McCarter, who entered the week averaging 7.8 points, 3.5 rebounds and 1.2 assists, turned in averages of 21.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists in two games last week. He opened with a career-high 29 points with five assists and four rebounds against East Carolina. He passed his previous scoring high of 16 with 18 first half points. McCarter then added 14 points, six boards, five helpers and three steals against Delaware State. For the week, he was 14-of-28 from the floor (=50.0percent), 13-of-16 from the free throw line (=81.3) and averaged 2.0 steals.



CROSSOVER DRIBBLE

The 2013-14 season is the second and, for now, final season with Divisional play. During the 2012-13 regular-season, the South Division "won" the first season of the Big South's crossover divisional games in men's basketball, as the South teams finished 22-14 (=61.1 percent) against the North Division. The host teams won a combined 22 games, with the South Division squads finishing 13-5 at home while going 9-9 on North Division home courts. Both Charleston Southern and UNC Asheville went 6-0 against the North Division in the regular-season. It was a different story in the postseason, as the North Division finished 7-4 against South Division teams in the 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Basketball Championship, which included the Conference Championship trophy.

ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH

For the first time in League history, four regular-season Big South games will appear in ESPNU in 2013-14 -- beginning this week with Friday's Radford at High Point game on the 24-hour college sports network. **ROY PHILPOTT** (play-by-play) and **DINO GAUDIO** (analyst) have the call from the Millis Center. ESPNU will make "Wildcard" selections of the remaining three broadcasts 21 days in advance. Those three telecasts will be Feb. 1 at 11:00am, Feb. 13 at 7:00pm and Feb. 28 at 7:00pm.

BIG SOUTH FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE SCORING COMBINATIONS

Since the Big South's first official men's basketball season in 1985-86, a total of 16 four-year classmate combinations have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period, with three pair reaching the mark as juniors -- Charleston Southern junior tandem **SAAH NIMLEY** (1,068) and **ARLON HARPER** (1,022) became the third on Dec. 28. Radford junior duo **JAVONTE GREEN** (1,035) and **R.J. PRICE** (966) are on their way to achieving the feat as well. The other pair of Big South teammates to reach 1,000 points as juniors were VMI's **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** (2007-08) and UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** (2010-11).

BACK IN FAMILIAR TERRITORY

VMI leads the Big South and the nation in scoring with 89.4 points per game, its highest average since 2008-09 when the Keydets scored a League- and NCAA-leading 93.8 a contest. VMI, which has led the Big South in scoring six out of the last seven years -- including last season, is second all-time for most times leading the Conference in scoring offense at six. Radford owns that record with nine times.

DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern is averaging 87.7 points this season, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest. Meanwhile, CSU and VMI could mark just the second time in League history that at least two teams averaged 80.0 points in the same year. The first (and only) time was in 1992-93 when three squads averaged 80.0 points -- Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3).

WHAT IS YOUR Q SCORE?

VMI freshman QJ PETERSON leads the Big South with 19.8 points per game, and is looking to become the first freshman ever to lead the Big South in scoring, as well as attempting to become the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game. The first (and only) was Liberty's SETH CURRY in 2008-09 (20.2). Peterson is the third-highest scoring freshman in the nation behind Fordham's JON SEVERE (20.5) and Duke's JABARI PARKER (20.4).

GLASS IS HALF FULL

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW** has 389 career assists and is 11 away from becoming the 23rd player in Big South history with 400. Once he reaches the milestone, he will be the first Keydet to join the League's 400-assist club.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** became the 46th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds when he surpassed the scoring milestone Dec. 30 vs. Houghton. He is the 12th Highlander on the Big South's 1,000/500 list, and enters the week 54th in League annals with 568 career boards. Green is the first Highlander with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds since **ART PARAK-HOUSKI** and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** in 2009-10.

TAKE COVER

VMI forward/center **D.J. COVINGTON** is the fourth player in League history with 1,000 career points (1,022), 500 career rebounds (517) and 200 career blocked shots (203). He has blocked a shot in 42 of his last 44 appearances, and since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (44 games), he has recorded 130 of his 203 career blocks in that span (=64.0 percent) for an average of 2.95 per contest.

D.J. - PART 1

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** became the sixth player in Big South history with 200 career blocked shots when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 20 against Virginia Intermont. He is averaging 5.5 blocks in his last four games to raise his career total to 219 -- now fourth all-time in the League record books. Cunningham leads the Big South with 3.55 rejections a game, which is currently the third-highest single-season total in League history. Meanwhile, Cunningham is 35th on the Big South's career rebounding list with 651, and is the fifth player in Big South history with 600 rebounds and 200 blocks.

D.J. - PART 2

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON**, who is seventh in Big South history with 203 career blocked shots, became the 71st player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Dec. 19 at East Carolina. He needs two blocks to move into the sixth position on the all-time chart.

BURRUS' BOARDS AND BLOCKS

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS**, who missed all of 2012-13 with an injury, became the 19th member of the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club when he surpassed the rebounding milestone Dec. 7 against Greensboro College -- becoming the 70th Big South player to grab 500 caroms. Burrus has tallied 114 rejections in his career -- 26th in League annals, and is just the second Liberty player on the list. He joins Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97.

WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern junior guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 16 times in their career (nine times last season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 13-3 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 16 outlings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

WATCH YOUR P'S AND Q'S

In addition to leading the Conference in scoring, VMI freshman QJ PETERSON is pacing the League in steals with 2.46 per game. It is the highest per game average since 2008-09, when Keydet twins CHAVIS and TRAVIS HOLMES averaged 3.39 and 3.22, respectively. Peterson is looking to become the first freshman to lead the League in steals per game. The last player to lead the Big South in scoring AND steals was Chavis Holmes in 2008-09 (22.0 ppg, 3.39 spg).

TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern is averaging a League-leading and national-best 11.58 three-pointers per game this season, and is looking to become the first Big South team other than VMI to average at least 10 triples a game in a single-season. CSU's average of 11.58 threes is the highest in the Big South since VMI averaged a Conference-record 13.69 in 2008-09. The Buccaneers' current per game tally would be fourth-highest in the League record book.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,431 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. Jesse had 1,235 of the total from 2008-12, while John Caleb is at 1,196 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

NORTH DIVISION

CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

RECO McCARTER scored a career-high 29 points, while MARVELLE HARRIS added season-highs of 16 points and 12 rebounds in CU's 79-71 loss to East Carolina, which is just the 2nd time the Camels have lost to the Pirates in the last 5 meetings ... Against ECU, Campbell tied its Gore Arena record for fewest turnovers (6) in a game at the building, which opened in 2008-09 ... Harris hit double digits for the 2nd-straight game with 12 points against Delaware State. Over the last 2 games, he is averaging 14 points and 9 rebounds, while shooting 87% (13-15) from the floor, well over his season averages of 4.3 points and 3.5 rebounds (.647 FG%) ... CU swept a 2-game season series from Georgia Southern with a 69-63 win at home on Dec. 30. The Camels went 3-0 vs. Southern Conference members this season ... Campbell opens Big South play at home Wednesday vs. High Point. The Camels have dropped 3-straight games to the Panthers.

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

JOHN BROWN led the Panthers with 25 points against Lees-McRae, his 18th career 20-point game. He's now averaging 18.1 ppg. In HPU's eight games against Mid-Major opponents, Brown averaged 20.1 points, 8.1 rebounds and 1.5 steals while shooting 55.1 percent from the floor ... HPU went 4-9 in non-conference games, one win off its 5-8 record last year ... High Point went 0-for-4 from three-point range against Lees-McRae, breaking a streak of 381 games with a three-pointer that dated back to the 2000-01 season ... Opening Conference play on Wednesday, the Panthers will look to defend their 2012-13 Big South North Division title. The team went 12-4 in League play last year, a program high for Big South wins.

LIBERTY FLAMES

Despite sinking more three-pointers than the renowned Princeton offense, Liberty came up short against the Tigers, dropping an 80-74 decision. With the defeat, Liberty ends the non-conference slate with a 6-9 record ... TOMASZ GIELO is the Flames' leading scorer over the last five games, averaging 14.8 ppg. Gielo is coming off a career-high 20-point performance against Princeton ... JOHN CALEB SANDERS scored a season-high 25 points against Princeton, marking the first time he has led the Flames in scoring this season ... Liberty has won the rebounding battle the last nine games, out-rebounding its opponents, 394-286, and averaging 39.4 rebounds during the span ... Liberty enters Wednesday's matchup against Radford with a five-game win streak inside the Dedmon Center.

LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood dropped its final non-conference game this past weekend, a 126-52 road loss at Louisiana Tech. KARL ZIEGLER led the Lancers with his team-high 14 points, adding a team-high five rebounds, while JEYLANI DUBLIN finished with 13 points, also adding a team-high five rebounds. Leading scorer TRISTAN CAREY (17.4), played just three minutes against the Bulldogs and was scoreless ... The 74-point margin of defeat was the largest in program history ... Longwood has dropped three-straight games away from Farmville after winning three of four home games ... The Lancers open Big South Conference competition this week, beginning with a road game at VMI on Jan. 8, before hosting Campbell on Jan. 11.

RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Prior to this season, RU has never had double-digit wins prior to Big South Conference play ... **JAVONTE GREEN** ranks 5th all-time in school history with 215 career offensive rebounds ... **KION BROWN** recorded his first career double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds at Hampton ... **BRANDON HOLCOMB** set a career-high with 10 points at Santa Clara and tied a season-high with 10 rebounds at UNLV on the West Coast road trip ... **R.J. PRICE** ranks 8th all-time in career three-point field goals made with 177. He tied career-highs with 30 points and 6 three-pointers vs. Sacred Heart ... **RASHUN DAVIS** set a career-high with 20 points vs. Sacred Heart ... **KYLE NOREEN** has dished out 21 assists with just 3 turnovers this season for a 7.0 assist-to-turnover ratio. The national statistical leader is at 5.0 (Noreen does not qualify for the national rankings based on number of assists per game).

VMI KEYDETS

D.J. COVINGTON scored 16 points, grabbed three rebounds and blocked three shots in VMI's 128-54 win over Washington College Saturday. Covington's three blocks moved him past **LEWIS PRESTON** (1990-93) for the No. 1 spot in career blocks at VMI. Covington now has 203 rejections for his career ... Freshman **Q.J. PETERSON** bounced back from a season-low 9 points at Clemson to lead VMI in scoring with 20 points against Washington College. It was Peterson's 7th 20-point game ... **TIM MARSHALL** (19) and **CHRISTIAN BURTON** (18) both set career scoring highs against Washington College ... With a 74-point margin of victory over Washington College, VMI broke its previous record of 65 which was set against Columbia Union on Nov. 28, 2007. The 128-point outburst was the eighth-largest in school history.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

ARLON HARPER became the 20th player in program history to score 1,000 points with a free throw at the 15:30 mark in the Dec. 28 win over St. Andrews. Harper joined teammate **SAAH NIMLEY** in the 1,000-point club, as Nimley reached the mark on Dec. 3 against Delaware ... CSU drained a program single-game record 20 three-pointers in its 122-40 win over St. Andrews. The Bucs also set a margin of victory record with their 82-point decision ... **MATT KENNEDY** hit his first six shots from the field and scored 18 points in the victory over St. Andrews. It was Kennedy's 9th double-digit scoring effort of the season. He did not have any in his first three years as a Buc.

COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chants closed out the non-conference portion of their schedule with an 86-67 win over Central Connecticut State. Six Chanticleers reached double-figures while two had double-doubles. Freshman ELIJAH WILSON led the way with 19 points. He has now scored in double-figures in 13 of his 14 career games, and leads the Chants with 15.5 points per game ... JOSH CAMERON is second at 12.9 and WARREN GILLIS is third at 12.2 ppg ... EL HADJI NDIEGUENE is averaging 9.3 rebounds per game while sitting in fifth in scoring at 7.1 ppg ... CCU is 5-1 in Big South Conference openers under head coach CLIFF ELLIS, with the one loss coming in overtime against Presbyterian during the 2008-09 season ... The Chants have two road games this week as they travel to Charleston Southern on Wednesday and Gardner-Webb on Saturday.

GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb returns home this week to open Big South Conference play and is 4-1 in Paul Porter Arena so far this season. The Runnin' Bulldogs are averaging 87.4 points at home and have five players averaging double figures ... **JEROME HILL** has amped his game up over the past five outings, shooting 64.3 percent to average 14.6 points and 9.0 rebounds during that stretch -- highlighted by a career-best outing at No. 7 Duke on Dec. 16 ... GWU will host UNC Asheville on Wednesday night in Boiling Springs to open League play. The Runnin' Bulldogs hold a 27-15 lead in the all-time series, but have defeated Asheville just twice since joining the Big South in 2008-09 -- with both of those wins coming last season in a season sweep.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

The Blue Hose have several players high up in the national rankings this season (as of Jan. 2). **JORDAN DOWNING** was 32nd in the nation in total points (272) and 29th in total field goals made (95), as well as 23rd in total field goal attempts (215). **WILLIAM TRUSS** was 22nd in total rebounds (131) and 33rd in double-doubles (5) ... Downing and Truss have stepped up their scoring output from last season. Downing averaged 12.8 ppg last season and is up almost seven points this season to 19.3 so far, which is second in the Big South. Truss has gone from 6.8 a game to 12.1 ppg (23rd in the League) ... Freshman **REGGIE DILLARD** is second on the squad with 12.6 ppg (19th in the Conference).

UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

UNC Asheville's five-game win streak came to an end with a 79-70 loss to Ohio on Saturday afternoon. The Bulldogs led by 12 at halftime (43-31) before the Bobcats rallied in the second half to send Asheville to its first home loss of the year ... Asheville finished the month of December at 5-1 for the second straight year ... ANDREW ROWSEY set a school freshman scoring record with a career-high 28 points against Ohio ... D.J. CUNNINGHAM leads the Big South and is 12th nationally in blocked shots with 3.55 per game ... The Bulldogs have blocked 40 shots in the last four games ... Asheville opens Big South Conference play on Wednesday at Gardner-Webb. The Bulldogs are 16-1 in League openers over the last 17 years and have won their last eight.

WINTHROP EAGLES

Winthrop is currently in the midst a four-game losing streak, its longest losing skid since the 2011-12 season ... Winthrop's Jan. 4 game was postponed by Barber-Scotia as it didn't have enough players to dress for the game after players were stranded in the blizzard that hit the Northeast, in addition to injuries. Winthrop now has an extra day to prepare for its Big South opener at Presbyterian College. This will be the second time in three seasons the Eagles open Big South play at PC ... Freshman KEON JOHNSON has 27 made threes on the season, which is ranked the program's history for freshman in a season. He's in pursuit of TYSON WATERMAN's mark of 52, which he'll reach and pass if he maintains his current 2.25 threes per game ... ANDRE SMITH is looking to move into Winthrop's all-time Top 10 for three-pointers made as he currently has 111 in his career, which is ranked 14th. He needs 11 more to crack the Top 10. He is currently on pace for 74 threes this season, which would push him to 7th all-time at Winthrop.
