Hibbert led Gardner-Webb to a 2-1 record on the week and the Upper Division Championship at the 2013 Continental Tire Las Vegas Invitational, GWU's second Thanksgiving Week tournament crown in as many seasons. The 6-foot-5 guard averaged a teamhigh 17.0 points and contributed 2.3 rebounds, 1.7 steals and 1.3 assists per game. In the Las Vegas portion of the tournament, Hibbert averaged 19.0 ppg, shot 53.8 percent from the floor and 53.8 percent (7-of-13) from long distance. He led Gardner-Webb with a career-high 23 points in the title bout win over a 6-2 Morehead State squad, knocking down 8-of-13 from the floor, 4-of-8 from 3-point range and 3-of-4 from the charity stripe.

THE CRONS BRAND Freshman of the **W**eek

TYRELL NELSON • F/C Fr. • Gardner-Webb Charlotte, N.C.

Nelson averaged 12.3 points, 7.7 rebounds, 1.0 blocks and 1.0 steals in three games last week. He started the week with a career-high 14 points on 7-of-10 shooting in 17 minutes at Northwestern, scoring 10 of those markers in the second half to keep the game tight down the stretch. He then tallied eight points and grabbed seven rebounds in the win over IUPUI in his second career start. Nelson concluded the week with career-highs of 15 points and 11 boards in GWU's overtime win against Morehead State. For the week, he was 15-of-21 from the field (=71.4 percent) to go along with nine offensive rebounds.

POINT OF ORDER

Charleston Southern leads the Big South in scoring with 94.2 points per game, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest. CSU's 94.2 scoring clip is the highest average in the League since VMI averaged a Conference-record 100.9 points in 2006-07. In fact, the Keydets are the only Big South member to average more than 90 points in a season, having done so three times -- 2006-07 (100.9), 2007-08 (91.3) and 2008-09 (93.8).

WHAT IS YOUR Q SCORE?

VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** leads the Big South with 22.4 points per game, the highest individual scoring average in the Big South since the 2007-08 season when VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (27.8) and High Point's **ARIZONA REID** (23.9) were above the threshold. Peterson is looking to become just the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game, and his current scoring average is ahead of the League's freshman record of 20.2 points that was set by Liberty's **SETH CURRY** in 2008-09. Meanwhile, Peterson is the third-highest scoring freshman in the nation and one of five frosh nationwide averaging more than 20.0 points per contest.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** became the 69th member of the Big South's 500-rebound club when he eclipsed the milestone Nov. 25 at Cornell. Now with 513, he is the first Highlander with 500 career boards since **ART PARAKHOUSKI** and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** in 2009-10. Meanwhile, Green is approaching 1,000 career points as he enters the week 107 points shy of that milestone.

WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern junior guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 15 times in their career (nine times last season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 12-3 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 15 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

TAKE COVER

VMI forward/center **D.J. COVINGTON** leads the Big South with 3.86 blocked shots this season, which would rank as the third-highest single-season average in League history. Covington has blocked a shot in eight consecutive games, dating back to last season, and in 37 of his last 38 appearances. Since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (38 games), Covington has recorded 120 of his 193 career blocks in that span (=62.2 percent) for an average of 3.16 per contest.

D.J. - PART 1

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM**, who is out for a few weeks with a knee injury, is sixth all-time in Big South history with 194 career blocked shots and is six away from becoming the sixth player with 200. He is also tied for 42nd on the Big South's career rebounding list with 599. Already one of 10 players in League annals with 500 rebounds and 150 blocked shots, Cunningham is looking to become the fifth player in Big South history with 600 rebounds and 200 blocks in 2013-14.

D.J. - PART 2

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** is seventh in Big South history with 193 career blocked shots. He needs 34 rebounds for 500 in his career, which would make him the 11th player in League history with 500 boards and 150 rejections.

CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** and Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** are the longest-tenured Big South coaches, as each is in his ninth year. Baucom's Big South tenure will end after this season with VMI's departure to the Southern Conference on July 1, 2014. Meanwhile, Baucom is sixth all-time in Big South history with 122 victories at the Institute, while Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is tied for seventh-place with his 115 wins at Coastal Carolina. Radebaugh sits in ninth-place all-time in League annals with 110 victories. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern is averaging a League-leading 12.33 three-pointers per game this season, as well as 44.3 percent from beyond the arc. The Bucs have made at least 12 treys in all but one game this year and have been successful at least 45 percent of the time in three contests. CSU's average of 12.33 threes is second nationally and the highest in the Big South since VMI averaged a Conference-record 13.69 in 2008-09. The Buccaneers' current per game tally would be third-highest in the League record book, while their current three-point percentage is the best in the Big South in 26 years when the Bucs made a League-record 45.1 percent from beyond the arc in 1987-88. Just three times previously has a Big South member made at least 44.0 percent from long distance in a season.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,332 points during their respective careers with the Flames — the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 1,097 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

BIG BURRUS IS BACK

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS**, who missed all of 2012-13 with an injury, is on the verge of joining the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club, which currently stands at 18 members. Burrus has tallied 110 rejections in his career -- 27th in League annals, and enters the week with 495 career rebounds to his credit. He would become just the second Liberty player on the list, joining Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Charleston Southern junior **SAAH NIMLEY** is six points away from becoming the 118th player in Big South history to score 1,000 points. Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** is the Big South's active leading career scorer with 1,097 points and the only active 1,000-point scorer in the Conference -- for now. GLASS IS HALF FULL

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW** has 355 career assists and is 45 away from becoming the 23rd player in Big South history with 400. Once he reaches the milestone, he will be the first Keydet to join the League's 400-assist club.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' 2012-13 season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 115. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 649 Division I wins and is tied for 32nd all-time in Division I victories.

NORTH DIVISION

CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

Campbell defeated Georgia Southern, 75-73 in overtime Saturday to improve to 5-0 in OT games since the start of the 2012-13 season. **D.J. MASON** (20) and **KYRE' HAMER** (15) hit career highs for the Camels, while **QUINTON RAY** stole the ball with 3 seconds left and drove for the winning lay-up as time expired. The Camels matched their season-high with 11 three-pointers made ... CU is 2-0 vs. SoCon teams this year (including a 73-66 win at Appalachian State Nov. 12) and will host Georgia Southern on Dec. 30 ... **ANTWON OLIVER** scored a season-high 14 points in Campbell's 62-55 win over St. Andrews ... The Camels travel to UNC Wilmington Tuesday for the 99th meeting in the series. Campbell has played UNCW more than any other opponent and while the Seahawks leads the series by a 35-10 margin in the Division I era (since 1977-78), CU has won 2 of the last 3 and 3 of the last 5 meetings. However, the Camels have not won in Wilmington since Dec. 16, 1995.

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

JOHN BROWN posted his second-straight double-double in HPU's 71-68 loss to Stephen F. Austin on Sunday. His 27 points were one shy of his career-high ... Brown went 11-for-11 from the free-throw line, setting a HPU Div. I record for free-throw percentage. The previous best was 10-for-10 by SHAY SHINE against North Carolina Central on Feb. 7, 2011 ... LORENZO CUGINI made his first career start and grabbed a season-high nine rebounds against Stephen F. Austin on Sunday. He played a career-high 31 minutes and also added three assists and two blocks ... ADAM WEARY has scored in double figures in all four of his games this season and is shooting 59.4 percent from the floor ... HPU's appearance on Fox Sports 1 on Thursday at 9 p.m. is the school's first nationally-televised game this season. The Panthers' next TV game is on ESPNU on Jan. 10 vs. Radford at the Millis Center.

LIBERTY FLAMES

After suffering a narrow 54-52 defeat at Missouri State, Liberty finished the week with wins over Hampton and Sam Houston State to capture the Laguna Madre Division Championship in the Corpus Christi Challenge ... For his performance in Texas, ANTWAN BURRUS was named to the Corpus Christi Challenge All-Tournament team ... Liberty has held its last three opponents under 55 points and 35.0 percent shooting from the field. The Flames have also out-rebounded their opponents in three-straight contests and four of the last five ... JOHN CALEB SANDERS entered the Top 20 on Liberty's all-time scoring list during the Flames' contest at Missouri State ... DAVON MARSHALL entered the Top 50 of Liberty's all-time scoring list during Tuesday's contest against the Bears. Marshall needs nine more points to reach 600 ... Burrus is steadily working his way to becoming the 24th member of Liberty's 1,000-point club, as he currently has 863 points.

LONGWOOD LANCERS

JEYLANI DUBLIN led the way against St. John's with 16 points off the bench, making 7-12 field goals and 2-3 free throws, and tying a career-high with four blocks ... TRISTAN CAREY, who missed the SJU game with an injury, led the Lancers against North Carolina A&T with 20 points, including 16 in the second half, making 4-10 three-pointers. LUCAS WOODHOUSE finished with a season-high 19 points, including 11 in the first half ... KARL ZIEGLER led Longwood against Mississippi Valley State with his career- and game-high 23 points, including 11-of-12 free throws, and was named to the All-Tournament Team. Ziegler finished the two games in New Jersey with 40 points, including 24-of-28 free throws ... Longwood is home for its next four games, including two this week against NAIA member WVU Tech on Wednesday, and Eastern Kentucky on Saturday.

RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Radford finished the week 1-1 and completed a three-game road swing with games at Cornell and Virginia Tech ... The Highlanders won their fourth-straight game and swept a pair of games in the state of New York with a decisive 86-71 victory at Cornell last Monday. R.J. PRICE scored a season-high 24 points in leading four RU players in double figures ... RU had its four-game winning streak snapped at Virginia Tech as the Hokies defeated the Highlanders, 81-56. JAVONTE GREEN led Radford with 15 points, followed by Price with 11. RU drops to 1-6 all-time vs. Virginia Tech.

VMI KEYDETS

D.J. COVINGTON was held to a season-low 7 points against William & Mary, marking the first time he has been held to single digits this year. Covington did log two blocks against the Tribe to push his career total to 193 rejections, second on the VMI all-time list, and needs 10 more blocks to surpass LEWIS PRESTON (1990-93) ... JULIAN ELLEBY made his first career start against William & Mary, making him the third freshman to start a game for the Keydets this year ... QJ PETERSON had his first career double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds against William & Mary.

SOUTH DIVISION

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

CSU snapped a 3-game losing streak with a 105-58 win over Trinity Baptist on Tuesday. It was the first game this season the Bucs did not hit at least 12 three-point field goals in a game, as CSU went 9-of-19 from long range ... Two of CSU's starters and three of its main rotation players are shooting better than 50 percent from three-point range, led by **SHELDON STRICKLAND**'s 58.6 percent clip. Strickland was just 17-of-62 from three last year, but is a remarkable 17-of-29 so far this season ... Through six games, CSU's bench is out-scoring its opposition by a whopping 285-89 ... CSU takes on Delaware Tuesday night before taking an 11-day break from game action for final exams. The Bucs defeated Delaware, 95-93, in Newark on Nov. 10.

COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chants fell at Clemson last week, 69-40 ... The Chants are now 2-5 this season, including 2-2 at home and 0-3 on the road ... **ELIJAH WILSON** continues to lead the Coastal attack as he is averaging 16.9 points per game and ranks fifth in the Conference in scoring. Wilson has scored in double-figures every game this season ... **EL HADJI NDIEGUENE** is averaging a team-high 7.7 rebounds per contest so far this season, which ranks fourth in the Big South ... The Chants begin a three-game homestand this week as they host Western Carolina and North Carolina Wesleyan on Wednesday and Thursday, respectively.

GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb improved to 5-1 on neutral courts over the past two seasons with its wins in Las Vegas. The wins in Vegas snapped a 3-game losing streak for GWU in that city, with previous visits in 2002 and 2004 ... **ISAIAH IVEY** earned a spot on the All-Tournament Team after scoring 17 second-half points in the win over Morehead State ... GWU played both games in Las Vegas without leading rebounder **JEROME HILL**, who was injured by an elbow at Northwestern ... Gardner-Webb plays its first home game in nearly a month on Wednesday night, hosting Wofford. GWU is 13-3 at home over the past two seasons (2-0 in 2013-14) ... **JOSH CASTELLANOS** made 11-of-12 free throws in the overtime period to spark Gardner-Webb's win vs. Morehead State. Castellanos dished off a season-best eight assists with just two turnovers at Northwestern ... GWU made 29-of-33 free throws in the second half and overtime in the Morehead State win.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

PC opens the month of December with a road contest at UNCG. The two teams meet for the first time Tuesday, Dec. 3, at the Greensboro Coliseum, and will mark PC's third SoCon opponent of the season. PC is 0-2 so far with close losses to The Citadel and Georgia Southern ... With a team so young, two freshmen find themselves in the top four in scoring with **REGGIE DILLARD** second with 13.6 ppg and **MARKUS TERRY** fourth with 6.8. Dillard's ppg is good enough for 16th in the Conference ... **WILLIAM TRUSS** has increased his rebounding from 4.6 a game last season to 9.8 and currently leads the Big South. With his 10.3 ppg, he is just 0.2 rpg from averaging a double-double.

UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

UNC Asheville ends a tough eight-game road trip to begin the season with a 1-7 record ... Asheville has been decimated by injuries. WILL WEEKS will be out for the season. D.J.
