She highlighted the three-game span with 21 points and 14 rebounds to lift Gardner-Webb to the 69-56 win over Winthrop on Jan. 4. She also posted a double-double of 18 points and 17 rebounds against UNC Asheville on Dec. 30. During the span, Green connected on 59 percent from the floor, to go along with seven blocks, five steals and four assists. The honor is her second Big South Player of the Week plaudit this season.

Jordan averaged 16.3 points and 10.8 rebounds per game to lead the Chanticleers to a 3-1 record in Big South play. She posted two double-doubles in the four-game span including 23 points and 13 rebounds in Coastal Carolina's win over Radford on Dec. 30. She also averaged 50 percent from the field and dished out seven assists during the two weeks. Defensively, Jordan came away with five steals and one block over the break. The honor marks her first Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

FANNING THE FLAMES -- LIBERTY TABBED PRESEASON FAVORITE

Fort the 16th time in the last 17 years, Liberty is the preseason women's basketball favorite for the 2013-14 season. The Lady Flames received 13 of the 25 first-place votes and 261 out of a possible 275 points. Liberty will have two starters and nine letterwinners back from last year's Big South championship and NCAA Tournament squad. Winthrop was voted second with 256 points and 11 first-place bids. Campbell was picked third with 206 points.

McCLANAHAN VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Winthrop senior **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** is the 2013-14 Big South Women's Hoops Preseason Player of the Year. McClanahan is the reigning two-time Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She is looking to become the first player with three consecutive Player of the Year Awards since Liberty's Katie Feenstra from 2003-05. McClanahan led the League in scoring for the second-straight year in 2012-13 with 19.8 points per game and was also tops with 5.8 assists per game.

PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH

Joining McClanahan on the Preseason All-Big South Team is Campbell's **KIERA GAINES**, High Point's **STACIA ROBERTSON**, Longwood's **DAEISHA BROWN** and Liberty's **EMILY FRAZIER**. Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** and **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** from Winthrop rounded out the Preseason All-Conference Team.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has two new coaches on the sideline this season. **JAIDA WILLIAMS** is the new skipper at Coastal Carolina, while **MIKE McGUIRE** took over at Radford.

THRICE AS NICE

For the second-straight year and third time in the last four years, three Big South women's squads received berths in the NCAA postseason., tying the League record. Liberty was the League's representative in the NCAA Tournament, while Winthrop captured the Big South's automatic bid to the WNIT. Presbyterian College, in its first year of full Division I status and postseason eligibility, accepted an at-large invitation to the WBI.

TRIPLE CROWN

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan will attempt to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the Conference in scoring in three consecutive seasons., as Liberty's Elena Kisseleva is the only player to win three Big South scoring titles. Meanwhile, McClanahan will look to become the first player to ever lead the League in assists three-straight years in 2013-14.

MAGIC WAND-A

With Campbell's win over Western Carolina earlier this season, **WANDA WATKINS** picked up her 500th career win. She is currently the 27th active coach to reach the milestone, while being one of six that have been at the same institution for at least 33 years.

EAGLES, EAGLES, EAGLES!!!

Winthrop defeated Florida Gulf Coast, 65-61, in the first round of the WNIT last March, marking the Big South's first women's basketball postseason win since 2005. It was Winthrop's first postseason win in women's basketball since becoming a Division I member in 1986, and it is also the Big South's third-ever victory in the WNIT.

THE COUNT DOWN BEGINS

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan is currently tied for No. 5 all time with 1,923 points. She is currently on pace to take over the top spot held by Elena Kisseleva of Liberty who finished her career with 2,154 points.

GREEN MACHINE

CATRINA GREEN of Gardenr-Webb currently the Big South's active leading rebounder with 809 career boards. She is currently No. 14 all-time in the Big South. Meanwhile, Green is became the 12th member of the Big South's 1,000 points, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shots club over the Christmas break. She currently has 1009 (No. 85 all-time) points and 131 rejections.

MILLIS CENTER NORTH

With High Point's 71-63 win at Liberty on Jan. 17 inside the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win back-to-back road games at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1995-96 and 1996-97 seasons.

IN RANGE WHEN SHE ENTERS THE GYM

Presbyterian College's KARLEE TAYLOR is four three-pointers away from becoming the 10th player in Big South history with 200 triples. Taylor made 85 treys last season (7th most in League history).

BROKE THE STREAK

With its win over Charleston Southern on Dec. 2, UNC Asheville snapped a 29-game conference losing streak that dated back to the 2011-12 season. The win marked head coach BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK's first career Big South win.

HOT STARTS

Winthrop and Coastal Carolina began the Conference in record-breaking fashion. Coastal Carolina's and Winthrop's 4-0 starts to the League slates marked its best runs in school history.

DIAPER DANDIES

Two Big South players have earned a combined 7-of-8 Big South Freshman of the Week nods this season. High Point's KAYLAH KEYS has earned the honor four times this season, while ERICA WILLIAMS of Winthrop has received the nod three times. Keys has five 20-point games this season and is averaging 16.1 points per game. Williams is posting 13.8 points per outing, to go along with a pair of 20-point outings.

CAMPBELL

Campbell is 8-5 on the season and 3-2 in league play after topping Longwood (67-59) and falling to Liberty (52-75) and High Point (62-76)... **CASEY ELLIOTT** scored 14 points against High Point and became the eighth-different Lady Camel to pace the team in scoring this season... A total of 80 3FG have been drained by the Lady Camels at a 36.4 rate this year, which ranks 46th nationally and atop the league rankings... Campbell has posted a 7-1 mark when it has outrebounded its opponent... Campbell paces the Big South in FG Pct (.364), FG Pct. Defense (.281) and Assists (16.38)... The Lady Camels are ranked second in Scoring Defense (60.1), FG Pct. Defense (.363), Rebounding Defense (37.8), Assist/Turnover Ratio (0.91) and 3FG Made (6.15)... **KIERA GAINES** is fourth in rebounding (8.3), third in assists (4.38) and 15th in scoring at 11.1... **ROSLYN PRESLEY** ranks 14th in scoring (11.2), while **ASHLEY JAMES** is 14th in rebounding (6.3). The Lady Camels face North Carolina Central on Monday in their final non-conference game of the season before hosting Charleston Southern Thursday and Coastal Carolina Saturday.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went 1-3 overall since returning from Christmas break, picking up a win in their first game back against Radford, while falling to Winthrop, Liberty and Longwood... The Bucs were led over the span by the standout play of senior **ANICIA DOTSON**, as the forward averaged 17.5 points per game and 6.0 rebounds per game, connecting at a 42.9% clip from the floor during the stretch, including a 22 point-11 rebound game against Radford, and a career-high 25 points on Saturday against Longwood... Senior guard **ERIN BRATCHER** also had the hot hand over the weekend, connecting on 15 three-pointers as the Buccaneers hit a season-high 12 triples on Saturday against Longwood, surpassing their previous high of 11 set on Thursday against Liberty... **DJ FOWLER** also averaged double-digits on the weekend with 11.5 points per game, including her first collegiate double-double against the Highlanders with 13 points and 10 assists... The Bucs are back in action this week on the road as CSU travels to Campbell on Thursday and High Point on Saturday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 3-1 over its last four games with wins over Longwood (83-53), Radford (67-66) and High Point (83-75) before falling to Liberty (62-71)... The Chanticleers set a school record with wins in each of its first four Big South Conference games and tied the school record with four consecutive league victories... Coastal's 30-point win at Longwood was the largest for the Chanticleers in a conference game in school history... Coastal, the league's highest scoring offense, averaged 73.8 point per game and shot 40.8 percent from the floor, including 39.2 percent from deep during the four games... **AJ JORDAN**, who notched double-double against Radford and High Point, paced CCU over the stretch averaging a 16.3-point, 10.8-rebound double-double... Overall, five Chants averaged 10-plus point through the four games... **ALEX PUCKETT** turned in her second career double-double with 17 point and 11 rebounds in the win over High Point... Gardner-Webb has won three in a row and four in a row in Big South play to move into a tie for first place... GWU will travel to face another league leader on Thursday, playing at Liberty in a key game set to be broadcast by ESPN3 (WatchESPN.com)... Guard **JASMINE DALE** is well on track to reach the 1,000-point mark by season's end for her career... **LANA DORAN** was strong in the Winthrop win, scoring 11 points in her third consecutive start... **JESSICA HEILIG** and **OLIVIA PARKER** were the beneficiaries of Radford's zone and double team of **CATRINA GREEN**, with each scoring 17 points inside in that 71-57 win.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers went 2-1 on the week with wins over Liberty and Campbell, two teams picked higher than HPU in the Big South Preseason Poll... Freshman **KAYLAH KEYS** averaged 21.3 points per game for the week while the Panthers front court duo of **Stacia Robertson** and **LATRICE PHELPS** also averaged double-figure points... High Point beat Liberty at home for the first time since March 9, 2009, snapping Liberty's streak of seven straight wins at the Millis Center... The win over Liberty was also the program's 200th win at the Millis Center... Junior **STACIA ROBERTSON** posted double-doubles in two of High Point's three games this week while swatting away seven blocks.

LIBERTY

Liberty's 75-52 home win over Campbell on Dec. 28 was the Lady Flames' 300th game at the Vines Center, where they are now 238-62 all-time... The Lady Flames' 75-70 setback at High Point on Dec. 30 snapped Liberty's streak of 16 straight wins over Big South opponents... Liberty bounced back with a 92-69 win at Charleston Southern on Jan. 2, setting a new season high for points... Liberty has not lost back-to-back Big South games since Feb. 20 & 22, 1997... The Lady Flames' 71-62 victory at Coastal Carolina on Jan. 4 was their 41st straight win in the teams' head-to-head series, which is the second-longest active winning streak against a single opponent in NCAA Division I women's basketball... Liberty is now 8-2 in its last 10 games after starting the season 0-4 and is 49-4 in games played in South Carolina under head coach **CAREY GREEN**... The Lady Flames have outrebounded 12 straight opponents and lead the nation in rebound margin at +17.0... **KATELYN ADAMS**, **CATHERINE KEARNEY** and **ASHLEY RININGER** all had double-doubles at Charleston Southern, marking the first time three Lady Flames have posted double-doubles in the same game since Feb. 4, 1986 versus Randolph-Macon... **REAGAN MILLER** moved into sixth place on Liberty's career list with 107 three-pointers made.

LONGWOOD

The Lancers, who dropped their final two decisions during a five-game homestand against league opponents Coastal Carolina and Campbell, snapped an eight-game skid with a pair of road wins in their two most recent outings. Longwood held off Presbyterian to take a 46-43 victory on Jan. 2. The squad then mounted a late second-half comeback after being down as many as 17 to defeat Charleston Southern, 78-71, on Jan. 4. Through 14 games, sophomore **DAEISHA BROWN** paces the squad with 17.8 points per game. Sophomore **RAVEN WILLIAMS** has added to the offensive effort with 12.3 points per game, while classmate **KYNDAL SKERSICK** totals 9.8. Sophomore **KHALILAH ALI** leads the Lancers on the boards with 6.5 rebounds per game, while Brown follows with 5.6. As a team, Longwood is shooting 36.4% (287-789) from the floor, including 26.8% (84-314) from beyond the arc, and 70.2% (144-205) from the foul line. The squad will host a pair of league contests this week, beginning with UNC Asheville on Thursday, Jan. 9. Tipoff is slated for 7 p.m.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Presbyterian College women's basketball team snapped a four-game losing streak and picked up its first Big South Conference win on Saturday with a 70-45 home victory over Radford... Through Thursday's games, PC ranked No. 6 in the nation in scoring defense at 52.1, a number that improved after Saturday's win to 51.6... The Blue Hose also boast the second-best turnover margin in the League (+1.71) and best in conference-only statistics (+4.20)... Senior guard **KARLEE TAYLOR** played in her 100th career game on Thursday against Longwood, becoming the eighth member in program history to play in 100 Division I games. Senior guard **SHERECE SMITH** also passed 300 career rebounds against the Lancers, moving her to sixth in the school's Division I record books... After Thursday's 46-43 loss against Longwood, five of PC's last six losses have come by seven points or fewer. Two losses (SC State and Gardner-Webb) this season have come by two points, one by three and another (Western Carolina) saw PC lose by a four-point margin... **KEYONNA ALLEN**'s 15-point, 10-rebound performance on December 28 against Winthrop gave the redshirt sophomore her first career double-double and the program's first since 2013 graduate **MARIAH PIETROWSKI** posted the same numbers against Campbell on February 21, 2013. She becomes the second active player with a double-double, joining **SHERECE SMITH**, who posted 16 points and 10 rebounds against Gardner-Webb on February 26, 2011... Freshman **AIANNA KELLY** holds the team's assists (2.3) and steals (1.6) lead... This week pits PC against High Point (Thursday, 7 p.m.) and Liberty (Saturday, 7 p.m.), both teams PC beat for the first time ever last season in one-off meetings against the two sides.

RADFORD

The Highlanders are still in search of their first Division I win after dropping contests to Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb and Presbyterian College. The 13-game losing streak is a school record... **AYANA AVERY** has added to her league-leading 3-point tally. The junior guard has 42 treys, well on pace to break the single-season school record... Freshman **KERMISHA CLARK** has come on strong as of late, scoring in double figures the past three games.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 1-2 over the holiday break, with a victory over Presbyterian and setbacks against Gardner-Webb and Winthrop... The victory the Blue Hose was the first for the Bulldogs since Feb. 13, 2010. That day Asheville got a game-high 18 points from former Bulldog Chioma Okoli in the 66-59 victory... Junior guard **SHONESE JONES** has now scored 829 career points... The Bulldogs picked up their first road win since Feb. 28, 2011 when the Bulldogs defeated Charleston Southern on Dec. 2, earning a 61-46 victory over the Lady Bucs. Asheville's last road win was at Winthrop, 66-61. The Bulldogs dropped 30 straight road games. This was also the last time the Bulldogs won a Big South Conference road contest. Asheville also snapped a 29-game Big South Conference losing skid as well. Previously, the Bulldogs' last Big South win came against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 21, 2012, a 72-65 victory for the Blue & White.

WINTHROP

The Eagles began conference play with a 4-0 record, the best in the program's history, but the streak ended in a loss at Gardner-Webb. Winthrop is in the midst of the most grueling part of its schedule. After this Thursday's game at Radford, the Eagles will have played six games over a 12-day span that began Dec. 28. Freshman forward **ERICA WILLIAMS** had her second double-double of the year with 24 points and a career-best 14 rebounds at Asheville in a 68-49 victory. In three games last week she averaged 13.7 points and 9 rebounds. She also had 14 points and 9 rebounds in a 69-49 home win over Charleston Southern. **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** broke the Big South career assist record against on Dec. 30 when she dished out 14 against Charleston Southern to pass former Elon guard Jayme Chikos' mark of 612. McClanahan's career assist total stands at 632. In Winthrop's loss at Gardner-Webb, sophomore center **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** was out with an injury.
