TRISTAN CAREY • G Sr. • Longwood Colonial Beach, Va.

Carey averaged 24.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and made 9-of-18 threepoint field goals (=50.0 percent) to lead Longwood to two wins last week. He scored a game-high 31 points at TCU, including 20 in the first half, to lead the Lancers to their first victory under new head coach Jayson Gee on Nov. 12. Carey made seven three-pointers and grabbed six rebounds in the program's first win against a Big 12 member and BCS school. He followed with a team-high 17 points, four rebounds and two steals against Mars Hill on Nov. 16 in the first home game this season for Longwood. For the week, Carey was 16-of-32 from the field and 7-of-8 from the charity stripe.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

ANDREW ROWSEY • G Fr. • UNC Asheville Lexington, Va.

Rowsey became the first UNC Asheville freshman in 10 years with back-to-back 20-point performances, as he scored 24 points at Western Carolina and 23 at College of Charleston last week. Rowsey went 9-of-20 from the field and 6-of-12 from beyond the arc against the Catamounts. He then went 8-of-11 from the field, 3-of-6 from the three-point line and 4-of-4 from the charity stripe at College of Charleston. Against the Cougars, Rowsey scored six points in overtime -- including all four of his free throws, to give the Bulldogs the win. For the week, he was 17-of-31 from the field (=54.8), 9-of-18 from three-point range and averaged 2.5 assists.

ONE AND NOT DONE

The Big South's three remaining new head coaches all experienced their first head coaching wins last week. Longwood's **JAYSON GEE** picked up his first win with the Lancers' 82-79 win at TCU on Nov. 12, while UNC Asheville's **NICK McDEVITT** scored his first head coaching victory with the Bulldogs' 67-58 overtime win at College of Charleston. Gardner-Webb's **TIM CRAFT** notched his first win this past Saturday with the Runnin' Bulldogs' 87-78 home victory over Jacksonville. On Nov. 8, Campbell's **KEVIN McGEEHAN** won his head coaching debut with the Camels' 87-62 home victory over Shenandoah.

LONGWOOD SCORES BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG 12 WIN IN 15 SEASONS

Longwood's 82-79 win at TCU last week was the Big South's first win over a member of the Big 12 Conference since the 1999-00 season. That year, Winthrop defeated Missouri, 51-46.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' 2012-13 season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 114. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 648 Division I wins and is tied for 31st all-time in Division I victories.

CLASS ACT

High Point graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY** is among the 30 candidates for the national Senior CLASS Award. He is the Big South's first official candidate since Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** in 2011-12.

ELDER STATESMEN

With the departure of UNC Asheville's **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** after 17 years as head coach of the Bulldogs, VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** and Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** are now the longest-tenured Big South coaches, as each is in his ninth year. Baucom's Big South tenure will end after this season with VMI's departure to the Southern Conference on July 1, 2014.

CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

VMI head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** is sixth all-time in Big South history with 121 victories at the Institute, while Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** ranks eighth with his 114 wins at Coastal Carolina. Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** sits in ninth-place all-time in League annals with 109 victories. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern junior guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 15 times in their career (nine times last season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 12-3 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 15 outlings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

D.J. - PART 1

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** is sixth all-time in Big South history with 192 career blocked shots and is eight away from becoming the sixth player with 200. He is also 48th on the Big South's career rebounding list with 585. Already one of 10 players in League annals with 500 rebounds and 150 blocked shots, Cunningham is on pace to become the fifth player in Big South history with 600 rebounds and 200 blocks in 2013-14.

D.J. - PART 2

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** is ninth in Big South history with 181 career blocked shots. He needs 54 rebounds for 500 in his career, which would make him the 11th player in League history with 500 boards and 150 rejections.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,276 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 1,041 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

BIG BURRUS IS BACK

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS**, who missed all of 2012-13 with an injury, is looking to join the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club, which currently stands at 18 members. Burrus has tallied 106 rejections in his career -- 28th in League annals, and has 469 career rebounds to his credit. He would become just the second Liberty player on the list, joining Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97.

ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH

For the first time in League history, four regular-season Big South games will appear in ESPNU in 2013-14. The 24-hour college sports network will televise the Jan. 10 Radford at High Point game, and will make "Wildcard" selections of the remaining three broadcasts 21 days in advance. Those three telecasts will be Feb. 1 at 11:00am, Feb. 13 at 7:00pm and Feb. 28 at 7:00pm.

BIG SOUTH'S 1.000-POINT CLUB

Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** is the Big South's active leading career scorer with 1,041 points and the only active 1,000-point scorer in the Conference. However, Charleston Southern's **SAAH NIM-LEY** is 31 points away from becoming the 118th player in Big South history to score 1,000 points. GLASS IS HALF FULL

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW** has 343 career assists and is 57 away from becoming the 23rd player in Big South history with 400. Once he reaches the milestone, he will be the first Keydet to join the League's 400-assist club.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** is seven rebounds away from 500 in his career, which would make him the 69th player in Big South history to eclipse the milestone. Green will become the first Highlander with 500 career boards since **ART PARAKHOUSKI** and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** in 2009-10. Meanwhile, Green is approaching 1,000 career points as he enters the week 157 points shy of that milestone.

HIGH POINT'S JOHN BROWN -- BIG SOUTH PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

High Point redshirt-sophomore forward **JOHN BROWN** is the 2013-14 Big South Conference Men's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year. Brown becomes the first sophomore in League history to be voted Preseason Player of the Year, and is High Point's third-ever preseason honoree. Brown was the Big South's Freshman of the Year in 2012-13 as he was the top scoring freshman during the regular-season at 16.4 points per game. Just the second freshman ever to be voted First-Team All-Conference, Brown was a Kyle Macy Freshman All-American Team member by *Collegeinsider.com* last season.

NORTH DIVISION

CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

Sophomore F **D.J. MASON** came off the bench to score a career-high 19 points (7-13 FG, 4-4 FT) in Campbell's 73-66 win at Appalachian State, CU's first-ever win at Boone. Mason then added 12 points (3-4 FG, 5-6 FT) in an 81-66 loss at N.C. State ... On the year, Mason is shooting 83% from the line (T-7th in the Big South) ... Sophomore G **LUKE MOYER** did not miss a shot (3-3 3FG, 2-2 FT) and scored a career-high 11 points in 10 minutes against the Wolfpack ... Campbell (2-1) hosts N.C. Central Monday and travels to Cincinnati on Wednesday to complete a stretch of 3 games in 5 days.

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

JOHN BROWN averaged 22.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in two games last week. He shot 66.7 percent (18-for-27) from the floor and 80.0 percent (8-for-10) from the free-throw line in the two games. Brown scored 26 points with nine rebounds, three assists, two blocks and two steals in the Panthers' win over Ferrum last Tuesday. In High Point's road game at Eastern Kentucky on Saturday, Brown scored 18 points with nine rebounds, four assists and two blocks. He led HPU in scoring both times ... Freshman shooting guard **ANTHONY LINDAUER** averaged six points and two rebounds last week, scoring all of his points on three-pointers and going 4-for-6 from long range.

LIBERTY FLAMES

Liberty dropped two contests last week, falling to William & Mary (84-72) on the road and Western Carolina (68-63) at home ... The Flames are now 1-2 on the season ... **ANTWAN BURRUS** posted 18 points in the game against the Tribe and followed up with the 10 tallies on Saturday, surpassing the 800-point mark for his collegiate career. He now has 802 career points ... **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** needs 25 points to crack the top 20 of Liberty's all-time scoring list. Sanders currently has 1,041 career tallies ... The Flames will square off with UNCW on Monday, and are 0-2 all-time against the Seahawks ... Liberty heads to Virginia on Saturday. The last time the Flames invaded John Paul Jones Arena, they came away with an 86-82 victory over the Cavaliers (Nov. 25, 2008).

LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood (2-1) posted a pair of non-conference wins last week, including an 82-79 road win at TCU of the Big 12 Conference on Nov. 12 in Fort Worth, Texas, and an 88-70 home win past Mars Hill ... Sophomore LUCAS WOODHOUSE made a three-point field goal with just 1.7-seconds remaining at TCU to give the Lancers their biggest win in program history, and first against a Big 12 member and BCS school. Senior TRISTAN CAREY scored a game-high 31 points, including 20 in the first half, to lead Longwood against the Horned Frogs and to its first victory under new head coach JAYSON GEE ... Sophomore KARL ZIEGLER posted his first collegiate double-double with 14 points and a career-high and game-high 10 rebounds, while sophomore transfer LERON FISHER, making his first start, and freshman DARRION ALLEN, off the bench, each finished with 11 points ... Woodhouse had seven points and a game-high seven assists ... Gee earned a victory in his first home game at the helm of the program with the Mars Hill win ... Longwood will remain at home to welcome Brown on Nov. 22, before going on the road to play at Penn State on Nov. 24.

RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Radford won its home opener for the 11th-straight season last Monday with an 89-78 victory over Chattanooga. The Highlanders followed that with their most impressive offensive performance of the **MIKE JONES** era in a 105-57 win past Brevard on Saturday at the Dedmon Center ... **JAVONTE GREEN** recorded his 16th career double-double against Chattanooga with 23 points and 12 rebounds. He shot .818 from the field (9-11) and scored 22 points in just 21 minutes against Brevard. He also recorded 7 rebounds, 2 assists, 2 steals, and a block ... **YA YA ANDERSON** has scored in double figures in all three games this season. He tallied 12 on each night vs. UTC and Brevard, and is shooting .538 from both the field and from behind the 3-point arc ... The Highlanders are +8.0 in rebounding average and are averaging +7.0 more assists per game than their opponents.

VMI KEYDETS

QJ PETERSON had 25 points, including 20 in the first half and 12-straight at one point, and **JORDAN WEETHEE** went 7-for-7 from the field, including 6-of-6 from three-point range, for a career-high 20 points to pace the VMI Keydets to a 121-80 win over the Bluefield State Blues Saturday afternoon at Cameron Hall. Peterson and Weethee were two of VMI's five players in double figures, which was the first time the Keydets had accomplished that feat since Jan. 5, 2013 against Liberty.

SOUTH DIVISION

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

The Bucs received strong efforts from juniors **SAAH NIMLEY** and **PAUL GOMBWER** Sunday in their 109-93 loss at No. 21/22 New Mexico. Nimley notched his first double-double of the year with 24 points and a career-high tying 12 assists. Gombwer, meanwhile, set a career-high with 17 points and led CSU with five rebounds ... CSU hit a season-high 15 three-pointers and performed well offensively in the second half, connecting on 57 percent of its shots overall while sinking 11-of-19 from beyond the arc.

COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chants went 1-1 last week at home as they defeated Guilford College, 76-49 before falling to the defending SEC Champions Ole Miss, 72-70 ...
