CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

CHRISTIAN REYES • RB • Junior
 Charleston Southern • Rogue River, Ore.

Buoyed by his offensive line of **ERIK AUSTELL**, **BLAKE STONE**, **JACKSON WILLIAMSON**, **CLAYTON TRUITT** and **BENNY TIMMONS**, Reyes rushed for 117 yards on 24 carries and scored two touchdowns in the Buccaneers' 31-26 victory over Coastal Carolina. He also caught two passes for 13 yards to finish the day with 130 all-purpose yards. Reyes scored CSU's final two touchdowns of the day -- a 10-yarder that pushed the Bucs' lead to 24-3 in the second quarter and a three-yard score for a 31-6 advantage early in the third period.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

JACOB HAGEN • DB • R-Junior
 Liberty • Orange Park, Fla.

Hagen tallied nine tackles (six solo, three assisted), a half-tackle for loss, a forced fumble, an interception and a pass break-up in the Flames' victory over Presbyterian. He was the team's top tackler while his six solo stops alone would have been second-most on the squad. Hagen was involved in both of Liberty's two takeaways and each led to points. With PC at the Liberty 10-yard line, Hagen forced a fumble that was recovered by the Flames and led to an eventual touchdown. Just before halftime, Hagen intercepted a deep pass and returned it 44 yards to set-up Liberty's third TD of the day.

Christopher made field goals from 39 and 52 yards and added three PATs to finish with nine points in the Keydets' 27-9 win over Gardner-Webb. His 39-yarder extended VMI's lead to 10-0 in the first half, while his career-long 52-yarder in the third quarter gave the Keydets a 20-3 advantage. It also marked the second-longest field goal made by a freshman in Big South history.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

DANIEL CROGHAN III • QB • R-Freshman
 Charleston Southern • Charleston, S.C.

Croghan amassed 209 yards of total offense and helped direct the Buccaneers to more than 40 minutes in time of possession in CSU's win over Coastal. He was 14-of-21 passing for 166 yards and a touchdown, and rushed nine times for 43 yards for an average of 4.8 per carry. Croghan finished the day with a 129.73 pass efficiency rating.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN EMERGES AS VICTOR IN MATCH-UP OF RANKED BIG SOUTH TEAMS

Charleston Southern defeated Coastal Carolina, 31-26 this past Saturday in the first match-up of ranked Big South teams from the two major FCS polls (*The Sports Network* and FCS Coaches). The Bucs led 31-6 before the Chanticleers tallied 20 unanswered points for the final margin. The win marks CSU's first-ever 3-0 start in Big South play.

PRELUDE TO A CHAMPIONSHIP?

As mentioned above, Charleston Southern is 3-0 in the Big South for the first time, and it marks the 16th time in League history -- and second this season -- that a member has opened 3-0 in Conference action. A 3-0 Big South start has occurred each year of Big South football, and 13 of those squads gave gone on to win/share the Big South Championship. The only team not to win the League title after starting 3-0 was Liberty in 2011 (second-place).

PIRATE'S TREASURE

Charleston Southern is the fourth team in League history to win 10 games in a season, which ties the Big South record for most victories in a campaign. The Buccaneers join Coastal Carolina (2004) and Liberty (2008) as the squad's to reach double-digit wins during the regular-season, as well as Stony Brook (2012) in the 10-win club. CSU will attempt to become the first Big South team to win 11 games this weekend.

FIT TO BE TIED

Charleston Southern snapped Coastal Carolina's 14-game regular-season win streak this past Saturday, which tied for the longest such streak in Big South history. The record was first set by the Buccaneers, who won 14 consecutive regular-season contests from Oct. 15, 2005 - Nov. 4, 2006.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN CAN CLINCH AT LEAST A SHARE OF BIG SOUTH TITLE ON SATURDAY

Charleston Southern can clinch at least a share of the 2013 Big South football championship with a victory at Gardner-Webb on Saturday. A win would move the Bucs to 4-0 in League play with a game remaining, and at worst CSU could finish in that scenario is 4-1. A loss Saturday keeps the title race open.

GARDNER-WEBB TO PLAY FOURTH NATIONALLY-RANKED OPPONENT SATURDAY

Saturday's Charleston Southern at Gardner-Webb games marks the fourth nationally-ranked opponent the Runnin' Bulldogs will play this season, tying the Big South record that has occurred nine times (Liberty and Coastal Carolina were the last to do so in 2012). GWU is 2-1 against ranked foes this year, including back-to-back wins in September.

BLUE SWARM

Charleston Southern is nationally-ranked for the sixth consecutive week, as the Buccaneers are No. 12 in this week's FCS Coaches poll and No. 13 in *The Sports Network* ranking. It is the highest ranking in program history, and marks the first time the Big South has had two teams inside the Top 15 at any point in the season. CSU entered the Top 25 rankings this season for the first time since the week of Nov. 6, 2006, following the Bucs' 9-0 start to the season (No. 24 - *Sports Network*, No. 25 - Coaches). The Big South has had three teams ranked this year -- the second time in League history that three teams were nationally-ranked in a season.

REYES OF SUNSHINE

Charleston Southern RB **CHRISTIAN REYES** is the first player in school history to rush for 1,000 yards in a season. He ranks second in the Big South with 1,184 rushing yards, and has six 100-yard rushing efforts to his credit. Reyes became CSU's single-season rushing leader in Week 9 during the Charlotte game as he eclipsed the previous mark of 774 (**VINSON BLAIR** in 1998).

DOUBLE DIP THE CHIP?


This Saturday, Coastal Carolina will attempt to give the Big South two 10-win teams for the first time in League history. It is the second time in the Conference record books that two teams have won at least nine regular-season games in the same season. Charleston Southern (10-1) and Coastal Carolina (9-1) join their 2006 counterparts, as both programs won nine regular-season games that season.

ALL'S WELL WITH CHADWELL

Charleston Southern head coach **JAMEY CHADWELL** is the first head coach to win 10 games in his first season in the Big South. The previous high for most wins by a new head coach in his first season in the League was eight wins -- Coastal Carolina's **JOE MOGLIA** in 2012.

HOME RUNS

Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina have the League's top two longest active home win streaks. The Bucs have won eight consecutive games at Buccaneer Field, which is CSU's longest since winning 12 consecutive home games from Oct. 15, 2005 - Oct. 6, 2007. The Chanticleers' run stands at seven-straight, which is their longest since winning 12 consecutive home games from Sept. 11, 2004 - Nov. 12, 2005.

RECORD ROAD WARRIORS

Charleston Southern's six road wins this year are the most in League history. The first Big South team to win at least five *regular-season* road games in a season, the Bucs eclipsed the previous record of five overall road wins (regular-season and postseason) that was set by Coastal Carolina in 2012. Earlier this season, Charleston Southern matched the Big South record for longest road winning streak (5). Liberty first set the mark with its five consecutive road wins from Oct. 20, 2007 - Oct. 4, 2008.

"LO-REND-ZONE"

Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** has 22 total touchdowns this season, one shy of matching the single-season record of 23 set by Stony Brook's **MIGUEL MAYSONET** last season. Taliaferro, who is the third player in Big South history with 20 touchdowns in a season, has scored 21 rushing touchdowns to equal the League mark that Maysonet set in 2012. Taliaferro is the first player in Big South history with five 3-TD games in a campaign and he scored a touchdown in each of CCU's first nine games of the season. Taliaferro's seven multi-TD games this year are tied for second-most in a single-season, two away from Maysonet's Big South record of nine in 2012.

CUP OF JOE

Coastal Carolina second-year head coach **JOE MOGLIA** has won 17 of his first 23 games leading the Chanticleers. It is tied for the most wins by a head coach in his first two years in the Big South, as former Gardner-Webb leader **STEVE PATTON** first established the all-time mark with his 17 victories in his first two seasons in the Big South (17-5 from 2002-03).

50 SHADES OF GREY

The Big South has a single-season record 11 50-point games this season, which surpasses the previous high of eight that was set during the 2004 campaign. Coastal Carolina owns six of the those 50-point games, establishing the Big South single-season mark for most 50-point contests. In fact, Coastal is the first team in League history to score 50 points in three-straight games *TWICE* in the same season. The Big South's remaining 50-point games belong to Gardner-Webb (3) and Liberty (2).

REAL ESTATE ACQUISITIONS

Coastal Carolina's season average of 499.6 yards of offense is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 468.1 established by the Chanticleers in 2006. Coastal has surpassed 500 yards of offense in a game a Big South-record six times this season -- including a Conference-record three games with more than 600 in a contest. Meanwhile, the Chants became the first team in Big South history to score 50 points, rush for more than 300 yards and gain more than 500 yards of offense in three consecutive games, as the Chanticleers surpassed all three benchmarks during Weeks 3-5. The Chants' achievement also tied the Big South records in each category separately.

CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE WON IN NOVEMBER

Five-time Big South football champion Coastal Carolina is 26-7 (=78.8) in its history in regular-season games in November. In fact, the Chanticleers are the only Big South member to win a game in November every season since 2003. In addition, five-time champ Liberty is 26-9 (=74.3 percent) since 2002 during the month of November.

KEEPING TALLIES ON TALIAFERRO

Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** has rushed for a CCU single-season record 1,334 yards through the Chanticleers' 10 games, breaking the old mark of 1,107 that was established by **PATRICK HALL** in 2004. Taliaferro has a school-record seven 100-yard rushing games this season, which also is school's all-time career record. His 1,334 rushing yards rank sixth on the Big South's single-season rushing list.

COAST IS CLEAR

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 9 in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 11 in *The Sports Network* ranking. The Chanticleers are the second team in Big South history to be ranked in BOTH polls each of the first 12 weeks of the regular-season (including preseason). The Chanticleers join former member Stony Brook, which was ranked in the Top 25 every week of the 2012 campaign. The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 32 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24).

BIG TIME RUSH

Charleston Southern has rushed for more than 200 yards in a game eight times this season -- including four games over 300 -- and is 8-0 when surpassing the 200-yard threshold. The Bucs, who rushed for more than 200 yards in five consecutive games during Weeks 3-7, have gained 200+ yards on the ground 13 times since the start of the 2012 season, and are 12-1 in those contests. CSU rushed for 298 yards at Appalachian State in Week 5, the first time the Buccaneers gained 200 yards on the ground in three consecutive games against non-Conference FCS opponents since the Big South began football in 2002.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL "GAME OF THE WEEK" CONTINUES THIS SATURDAY

The Big South Conference is televising nine football games exclusively on ESPN3 this season as part of its "Game of the Week" package. The next broadcast is Saturday's Presbyterian College at Coastal Carolina game live from Conway, S.C., with **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) on the call from Brooks Stadium. Overall, the Big South will appear on television every week of the season for the second consecutive year as a total of 25 games will be televised. The nine-game ESPN3 package included two televised non-Conference match-ups for the first time.

AFTER FURTHER REVIEW

The Big South is one of three FCS conferences utilizing video instant replay, as the League is using the technology during its final eight ESPN3 broadcasts.

EYES ON HAZEL

Coastal Carolina senior WR and Big South Preseason Offensive Player of the Year **MATT HAZEL** is the Big South's active career leader with 155 receptions (8th in League history), 2,178 receiving yards (6th) and 25 touchdowns (4th). He became the ninth player in the Conference record book with 2,000 yards receiving in Week 9. Hazel is among the 2014 Senior Bowl Watch List candidates as well as the South Carolina Football Hall of Fame College Player of the Year Award Watch List.

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal is 14-1 in its last 15 games when rushing for more than 200 yards, including 8-0 this season. The Chanticleers have rushed for more than 200 yards 58 times in their history, and are 53-5 (=91.4) when reaching 200 rushing yards. Earlier this season Coastal rushed for more than 300 yards in three consecutive games during Weeks 3-5 (358.7 average in that span), the first Big South member since Stony Brook in 2011 to surpass the threshold in three-straight contests, and the fourth time overall. The Chanticleers' 19 all-time 300-yard rushing games are a Big South record.

THE NEW 40

Coastal Carolina scored at least 40 points in seven consecutive games during Weeks 3-10, tying the Big South record. The record was first established by former member Stony Brook during the 2011 season from Oct. 8-Nov. 19. Coastal also scored at least 40 points in six-straight Big South games, the second-longest such streak in the Conference record book. Stony Brook holds that record as well, which is seven games spanning two seasons (Oct. 8, 2011 - Oct. 13, 2012).

SECOND HALF SHUTDOWN

Coastal Carolina is averaging 20.7 points in the second half this season, while holding its opponents to an average of 8.7 points during the final 30 minutes of regulation. The Chanticleers have not allowed points in the third quarter four times, and none in the fourth quarter five times -- and includes two games with second half shutouts. Coastal's defense is allowing just 193.2 yards in the second half of games (excluding overtimes) with a total of just 11 touchdowns and three field goals. Opponents have mustered just 4.1 points against the Chants in the third quarter and 4.6 points in the fourth stanza.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 95, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (26). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's active leader for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 39, the third-longest streak in Big South history. That record is 45 games, established by the Flames from Sept. 23, 2006 - Sept. 18, 2010.

DOUBLED UP

Liberty owns the Conference record for most consecutive Big South games scoring in double figures at 44. Meanwhile, the Flames have scored in all 56 of their Conference games since 2002, while VMI tallied points in all 54 of its League contests since joining the Big South in 2003. Presbyterian College is the final Conference member to have not been shut out in a League contest (27 games).

APON TOP THE OF WORLD

Liberty TE **BRANDON APON** is the Big South's career leader for most touchdown receptions by a tight end with eight, as he broke the all-time mark of six in the Coastal Carolina game in Week 8. He surpassed former Charleston Southern tight ends **BRYAN MEERS** (2004-05) and **CLAYTON COFFMAN** (2006-09) for the touchdown record. Apon has caught eight of his 22 career receptions for scores -- 36.4 percent.

FIRE HYDRANT

Each of Liberty's four losses have been by single digits for a combined total of 23 points, an average of 5.75 points. On the flip side, the Flames' average margin of victory in their six wins is 29.8 points. Meanwhile, Liberty's 24-0 shutout win over Gardner-Webb in Week 9 was its Big South-record eighth since the League began football in 2002.

SOLO ARTIST

Coastal Carolina junior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is 10th all-time in Big South history with 149 career solo tackles. He needs five to move past Gardner-Webb's **MARIO BROWN** (153) for ninth-place in the Conference record book. Backus is fifth in the nation with 6.2 solo tackles per game, and based on that average, he would conclude the regular-season at 161 career solo stops, which would put him seventh on the all-time list.

INSIDE THE TACKLE BOX

Coastal Carolina junior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the Big South's active leading career tackler with 271 stops. He ranks 20th in Big South history and is 35 away from cracking the all-time Top 10. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College's **DONELLE WILLIAMS**, Gardner-Webb's **TANNER BURCH**, Coastal Carolina's **MIKE McCLURE** and VMI's **WESTON REBER** all joined the Big South's 200-tackle club this season. Gardner-Webb's **PRESTON PEMASA** (194) is nearing the milestone. Below is a closer look at the Conference's active players with 200 tackles:

HOME COOKIN'

Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** leads the Big South with 65 receptions, 852 receiving yards and seven TDs. He has a League-high five 100-yard receiving games and seven in his career -- tied for the fourth-most all-time. Cook is looking to become the first GWU receiver to lead the Big South in receptions and receiving yards since 2009 (**JAMES PERRY III**), and lead in touchdown catches since 2008 (**DOBSON COLLINS**). Cook is also attempting to be the first Gardner-Webb player to lead the Big South in all three categories. The last Big South player to do was Liberty's **CHRIS SUMMERS** in 2011.

HIGH VOLUME

Coastal Carolina is averaging 47.2 points after four of five Conference games this season. The current record for scoring offense in League games is 48.8 points, set by Stony Brook during a six-game Big South season in 2011.

BEATTY ON IT

Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** became the 11th quarterback in Big South history with 5,000 career passing yards when he eclipsed the milestone in Week 10 against Warner. He is now ninth in League history with 5,268 yards, and also ranks in the Conference's career Top 10 with 468 completions (9th) and 758 pass attempts (8th). Meanwhile, Beatty threw for 200 yards in five-straight games during Weeks 6-10, the longest streak by a GWU quarterback since **NICK ROBERTS** did it in five games spanning the 2004-05 seasons.

KORDENBROCK IS LOCKED IN

VMI senior QB **ERIC KORDENBROCK** became the seventh quarterback in Big South history with 6,000 career passing yards when he surpassed the milestone against Charleston Southern in Week 7. He is sixth all-time with 6,142 and needs 219 yards to move past Coastal Carolina's **ZACH MacDOWALL** (6,360) for fifth-place. Meanwhile, Kordenbrock is third all-time in the Conference record book with 567 completions and second with 1,052 attempts, and is chasing former Gardner-Webb QB **NICK ROBERTS** (597) for second in completions. Kordenbrock entered the League's Top 10 for career touchdown passes in Week 7 and is tied for 10th with 32.

PRESS ON

Gardner-Webb senior DE **PRESTON PEMASA** is second in Big South history with 45.0 career tackles-for-loss -- the second player in League history with at least 40 career stops behind the line of scrimmage. Pemasa, who has recorded a TFL in eight of his 10 games this season, is also fourth in the Conference record book with 16.0 quarterback sacks and is 1.5 sacks shy of moving into second in that category. Former Gardner-Webb All-American **BRIAN JOHNSTON** is the Big South's all-time leader in both categories with 53.5 TFL and 20.5 sacks.

BUYING STOCK IN KORDENBROCK

VMI quarterback **ERIC KORDENBROCK** tallied his third 300-yard passing game of the season with 359 against Robert Morris in Week 5. It is the most 300-yard passing games in a season since Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** had four last year. Kordenbrock now has four career 300-yard passing games, third-most in League history. Meanwhile, Kordenbrock's efforts this season include back-to-back 300-yard passing games -- the first Keydet QB with two-straight 300-yard passing games since 1986 when **DAVE BROWN** threw for 422 yards against Appalachian State and followed with 390 yards the next week at East Tennessee State.

BIG SOUTH SCORES RECORD NON-LEAGUE FCS WINS

The Big South is 16-7 through 23 games against FCS opponents -- the most victories against non-Conference FCS foes in the League's 12-year football history. The previous best was 13 wins in 2006. The Big South has won eight of its 16 FCS games on the road this season -- also a League record. The Conference has also assured itself of its first winning record against out-of-conference FCS members, as two non-Conference FCS games remain in the regular-season. The Big South is 6-2 against the SoCon this season, another all-time win mark and bests the previous high of four in 2006.

POINTS LEADER

Coastal Carolina is second in the nation in scoring offense at 45.5 points per game, and is looking to become the third Big South team to lead the nation in scoring at seasons end. Liberty was the national leader in 2009 (36.36) while Stony Brook was the country's top scoring offense in 2011 (38.00). The Big South single-season record for highest scoring offense is 42.6 points, set by Liberty in 2007.

AMERICAN PICKERS

Liberty leads the Big South with 14 interceptions for 269 yards. It is the sixth-most interceptions yards in a single-season in League history and the most for the Flames since LU gained 288 yards on picks in 2007. Liberty has returned two of its 14 interceptions this season for scores, its fourth time with at least two pick-sixes as Big South members (3 in 2007, 2 in 2003 and 2 in 2011).

MASTROMATTEO LANDS NFF SCHOLAR-ATHLETE AWARD AND POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

Coastal Carolina senior **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO** is one of 16 student-athletes -- from a pool of 171 semifinalists across all NCAA divisions and the NAIA -- to receive the National Football Foundation (NFF) National Scholar-Athlete Award. Each honoree receives an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship, and one member of the class will be announced as the 24th recipient of the William V. Campbell Trophy, which recognizes the top scholar-athlete in the nation.

IT'S ACADEMIC

The Big South placed six players on the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District teams last week, tied for the most Academic All-District honorees in League history that was first achieved in 2008. This year's honorees are **LUCAS BEATTY** and **KEON WILLIAMS** from Gardner-Webb, **MITCH HANSON** and **SCOTT HYLAND** from Liberty and **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO** and **JEFFERY SALLEY** from Coastal Carolina. All six move into the national Academic All-America ballot.

McKIE'S BACK IN TOWN

Presbyterian College's **JEREMIAH McKIE** returned a kickoff 97 yards for a touchdown against VMI in Week 8, tied for the fourth-longest kickoff return in Big South history. He had a 50-yard punt return for a score in Week 2 vs. Brevard, and is now the first player in League annals with a kickoff return touchdown and punt return touchdown in the same season.

BACK TO THE BEACH

Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS** returned an interception 73 yards for a touchdown against Gardner-Webb in Week 7, the second-longest interception return in Coastal history and the longest returned for a TD in CCU annals. Backus' pick-six is the seventh-longest in Big South history and the longest INT return by a linebacker. His 113 interception return yards this season are the most by a linebacker in the Conference record book.

BACKUS ADDED TO BUCHANAN LIST

Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS** was added to the 2013 Buck Buchanan Award Watch List on Oct. 1, becoming the first Big South candidate for the FCS Defensive Player of the Year award since 2011 (Coastal's **JOSH NORMAN** and Presbyterian's **JUSTIN BETHEL**). Backus is the seventh overall Big South student-athlete to be an official candidate for the Buchanan Award.

TALIAFERRO ADDED TO PAYTON AWARD LIST

Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** was added to the 2013 Walter Payton Award Watch List on Oct. 24, which marks the fourth-straight season the Big South has had a candidate for the FCS Offensive Player of the Year award. Taliaferro is the eighth overall Big South student-athlete to be an official candidate for the Payton Award. Coupled with Chants' LB **QUINN BACKUS** on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List, Coastal is one of five schools nationally with candidates for both National Player of the Year awards.

FOGG ALERT

Liberty redshirt-senior **KEVIN FOGG** recorded a 29-yard pick-6 against Monmouth in Week 2 -- his sixth career return touchdown and first interception return TD. He is the first player in Big South history with return touchdowns on an interception (1), fumble (1), punt (1) and kickoff (3). Fogg is tied as the Big South's all-time leader for most kickoff return touchdowns, and coupled with his one career punt return score, he is second in League history with four kick return TDs.

THE 20/20 EXPERIENCE - 2 OF 2

Coastal Carolina has scored at least 20 points in 18 consecutive games, dating back to last season – the longest current streak in the Big South and the Chanticleers’ longest such streak since scoring 20 points in 20 consecutive contests from Sept. 24, 2005 to Nov. 25, 2006. Coastal’s 53 points at Elon in Week 5 was its most scored against a non-Conference FCS foe since scoring 66 points vs. Savannah State on Nov. 4, 2006.

MOVING ON

VMI is playing its final campaign in the Big South this season, as the Keydets are rejoining the Southern Conference next fall. VMI concluded its Big South schedule this past Saturday with a 27-9 win over Gardner-Webb, and ends its 11-year affiliation in the League with a 12-42 record in Conference games. The Keydets scored a point in all 54 of their Big South games, the second-longest such streak in League annals.

COMING ATTRACTIONS

The Big South Conference will welcome **MONMOUTH UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2014 and start-up program **KENNESAW STATE UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2015. Monmouth’s addition will maintain the League’s membership at six squads, while KSU’s addition returns the Big South to seven members, which was the total from 2008-12. The Hawks got an early taste of League play with their 45-15 defeat at Liberty in Week 2. The Big South is 3-0 against Monmouth, with Coastal Carolina also earning wins in 2008 and 2009.

50-50 PROPOSITION

Earlier this season, Coastal Carolina became the first team in Big South history to score 50 points in three consecutive games against non-Conference FCS opponents. The streak began with 51 at Eastern Kentucky in Week 3, followed by 50 points against Hampton in Week 4, and 53 at Elon in Week 5. The Chants tied the Big South mark for most consecutive 50-point games, joining Gardner-Webb (Nov. 20, 2004 - Sept. 10, 2005) and Liberty (Oct. 31 - Nov. 14, 2009).

FIRE MARSHALL

Liberty held back-to-back Big South opponents to seven points-or-less for the first time since 2008. The Flames shutout Gardner-Webb in Week 9, and allowed VMI just seven points in Week 10. Six seasons ago, Liberty shutout Stony Brook and Charleston Southern in consecutive League games. The last Big South member to hold Conference opponents to seven points-or-less in consecutive games was Stony Brook in 2010.

RECORD COMBOS

Coastal Carolina (554) and Liberty (615) combined for 1,169 yards of offense in Week 8, a record for a Big South game and the second-highest overall total in League history. The previous high in a League contest was 1,143 yards by Coastal (596) and Gardner-Webb (547) on Nov. 3, 2012. Coastal and Liberty tied the Big South single-game record for most combined points with 107, the third time the combined total has been reached (Gardner-Webb at VMI in 2005, and Liberty vs. VMI in 2007).

REAL ESTATE VALUATION

For the first time in Big South history, two Conference games surpassed 1,000 combined yards of offense in the same week. As mentioned above with the Coastal Carolina and Liberty total of 1,169, Presbyterian College (535) and VMI (540) combined for 1,075 offensive yards in Week 8, which is the third-highest total in a Big South game.

GARDNER-WEBB SCORES LEAGUE FIRST -- BACK-TO-BACK WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS

Gardner-Webb blanked No. 8/10 Wofford, 3-0, in Week 4 -- becoming the first team in Big South history to defeat nationally-ranked opponents in consecutive weeks. The Runnin’ Bulldogs knocked off then-No. 11/15 Richmond in Week 3 (12-10), also without a touchdown. The Wofford win gave the Big South a League-record three wins over ranked teams in 2013. Meanwhile, GWU won its first road game against a non-Conference foe since Sept. 12, 2009 at Western Carolina, and the Wofford win was Gardner-Webb’s first over a ranked team on the road since a 38-35 win at No. 23 New Hampshire on Nov. 11, 2000.

BIG SOUTH SCORES LEAGUE FIRST WITH TWO WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS IN SAME WEEK

For the first time in League history, the Big South defeated two nationally-ranked teams in the same week of the regular-season as Gardner-Webb upset No. 11/15 Richmond and Coastal Carolina won at No. 25 Eastern Kentucky in Week 3. It was the second time overall in the Conference record book, as the Chants and former member Stony Brook achieved the feat in the first round of the 2012 FCS Playoffs. GWU also handed Richmond its first non-conference FCS loss since 2005 -- ending the Spiders’ 17-game win streak in such games. Meanwhile, the Chants’ win at EKU improved the Big South to 4-7 all-time when a ranked Big South team plays a nationally-ranked non-Conference opponent.

* Charleston Southern meets Gardner-Webb for the 13th time on Saturday. The Bucs won last year's meeting, 28-10, to snap a three-game losing streak to GWU.

* Charleston Southern took the lead in the Big South race with one of the biggest wins in school history on Saturday, a 31-26 win over No. 3/5 Coastal Carolina in front of a record crowd (6,135) at Buccaneer Field.

* Coastal (No. 3/5) is the highest-ranked opponent CSU has ever defeated.

* CSU piled up 323 yards rushing and kept the football away from the nation's No. 1 offense with more than 40 minutes in time of possession (40:34). The Bucs now lead the nation in time of possession.

* R-Freshman QB **DANNY CROGHAN III** was 14-of-21 for 166 yards and a TD against Coastal, while true freshman QB **KYLE COPELAND** also had a passing TD and 79 yards rushing in the Bucs' two-QB system.

* CSU built a 24-6 halftime lead in the Coastal win and held off a late Chanticleer rally by holding the ball for the final 6:07 to seal the victory.

* WR **KEVIN GLEARS** leads the squad with 29 receptions and six TD grabs. His six touchdown catches are the most by a Buccaneer since **GERALD STEVENSON** had nine in 2008.

* The Bucs lead the Big South and rank seventh nationally in 3rd down defense at 29.6 percent allowed. CSU held Coastal Carolina to 4-of-12 on third downs (=33.3 percent).
