**FANNING THE FLAMES -- LIBERTY TABBED PRESEASON FAVORITE**

Fort the 16th time in the last 17 years, Liberty is the preseason women's basketball favorite for the 2013-14 season. The Lady Flames received 13 of the 25 first-place votes and 261 out of a possible 275 points. Liberty will have two starters and nine letterwinners back from last year's Big South championship and NCAA Tournament squad. Winthrop was voted second with 256 points and 11 first-place bids. Campbell was picked third with 206 points.

**MCCLANAHAN VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR**

Winthrop senior **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** is the 2013-14 Big South Women's Hoops Preseason Player of the Year. McClanahan is the reigning two-time Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She is looking to become the first player with three consecutive Player of the Year Awards since Liberty's Katie Feenstra from 2003-05. McClanahan led the League in scoring for the second-straight year in 2012-13 with 19.8 points per game and was also tops with 5.8 assists per game.

**PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH**

Joining McClanahan on the Preseason All-Big South Team is Campbell's **KIERA GAINES**, High Point's **STACIA ROBERTSON**, Longwood's **DAEISHA BROWN** and Liberty's **EMILY FRAZIER**. Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** and **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** from Winthrop rounded out the Preseason All-Conference Team.

**NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE**

The Big South has two new coaches on the sideline this season. **JAIDA WILLIAMS** is the new skipper at Coastal Carolina, while **MIKE MCGUIRE** took over at Radford.

**THRICE AS NICE**

For the second-straight year and third time in the last four years, three Big South women's squads received berths in the NCAA postseason., tying the League record. Liberty was the League's representative in the NCAA Tournament, while Winthrop captured the Big South's automatic bid to the WNIT. Presbyterian College, in its first year of full Division I status and postseason eligibility, accepted an at-large invitation to the WBI.

**TRIPLE CROWN**

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan will attempt to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the Conference in scoring in three consecutive seasons., as Liberty's Elena Kisseleva is the only player to win three Big South scoring titles. Meanwhile, McClanahan will look to become the first player to ever lead the League in assists three-straight years in 2013-14.

**MAGIC WAND-A**

With Campbell's win over Western Carolina earlier this season, **WANDA WATKINS** picked up her 500th career win. She is currently the 27th active coach to reach the milestone, while being one of six that have been at the same institution for at least 33 years.

**EAGLES, EAGLES, EAGLES!!!**

Winthrop defeated Florida Gulf Coast, 65-61, in the first round of the WNIT last March, marking the Big South's first women's basketball postseason win since 2005. It was Winthrop's first postseason win in women's basketball since becoming a Division I member in 1986, and it is also the Big South's third-ever victory in the WNIT.

**THE COUNT DOWN BEGINS**

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan is currently tied for No. 8 all time with 1,845 points. She is currently on pace to take over the top spot held by Elena Kisseleva of Liberty who finished her career with 2,154 points.

**GREEN MACHINE**

**CATRINA GREEN** of Gardenr-Webb currently the Big South's active leading rebounder with 765 career boards. She is currently tied for 23 all-time in the Big South. Meanwhile, Green is approaching the Big South's 1,000 points, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shots club, which stands at 11 members. She currently has 930 points and 128 rejections.

**MILLIS CENTER NORTH**

With High Point's 71-63 win at Liberty on Jan. 17 inside the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win back-to-back road games at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1995-96 and 1996-97 seasons.

**IN RANGE WHEN SHE ENTERS THE GYM**

Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** is four three-pointers away from becoming the 10th player in Big South history with 200 triples. Taylor made 85 treys last season (7th most in League history).

**BACK IN (THE) BLACK**

With its win over Charleston Southern on Dec. 2, UNC Asheville snapped a 29-game conference losing streak that dated back to the 2011-12 season. The win marked head coach **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK**'s first career Big South win.

**CAMPBELL**

Campbell is 4-2 on the season and 1-0 in league play after topping Radford, 72-58, on Dec. 2...Campbell led wire-to-wire against the Highlanders after a 6-0 start...A total of 13 players hit the score sheet as all 15 players on the roster played at least three minutes...**ROSLYN PRESLEY** paced the Lady Camels with 12 points, becoming the third different player to lead Campbell in scoring this year...The Lady Camels eclipsed the 20-assist mark for the fourth time this year, while **RAECHAUN EDWARDS** tallied seven for the second time this season...Campbell utilized a 15-2 run towards the end of the first half to take a 37-20 advantage at the break...The Lady Camels have hit 38 three-point field goals at a .373 rate...Campbell has compiled a .436 pct. from the field...A +9.2 rebounding pct. has been recorded by Campbell, which has outrebounded its opponents in each of its victories...Campbell returns to action on Wednesday after a nine-day break for final exams against Asheville.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

In their final matchup before exams, Charleston Southern fell in their Big South opener to UNC Asheville at home inside the Buc Dome, 61-46... Charleston Southern struggled from the floor in their Big South opener and was unable to mount a comeback attempt in the second half...**ANICIA DOTSON** led the Buccaneers with 14 points on the evening and **DJ FOWLER** was in double-digits for CSU on the night with 10 points in 32 minutes, but the Buccaneers offense struggled from the floor in shooting 28.3 percent as a team in the contest...CSU cut into the Bulldogs lead, bringing the game back to within 12 points at 57-45 on four **TATUM JARVIS** free throws, but the Bucs rally fell short in the loss... Doston led the Bucs with 14 points, going 4-for-8 from the floor in the contest, while **DJ FOWLER** had 10 points and four steals in the game to pace the Buccaneers...**ALYSSA MANN** connected on two big three-pointers early in the contest on her way to finishing with nine points... Charleston Southern returns to the road this weekend, traveling to Chapel Hill, N.C., to take on North Carolina on Saturday.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina went 1-0 on the week with a 85-63 home win over Gardner-Webb in the Big South Conference opener for both teams ... Coastal led by 36-30 at the half before outscoring the Runnin' Bulldogs 49-33 in the second period ... The Chanticleers were led by **ALEX PUCKETT**'s career-high 24 points ... Puckett also added 11 rebounds to tally the first double-double of her career ... **AJ JORDAN** scored 23 in the contest, marking her fifth 20-plus point effort of the season ... Redshirt freshman **MEGAN PITTMAN** led all rebounders with a career-high 13, including 10 on the defensive glass ... **KAYLA COOK** also finished in double-figures with 11 points ... Coastal finished the game shooting 46.5 percent from the floor and a season-high 77.8 percent at the charity stripe ... The Chants step out of conference play in the coming week to host Palmetto state rival Furman on Sunday, Dec. 15 at 2 p.m.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb snapped a three-game road losing streak with a 54-52 win at Presbyterian Saturday afternoon ... **CANDACE BROWN**'s game-winner came with just 20 seconds on the clock, and she added a free throw later for the final margin ... GWU's three road losses this season seen the Runnin' Bulldogs trail by 20 points or more in each game ... **JASMINE DALE** rediscovered her shooting touch away from home, hitting 57.1 percent of her 3-point shots and averaging 15.0 points per game last week ... **CATRINA GREEN** posted averages of 11.5 points and 11.0 rebounds for the week, and continues to be a rebounding machine for Gardner-Webb ... **JESSICA HEILIG** had 15 points at Coastal Carolina, and averaged 13.5 points and 6.0 rebounds in the two games ... Gardner-Webb owned a 4.5 rebounding edge on average in last week's games ... GWU returns home to host Wofford in its lone game of the week ... The Runnin' Bulldogs are 4-0 with an average margin of victory topping 20 points in Paul Porter Arena so far this season - with wins over UNC Greensboro, Kennesaw State and Appalachian State highlighting that start at home.

**HIGH POINT**

The Panthers opened league play with a 68-54 win over Longwood on Friday ... Freshman **KAYLAH KEYS** led the team with 23 points while grabbing a career-high eight rebounds and dishing out a career-high five assists ... Senior **TAYLER TREMBLAY** also scored in double figures with 13 points ... Keys has scored in double figures for the last four games, including two 20-point performances ... Tremblay now has 729 career points, moving her in to 15th on HPU's Div. I scoring list ... She needs 22 points to reach Charlena Martin who is in 14th with 751 points from 2003-05 ... With 285 career assists Tremblay needs five more helpers to move past **ERIN REYNOLDS** for fourth on HPU's Div. I assists list ... In HPU's three games last week **DEANNEISHA JACKSON** averaged nine rebounds per game, second on the team behind **STACIA ROBERTSON** with 9.7.

**LIBERTY**

Liberty went 2-0 last week with a pair of home victories over in-state opponents (Richmond and Radford) ... After starting the season 0-4, the Lady Flames are now 4-1 in their last five games ... Liberty's 76-61 victory over Richmond on Tuesday was just the Lady Flames' fourth triumph in 24 all-time meetings with the Spiders ... The Lady Flames then opened Big South play with a win for the 13th time in the last 14 seasons Saturday, recording a 70-49 win over Radford ... It was the 60th all-time matchup between the Lady Flames and Highlanders, and Liberty now leads the series 36-24 after going 35-4 in the last 39 tilts ... Liberty shot 51.9 percent from the field against Richmond and is now 95-1 under head coach **CAREY GREEN** when making at least half of its field goals in a game ... **REAGAN MILLER**, who hit three triples against Richmond, is tied with **MEGAN FRAZEE** for ninth place in program history with 98 career three-pointers made ... **ASHLEY RININGER** posted her sixth double-double of the season versus Radford, while **CATHERINE KEARNEY** notched her first career double-double ... Liberty's lone action this week will be a Thursday home exhibition game with Anderson (S.C.) ... It will be the Lady Flames' second "Best Field Trip Ever Day" ... Last season, 3,230 fans, mostly local elementary school students, attended the inaugural event.

**LONGWOOD**

Longwood faced a setback in its only game last week to move to 3-4 overall this season, including 0-1 in Big South Conference action. The Lancers pulled within nine points with less than four minutes to play in the first half, but were unable to come any closer, as High Point secured its lead with an 18-3 run en route to the 68-54 decision in the league opener for both squads. Sophomore **JACLYN REAGAN** returned from an injury to make her first appearance of the season, logging a personal-best, four three-pointers for a career-high 12 points. Through seven games, sophomore **DAEISHA BROWN** paces the squad with 18.0 points per game. Sophomore Raven Williams has added to the offensive effort with 14.0 points per game, while redshirt-senior Heather Tobeck totals 9.0. Sophomore **KHALILAH ALI** leads the Lancers on the boards with 6.9 rebounds per game, while Brown follows with 5.9. As a team, Longwood is shooting 39.6% (148-396) from the floor, including 25.9% (42-162) from beyond the arc, and 75.5% (83-110) from the foul line. The squad will kick off a five-game homestand on Sunday, December 15 when Longwood hosts Savannah State at 2 p.m. in Willett Hall.

**PRESBYTERIAN**

The Presbyterian College women's basketball team dropped both of its games last week by an average of three points, falling to Western Carolina (42-38) and Gardner-Webb (54-52) at home...
