### CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### JORDAN DOWNING • G R-Jr. • Presbyterian College Huntersville, N.C.

Downing led PC to a 2-1 record last week as he averaged 24.3 points in the three games. At UNCG, he recorded a career-high and PC Division I record 37 points in leading the Blue Hose to the 87-66 win. He was 11-of-15 from the field, including 5-of-6 from three-point range, and made all 10 of his free throws against the Spartans. Following 15 points in just 22 minutes against Montreat, Downing scored a team-high 21 points against Furman on Dec. 7. For the week, Downing was 26-of-44 from the floor ( = 59.1 percent), 8-of-15 from three-point range (=53.3) and 13-of-14 from the charity stripe (=92.9).

### THE CRONS BRAND Freshman of the **W**eek

#### **REGGIE DILLARD • G** Fr. • Presbyterian College Greensboro, N.C.

Dillard averaged 12.3 points, 8.7 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals in three games. He scored in double-digits in two outings, including a team-leading 19 against Montreat. Dillard handed out eight assists in the win at UNCG as well as nine helpers against both Montreat and Furman. For the week, he was 14-of-29 from the field ( =48.3), including 5-of-14 from long distance ( =35.7).

#### POINT OF ORDER

Charleston Southern leads the Big South and the nation in scoring with 92.1 points per game, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest. CSU's 92.1 scoring clip is the highest average in the League since VMI averaged 93.8 points in 2008-09. In fact, the Keydets are the only Big South member to average more than 90 points in a season, having done so three times – 2006-07 (100.9), 2007-08 (91.3) and 2008-09 (93.8).

#### WHAT IS YOUR Q SCORE?

VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** leads the Big South with 21.3 points per game, the highest individual scoring average in the Big South since the 2009-10 season when Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** (21.4) was above the threshold. Peterson is looking to become just the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game, and his current scoring average is ahead of the League's freshman record of 20.2 points that was set by Liberty's **SETH CURRY** in 2008-09. Meanwhile, Peterson is the second-highest scoring freshman in the nation and one of four frosh nationwide averaging more than 20.0 points per contest.

#### **BURRUS' BOARDS AND BLOCKS**

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS**, who missed all of 2012-13 with an injury, became the 19th member of the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club when he surpassed the rebounding milestone this past Saturday against Greensboro College -- becoming the 70th Big South player to grab 500 caroms. Burrus has tallied 111 rejections in his career -- 27th in League annals, and is just the second Liberty player on the list. He joins Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97.

#### **GREEN MACHINE**

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** became the 69th member of the Big South's 500-rebound club when he eclipsed the milestone Nov. 25 at Cornell. Now with 522, he is the first Highlander with 500 career boards since **ART PARAKHOUSKI** and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** in 2009-10. Meanwhile, Green is approaching 1,000 career points as he enters the week 78 points shy of that milestone.

#### WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern junior guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 15 times in their career (nine times last season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 12-3 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 15 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

#### **TAKE COVER**

VMI forward/center **D.J. COVINGTON** leads the Big South with 3.33 blocked shots this season, which would rank as the fourth-highest single-season average in League history. Covington has blocked a shot in 10 consecutive games, dating back to last season, and in 39 of his last 40 appearances. Since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (40 games), Covington has recorded 123 of his 196 career blocks in that span (=62.8 percent) for an average of 3.08 per contest.

#### **D.J. - PART 1**

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** is sixth in Big South history with 196 career blocked shots. He needs 11 rebounds for 500 in his career and is on the verge of becoming just the fifth player in League history with 500 boards and 200 rejections.

#### D.J. - PART 2

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM**, who is out for a few weeks with a knee injury, is seventh all-time in Big South history with 194 career blocked shots and is six away from joining the 200-blocked shot club. He is also tied for 42nd on the Big South's career rebounding list with 599. Already one of 10 players in League annals with 500 rebounds and 150 blocked shots, Cunningham is looking to become the fifth player in Big South history with 600 rebounds and 200 blocks in 2013-14.

#### TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern is averaging a League-leading 11.43 three-pointers per game this season, as well as 41.7 percent from beyond the arc. The Bucs have made at least 12 treys in all but two games this year and have been successful at least 45 percent of the time in three contests. CSU's average of 11.43 threes is third nationally and the highest in the Big South since VMI averaged 11.55 in 2009-10. The Buccaneers' current per game tally would be fifth-highest in the League record book, while their current three-point percentage is the best since 2003-04 when Birmingham-Southern converted 43.0 percent from beyond the arc.

#### WATCH YOUR P'S AND Q'S

In addition to leading the Conference in scoring, VMI freshman QJ PETERSON is pacing the League in steals with 2.78 per game. It is the highest per game average since 2008-09, when Keydet twins CHAVIS and TRAVIS HOLMES averaged 3.39 and 3.22, respectively. Peterson is looking to become the first freshman to lead the League in steals per game. The last player to lead the Big South in scoring and steals was Chavis Holmes in 2008-09 (22.0 ppg, 3.39 spq).

#### CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** and Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** are the longest-tenured Big South coaches, as each is in his ninth year. Baucom's Big South tenure will end after this season with VMI's departure to the Southern Conference on July 1, 2014. Meanwhile, Baucom is sixth all-time in Big South history with 123 victories at the Institute, while Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is in seventh-place with his 117 wins at Coastal Carolina. Radebaugh sits in ninth-place all-time in League annals with 110 victories. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

#### **BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,344 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. #### **BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB**

Charleston Southern junior **SAAH NIMLEY** became the 118th player in Big South history to score 1,000 points when he eclipsed the milestone Dec. 3 vs. Delaware. He joins Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** as the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers -- for now, as Sanders stands at 1,109 points. #### **GLASS IS HALF FULL**

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW** has 368 career assists and is 32 away from becoming the 23rd player in Big South history with 400. Once he reaches the milestone, he will be the first Keydet to join the League's 400-assist club.

#### IN WILLIAM WE TRUSS

Presbyterian College junior **WILLIAM TRUSS** leads the Big South with 10.0 rebounds per game. He is looking to become the first Big South player to average double-digit rebounds since Liberty's **JOHN BROWN** (10.8) in 2010-11. If Truss can maintain his top position, he would become the first Blue Hose player to lead the League in rebounds.

#### **CLIFF NOTES**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' 2012-13 season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 117. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 651 Division I wins and is 32nd all-time in Division I victories. ### BIG SOUTH MEN'S BASKETBALL WEEKLY REPORT • TEAM-BY-TEAM NOTEBOOK • DEC. 9, 2013

#### **NORTH DIVISION**

#### CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

After a week-long break for final exams, Campbell (4-4) returns to action Tuesday when it hosts Division II Chowan. CU is 2-0 vs. non-D1 members this year. Campbell leads the all-time series, 16-3, with the first 18 of those meetings coming between 1952-61 (CU won 15). The teams have not met since Nov. 15, 2008 when the Camels defeated the Hawks in the first men's basketball game at Gore Arena ... CU travels to Loyola-III. Friday for its first meeting with the Ramblers, who are new members of the Missouri Valley Conference. CU last took on a MVC foe in Nov. 2011 when the Camels dropped a 104-81 decision at No. 25 Creighton ... ANDREW RYAN is 4th among League leaders with a 46.5 3FG percentage and 8th in 3s per outing (2.5). He is averaging 15.3 points at home, 11.9 overall ... Freshman KYRE' HAMER has scored in double digits in each of CU's last 2 games.

#### HIGH POINT PANTHERS

**ALLAN CHANEY**, who missed the last two games, will not resume his playing career due to health concerns ... Freshman **JORGE PEREZ-LAHAM** led High Point with a career-high 10 points at Georgetown. It was the first time this season that a freshman led the Panthers in scoring ... Freshmen accounted for 25 of HPU's 45 points at Georgetown ... **JOHN BROWN** scored eight points against Georgetown, just the fourth time in 35 career games that he was held to single digits.
