#### WELCOME MAT

Just one of the Big South's four new head coaches won in his coaching debut. Campbell's **KEVIN McGEEHAN** picked up his first victory as a collegiate head coach in his first game at the helm of the Camels wth Campbell's 87-62 home victory over Shenandoah on Nov. 8. The League's other new coaches debuted against formidable foes in No. 1 Kentucky (UNC Asheville's **NICK McDEVITT**), Xavier (Gardner-Webb's **TIM CRAFT**) and South Carolina (Longwood's **JAYSON GEE**).

#### **CLASS ACT**

High Point graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY** is among the 30 candidates for the national Senior CLASS Award. He is the Big South's first official candidate since Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** in 2011-12.

#### **BUILDING HOME EQUITY**

The Big South went 6-0 in its home games this past weekend, with VMI picking up two victories in winning the All-Military Classic at Cameron Hall. Campbell, Charleston Southern, Liberty and Winthrop were the Conference's other winners at home during the season-opening weekend.

#### **ELDER STATESMEN**

With the departure of UNC Asheville's **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** after 17 years as head coach of the Bulldogs, VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** and Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** are now the longest-tenured Big South coaches, as each is in his ninth year. Baucom's Big South tenure will end after this season with VMI's departure to the Southern Conference on July 1, 2014.

#### **CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER**

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is sixth all-time in Big South history with 120 victories at the Institute, while Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** ranks eighth with his 113 wins at Coastal Carolina. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** sits in ninth-place all-time in League annals with 109 victories.

#### WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern junior guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 14 times in their young career (nine times last season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 12-2 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 14 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

#### THE D.J.'S

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** is eighth all-time in Big South history with 182 career blocked shots and is 18 away from becoming the sixth player with 200. He is also tied for 55th on the Big South's career rebounding list with 563. Already one of 10 players in League annals with 500 rebounds and 150 blocked shots, Cunningham is on pace to become the fifth player in Big South history with 600 rebounds and 200 blocks in 2013-14. Meanwhile, VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** is ninth in Big South history with 170 career blocked shots. He needs 66 rebounds for 500 in his career, which would make him the 11th player in League history with 500 boards and 150 rejections.

#### **BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,252 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 1,014 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

#### **BIG BURRUS IS BACK**

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS** returned to the Flames' lineup after missing all of 2012-13 with an injury. He is looking to join the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club, which currently stands at 18 members. Burrus has tallied 105 rejections in his career — tied for 28th in League annals, and has 457 career rebounds to his credit. He would become just the second Liberty player on the list, joining Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97.

#### HIGH POINT'S JOHN BROWN VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

High Point redshirt-sophomore forward **JOHN BROWN** is the 2013-14 Big South Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year. Brown becomes the first sophomore in League history to be voted Preseason Player of the Year, and is High Point's third-ever preseason honoree. Brown was the Big South's Freshman of the Year in 2012-13 as he was the top scoring freshman during the regular-season at 16.4 points per game. Just the second freshman ever to be voted First-Team All-Conference, Brown was a Kyle Macy Freshman All-American Team member by *Collegeinsider.com* last season. He finished the campaign third in the Big South in field goal percentage (51.9), sixth in block shots (1.21), seventh in steals (1.71) and 12th in rebounding (6.1). Brown scored at least 20 points 12 times last season—tied for third-most in the Big South and he registered double-figure points in 25 of his 28 games. He also notched four double-doubles—three of which were 20-point/10-rebound performances. Brown earned a spot on the Preseason All-Conference First-Team, which appears below:

#### **NORTH DIVISION**

#### CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

In the Division I head coaching debut of **KEVIN McGEEHAN**, Campbell improved to 7-1 in its last eight opening games and won its eighth-straight home opener. The last time CU dropped its first home game was in 2005 (90-81 loss to San Diego at Carter Gym). Campbell has won all six of its home openers at Gore Arena ... **DARIUS LEONARD** scored a career-high 18 points vs. Shenandoah and added nine rebounds ... **RECO McCARTER** set career-highs with six steals and three blocks, while scoring 12 points and dealing four assists vs. the Hornets ... Freshman PG **QUINTON RAY** pulled down eight rebounds vs. Shenandoah ... Campbell plays at Appalachian State (Tues.) and N.C. State (Sat.) this weekend in the Global Sports Shootout. The Camels defeated the Mountaineers 101-82 last year at Buies Creek. CU dropped an 87-81 decision at N.C. State in December 2011.

#### **HIGH POINT PANTHERS**

Graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY** scored 21 points with 12 rebounds in High Point's season opener at UNCG. He led the team with 33 minutes played, hit nine field goals and went 3-for-3 from the free throw line.

#### LIBERTY FLAMES

Playing in front of a Vines Center crowd of 7,043, the Flames christened the 2013-14 season with a 21-point win, defeating Randolph College, 74-53. The attendance mark is the highest at the Vines Center since the Flames squared off with Clemson in front of 8,143 spectators on Nov. 17, 2009 ... Junior **TOMASZ GIELO** paced Liberty with 14 points, followed by **ANDREW SMITH**, who had 10 tallies and set a career high with eight rebounds ... In his first game back since missing the entire 2012-13 season, redshirt senior forward **ANTWAN BURRUS** had eight points and five rebounds in 26 minutes of action.

#### LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood (0-1) dropped its season-opening game at South Carolina, 82-44. Senior TRISTAN CAREY led the Lancers with 12 points in the much-anticipated first game of the JAYSON GEE era. Sophomore LUCAS WOODHOUSE added nine points and a game-high four assists, while redshirt-junior JEYLANI DUBLIN finished with eight points off the bench. Sophomore KARL ZIEGLER contributed five points and seven rebounds, and freshman ISAAC BELTON had five points and a game-high three steals ... Longwood will remain on the road to play at TCU of the Big 12 Conference on Nov. 12 at 8 p.m. ET at the Daniel-Meyer Coliseum in Fort Worth, Texas. The TCU game will be televised on FOX Sports Southwest Plus ... The Lancers will play their home opener against Division II Mars Hill on Nov. 16 at 5 p.m. at Willett Hall in Farmville.

#### RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Radford finished the week 0-1 after opening its season Friday with a 76-54 loss at George Washington. YA YA ANDERSON scored 15 points off the bench to lead the Highlanders ... George Washington used a 16-6 run over the first nine minutes of the second half to put the game away ... RU now prepares for Monday's home opener vs. Chattanooga. Radford is 34-5 all-time in home openers, and has not lost a home opener in 10-straight seasons. The last team to defeat RU in its first game of the season in Dedmon was Hampton in the 2002-03 season.

#### VMI KEYDETS

VMI's All-Military Classic title was the program's first regular season tourney trophy since the 1978 Siena College Tournament in Loudonville, N.Y. (January 3-4, 1978) ... VMI's 71-63 win over Air Force was the program's first over a service academy since a 93-65 win over Army at Cameron Hall on Nov. 13, 2009 ... VMI started two freshmen in its opening game line-up (CRAIG HINTON and QJ PETERSON) against The Citadel, marking the first time a frosh had been in the season opening starting lineup since RODNEY GLASGOW against Randolph College on Nov. 12, 2010 ... Glasgow joined Peterson (MVP) on the All-Military Classic All-Tourney team and averaged 18 points and 4.5 assists over the two games ... Redshirt sophomore forward JORDAN WEETHEE, sidelined by a knee injury the entire 2012-13 season, returned to action with flair as he logged the Keydets' first double-double of the year with 10 points and 11 rebounds. He also threw down a dramatic first half dunk that was tagged as ESPN SportsCenter's "Top Play of the Day."

#### **SOUTH DIVISION**

#### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

The Bucs opened the 2013-14 season with a 130-51 blowout of Johnson University at the Buc Dome on Friday night. CSU made its first 10 shots of the night and shot 83 percent from the floor in the first half. Junior forward CEDRICK BOWEN led five players in double figures with a career-high 20 points, and added a career-best 10 rebounds as CSU posted a whopping 50-15 advantage on the glass ... At Delaware on Sunday, SAAH NIMLEY scored 24 points and buried a tough step back jumper late as CSU held off the Blue Hens for a wild 95-93 win. Nimley's contested 18-footer gave the Bucs a 95-89 advantage with 1:06 remaining.

#### COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chants went 0-1 last week to open the season as they fell 72-63 at the University of Akron ... CCU is now 4-12 when opening the season on the road ... Five Chants made their CCU debut, including three freshmen ... Freshman **ELIJAH WILSON** paced the Chanticleer offense with 15 points on 5-of-11 shooting ... Senior **EL HADJI NDIEGUENE**, who missed the first four weeks of practice with a back injury, came off the bench to led the team in rebounding with seven boards ... CCU takes on Guilford College Monday night in its home opener before hosting SEC Tournament Champion Ole Miss on Saturday.

#### GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb suffered its first loss by more than 20 points in nearly two full seasons when it dropped an 83-59 decision at Xavier. The last time GWU lost by as many points came at Indiana in November, 2011. GWU had not suffered a 20-point loss since then until Friday night ... Gardner-Webb jumped out to a 7-0 lead on the Big East Musketeers and led 9-3 after **NAJI HIBBERT** drained his first jumper off an in-bounds play with 14:04 left. Hibbert turned his ankle on that shot, however, and was limited the rest of the way -- missing the entire second half ... Gardner-Webb point guards **TYLER STRANGE** (6 assists) and **JOSH CASTELLANOS** (3 assists) combined for nine assists and just one turnover in a solid outing for the position.

#### PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

It was a 2-3 possession game for much of the first half against Georgia Tech. Up by just two, 34-32, with 1:48 to go in the first half, the Yellow Jackets scored eight unanswered to take a 10-point lead at the half, the first double-digit lead of the game. Georgia Tech continued its offense explosion in the second half for the eventual 31-point win, 88-57. **JORDAN DOWNING** led the squad with 22 points ... Just three current Blue Hose have ever started a game at PC, for a total of 58 games . The Blue Hose return six players who have combined for 149 games played.

#### **UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS**

UNC Asheville lost at top-ranked Kentucky Friday night, 89-57. The Bulldogs led by one on three occasions in the first half. **WILL WEEKS** scored 19 points and had seven rebounds in the loss to the Wildcats. **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** just missed a double-double with eight points and 10 rebounds. ... Asheville plays its first eight games away from home to start the season. The Bulldogs are at Western Carolina Monday night and College of Charleston Friday evening ... Cunningham was credited with two blocked shots at Kentucky and now has 182 career blocks. He is in third-place on the school's all-time career list and needs nine to move past **C.J. WALKER** (190) into second-place.

#### WINTHROP EAGLES

Freshman **KEON JOHNSON** started his first collegiate game and scored 16 of his 19 points in the second half to help Winthrop overcome an eight-point second half deficit and defeat Roanoke College, 93-74 on Saturday. His lone bucket of the first half cut the deficit to single-digits at 9 points at the 6:31 mark. Johnson opened up the second half by scoring the first eight points for the Eagles and had them within two points with 17:27 left. He made two free throws to cut the deficit to six, then made a three-point play two possessions later to cut the lead to five and then hit a three-pointer to make it a 2-point game. At the 14:53 mark the Eagles took their first lead since the first 2 ½ minutes of the game and after a Roanoke miss, Johnson buried a three for a four-point advantage that Winthrop quickly turned into a double-figure lead.
