Brown shot 68.0 percent (17-of-25) and averaged 20.0 points and 10.0 rebounds while leading High Point to a pair of non-conference wins last week. He scored 18 points on 7-of-10 shooting and had 12 rebounds, three assists and three blocks in the Panthers' 80-69 win over William & Mary on Wednesday. Brown then scored 22 points on 10-of-15 shooting and grabbed eight rebounds with two blocks in High Point's win over Wofford on Sunday.

## CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

**DARIUS LEONARD** scored 16 points on 7-of-10 shooting (2-of-3 threes) at Cincinnati. The redshirt-junior center is the lone Camel to score in double figures in all 5 games this year ... Redshirt-junior guard **ANDREW RYAN** pulled down a career-high 10 rebounds vs. N.C. Central, then tallied 17 points (5-8 threes) with 4 assists at Cincinnati ... Redshirt junior forward **RECO McCARTER** scored a season-high 13 points at Cincinnati ... Campbell (2-3) hosts NAIA member St. Andrews Wednesday at noon, then travels to Georgia Southern for a 7 p.m. tip-off Saturday. The Camels own a 13-0 all-time record against St. Andrews, most recently a 76-52 triumph Nov. 13, 2009 ... Campbell and Georgia Southern have not played since the 1984-85 campaign, but square off twice this year. The Eagles will travel to Gore Arena Dec. 30.

## HIGH POINT PANTHERS

**JOHN BROWN** averaged 20 points and 10 rebounds while shooting 68.0 percent from the floor last week. His 22-point performance against Wofford on Sunday was the 15th 20+ point game of his career ... Brown is averaging 2.2 assists this season after averaging 0.7 last year ... **DEVANTE WALLACE's** 17 points at William & Mary last Wednesday were a career-high against a Div. I opponent. In five games this season, he's averaging 9.0 points and 5.6 rebounds while shooting 44.4 percent (8-of-18) from three-point range ... Sophomore forward **LORENZO CUGINI** scored a career-high 15 points and hit two three-pointers against Wofford ... High Point's win over William & Mary was the team's first over a CAA opponent since the 2004-05 season. HPU is 3-7 against CAA teams since moving up to NCAA Div. I in 1999-00 ... The Panthers have beaten Wofford in the teams' last two meetings. They rematch on Dec. 30 in Spartanburg, S.C.

## LIBERTY FLAMES

Liberty is currently on a four-game losing skid after dropping contests to UNCW and Virginia last week ... **DAVON MARSHALL** paced the Flames with a season-high 24 points against Wilmington. Marshall followed up with a 15-point performance on Saturday versus the Cavaliers. The senior now needs five points to crack Liberty's all-time top 50 scoring list ... Marshall has also made 30 consecutive free throws dating back to Liberty's 2013 Big South Championship first round game against Coastal Carolina. He is a perfect 13-for-13 on the season and needs 12 to surpass **SETH CURRY** (41) for the most consecutive free throws in program history ... **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** (1,062) is three points away breaking into the top 20 on Liberty's career points list ... **ANTWAN BURRUS** (107) is currently tied for third on the program's all-time blocked shots list. Burrus (475) also needs six more boards to surpass **BRAD HAMERSLEY** for 15th on the program's all-time rebounding list.

## LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood (2-3) dropped a pair of non-conference games last week, an 81-69 home loss to Brown and a 93-67 road loss at Penn State ... Senior **TRISTAN CAREY** led Longwood with a game-high 21 points against Brown, adding game highs of nine rebounds and four steals ... He surpassed the 1,000 career point plateau against the Bears, and now totals 1,026 points (20th all-time) with the Lancers in 69 games (14.9) since transferring from La Salle University following his freshman season in 2009-10 ... Freshman **ISAAC BELTON** led Longwood at PSU in the first game of the Barclays Center Classic presented by Continental Tire with his season-high 17 points off the bench in 21 minutes, including 7-8 free throws ... Longwood will remain on the road to play at St. John's on Nov. 26, and will continue in the event at Monmouth University in West Long Branch, New Jersey with games against North Carolina A&T on Nov. 29, and either host Monmouth or Mississippi Valley State on Nov. 30.

## RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Radford posted its first road win of the season, 69-63 at Binghamton, in its only game of the week. The Highlanders overcame a 14-point second half deficit against the Bearcats, which is the largest margin erased in the **MIKE JONES** era. With the win, the Highlanders have pushed their winning streak to three games, which is the longest under Jones ... RU is 3-1 for the second time in three seasons heading into Monday's contest at Cornell ... **YA YA ANDERSON** has scored in double figures in each game this season.

## VMI KEYDETS

Senior center **D.J. COVINGTON** averaged 24.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, and 5.0 blocks in games against Virginia Tech and Bridgewater last week ... Senior guard **RODNEY GLASOW** continues to provide a steady hand at point guard and averaged 17 points and 5.0 assists in two games last week. Glasgow helped fuel VMI's second half rally that fell short at Virginia Tech and finished with 22 points, four 3-pointers and four assists against the Hokies ... VMI's 13 blocks against Bridgewater Nov. 20 tied a Cameron Hall record.

## SOUTH DIVISION

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

CSU pushed No. 20 Baylor to the final minute in a 69-64 loss last Wednesday night. It was the second-straight time CSU put a scare into a Big 12 opponent. The Bucs led Kansas State 49-35 at halftime in the 2011-12 season opener before falling, 72-67 ... Junior **WILL SAUNDERS** scored a team-high 16 points against Baylor and hit a long three-pointer with 54 seconds left to cap a 7-0 run and pull the Bucs within 67-64 ... Saunders and senior **SHELDON STRICKLAND** (4-of-5 from three-point range) are leading the way for a CSU team that is thriving on the three-ball through five games. Saunders is 17-of-32 (53.1%) from beyond the arc, while Strickland is 15-of-27 (55.6%). CSU is 65-of-148 (43.9%) from three-point range as a team, and has connected on at least 12 treys in all five of its games ... The Bucs have showcased their depth by outscoring the opponent's bench, 235-75, so far this season.

## COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chants went 1-2 last week in EA Sports Maui Invitational games ... CCU began the week on the road at Minnesota for the Maui Invitational Opening Games. CCU fell 82-72 in a hard fought game ... Coastal then hosted the Maui on the Mainland Tournament and defeated St. Francis-NY, 70-59, before falling to Louisiana-Lafayette in the championship, 73-69 ... Freshman **ELIJAH WILSON** once again led the Chants this week averaging 19.0 points per game ... Senior **EL HADJI NDIUGUENE** averaged 9.0 points and 9.3 rebounds over the three games ... On the season, Wilson is averaging 17.0 points per game followed by junior **WARREN GILLIS** at 11.2 per game. Ndieguene is averaging 8.3 rebounds per game to lead the squad ... The Chants have just one game this week as they travel to Clemson. It will be the third meeting between the Chants and Tigers over the last three seasons. CCU has won the previous two meetings.

## GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb is in the midst of a four-games-in-six-days road trip that concludes this Thursday and Friday at the Orleans Arena in Las Vegas ... **JEROME HILL** has averaged 16.3 points per game in the team's last three games against Division I opponents, including 17 points at Missouri this past Saturday ... **TYLER STRANGE** has been very effective at point guard, dishing off 30 assists in five games with just seven turnovers ... **ISAIAH IVEY** averaged 12.5 points last week in two games, including a career-high 13 off the bench at Missouri.

## PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

**JORDAN DOWNING** and **WILLIAM TRUSS** have stepped up their scoring output from last season ... Downing averaged 12.8 ppg last season and is up six points this season to 18.8 so far ... Truss has gone from 6.8 a game to 10.0 ppg ... With a team so young, two freshmen find themselves in the top four in scoring with **REGGIE DILLARD** second with 13.3 ppg and **MARKUS TERRY** fourth with 6.8 ... Truss, who averaged just 4.6 rebounds and 6.8 points per game in 2012, is averaging a double-double in six games with 10.0 rpg and 10.0 ppg ... PC is heading to the Cancun Challenge this week with little knowledge of the teams they are facing. The Blue Hose have never played Bowling Green or potential opponent Oral Roberts. While PC has faced Georgia Southern, it has not been since a 72-58 loss back in 1993. Overall, the Eagles lead the series, 13-6, dating back to 1950.

## UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

Asheville has still not played a home game as the Bulldogs played two games in the NIT Tip-Off against Duke and Norfolk State and will play this week in the third and fourth round at Rhode Island and vs. East Carolina ... **SAM HUGHES** is starting in place of injured forward **WILL WEEKS** and he stepped up at Duke with 16 points and four steals against the Blue Devils. He then scored 16 the next night with a career-best eight rebounds against preseason MEAC favorite Norfolk State ... Freshman guard **DAVID ROBERTSON** also played well at Duke with 12 points against the Blue Devils and 13 points vs. Norfolk State ... The Bulldogs placed five players in double figures in an 80-78 loss to the Spartans ... **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** has collected 599 career rebounds and has 194 career blocked shots.

## WINTHROP EAGLES

**JAMES BOURNE** averaged 13.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 1.0 blocks per game to help the Eagles to a 2-0 record last week. He was an impressive 68.8 percent (11-of-16) from the field, including 6-for-6 vs. Virginia Intermont. Bourne scored 12 points and pulled down nine rebounds in aiding the Eagles to a 76-66 road win at East Tennessee State ... **KEON JOHNSON** averaged 15.5 points last week and was 3-for-4 from the field in the second half at ETSU, including knocking down his only triple, and was also 2-2 from the foul line to finish with 11 points, four rebounds, three assists and two steals. He followed that with a career-high 20 points in the win over Virginia Intermont.
