**WILLIAM TRUSS • C**  
**Jr. • Presbyterian College**  
**Vestavia Hills, Ala.**

Truss averaged 19.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 2.5 blocks in two games last week. He led the Blue Hose in rebounds in both contests (eight vs. UT-Martin and seven vs. Appalachian State), and scored a career-high 25 points in the win over the Mountaineers. For the week, Truss was 15-of-19 from the field (=78.9 percent) and 9-of-11 from the charity stripe (=81.8).

**ANTWAN BURRUS • F**  
**R-Sr. • Liberty**  
**Winterville, N.C.**

Burrus averaged 17.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.0 blocks in two games last week. He was Liberty's top scorer and rebounder in both contests, including 16 points and eight rebounds in the Flames' victory over Howard. He scored 15 of his 19 points against Furman in the second half and grabbed seven boards against the Paladins. For the week, Burrus was 12-of-22 from the field (=54.5 percent) and 11-of-14 from the free throw line (=78.6).

**KEON JOHNSON • G**  
**Fr. • Winthrop**  
**Mansfield, Ohio**

Johnson averaged 15.0 points and 4.0 rebounds in two games last week. He was 9-of-20 from the field (=45.0 percent), 6-of-11 from three-point range (=54.5) and 6-of-6 from the line (=100.0). Johnson opened the week with 12 points and a team-high four rebounds at North Carolina Central, and followed with a team-leading 18 points against Wofford. He scored 16 of his 18 markers in the second half.

**BACK IN FAMILIAR TERRITORY**

VMI leads the Big South in scoring with 89.5 points per game, its highest average since 2008-09 when the Keydets scored a League- and NCAA-leading 93.8 a contest. VMI, which has led the Big South in scoring six out of the last seven years -- including last season, is second all-time for most times leading the Conference in scoring offense at six. Radford owns that record with nine times.

**DO THE CHARLESTON**

Charleston Southern is averaging 87.1 points this season, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest.

**WHAT IS YOUR Q SCORE?**

VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** leads the Big South with 20.8 points per game, the third-straight season the Conference would have a 20-point scorer. Peterson is looking to become the first freshman ever to lead the Big South in scoring, as well as just the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game. His current scoring average is ahead of the League's freshman record of 20.2 points that was set by Liberty's **SETH CURRY** in 2008-09. Meanwhile, Peterson is the second-highest scoring freshman in the nation behind Duke's **JABARI PARKER** (22.1) -- and the two are the lone freshmen nationwide averaging more than 20.0 points per contest.

**TAKE COVER**

VMI forward/center **D.J. COVINGTON** leads the Big South with 2.91 blocked shots this season, and if he can maintain his top ranking, he would become the just the second player to lead the League in blocked shots per game three times. UNC Asheville's **ADAM EARNHARDT** was the first to do it, and did so in three consecutive seasons from 1998-01. Covington led the Big South as a freshman in 2010-11 (2.28) and tied for the lead last season with 3.00. He has blocked a shot in 40 of his last 42 appearances, and since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (42 games), he has recorded 125 of his 198 career blocks in that span (=63.1 percent) for an average of 2.98 per contest.

**D.J. - PART 1**

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM**, who missed three games from Nov. 25-Dec. 1, became the sixth player in Big South history with 200 career blocked shots when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 20 against Virginia Interment. He needs two rejections to move into sole possession of fifth-place. He is also 41st on the Big South's career rebounding list with 625, and is now the fifth player in Big South history with 600 rebounds and 200 blocks.

**D.J. - PART 2**

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON**, who is seventh in Big South history with 198 career blocked shots, became the 71st player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Dec. 19 at East Carolina. He is two blocked shots away from becoming the seventh player with 200 rejections, as well as the sixth player with 500 boards and 200 blocks.

**BURRUS' BOARDS AND BLOCKS**

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS**, who missed all of 2012-13 with an injury, became the 19th member of the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club when he surpassed the rebounding milestone Dec. 7 against Greensboro College -- becoming the 70th Big South player to grab 500 car-oms. Burrus has tallied 113 rejections in his career -- 26th in League annals, and is just the second Liberty player on the list. He joins Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97.

**GREEN MACHINE**

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** became the 69th member of the Big South's 500-rebound club when he eclipsed the milestone Nov. 25 at Cornell. Now with 541, he is tied for 61st in League history and is the first Highlander with 500 career boards since **ART PARAKHOUSKI** and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** in 2009-10. Meanwhile, Green is approaching 1,000 career points as he enters the week 32 points shy of that milestone.

**WINNING COMBINATION**

Charleston Southern junior guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 16 times in their career (nine times last season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 13-3 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 15 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

**GLASS IS HALF FULL**

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW** has 379 career assists and is 21 away from becoming the 23rd player in Big South history with 400. Once he reaches the milestone, he will be the first Keydet to join the League's 400-assist club.

**WATCH YOUR P'S AND Q'S**

In addition to leading the Conference in scoring, VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** is pacing the League in steals with 2.55 per game. It is the highest per game average since 2008-09, when Keydet twins **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** averaged 3.39 and 3.22, respectively. Peterson is looking to become the first freshman to lead the League in steals per game. The last player to lead the Big South in scoring AND steals was Chavis Holmes in 2008-09 (22.0 ppg, 3.39 spg).

**TREASURE CHEST**

Charleston Southern is averaging a League-leading 10.90 three-pointers per game this season, and is looking to become the first Big South team other than VMI to average at least 10 triples a game in a single-season. CSU's average of 10.90 threes is third nationally and the highest in the Big South since VMI averaged 11.32 in 2010-11. The Buccaneers' current per game tally would be sixth-highest in the League record book. Meanwhile, the Keydets are averaging exactly 10.00 three-pointers per game, and it would be the first time in League history that two teams averaged double-digit threes in the same season.

**BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,384 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 1,149 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

**BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB**

Charleston Southern junior **ARLON HARPER** is one point away from becoming the second player this season and 119th overall in Big South history with 1,000 career points. He is on the cusp of joining teammate **SAAH NIMLEY** and Liberty's **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** as the Big South's active 1,000-point scorers -- for now. **CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER**

VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** and Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** are the longest-tenured Big South coaches, as each is in his ninth year. Baucum's Big South tenure will end after this season with VMI's departure to the Southern Conference on July 1, 2014. Meanwhile, Baucum is sixth all-time in Big South history with 124 victories at the Institute, while Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is in seventh-place with his 119 wins at Coastal Carolina. Radebaugh sits in ninth-place all-time in League annals with 111 victories. Here is a look at the Big South's Top 10 winningest coaches:

**DOUBLE DRIBBLES**

Five Big South players have scored in double-figures in every game this season. Presbyterian College's **JORDAN DOWNING** (13), Longwood's **TRISTAN CAREY** (12), VMI's **RODNEY GLASGOW** (11) and freshmen **QJ PETERSON** of VMI (11) and **ELIJAH WILSON** of Coastal Carolina (12) make up the quintet. Dating back to last season, Glasgow and Carey have the longest active double-figure scoring streak at 15 games, followed by Downing (14).

**CLIFF NOTES**

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' 2012-13 season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 119. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 653 Division I wins and is 32nd all-time in Division I victories. **ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH**

For the first time in League history, four regular-season Big South games will appear in ESPNU in 2013-14. The 24-hour college sports network will televise the Jan. 10 Radford at High Point game, and will make "Wildcard" selections of the remaining three broadcasts 21 days in advance. Those three telecasts will be Feb. 1 at 11:00am, Feb. 13 at 7:00pm and Feb. 28 at 7:00pm.

**IN WILLIAM WE TRUSS**

Presbyterian College junior **WILLIAM TRUSS** leads the Big South with 9.6 rebounds per game. If he can return to averaging double-figure rebounds, he would become the first Big South player to average at least 10.0 boards in a season since Liberty's **JOHN BROWN** (10.8) in 2010-11. Truss is looking to become the first Blue Hose player to lead the League in rebounds.

**CLASS ACT**

High Point graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY** is among the 30 candidates for the national Senior CLASS Award. He is the Big South's first official candidate since Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** in 2011-12.

**LONGWOOD SCORES BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG 12 WIN IN 15 SEASONS**

Longwood's 82-79 win at TCU on Nov. 12 was the Big South's first win over a member of the Big 12 Conference since the 1999-00 season. That year, Winthrop defeated Missouri, 51-46.
