Woodrum was responsible for 279 yards of offense and four touchdowns in leading the Flames to a 56-14 win at No. 16/18 Charleston Southern and claim a share of the Big South championship. He was 23-of-28 passing (=82.1 percent) for 239 yards and three touchdowns while rushing for 40 yards and a score. Woodrum opened the game with a 13-yard touchdown run, then connected on TD passes of 18 yards and three yards to give Liberty a 21-0 advantage at halftime. He tossed a six-yard touchdown pass to open the scoring in the fourth quarter.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

CHAD GETER • LB • Sophomore
 Gardner-Webb • Irmo, S.C.

Geter registered a career-high 12 total tackles -- including 11 solo stops, and broke up a pass in Gardner-Webb's 20-13 win at Presbyterian College. He had six solo hits in a dominant first half that saw GWU limit the Blue Hose to just 49 total yards in opening a 13-0 lead at the break. Geter's performance helped Gardner-Webb to its seventh win of the season -- the program's highest win total since 2003.

Day connected on both field goal and PAT attempts to finish with eight points at Presbyterian, and averaged 42.1 yards on 11 punts in helping the Runnin' Bulldogs to a seven-point win over the Blue Hose. His second quarter field goals from 26 and 23 yards gave GWU a 13-0 lead at halftime. He also pinned PC inside the 20-yard line four times and had long punts of 56 and 59 yards. Day's hang time on a 44-yard punt late in the third quarter led to a muffed catch, which GWU converted into a touchdown and 20-7 advantage.

COASTAL CAROLINA CLINCHES BIG SOUTH'S AUTOMATIC BID TO FCS PLAYOFFS

Coastal Carolina is the Big South's automatic bid recipient to the 2013 FCS Playoffs, marking the third time in the League's four-year history of having the AQ that Coastal is the Big South's automatic representative. The Chanticleers will host a playoff game for the second time (first was in 2010) and will face Bethune-Cookman in a rematch of last season's first round game.

CHANTICLEERS TO MAKE FOURTH PLAYOFF APPEARANCE

Coastal Carolina will make its Big South-record fourth playoff appearance this Saturday when the Chanticleers host Bethune-Cookman. Coastal was the Big South's first playoff team in 2006 as an at-large, and received the League's first-ever automatic bid in 2010. The Chants were automatic qualifiers last season as well. Coastal is 1-3 all-time in the FCS Playoffs, while the Big South is 3-5 in the postseason -- but 2-1 in home playoff games.

BIG SOUTH HAS CO-CHAMPIONS FOR THE FOURTH TIME IN FIVE YEARS

Coastal Carolina and Liberty shared the Big South football championship with 4-1 League records, marking the fourth time in five seasons that the Conference has had co-champions in football. It is the sixth time in the League's 12-year football history that multiple champions have been crowned in a season. Coastal received the Big South's automatic bid to the playoffs based on the Chanticleers' head-to-head win over Liberty on Oct. 19.

SIX PACK

Coastal Carolina was the first team in Big South history to win six Big South football championships when the Chanticleers clinched a share of the title during Week 12, and Liberty joined them atop the leaderboard with its sixth title as well. The Chanticleers have won titles in 2004, 2005 (shared), 2006, 2010 (shared), 2012 (shared) and 2013 (shared). Liberty's six championships have come in 2007, 2008, 2009 (shared), 2010 (shared), 2012 (shared) and 2013 (shared).

PRELUDE TO A CHAMPIONSHIP

Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern each started League play with 3-0 records -- the 15th and 16th time in Big South history that a member opened 3-0 in Conference action. With Coastal capturing a share of the League title, 14 squads that were 3-0 have now gone to win/share the Big South championship. Charleston Southern becomes just the second team to start 3-0 in League play to not win the trophy, joining the 2011 Liberty Flames as the only teams to open 3-0 in Big South games and not finish first.

CHAMPIONSHIP BAROMETER

The winner of the Coastal Carolina-Liberty meeting has won or shared the Big South football championship nine times out of 11 all-time match-ups. In Week 8, Coastal Carolina won for just the second time in Lynchburg with its 55-52 double-overtime victory over Liberty, which ended the Flames' Big South-record 18-game home Conference win streak. Coastal now leads the series with Liberty, 6-5. Here is a closer look at the series:

CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE WON IN NOVEMBER

Six-time Big South football champion Coastal Carolina is 27-8 (=77.1) in its history in regular-season games in November. In fact, the Chanticleers are the only Big South member to win a game in November every season since 2003. In addition, six-time champ Liberty is 28-9 (=75.7 percent) since 2002 during the month of November.

7-UP

A League-record four Big South teams won at least seven games this season, breaking the old record of three that was set in 2011. The Conference had two 10-win teams for the first time in Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern. It is also the first time that three members won at least eight games in the same year, as Liberty finished with eight victories. Gardner-Webb's seven wins rounds out the list.

FLAMES CONTINUE BIG SOUTH'S SEASON-ENDING TRADITION

Liberty closed out the regular-season with five consecutive wins, continuing a streak in the Big South that has occurred every year since the League's first season in 2002 -- a minimum four-game win streak to finish the year. Last season, Coastal Carolina reeled off five-straight wins to end the regular-season. Prior to that, it was Stony Brook in 2011 (8 consecutive wins); Coastal Carolina in 2010 (4); Charleston Southern in 2008 and 2009 (4); Liberty in 2007 (5); Coastal Carolina in 2006 (8); Charleston Southern in 2005 (5); Coastal Carolina (8) and Liberty (4) in 2004; Liberty in 2003 (4) and Gardner-Webb in 2002 (8).

"LO-REND-ZONE"

Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** has set the Big South single-season record for most touchdowns (25) and rushing touchdowns (23). The third player in Big South history with 20 TDs in a season, Taliaferro broke the old records set by Stony Brook's **MIGUEL MAYSONET** in 2012. Maysonet's record totals were 23 overall touchdowns and 21 rushing scores. Meanwhile, Taliaferro is the first player in Big South history with five 3-TD games in a campaign and has scored a touchdown in 11 of CCU's 12 games this season. His eight multi-TD games this year are second-most in a single-season, one away from Maysonet's Big South record of nine in 2012.

PULLING RANK

Gardner-Webb defeated its third nationally-ranked opponent with its 27-10 win over No. 12/13 Charleston Southern in Week 12. GWU was playing its fourth Top 25 opponent of the regular-season and is the first team in Big South history to defeat three nationally-ranked teams in a campaign. The Runnin' Bulldogs allowed just 20 combined points in its three upset wins (6.7 ppg) and held two opponents to less than 20 yards rushing.

TEN-TAMOUNT

For the first time in Big South history, two teams have won 10 games in a season. Charleston Southern was the first to 10 wins this year, reaching double-digits in Week 11, while Coastal Carolina is now the first team in League annals with two 10-win campaigns (2004, 2013). It is the fifth time in League history that a member has collected 10 victories in a season, and Coastal will look to become the Big South's first 11-win program this weekend in the FCS Playoffs.

COASTAL'S RECORD SETTING SEASON

Coastal Carolina has established the Big South single-season record with 511 points, 69 touchdowns, and 5,932 yards of offense -- breaking the old marks of 494 points, 66 touchdowns and 5,741 yards that were set by Stony Brook in 2011. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina's season average of 494.3 yards of offense is pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 468.1 established by the Chanticleers in 2006. Coastal has surpassed 500 yards of offense in a game a Big South-record seven times this season -- including a Conference-record four games with more than 600 in a contest.

CUP OF JOE

Coastal Carolina second-year head coach **JOE MOGLIA** has won 18 of his first 25 games leading the Chanticleers -- the most wins by a head coach in his first two years in the Big South. The previous record was 17 victories established by former Gardner-Webb leader **STEVE PATTON** in his first two seasons in the Big South from 2002-03 (17-5).

ALL'S WELL WITH CHADWELL

Charleston Southern head coach **JAMEY CHADWELL** is the first head coach to win 10 games in his first season in the Big South. The previous high for most wins by a new head coach in his first season in the League was eight wins -- Coastal Carolina's **JOE MOGLIA** in 2012.

50 SHADES OF GREY

The Big South has a single-season record 13 50-point games this season, which surpasses the previous high of eight that was set during the 2004 campaign. Coastal Carolina owns six of the those 50-point games, establishing the Big South single-season mark for most 50-point contests. In fact, Coastal is the first team in League history to score 50 points in three-straight games *TWICE* in the same season. The Big South's remaining 50-point games belong to Liberty (4) and Gardner-Webb (3).

KEEPING TALLIES ON TALIAFERRO

Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** has rushed for a CCU single-season record 1,487 yards through the Chanticleers' 12 games, breaking the old mark of 1,107 that was established by **PATRICK HALL** in 2004. Taliaferro has a school-record eight 100-yard rushing games this season, which also is the school's all-time career record. His 1,487 rushing yards rank fourth on the Big South's single-season rushing list. Meanwhile, Taliaferro is 149 rushing yards away from 2,000 in his career.

MEET THE CANDIDATES

The Big South has five individuals as official candidates for the national awards in FCS. Gardner-Webb DL **SHAQUILLE RIDDICK** was added to the Buck Buchanan Award list last week, joining Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS** among the 20 candidates for National Defensive Player of the Year. It is just the second time in League history that two Big South players are among the Buchanan Award finalists. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina RB **LORENZO TALIAFERRO** is a Walter Payton award candidate for National Offensive Player of the Year. In addition, the Conference has -- for the second consecutive season -- two candidates for the Eddie Robinson Award honoring the National Coach of the Year in Charleston Southern's **JAMEY CHADWELL** and Coastal Carolina's **JOE MOGLIA**.

COAST IS CLEAR

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 11 in both the FCS Coaches poll and *The Sports Network* ranking. The Chanticleers are the second team in Big South history to be ranked in BOTH polls each week of the season (including preseason). The Chanticleers join former member Stony Brook, which was ranked in the Top 25 every week of the 2012 campaign. The Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 34 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24).

BLUE SWARM

Charleston Southern is nationally-ranked for the eighth consecutive week, as the Buccaneers are No. 20 in this week's FCS Coaches poll and No. 23 in *The Sports Network* ranking. CSU was No. 12/13 in the Nov. 11 polls -- the highest rankings in program history and the first time the Big South had two teams inside the Top 15 at any point in the season. CSU entered the Top 25 rankings this season for the first time since the week of Nov. 6, 2006. The Big South had three teams ranked this year -- the second time in League history that three teams were nationally-ranked in a season.

HOME RUNS

Coastal Carolina has the League's longest active home win streak at eight, their longest since winning 12 consecutive home games from Sept. 11, 2004 - Nov. 12, 2005.

REYES OF SUNSHINE

Charleston Southern RB **CHRISTIAN REYES** is the first player in school history to rush for 1,000 yards in a season. He concludes the season second in the Big South with 1,254 rushing yards, and had six 100-yard rushing efforts to his credit. Reyes became CSU's single-season rushing leader in Week 9 during the Charlotte game as he eclipsed the previous mark of 774 (**VINSON BLAIR** in 1998).

RECORD ROAD WARRIORS

Charleston Southern's six road wins this year are the most in League history. The first Big South team to win at least five *regular-season* road games in a season, the Bucs eclipsed the previous record of five overall road wins (regular-season and postseason) that was set by Coastal Carolina in 2012. Earlier this season, Charleston Southern matched the Big South record for longest road winning streak (5). Liberty first set the mark with its five consecutive road wins from Oct. 20, 2007 - Oct. 4, 2008.

EYES ON HAZEL

Coastal Carolina senior WR **MATT HAZEL** is the Big South's active career leader with 168 receptions (5th in League history), 2,380 receiving yards (6th) and 25 touchdowns (4th). He became the ninth player in the Conference record book with 2,000 yards receiving in Week 9. Hazel is among the 2014 Senior Bowl Watch List candidates as well as the South Carolina Football Hall of Fame College Player of the Year Award Watch List.

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal is 15-1 in its last 16 games when rushing for more than 200 yards, including 9-0 this season. The Chanticleers have rushed for more than 200 yards 59 times in their history, and are 54-5 (-91.5) when reaching 200 rushing yards. Earlier this season Coastal rushed for more than 300 yards in three consecutive games during Weeks 3-5 (358.7 average in that span), the first Big South member since Stony Brook in 2011 to surpass the threshold in three-straight contests, and the fourth time overall. The Chanticleers' 20 all-time 300-yard rushing games are a Big South record.

SECOND HALF SHUTDOWN

Coastal Carolina averaged 20.45 points in the second half this season against FCS foes, while holding those opponents to an average of 9.09 points during the final 30 minutes of regulation. In those games, the Chanticleers did not allow points in the third quarter five times, and none in the fourth quarter five times -- including two games with second half shutouts. Coastal's defense allowed FCS members just 192.8 yards in the second half of games (excluding overtimes) with a total of just 13 touchdowns and three field goals. FCS opponents mustered just 3.73 points against the Chants in the third quarter and 5.36 points in the fourth stanza.

SHAQ THE SACK MASTER

Gardner-Webb junior DL **SHAQUILLE RIDDICK** set the Big South single-season sack record with 8.5, breaking the old mark of 8.0 that was set by Liberty's **AARON DeBERRY** in 2002. Riddick also led the Big South with 19.0 TFL -- the third-most in a single-season in Big South history. Meanwhile, Riddick was added the Ted Hendricks Award Watch List on Nov. 18, which honors the national Defensive End of the Year. He is the lone FCS player on the list.

SOLO ARTIST

Coastal Carolina junior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is tied for eighth all-time in Big South history with 155 career solo tackles, matching former Coastal Carolina safety **DOMINIQUE DAVENPORT**'s career solo tackle total from 2006-10. Backus, who is 14th in the nation with 5.7 solo tackles per game, needs four solo hits to move past Stony Brook's **DOMINICK REYES** (158) for seventh-place in the Conference record book.

INSIDE THE TACKLE BOX

Coastal Carolina junior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the Big South's active leading career tackler with 281 stops. He ranks 16th in Big South history and is 19 away from becoming the 11th player with 300. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College's **DONELLE WILLIAMS**, Gardner-Webb's **TANNER BURCH** and **PRESTON PEMASA**, Coastal Carolina's **MIKE McCLURE** and VMI's **WESTON REBER** all joined the Big South's 200-tackle club this season. HOME COOKIN'

Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** leads the Big South with 76 receptions, 1,008 receiving yards and nine TDs. He had a League-high five 100-yard receiving games and seven in his career -- tied for the fourth-most all-time. Cook is looking to become the first GWU receiver to lead the Big South in receptions and receiving yards since 2009 (**JAMES PERRY III**), and lead in touchdown catches since 2008 (**DOBSON COLLINS**). Cook is also attempting to be the first Gardner-Webb player to lead the Big South in all three categories. The last Big South player to do was Liberty's **CHRIS SUMMERS** in 2011.

HIGH VOLUME

Coastal Carolina averaged 47.0 points in its five Conference games this season, the third-highest scoring average in League contests. The Chanticleers won three of their four Big South games by at least 30 points, tying the Big South record set by Liberty in 2007 and matched by the Flames in 2009.

BEATTY ON IT

Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** became the 11th quarterback in Big South history with 5,000 career passing yards when he eclipsed the milestone in Week 10 against Warner. He concludes the season ninth in League history with 5,611 yards, and also ranks in the Conference's career Top 10 with 503 completions (5th) and 821 pass attempts (T-6th). Beatty became the fifth QB in League history with 500 completions during the regular-season finale at Presbyterian.

PRESS ON

Gardner-Webb senior DE **PRESTON PEMASA** ends his career second in Big South history with 46.5 career tackles-for-loss -- the second player in League history with at least 40 career stops behind the line of scrimmage. Pemasa, who recorded a TFL in 10 of his 12 games this season, is also tied for third in the Conference record book with 16.5 quarterback sacks. Former Gardner-Webb All-American **BRIAN JOHNSTON** is the Big South's all-time leader in both categories with 53.5 TFL and 20.5 sacks.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN EMERGES AS VICTOR IN MATCH-UP OF RANKED BIG SOUTH TEAMS

Charleston Southern defeated Coastal Carolina, 31-26 in Week 11 in the first match-up of ranked Big South teams from the two major FCS polls (*The Sports Network* and FCS Coaches). The Bucs led 31-6 before the Chanticleers tallied 20 unanswered points for the final margin. The win gave CSU its first-ever 3-0 start in Big South play.

FIT TO BE TIED

Charleston Southern snapped Coastal Carolina's 14-game regular-season win streak in Week 11, which tied for the longest such streak in Big South history. The record was first set by the Buccaneers, who won 14 consecutive regular-season contests from Oct. 15, 2005 - Nov. 4, 2006.

BIG SOUTH SCORES RECORD NON-LEAGUE FCS WINS

The Big South went 16-9 against FCS opponents in the regular-season -- the most victories against non-Conference FCS foes in the League's 12-year football history. The previous best was 13 wins in 2006. The Big South won eight of its 16 FCS games on the road this season -- also a League record. The Conference posted its first winning record against out-of-conference FCS members, and went 6-3 against the SoCon this season, another all-time win mark and bests the previous high of four in 2006.

AMERICAN PICKERS

Liberty led the Big South with 19 interceptions for 365 yards in 2013. It is the third-most INTs in League history, while the 365 return yards are second-most in a campaign. It is also the second-time the Flames have amassed more than 300 yards on interception returns, the last being in 2003 (313). Liberty returned two of its 19 interceptions this season for scores, its fourth time with at least two pick-sixes as Big South members (3 in 2007, 2 in 2003 and 2 in 2011).

BIG TIME RUSH

Charleston Southern rushed for more than 200 yards in a game eight times this season -- including four games over 300 -- and went 8-0 when surpassing the 200-yard threshold. The Bucs, who rushed for more than 200 yards in five consecutive games during Weeks 3-7, have gained 200+ yards on the ground 13 times since the start of the 2012 season, and are 12-1 in those contests. CSU rushed for 298 yards at Appalachian State in Week 5, the first time the Buccaneers gained 200 yards on the ground in three consecutive games against non-Conference FCS opponents since the Big South began football in 2002.

THE 20/20 EXPERIENCE - 2 OF 2

Coastal Carolina saw its streak of consecutive games with 20 points scored end at 19 games, as the Chanticleers managed just 10 points at South Carolina this past Saturday. It was the longest such streak for the Chanticleers since scoring 20 points in 20 consecutive contests from Sept. 24, 2005 to Nov. 25, 2006. Meanwhile, Coastal's 53 points at Elon in Week 5 was its most scored against a non-Conference FCS foe since scoring 66 points vs. Savannah State on Nov. 4, 2006.

KORDENBROCK'S CAREER COMES TO AN END

VMI senior QB **ERIC KORDENBROCK** missed the final five games of the season with an injury suffered at Presbyterian in Week 8. He concludes his career sixth all-time in Big South history with 6,142 passing yards, third all-time in the Conference record book with 567 completions and second with 1,052 attempts. Kordenbrock entered the League's Top 10 for career touchdown passes in Week 7 and is tied for 10th with 32. In addition, Kordenbrock tallied three 300-yard passing games this season, the most since Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** had four last year. Kordenbrock has four career 300-yard passing games, third-most in League history, and is also the only quarterback in Conference annals with four 80-yard pass plays.

McKIE'S BACK IN TOWN

Presbyterian College's **JEREMIAH McKIE** returned a kickoff 97 yards for a touchdown against VMI in Week 8, tied for the fourth-longest kickoff return in Big South history. He had a 50-yard punt return for a score in Week 2 vs. Brevard, and is the first player in League annals with a kickoff return touchdown and punt return touchdown in the same season.

BACK TO THE BEACH

Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS** returned an interception 73 yards for a touchdown against Gardner-Webb in Week 7, the second-longest interception return in Coastal history and the longest returned for a TD in CCU annals. Backus' pick-six is the seventh-longest in Big South history and the longest INT return by a linebacker. His 113 interception return yards this season are the most by a linebacker in the Conference record book.

MASTROMATTEO LANDS NFF SCHOLAR-ATHLETE AWARD AND POSTGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

Coastal Carolina senior **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO** is one of 16 student-athletes -- from a pool of 171 semifinalists across all NCAA divisions and the NAIA -- to receive the National Football Foundation (NFF) National Scholar-Athlete Award. Each honoree receives an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship, and one member of the class will be announced as the 24th recipient of the William V. Campbell Trophy, which recognizes the top scholar-athlete in the nation.

IT'S ACADEMIC

The Big South placed six players on the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District teams Nov. 7, tied for the most Academic All-District honorees in League history that was first achieved in 2008. This year's honorees are **LUCAS BEATTY** and **KEON WILLIAMS** from Gardner-Webb, **MITCH HANSON** and **SCOTT HYLAND** from Liberty and **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO** and **JEFFERY SALLEY** from Coastal Carolina. All six are on the national Academic All-America ballot.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 97, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (28). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's active leader for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 41, the third-longest streak in Big South history. That record is 45 games, established by the Flames from Sept. 23, 2006 - Sept. 18, 2010.

DOUBLED UP

Liberty owns the Conference record for most consecutive Big South games scoring in double figures at 46. Meanwhile, the Flames have scored in all 58 of their Conference games since 2002, while VMI tallied points in all 54 of its League contests since joining the Big South in 2003. Presbyterian College is the final Conference member to have not been shut out in a League contest (29 games).

APON TOP THE OF WORLD

Liberty TE **BRANDON APON** concludes his career as the Big South's all-time leader for most touchdown receptions by a tight end with eight, as he broke the record of six in the Coastal Carolina game in Week 8. He surpassed former Charleston Southern tight ends **BRYAN MEERS** (2004-05) and **CLAYTON COFFMAN** (2006-09) for the touchdown record. Apon caught eight of his 24 career receptions for scores -- 33.3 percent.

FIRE HYDRANT

Each of Liberty's four losses this season were by single digits for a combined total of 23 points, an average of 5.75 points. On the flip side, the Flames' average margin of victory in their eight wins was 32.4 points. Meanwhile, Liberty's 24-0 shutout win over Gardner-Webb in Week 9 was its Big South-record eighth since the League began football in 2002.

FOGG HAS LIFTED

Liberty redshirt-senior **KEVIN FOGG** departs the Big South with six career return touchdowns, as he is the only player in Big South history with return touchdowns on an interception (1), fumble (1), punt (1) and kickoff (3). Fogg tied as the Big South's all-time leader for most kickoff return touchdowns, and coupled with his one career punt return score, he is second in League history with four kick return TDs. Meanwhile, Fogg tallied nine interceptions for 186 yards in his career -- tied for ninth all-time in INTs and second all-time in interception return yards.

MOVING ON

VMI played its final campaign in the Big South this season, as the Keydets are rejoining the Southern Conference next fall. VMI concluded its Big South schedule in Week 11 with a 27-9 win over Gardner-Webb, and ends its 11-year affiliation in the League with a 12-42 record in Conference games. The Keydets scored a point in all 54 of their Big South games, the second-longest such streak in League annals.

COMING ATTRACTIONS

The Big South Conference will welcome **MONMOUTH UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2014 and start-up program **KENNESAW STATE UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2015. Monmouth's addition will maintain the League's membership at six squads, while KSU's addition returns the Big South to seven members, which was the total from 2008-12. The Hawks got an early taste of League play with their 45-15 defeat at Liberty in Week 2. The Big South is 3-0 against Monmouth, with Coastal Carolina also earning wins in 2008 and 2009.

GARDNER-WEBB SCORES LEAGUE FIRST -- BACK-TO-BACK WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS

Gardner-Webb blanked No. 8/10 Wofford, 3-0, in Week 4 -- becoming the first team in Big South history to defeat nationally-ranked opponents in consecutive weeks. The Runnin' Bulldogs knocked off then-No. 11/15 Richmond in Week 3 (12-10), also without a touchdown. The Wofford win gave the Big South a League-record three wins over ranked non-conference FCS teams in 2013. Meanwhile, GWU won its first road game against a non-Conference foe since Sept. 12, 2009 at Western Carolina, and the Wofford win was Gardner-Webb's first over a ranked team on the road since a 38-35 win at No. 23 New Hampshire on Nov. 11, 2000.

BIG SOUTH SCORES LEAGUE FIRST WITH TWO WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS IN SAME WEEK

For the first time in League history, the Big South defeated two nationally-ranked teams in the same week of the regular-season as Gardner-Webb upset No. 11/15 Richmond and Coastal Carolina won at No. 25 Eastern Kentucky in Week 3. It was the second time overall in the Conference record book, as the Chants and former member Stony Brook achieved the feat in the first round of the 2012 FCS Playoffs. GWU also handed Richmond its first non-conference FCS loss since 2005 -- ending the Spiders' 17-game win streak in such games. Meanwhile, the Chants' win at ECU improved the Big South to 4-7 all-time when a ranked Big South team plays a nationally-ranked non-Conference opponent.

BIG SOUTH FCS PLAYOFF HISTORY

The Big South Conference begins its fifth appearance in the FCS Playoffs. The Big South is 3-5 in its history in the postseason, and has reached the second round three times. Here is a look at the Conference's all-time playoff history:

* Charleston Southern concluded the season with a school-record 10 wins, as well as a League-record six road victories.

* The Buccaneers were mentioned as one of the teams first teams left out of the FCS Playoff bracket, announced on Sunday.

* Freshman RB **MIKE HOLLOWAY** had 73 yards on four carries to lead the Bucs' attack in the season-finale against Liberty.

* WR **DONTE SUMPTER** hauled in a 42-yard touchdown pass and QB **KYLE COPELAND** had a 4-yard TD run for the Bucs' two scores.

* Senior DB **ELJJAH LEE** had 10 tackles, including two for loss, to lead the Bucs' defense vs. Liberty.

* The Bucs threw 16 touchdown passes this season and totaled 22 rushing scores. Their 40 overall touchdowns are the most since scoring 41 in 2006.

* RB **CHRISTIAN REYES** capped his first season at Charleston Southern with 1,254 rushing yards and nine touchdowns, both CSU records.

* WR **KEVIN GLEARS** led the squad with 31 receptions and six TD grabs. His six touchdown catches are the most by a Buccaneer since **GERALD STEVENSON** had nine in 2008.

* The Bucs averaged 232.9 rushing yards per game this season, their highest since the Big South began football in 2002. It is also the second-straight season CSU averaged more than 200 rushing yards per game.

* Coastal Carolina meets Bethune-Cookman for the second time on Saturday and second-straight year in the FCS Playoffs. The Chanticleers won last year's meeting, a 24-14 road victory.

* Coastal concluded the regular-season with a perfect 6-0 record at home, its first undefeated home campaign since going 5-0 at Brooks Stadium in 2009. A win Saturday would tie the school record for most home wins in a season (7 in 2004).

* The Chanticleers enter the playoffs as a ranked team for the second time. In 2006, CCU opened the postseason ranked No. 13 in both major polls.

* Coastal has rushed for 200-plus yards in 16 of its last 19 games.

* With 302 first downs in 12 games this season, Coastal has broken the Big South record for first downs with the previous mark being 288 set by CCU in 13 games last season.

* WR **MATT HAZEL** (168) is CCU's all-time leader in career receptions. He broke **JEROME SIMPSON** previous record of 161 during Week 12.

* QB **ALEX ROSS**, in 12 starts (18 games played), has been involved in six of the program's top seven single-game efforts for total offense.

* CCU has allowed a touchdown or less in seven of 12 games this season and has not allowed a fourth-quarter TD seven times. The Chants have set a school record with 51 PBU this season.

* Gardner-Webb ended the season with two consecutive wins, its longest win streak to close out the season since concluding the 2004 campaign with two-straight victories.

* The Runnin' Bulldogs defeated more ranked teams in 2013 (3) than it had in its previous 13 seasons as a member of Division I FCS (2). Each of the teams GWU has knocked off this season were ranked in the Top 15.

* GWU has reached seven wins for the first time since 2003 when the Runnin' Bulldogs were 8-4.

* Head coach **CARROLL MCCRAY** is the first GWU coach to post a winning mark in his first season since 1997, and only the second in Gardner-Webb's senior college history to do so.

* Gardner-Webb's defense finished the regular-season ranked No. 6 nationally in total defense (296.8 yards per game), its best mark since 2010 (15th, 308.0 ypg). The mark sets a Big South record for total defense, edging last season's Stony Brook unit (298.6 yards per game).

* WR **KENNY COOK** (1,008) became the program's first 1,000-yard receiver since **RODNEY ROBINSON** in 1992. RB **JUANNE BLOUNT** (1,040) became the second 1,000-yard rusher in the past three seasons, but just the fourth since 1989. It is the first time GWU has had a 1,000-yard rusher and receiver in the same season.

* GWU won multiple road games in a season for the first time since 2009 and won a Big South road game for the first time since October 22, 2011.

* Liberty's win over #16/18 Charleston Southern marked the second-highest ranked opponent the Flames have defeated on the road in program history.

* The Flames have defeated a Top 20 program in its final game of the year for the second time in the last six seasons (Liberty wrapped up the 2008 season with a 26-3 victory over No. 12 Elon at home on Nov. 22).

* Liberty scored 447 points in 2013, the second-most in a season in program history (program record is 469 points scored in 2007).

* **JACOB HAGEN**'s six INTs are the most by a Flame since **RICHARD SHELTON** had six in 1987. Hagen is tied for the national lead for interceptions and is seventh in INTs per game (0.5).

* With 16 rushing touchdowns, **DESMOND RICE** has the most by a Flame since **RASHAD JENNINGS** had 17 in 2008.

* The Flames rushed for a school-record 36 touchdowns this season, breaking the old mark of 32 that was set in 2007.

* QB **JOSH WOODRUM** finished the season with 2,581 passing yards, which ranks second in Liberty's record books among passing yards by a sophomore quarterback (school record is 3,076 by **ROBBY JUSTINO** in 1991).

* The Blue Hose defense delivered one of its best games of the season, holding Gardner-Webb to minus-1 yard in the fourth quarter and zero third down conversions in the second half on eight tries.

* **UGONNA AKOH** tied with Big South single-game record with 5.0 TFL against the Runnin' Bulldogs, and added a forced fumble, eight tackles and 1.5 sacks.

* PC outrushed the Runnin' Bulldogs, 138 to 103, thanks in part to **DEMARCUS ROUSE**'s 45 yards on eight carries. PC also matched the visitors in first downs (16) and held them to a combined 38 yards on two kickoff and two punt returns.

* Akoh recorded at least one TFL in all but two games this season, and finished second in the Big South with 14.0 TFL.

* QB **HEYS McMATH** threw a touchdown pass in all six of his appearances this season, including four games with at least two.

* The 1,626 rushing yards by the Blue Hose this season ranks second in the PC Division I era, while the 21 rushing TDS tied for first. PC's 37 total TDs scored is tied for 2nd.

* PC's offensive line surrendered just 11 sacks this season to lead the Big South and rank 15th in the nation in fewest sacks allowed per game (1.0).

* VMI suffered its first 10-loss season since finishing the 2006 campaign with a 1-10 mark. The Keydets conclude their 11-year affiliation in the Big South with a 27-96 overall record and 12-42 mark in League games.

* The Keydets held a 17-7 advantage over Bucknell before the Bison scored 21 unanswered points to take the lead for good at 28-17 with 13:31 left in the game.

* WR **JAMES ROGERS** led VMI with a game-high six catches for 91 yards against Bucknell.

* Rogers combined with **SAM PATTERSON** (3-57) and **DOUG BURTON** (4-51) to catch 13 of **A.J. AUGUSTINE**'s 19 passes and 199 of Augustine's 244 passing yards on Saturday.

* Patterson caught a pass in all 12 games, and led the team with eight TD receptions -- which were second in the Big South and the most by a Keydet since **MARK STOCK** had eight in 1986.

* Since replacing injured QB **ERIC KORDENBROCK** in Week 8, Augustine went 93-of-154 for 1,149 yards and nine touchdowns, along with a 120.31 passing efficiency rating.

* RB **DERRICK ZIGLAR** finished the season with 768 yards, the most by a VMI back since **HOWARD ABEGESAH** gained 954 in 2009.

* PK **DILLON CHRISTOPHER** made two 52-yard field goals this season, the first player in Big South history to make two from that distance in the same season.
