in Big South history with back-to-back games of 100 yards rushing and 100 yards passing when he achieved the feat in Weeks 2 and 3. He rushed for 135 yards and passed for 140 in Week 3 at Campbell after gaining 102 rushing yards and 123 passing yards against Shorter in Week 2. Now the fifth quarterback in Big South history with two career 100-yard rushing and passing games, Dixon is the second quarterback in League annals to rush for 100 yards in consecutive contests. The first was VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008.

**BLOUNT FORCE**

Gardner-Webb RB **JUANNE BLOUNT**'s 35 rushing attempts at Wofford in Week 4 is tied for the third-most in a single-game in Big South history. It was the most rushing carries by a Big South player since Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** had 35 at Coastal Carolina on Oct. 4, 2008. Meanwhile, Blount became the first Runnin' Bulldog with more than 400 rushing yards (420) after four games since **KENNY LITTLE** in 2011 (407), and Blount's total was the most rushing yards by a GWU back through four games since before the Big South began football in 2002.

**COMBO MEAL**

Coastal Carolina (631) and Eastern Kentucky (477) combined for 1,108 yards in Week 3. The combined yardage is the sixth-highest total in Big South history, and the Chanticleers have been involved in three of the top six. Coastal has the top spot (1,212 with Old Dominion on Dec. 2, 2012) and also the third-highest (1,143 with Gardner-Webb on Nov. 3, 2012).

**DAY'S BIG DAY**

Gardner-Webb PK **JORDAN DAY** tied the Big South single-game record with his four field goals against No. 11/15 Richmond in Week 3, as he scored all 12 points in the Runnin' Bulldogs' 12-10 victory. Day is the eighth different kicker in League history to make four field goals in a game, and the first since former GWU kicker **TREVER AUSTIN** on Oct. 22, 2011 against Coastal Carolina.

**COMING ATTRACTIONS**

The Big South Conference will welcome **MONMOUTH UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2014 and start-up program **KENNESAW STATE UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2015. Monmouth's addition will maintain the League's membership at six squads, while KSU's addition returns the Big South to seven members, which was the total from 2008-12. The Hawks got an early taste of League play with their 45-15 defeat at Liberty in Week 2. The Big South is 3-0 against Monmouth, with Coastal Carolina also earning wins in 2008 and 2009.

**MOVING ON**

VMI is playing its final campaign in the Big South this season, as the Keydets are rejoining the Southern Conference next fall. The Big South bid farewell to Stony Brook following the 2012 campaign with the Seawolves' move to the CAA after five years as an associate member.

\* Coastal Carolina is idle this Saturday and returns to action Oct. 12 in its Big South opener against Gardner-Webb.

\* Coastal actually trailed 27-25 late in the second quarter at Elon. The Phoenix gained 255 yards (231 on the ground) in the first half before CCU scored a go-ahead TD with 28 seconds left as part of a 28-0 run to end the game.

\* The CCU defense was dominant in the second half, pitching a shutout and allowing Elon to gain just 78 yards of total offense (48 in the third quarter and 30 in the fourth). In fact, 58 of Elon's 78 yards came on one drive in the 3rd quarter (13 plays covering 5:08) that ended in a missed 34-yard field goal. In the second half, Elon rushed 13 times for 45 yards and was just 6-of-13 passing for 33 yards.

\* Coastal Carolina set a school record with 652 yards of total offense at Elon, which is the 10th-best total in the NCAA FCS this season and seventh-best in Big South history.

\* Starting late in game two of the season versus Furman, CCU has now scored on 26 of its last 41 drives (63.4 percent), not including three "victory" formations.

\* In six career starts at quarterback, **ALEX ROSS** has led CCU to three of the program's top-five, single-game total offensive efforts. He is also 6-0 in that span.

\* **LORENZO TALIAFERRO's** 205 rushing yards and 32 attempts at Elon rank second on the CCU single-game list.

\* Five of **JOSH WOODRUM**'s six pass completions Saturday were to **DARRIN PETERSON**, including both of his touchdown passes.
