FANNING THE FLAMES -- LIBERTY TABBED PRESEASON FAVORITE

Fort the 16th time in the last 17 years, Liberty is the preseason women's basketball favorite for the 2013-14 season. The Lady Flames recieved 13 of the 25 first-place votes and 261 out of a possible 275 points. Liberty will have two starters and nine letterwinners back from last year's Big South championship and NCAA Tournament squad. Winthrop was voted second with 256 poitns and 11 first-place bids. Campbell was picked third with 206 points.

MCCLANAHAN VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Winthrop senior **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** is the 2013-14 Big South Women's Hoops Preseason Player of the Year. McClanahan is the reigning two-time Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She is looking to become the first player with three consecutive Player of the Year Awards since Liberty's Katie Feenstra from 2003-05. McClanahan led the League in scoring for the second-straight year in 2012-13 with 19.8 points per game and was also topbs with 5.8 assists per game.

PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH

Joining McClanahan on the Preseason All-Big South Team is Campbell's **KIERA GAINES**, High Point's **STACIA ROBERTSON**, Longwood's **DAEISHA BROWN** and Liberty's **EMILY FRAZIER**. Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** and **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** from Winthrop rounded out the Preseason All-Conference Team.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has two new coaches on the sideline this season. **JAIDA WILLIAMS** is the new skipper at Coastal Carolina, while **MIKE MCGUIRE** took over at Radford.

THRICE AS NICE

For the second-straight year and third time in the last four years, three Big South women's squads recieved berths in the NCAA postseason., tying the League record. Liberty was the League's representative in the NCAA Tournament, while Winthrop captured the Big South's automatic bid to the WNIT. Presbyterian College, in its first year of full Division I status and postseason eligibility, accpeted an at-large invitation to the WBI.

TRIPLE CROWN

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan will attempt to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the Conference in scoring in three consecutive seasons., as Liberty's Elena Kisseleva is the only player to win three Big South scoring titles. Meanwhile, McClanahan will look to become the first player to ever lead the League in assists three-straight years in 2013-14.

MAGIC WAND-A

With Campbell's win over Western Carolina earlier this season, **WANDA WATKINS** picked up her 500th career win. She is currently the 27th active coach to reach the milestone, while being one of six that have been at the same institution for at least 33 years.

EAGLES, EAGLES, EAGLES!!!

Winthrop defeated Florida Gulf Coast, 65-61, in the first round of the WNIT last march, marking the Big South's first women's basketball postseason win since 2005. It was Winthrop's first postseason win in women's basketball since becoming a Division I member in 1986, and it is also the Big South's third-ever victory in the WNIT.

THE COUNT DOWN BEGINS

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan is currently tied for No. 8 all time with 1,862 points. She is currently on pace to take over the top spot held by Elena Kisseleva of Liberty who finished her career with 2,154 points.

GREEN MACHINE

CATRINA GREEN of Gardenr-Webb currently the Big South's active leading rebounder with 782 career boards. She is currently tied for 17 all-time in the Big South. Meanwhile, Green is approaching the Big South's 1,000 points, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shots club, which stands at 11 members. She currently has 948 points and 131 rejections.

MILLIS CENTER NORTH

With High Point's 71-63 win at Liberty on Jan. 17 inside the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win back-to-back road games at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1995-96 and 1996-97 seasons.

IN RANGE WHEN SHE ENTERS THE GYM

Presbyterian College's KARLEE TAYLOR is four three-pointers away from becoming the 10th player in Big South history with 200 triples. Taylor made 85 treys last season (7th most in League history).

BROKE THE STREAK

With its win over Charleston Southern on Dec. 2, UNC Asheville snapped a 29-game conference losing streak that dated back to the 2011-12 season. The win marked head coach BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK's first career Big South win.

CAMPBELL

The Lady Camels sunk 32-of-41 free throws against the Bulldogs to secure the win, attempting the most shots from the charity stripe since going 32-of-44 against Asheville (11/21/06)...**RAECHAUN EDWARDS** registered her first-career 20-point outing by making 11-of-12 free throws and 4-of-10 jumpers including one trey... The 11 made free throws were the most by a Lady Camel since Marlana Murphy hit 16 at Elon (11/10/07)...Double-digit scorers were Jessica Moore (15) and **ROSLYN PRESLEY** (11)...The Lady Camels have hit 43 three-point field goals at a .371 rate...Campbell has compiled a .419 pct. from the field...A +3.3 rebounding pct. has been recorded by Campbell, which has outrebounded its opponents in four of its victories...Head Coach **WANDA WATKINS**, who is in her 33rd season at the helm of the Lady Camels program picked up her 500th victory on Nov. 16 against Western Carolina...Campbell plays a trip of games this week at N.C. Central on Monday, against UVA-Wise on Wednesday and at Elon on Friday.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern fell on the road to #15/#14 North Carolina this past Saturday, dropping a 100-49 decision to the Tar Heels inside Carmichael Arena...CSU trailed 49-30 at the half despite the sharp-shooting of senior guard **ERIN BRATCHER**, but the depth and bench play of UNC in the second half left the Bucs behind in their second loss to a ranked opponent on the season...Bratcher led the Bucs with 14 points, connecting on four three-pointers in the contest, while **DJ FOWLER** added 12 points of her own on the afternoon in the matchup...CSU closes out their pre-Christmas break schedule this week, traveling to Western Carolina on Monday night, before hosting Savannah State on Thursday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 0-1 on the week, suffering a 79-72 home win loss to Southern Conference member Furman ... The loss was the first by the Chanticleers at home this season ... **AJ JORDAN** scored 20-plus points for the fifth time this season, finishing with 23 to lead all scorers ... **KARSEN SIMS** poured in a career-high 17 points, while also playing a career-high 30 minutes in her first career start ... **ANGELICA HENRY** finished with an 11-point, 11-rebound double-double ... **KATELYN CONNOR** led all rebounders with 13, helping Coastal to a 51-41 advantage in total boards ... Coastal trailed by as many as 13 late in the first half, but rallied to cut Furman's lead to a single point three separate times in the second half ... Coastal wraps up its nonconference slate on Wed., Dec. 18 in its annual appearance in the CresCom Bank Carolinas Challenge at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center. The Chants will face familiar foe College of Charleston at 5 p.m.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb improved to 5-0 in Paul Porter this season ... GWU has won all five games by double figures ... GWU is 3-1 against Southern Conference teams this season with home wins over UNC Greensboro, Appalachian State and Wofford and a narrow road loss to Davidson.

HIGH POINT

Freshman Kaylah Keys led the Panthers with 26 points against Winthrop ... She is now leading the team with 15.3 points per game ... She also had a career-high six assists to go with seven rebounds ... Junior **LATRICE PHELPS** posted her first double-double with 11 points and 14 rebounds, both career highs ... The Panthers finish up non-conference play with games at UAB and North Carolina this week ... HPU is 0-1 against UAB all-time with a 58-53 loss at the Millis Center last year.

LIBERTY

Liberty's only action last week was a 69-66 exhibition game victory over Anderson, Thursday at the Vines Center ... The Lady Flames' lone contest this coming week will be their final non-conference tilt of the regular season ... Liberty will travel to UNCW on Thursday for an 11:30 a.m. tipoff ... The Lady Flames are 3-5 in non-conference games so far this season, but have won back-to-back non-conference matchups and a season-best three straight contests overall ... Liberty, which has led the nation in rebound margin in back-to-back seasons, currently ranks No. 2 behind Notre Dame at +16.8 this season ... **REAGAN MILLER** needs two triples to become the ninth player in program history to make 100 career three-pointers.

LONGWOOD

The Lancers dropped a 79-55 decision at home against Savannah State on Dec. 15 in its only game last week. Sophomore **KHALILAH ALI** logged her second double-double of the season with 11 points and 11 rebounds in that contest. Longwood pulled within one point of SSU's lead on three occasions in the second half, but were unable to regain control thanks to a 20-2 run by the Lady Tigers. Through eight games, sophomore **DAEISHA BROWN** paces the squad with 17.9 points per game. Sophomore **RAVEN WILLIAMS** has added to the offensive effort with 14.0 points per game, while sophomore **KYNDAL SKERSICK** totals 9.1. Sophomore Ali leads the Lancers on the boards with 7.4 rebounds per game, while Brown follows with 6.3. As a team, Longwood is shooting 37.3% (170-456) from the floor, including 26.2% (48-183) from beyond the arc, and 73.9% (88-119) from the foul line. The squad continues a five-game homestand on Wednesday, December 18 when Longwood hosts Eastern Kentucky University at 7 p.m. in Willett Hall.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Presbyterian College women's basketball team played no games this week while breaking for final exams. The Blue Hose resume action on Monday morning in their annual Education Day game against the Truett-McConnell Bears before ending non-conference play on Wednesday at Auburn in a 7 p.m. tilt... Through December 8, PC ranks No. 7 in NCAA Division I in scoring defense, holding opponents to 52.1 points per game... Redshirt freshman **KEYONNA ALLEN** leads the team in points (8.3) and junior **NOELLE CARTER** leads in rebounds (6.0). Carter set a new career-high with 10 rebounds two weeks ago against Western Carolina and Allen tied a career-best with nine.

RADFORD

The Highlanders concluded their six-game road stretch with a 70-49 loss at Liberty Saturday afternoon. Sophomore **AISHA FOY** scored a season-high 15 points on 5-of-8 shooting and dished out a career-high four assists... Junior **AYANA AVERY** chipped in with 10 points and three steals, while senior **BRESHARA GORDON** matched a career high as she pulled down a team-best five rebounds and also charted a career-best four steals... Following a break for final exams, Radford returns to the Dedmon Center Monday, Dec. 16 against Appalachian State. Tipoff is set for 7 p.m. against the Mountaineers. The Highlanders will look to snap a six-game losing streak when they return home where they won their only two games this season.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 0-1 on the week, falling 67-59 to Campbell on Wednesday evening... In the loss at Campbell the Bulldogs trailed at the half for only the second time this season... Asheville has lost five in a row to the Camels, with the Bulldogs last victory over Campbell coming on Nov. 20, 2010. Former Bulldog Kendall Shepard hit a 3-pointer as time expired to lift the Blue & White to a 78-75 victory. The game was a non-conference contest, as Campbell had not yet rejoined the Big South Conference... The Bulldogs will next be in action on Tuesday, Dec. 17, when they host North Carolina Central at Kimmel Arena. The two teams last met on Dec. 29, 2010 in Durham, N.C., with Asheville earning a 67-56 victory on the road... Asheville will play at Vanderbilt on Saturday, marking the first time the Bulldogs have played a Southeastern Conference opponent since Jan. 3, 2008, when Asheville played at South Carolina.

WINTHROP

Winthrop moved up to No. 22 in last week's CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll. The Eagles broke into the top 25 for the first time at No. 24 two weeks ago. During the first half of the High Point game on Saturday, **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** became the all-time leading scorer in Winthrop history as she surpassed men's standout Charles Brunson whose 1,850 career points were the most since 1982. She has now scored 1,862 points. She also had 10 assists to move within six of breaking the Winthrop women's career assist record that has stood at 595 since 1991. She now has 590. The 17-point, 10-assist performance is McClanahan's fourth double-double of the season (two with points and rebounds, and two with points and assists). She has now scored in double figures in 32 straight games. Sophomore center **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** has double-doubles in six straight games and seven of eight this season after a 13-point, 15-rebound effort at High Point. Her career double-double total now stands at 21. Senior reserve guard **TIFFANY CHARLES** collected a career-high eight rebounds vs. High Point. Winthrop's Big South opening win over High Point was the third straight victory over the Panthers after losing the previous five. Winthrop will not play again until Friday when they visit No. 12 ranked South Carolina for a 12 noon start.
