Taliaferro rushed 16 times for 132 yards and two touchdowns in Coastal's victory over Presbyterian College. He had no negative rushing yards and averaged 8.6 yards per carry in playing just the first half. Half of his rushes went for either a first down or touchdown, and he gained 90 yards on his first seven attempts. Taliaferro's two TD runs were from three yards and one yard, and the scores broke three more Big South records, as he is now the single-season leader for points (144), overall touchdowns (24) and rushing TDs (23).

Riddick helped the Runnin' Bulldogs to a 27-10 win over No. 12/13 Charleston Southern with eight total tackles, 4.0 tackles-for-loss, two sacks and five quarterback hurries. His first quarterback pressure caused a pass deflection and interception that GWU would turn into the first touchdown of the game. Riddick recorded five solo stops on the day and his two sacks gave him a Big South single-season record 8.5 on the year.

Day booted a pair of field goals and scored nine points, and averaged 47.5 yards on his six punts against Charleston Southern. He boomed three punts more than 50 yards and pinned CSU inside its own 20-yard line three times. Day's two first half field goals helped GWU to a 20-0 lead at the break. He later sealed the win with a heads-up 21-yard rush on 4th-and-10 with 2:35 remaining in the game. Day scooped up a low and hard snap and darted outside and down the sideline for the first down, which allowed Gardner-Webb to run out the clock.

COASTAL CAROLINA CLINCHES SHARE OF BIG SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP

Coastal Carolina has clinched a share of the Big South football championship following its 46-13 win over Presbyterian College this past Saturday and coupled with Charleston Southern's loss at Gardner-Webb. The Chanticleers finished 4-1 in Big South play and have captured their sixth League title in their 11th season of existence. Coastal will share the regular-season championship with either Charleston Southern or Liberty, as one of those teams will also be 4-1 after this Saturday.

BIG SOUTH'S AUTOMATIC BID STILL UP FOR GRABS ENTERING FINAL WEEKEND

For the fifth time in the 12-year history of Big South football, the Conference will have co-champions. Coastal Carolina has already secured a share of the title with its 4-1 League record, and will be joined atop the standings with either Charleston Southern or Liberty. Below are the scenarios entering the final week of the 2013 season that will determine the Big South's automatic playoff representative:

COASTAL CAROLINA can clinch the League's automatic bid if Liberty defeats Charleston Southern Saturday:

- Liberty would finish 4-1 to tie Coastal for the regular-season title, but the Chanticleers receive the AQ based on its head-to-head victory over the Flames on Oct. 19.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN can clinch the League's automatic bid if the Buccaneers defeat Liberty Saturday:

- Charleston Southern would finish 4-1 and tie Coastal for the regular-season title, with the Buccaneers receiving the AQ based on its head-to-head victory over the Chanticleers on Nov. 9.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL "GAME OF THE WEEK" CONCLUDES THIS SATURDAY

The Big South Conference's "BB&T Game of the Week" package concludes this Saturday with the game that will determine the Big South's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs -- Liberty at Charleston Southern exclusively on ESPN3. **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) have the call live from Buccaneer Field at 11:00am. The Big South had television coverage every week of the 2013 season for the second consecutive year as a total of 25 games were televised. The League's nine-game ESPN3 package included two televised non-Conference match-ups for the first time.

SIX PACK

Coastal Carolina is the first team in Big South history to win six Big South football championships. The Chanticleers have won titles in 2004, 2005 (shared), 2006, 2010 (shared), 2012 (shared) and 2013 (shared). Liberty will attempt to join the Chants in the six championship club this Saturday, as the Flames have five Big South titles to their credit -- 2007, 2008, 2009 (shared), 2010 (shared) and 2012 (shared). Charleston Southern is looking for its second Big South crown and first since 2005 (shared with Coastal).

PRELUDE TO A CHAMPIONSHIP

Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern each started League play with 3-0 records -- the 15th and 16th time in Big South history that a member opened 3-0 in Conference action. With Coastal capturing a share of the League title, 14 squads that were 3-0 have now gone to win/share the Big South championship. Charleston Southern will look to add its name to the list this weekend. The only team not to win the League title after starting 3-0 was Liberty in 2011 (second-place).

"LO-REND-ZONE"


Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** has set the Big South single-season record for most touchdowns (24) and rushing touchdowns (23). The third player in Big South history with 20 TDs in a season, Taliaferro broke the old records set by Stony Brook's **MIGUEL MAYSONET** in 2012. Maysonet's record totals were 23 overall touchdowns and 21 rushing scores. Meanwhile, Taliaferro is the first player in Big South history with five 3-TD games in a campaign and has scored a touchdown in 10 of CCU's 11 games this season. His eight multi-TD games this year are second-most in a single-season, one away from Maysonet's Big South record of nine in 2012.

PULLING RANK

Gardner-Webb defeated its third nationally-ranked opponent this past Saturday with its 27-10 win over No. 12/13 Charleston Southern. GWU was playing its fourth Top 25 opponent of the regular-season and is the first team in Big South history to defeat three nationally-ranked teams in a campaign. The Runnin' Bulldogs allowed just 20 combined points in its three upset wins (6.7 ppg) and held two opponents to less than 20 yards rushing.

CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE WON IN NOVEMBER

Six-time Big South football champion Coastal Carolina is 27-7 (=79.4) in its history in regular-season games in November. In fact, the Chanticleers are the only Big South member to win a game in November every season since 2003. In addition, five-time champ Liberty is 27-9 (=75.0 percent) since 2002 during the month of November.

TEN-TAMOUNT

For the first time in Big South history, two teams have won 10 games in a season. Charleston Southern was the first to 10 wins this year, reaching double-digits in Week 11, while Coastal Carolina is now the first team in League annals with two 10-win campaigns (2004, 2013). The Big South is the only FCS Conferences with multiple 10-win programs, and it is the fifth time in League history that a member has collected 10 victories in a season. Both squads will attempt to become the first Big South team to win 11 games this weekend.

COASTAL'S RECORD SETTING SEASON

Coastal Carolina has established the Big South single-season record with 501 points and 68 touchdowns, breaking the old marks of 494 points and 66 touchdowns that were set by Stony Brook in 2011. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's season average of 512.5 yards of offense is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 468.1 established by the Chanticleers in 2006. Coastal has surpassed 500 yards of offense in a game a Big South-record seven times this season -- including a Conference-record four games with more than 600 in a contest. With 5,638 yards this season, the Chanticleers need 104 yards of offense at South Carolina this Saturday to break Stony Brook's single-season record of 5,741 in 2011.

CUP OF JOE

Coastal Carolina second-year head coach **JOE MOGLIA** has won 18 of his first 24 games leading the Chanticleers -- the most wins by a head coach in his first two years in the Big South. The previous record was 17 victories established by former Gardner-Webb leader **STEVE PATTON** in his first two seasons in the Big South from 2002-03 (17-5).

ALL'S WELL WITH CHADWELL

Charleston Southern head coach **JAMEY CHADWELL** is the first head coach to win 10 games in his first season in the Big South. The previous high for most wins by a new head coach in his first season in the League was eight wins -- Coastal Carolina's **JOE MOGLIA** in 2012.

50 SHADES OF GREY

The Big South has a single-season record 12 50-point games this season, which surpasses the previous high of eight that was set during the 2004 campaign. Coastal Carolina owns six of the those 50-point games, establishing the Big South single-season mark for most 50-point contests. In fact, Coastal is the first team in League history to score 50 points in three-straight games *TWICE* in the same season. The Big South's remaining 50-point games belong to Gardner-Webb (3) and Liberty (3).

KEEPING TALLIES ON TALIAFERRO

Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** has rushed for a CCU single-season record 1,466 yards through the Chanticleers' 11 games, breaking the old mark of 1,107 that was established by **PATRICK HALL** in 2004. Taliaferro has a school-record eight 100-yard rushing games this season, which also is school's all-time career record. His 1,466 rushing yards rank fourth on the Big South's single-season rushing list. Meanwhile, Taliaferro is 170 rushing yards away from 2,000 in his career.

COAST IS CLEAR

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 7 in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 11 in *The Sports Network* ranking. The Chanticleers are the second team in Big South history to be ranked in BOTH polls each week of the regular-season (including preseason). The Chanticleers join former member Stony Brook, which was ranked in the Top 25 every week of the 2012 campaign. The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 33 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24).

BLUE SWARM

Charleston Southern is nationally-ranked for the seventh consecutive week, as the Buccaneers are No. 16 in this week's FCS Coaches poll and No. 18 in *The Sports Network* ranking. CSU was No. 12/13 in the Nov. 11 polls -- the highest rankings in program history and the first time the Big South had two teams inside the Top 15 at any point in the season. CSU entered the Top 25 rankings this season for the first time since the week of Nov. 6, 2006. The Big South has had three teams ranked this year -- the second time in League history that three teams were nationally-ranked in a season.

HOME RUNS

Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina have the League's longest active home win streak at eight each. The Bucs have won eight consecutive games at Buccaneer Field, which is CSU's longest since winning 12 consecutive home games from Oct. 15, 2005 - Oct. 6, 2007. The Chanticleers' eight-game run is their longest since winning 12 consecutive home games from Sept. 11, 2004 - Nov. 12, 2005.

REYES OF SUNSHINE

Charleston Southern RB **CHRISTIAN REYES** is the first player in school history to rush for 1,000 yards in a season. He ranks second in the Big South with 1,216 rushing yards, and has six 100-yard rushing efforts to his credit. Reyes became CSU's single-season rushing leader in Week 9 during the Charlotte game as he eclipsed the previous mark of 774 (**VINSON BLAIR** in 1998). He needs one rushing touchdown to become the first Buccaneer with 10 in a season.

RECORD ROAD WARRIORS

Charleston Southern's six road wins this year are the most in League history. The first Big South team to win at least five *regular-season* road games in a season, the Bucs eclipsed the previous record of five overall road wins (regular-season and postseason) that was set by Coastal Carolina in 2012. Earlier this season, Charleston Southern matched the Big South record for longest road winning streak (5). Liberty first set the mark with its five consecutive road wins from Oct. 20, 2007 - Oct. 4, 2008.

EYES ON HAZEL

Coastal Carolina senior WR and Big South Preseason Offensive Player of the Year **MATT HAZEL** is the Big South's active career leader with 162 receptions (T-6th in League history), 2,297 receiving yards (6th) and 25 touchdowns (4th). He became the ninth player in the Conference record book with 2,000 yards receiving in Week 9. Hazel is among the 2014 Senior Bowl Watch List candidates as well as the South Carolina Football Hall of Fame College Player of the Year Award Watch List.

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal is 15-1 in its last 16 games when rushing for more than 200 yards, including 9-0 this season. The Chanticleers have rushed for more than 200 yards 59 times in their history, and are 54-5 (=91.5%) when reaching 200 rushing yards. Earlier this season Coastal rushed for more than 300 yards in three consecutive games during Weeks 3-5 (358.7 average in that span), the first Big South member since Stony Brook in 2011 to surpass the threshold in three-straight contests, and the fourth time overall. The Chanticleers' 20 all-time 300-yard rushing games are a Big South record.

FIT TO BE TIED

Charleston Southern snapped Coastal Carolina's 14-game regular-season win streak in Week 11, which tied for the longest such streak in Big South history. The record was first set by the Buccaneers, who won 14 consecutive regular-season contests from Oct. 15, 2005 - Nov. 4, 2006.

SECOND HALF SHUTDOWN

Coastal Carolina is averaging 20.45 points in the second half this season, while holding its opponents to an average of 9.09 points during the final 30 minutes of regulation. The Chanticleers have not allowed points in the third quarter five times, and none in the fourth quarter five times -- including two games with second half shutouts. Coastal's defense is allowing just 192.8 yards in the second half of games (excluding overtimes) with a total of just 13 touchdowns and three field goals. Opponents have mustered just 3.73 points against the Chants in the third quarter and 5.36 points in the fourth stanza.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 96, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (27). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's active leader for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 40, the third-longest streak in Big South history. That record is 45 games, established by the Flames from Sept. 23, 2006 - Sept. 18, 2010.

DOUBLED UP

Liberty owns the Conference record for most consecutive Big South games scoring in double figures at 45. Meanwhile, the Flames have scored in all 57 of their Conference games since 2002, while VMI tallied points in all 54 of its League contests since joining the Big South in 2003. Presbyterian College is the final Conference member to have not been shut out in a League contest (28 games).

APON TOP THE OF WORLD

Liberty TE **BRANDON APON** is the Big South's career leader for most touchdown receptions by a tight end with eight, as he broke the all-time mark of six in the Coastal Carolina game in Week 8. He surpassed former Charleston Southern tight ends **BRYAN MEERS** (2004-05) and **CLAYTON COFFMAN** (2006-09) for the touchdown record. Apon has caught eight of his 22 career receptions for scores -- 36.4 percent.

FIRE HYDRANT

Each of Liberty's four losses have been by single digits for a combined total of 23 points, an average of 5.75 points. On the flip side, the Flames' average margin of victory in their seven wins is 31.0 points. Meanwhile, Liberty's 24-0 shutout win over Gardner-Webb in Week 9 was its Big South-record eighth since the League began football in 2002.

SHAQ THE SACK MASTER

Gardner-Webb junior DL **SHAQUILLE RIDDICK** has set the Big South single-season sack record with 8.5, breaking the old mark of 8.0 that was set by Liberty's **AARON DeBERRY** in 2002. Riddick also leads the Big South with 19.0 TFL -- the third-most in a single-season in Big South history. He needs one more TFL to become just the third player in League annals with 20 stops behind the line of scrimmage. Meanwhile, Riddick was added the Ted Hendricks Award Watch List on Monday, Nov. 18, which honors the national Defensive End of the Year.

SOLO ARTIST

Coastal Carolina junior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is tied for ninth all-time in Big South history with 153 career solo tackles. He needs three to move past Coastal Carolina's **DOMINIQUE DAVENPORT** (155) for eighth-place in the Conference record book. Backus is seventh in the nation with 6.0 solo tackles per game, and based on that average, he would conclude the regular-season at 159 career solo stops, which would put him seventh on the all-time list.

INSIDE THE TACKLE BOX

Coastal Carolina junior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the Big South's active leading career tackler with 278 stops. He ranks 17th in Big South history and is 28 away from cracking the all-time Top 10. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College's **DONELLE WILLIAMS**, Gardner-Webb's **TANNER BURCH**, Coastal Carolina's **MIKE McCLURE** and VMI's **WESTON REBER** all joined the Big South's 200-tackle club this season. Gardner-Webb's **PRESTON PEMASA** (198) is nearing the milestone. Below is a closer look at the Conference's active players with 200 tackles:

HOME COOKIN'

Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** leads the Big South with 72 receptions, 931 receiving yards and eight TDs. He has a League-high five 100-yard receiving games and seven in his career -- tied for the fourth-most all-time. Cook is looking to become the first GWU receiver to lead the Big South in receptions and receiving yards since 2009 (**JAMES PERRY III**), and lead in touchdown catches since 2008 (**DOBSON COLLINS**). Cook is also attempting to be the first Gardner-Webb player to lead the Big South in all three categories. The last Big South player to do was Liberty's **CHRIS SUMMERS** in 2011.

POINTS LEADER

Coastal Carolina is third in the nation in scoring offense at 45.5 points per game -- just 1.3 points off national leader Eastern Illinois, and is in contention to become the third Big South team to lead the nation in scoring at seasons end. Liberty was the national leader in 2009 (36.36) while Stony Brook was the country's top scoring offense in 2011 (38.00). The Big South single-season record for highest scoring offense is 42.6 points, set by Liberty in 2007.

HIGH VOLUME

Coastal Carolina averaged 47.0 points in its five Conference games this season, the third-highest scoring average in League contests. The Chanticleers won three of their four Big South games by at least 30 points, tying the Big South record set by Liberty in 2007 and matched by the Flames in 2009.

BEATTY ON IT

Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** became the 11th quarterback in Big South history with 5,000 career passing yards when he eclipsed the milestone in Week 10 against Warner. He is now ninth in League history with 5,402 yards, and also ranks in the Conference's career Top 10 with 488 completions (6th) and 791 pass attempts (8th). Beatty is 12 completions away from becoming the fifth QB in League history with 500.

PRESS ON

Gardner-Webb senior DE **PRESTON PEMASA** is second in Big South history with 46.0 career tackles-for-loss -- the second player in League history with at least 40 career stops behind the line of scrimmage. Pemasa, who has recorded a TFL in nine of his 11 games this season, is also fourth in the Conference record book with 16.0 quarterback sacks and is 1.5 sacks shy of moving into second in that category. Former Gardner-Webb All-American **BRIAN JOHNSTON** is the Big South's all-time leader in both categories with 53.5 TFL and 20.5 sacks.

BIG SOUTH SCORES RECORD NON-LEAGUE FCS WINS

The Big South is 16-8 through 24 games against FCS opponents -- the most victories against non-Conference FCS foes in the League's 12-year football history. The previous best was 13 wins in 2006. The Big South has won eight of its 16 FCS games on the road this season -- also a League record. The Conference has also assured itself of its first winning record against out-of-conference FCS members, as one non-Conference FCS game remains in the regular-season. The Big South is 6-3 against the SoCon this season, another all-time win mark and bests the previous high of four in 2006.

BIG TIME RUSH

Charleston Southern has rushed for more than 200 yards in a game eight times this season -- including four games over 300 -- and is 8-0 when surpassing the 200-yard threshold. The Bucs, who rushed for more than 200 yards in five consecutive games during Weeks 3-7, have gained 200+ yards on the ground 13 times since the start of the 2012 season, and are 12-1 in those contests. CSU rushed for 298 yards at Appalachian State in Week 5, the first time the Buccaneers gained 200 yards on the ground in three consecutive games against non-Conference FCS opponents since the Big South began football in 2002.

THE 20/20 EXPERIENCE - 2 OF 2

Coastal Carolina has scored at least 20 points in 19 consecutive games, dating back to last season -- the longest current streak in the Big South and the Chanticleers' longest such streak since scoring 20 points in 20 consecutive contests from Sept. 24, 2005 to Nov. 25, 2006. Coastal's 53 points at Elon in Week 5 was its most scored against a non-Conference FCS foe since scoring 66 points vs. Savannah State on Nov. 4, 2006.

AMERICAN PICKERS

Liberty leads the Big South with 15 interceptions for 265 yards. It is the sixth-most interceptions yards in a single-season in League history and the most for the Flames since LU gained 288 yards on picks in 2007. Liberty has returned two of its 15 interceptions this season for scores, its fourth time with at least two pick-sixes as Big South members (3 in 2007, 2 in 2003 and 2 in 2011).

KORDENBROCK'S CAREER COMES TO AN END

VMI senior QB **ERIC KORDENBROCK** has been declared out for the rest of the season following an injury suffered at Presbyterian in Week 8. He concludes his career sixth all-time in Big South history with 6,142 passing yards, third all-time in the Conference record book with 567 completions and second with 1,052 attempts. Kordenbrock entered the League's Top 10 for career touchdown passes in Week 7 and is tied for 10th with 32. In addition, Kordenbrock tallied three 300-yard passing games this season, the most since Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** had four last year. Kordenbrock has four career 300-yard passing games, third-most in League history, and is also the only quarterback in Conference annals with four 80-yard pass plays.

McKIE'S BACK IN TOWN

Presbyterian College's **JEREMIAH McKIE** returned a kickoff 97 yards for a touchdown against VMI in Week 8, tied for the fourth-longest kickoff return in Big South history. He had a 50-yard punt return for a score in Week 2 vs. Brevard, and is the first player in League annals with a kickoff return touchdown and punt return touchdown in the same season.

BACK TO THE BEACH

Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS** returned an interception 73 yards for a touchdown against Gardner-Webb in Week 7, the second-longest interception return in Coastal history and the longest returned for a TD in CCU annals. Backus' pick-six is the seventh-longest in Big South history and the longest INT return by a linebacker. His 113 interception return yards this season are the most by a linebacker in the Conference record book.

MASTROMATTEO LANDS NFF SCHOLAR-ATHLETE AWARD AND POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

Coastal Carolina senior **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO** is one of 16 student-athletes -- from a pool of 171 semifinalists across all NCAA divisions and the NAIA -- to receive the National Football Foundation (NFF) National Scholar-Athlete Award. Each honoree receives an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship, and one member of the class will be announced as the 24th recipient of the William V. CHARLESTON SOUTHERN EMERGES AS VICTOR IN MATCH-UP OF RANKED BIG SOUTH TEAMS

Charleston Southern defeated Coastal Carolina, 31-26 in Week 11 in the first match-up of ranked Big South teams from the two major FCS polls (*The Sports Network* and FCS Coaches). The Bucs led 31-6 before the Chanticleers tallied 20 unanswered points for the final margin. The win gave CSU its first-ever 3-0 start in Big South play.

BACKUS ADDED TO BUCHANAN LIST

Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS** was added to the 2013 Buck Buchanan Award Watch List on Oct. 1, becoming the first Big South candidate for the FCS Defensive Player of the Year award since 2011 (Coastal's **JOSH NORMAN** and Presbyterian's **JUSTIN BETHEL**). Backus is the seventh overall Big South student-athlete to be an official candidate for the Buchanan Award.

TALIAFERRO ADDED TO PAYTON AWARD LIST

Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** was added to the 2013 Walter Payton Award Watch List on Oct. 24, which marks the fourth-straight season the Big South has had a candidate for the FCS Offensive Player of the Year award. Taliaferro is the eighth overall Big South student-athlete to be an official candidate for the Payton Award. Coupled with Chants' LB **QUINN BACKUS** on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List, Coastal is one of five schools nationally with candidates for both National Player of the Year awards.

FOGG ALERT

Liberty redshirt-senior **KEVIN FOGG** recorded a 29-yard pick-6 against Monmouth in Week 2 -- his sixth career return touchdown and first interception return TD. He is the first player in Big South history with return touchdowns on an interception (1), fumble (1), punt (1) and kickoff (3). Fogg is tied as the Big South's all-time leader for most kickoff return touchdowns, and coupled with his one career punt return score, he is second in League history with four kick return TDs.

MOVING ON

VMI is playing its final campaign in the Big South this season, as the Keydets are rejoining the Southern Conference next fall. VMI concluded its Big South schedule in Week 11 with a 27-9 win over Gardner-Webb, and ends its 11-year affiliation in the League with a 12-42 record in Conference games. The Keydets scored a point in all 54 of their Big South games, the second-longest such streak in League annals.

COMING ATTRACTIONS

The Big South Conference will welcome **MONMOUTH UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2014 and start-up program **KENNESAW STATE UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2015. Monmouth's addition will maintain the League's membership at six squads, while KSU's addition returns the Big South to seven members, which was the total from 2008-12. The Hawks got an early taste of League play with their 45-15 defeat at Liberty in Week 2. The Big South is 3-0 against Monmouth, with Coastal Carolina also earning wins in 2008 and 2009.

RECORD COMBOS

Coastal Carolina (554) and Liberty (615) combined for 1,169 yards of offense in Week 8, a record for a Big South game and the second-highest overall total in League history. The previous high in a League contest was 1,143 yards by Coastal (596) and Gardner-Webb (547) on Nov. 3, 2012. Coastal and Liberty tied the Big South single-game record for most combined points with 107, the third time the combined total has been reached (Gardner-Webb at VMI in 2005, and Liberty vs. VMI in 2007).

GARDNER-WEBB SCORES LEAGUE FIRST -- BACK-TO-BACK WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS

Gardner-Webb blanked No. 8/10 Wofford, 3-0, in Week 4 -- becoming the first team in Big South history to defeat nationally-ranked opponents in consecutive weeks. The Runnin' Bulldogs knocked off then-No. 11/15 Richmond in Week 3 (12-10), also without a touchdown. The Wofford win gave the Big South a League-record three wins over ranked non-conference FCS teams in 2013. Meanwhile, GWU won its first road game against a non-Conference foe since Sept. 12, 2009 at Western Carolina, and the Wofford win was Gardner-Webb's first over a ranked team on the road since a 38-35 win at No. 23 New Hampshire on Nov. 11, 2000.

BIG SOUTH SCORES LEAGUE FIRST WITH TWO WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS IN SAME WEEK

For the first time in League history, the Big South defeated two nationally-ranked teams in the same week of the regular-season as Gardner-Webb upset No. 11/15 Richmond and Coastal Carolina won at No. 25 Eastern Kentucky in Week 3. It was the second time overall in the Conference record book, as the Chants and former member Stony Brook achieved the feat in the first round of the 2012 FCS Playoffs. GWU also handed Richmond its first non-conference FCS loss since 2005 -- ending the Spiders' 17-game win streak in such games. Meanwhile, the Chants' win at EKU improved the Big South to 4-7 all-time when a ranked Big South team plays a nationally-ranked non-Conference opponent.
