RECO McCARTER • F R-Jr. • Campbell Goldsboro, N.C.

McCarter averaged 21.0 points, 7.5 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 2.5 steals in leading Campbell to a pair of victories to open Conference play last week. He led CU with 19 points, seven rebounds and five assists in a 74-71 win over High Point on Wednesday, and then ignited the Camels' game-ending 25-7 run with 11 points as part of a team-high 23 markers in Campbell's come-frombehind win at Longwood. McCarter added eight boards, four assists, three steals and two blocks against the Lancers. For the week, Mc-Carter was 15-of-27 from the floor (=55.6 percent), 5-of-11 from long range (=45.5), and 7-of-10 from the line (=70.0).

QJ PETERSON • G Fr. • VMI Hedgesville, W.Va.

Peterson averaged 22.5 points, 2.5 rebounds and 2.0 steals in his first two Big South games last week. He debuted with 30 points in the Keydets' 95-72 League-opening win over Longwood. Peterson followed with 15 points and four steals in VMI's five-point loss to Liberty. For the week, he was 13-of-29 from the field (=44.8) and 15-of-20 from the charity stripe (=75.0 percent).

FOUR TEAMS EMERGE 2-0 AFTER FIRST WEEK OF CONFERENCE GAMES

Radford, Campbell, Winthrop and UNC Asheville all opened 2-0 in Big South play last week. Campbell is 2-0 in League action for the third-straight year, while Asheville is 2-0 for the first time since 2011-12. Radford is 2-0 for the first time since opening 4-0 in 2009-10, and Winthrop is 2-0 for the first time since 2006-07 when the Eagles went undefeated in Big South action at 14-0.

SHOOTING FOR THREE

Radford, Campbell, Winthrop and UNC Asheville are all have an opportunity to open 3-0 in Conference games this week. As noted above, Radford's last 3-0 start was in 2009-10 (4-0) and Winthrop last opened League play 3-0 in 2006-07 (14-0). Campbell is seeking its third consecutive 3-0 start, while UNC Asheville is in search of its first 3-0 start since opening 8-0 in 2011-12. Meanwhile, if all four teams win their next game, it would mark just the second time in Big South history that four teams opened League play at 3-0. The first time was in 2011-12 (UNC Asheville, Coastal Carolina, Charleston Southern, Campbell).

ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH -- FEB. 1 SELECTION IS COASTAL AT CAMPBELL

For the first time in League history, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2013-14. Included in the package are three "Wildcard" selections, and the first game chosen is Coastal Carolina at Campbell on Feb. 1 at 11:00am (game moved up from original 4:00pm time). ESPNU will make "Wildcard" selections of these broadcasts 21 days in advance, and the next "Wildcard" games are Thursday, Feb. 13 at 7:00pm, and Friday, Feb. 28 at 7:00pm.

BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK TIPS OFF THIS WEEK

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 returns this season with the first broadcast being the Longwood at Radford game on Saturday, Jan. 18 live at 4:00pm. MATT HOGUE (play-by-play) and RALPH PATTERSON (analyst) will call the action from the Dedmon Center in Radford, Va. For the second consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry eight Big South matchups, as well as all four quarterfinal games of the 2014 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Men's Basketball Championship for the first time.

A GAME OF MARGINS

The first week of Conference games saw an even split, as the visiting teams went 6-6 in the first 12 Big South games. Seven games were decided by less than 10 points (6.0 average), while the remaining five were decided by double digits (15.6). Through 12 Conference games, the average margin of victory in the League season is exactly 10.0 points. Last season, the home teams went 61-35 (=63.5 percent) during the Big South schedule, while the average margin of victory in the Conference season was 10.72 points.

BIG SOUTH FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE SCORING COMBINATIONS

Since the Big South's first official men's basketball season in 1985-86, a total of 16 four-year classmate combinations have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period, with three pair reaching the mark as juniors -- Charleston Southern junior tandem **SAAH NIMLEY** (1,100) and **ARLON HARPER** (1,053) became the third on Dec. 28. Radford junior duo **JAVONTE GREEN** (1,070) and **R.J. PRICE** (998) are on their way to achieving the feat as well. The other pair of Big South teammates to reach 1,000 points as juniors were VMI's **CHAVIS** and **TRAVIS HOLMES** (2007-08) and UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** and **J.P. PRIMM** (2010-11).

BACK IN FAMILIAR TERRITORY

VMI leads the Big South and is second in the nation in scoring with 89.1 points per game, its highest average since 2008-09 when the Keydets scored a League- and NCAA-leading 93.8 a contest. VMI, which has led the Big South in scoring six out of the last seven years -- including last season, is second all-time for most times leading the Conference in scoring offense at six. Radford owns that record with nine times.

DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern is averaging 86.3 points this season, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest. Meanwhile, CSU and VMI could mark just the second time in League history that at least two teams averaged 80.0 points in the same year. The first (and only) time was in 1992-93 when three squads averaged 80.0 points -- Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3).

WHAT IS YOUR Q SCORE?

VMI freshman QJ PETERSON leads the Big South with 20.2 points per game, and is looking to become the first freshman ever to lead the Big South in scoring, as well as the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game. The first (and only) was Liberty's SETH CURRY in 2008-09 (20.2). Peterson is the second-highest scoring freshman in the nation behind Fordham's JON SEVERE (21.4).

RAISE YOUR GLASS FOR RODNEY

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW** became the 23rd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday against Liberty. He is the first Keydet to join the League's 400-assist club. Meanwhile, Glasgow eclipsed 1,000 career points Jan. 8 against Longwood to become the 122nd member of the Big South's 1,000-point scoring club. He is now one of 19 players in League history with 1,000 career points (1,034) and 400 career assists (401).

BIG SOUTH FRESHMEN FIVE FAB?

Five freshmen players are among the Big South's top 19 scorers -- including three in the top 10. As previously mentioned, VMI frosh **QJ PETERSON** is the League's leader with 20.2 points. UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is seventh at 16.3 points, while Coastal Carolina's **ELIJAH WILSON** is ninth at 15.4 markers per game. Presbyterian's **REGGIE DILLARD** is 17th in the League in scoring at 12.6, with Winthrop freshman **KEON JOHNSON** in 19th at 12.4.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** became the 46th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds when he surpassed the scoring milestone Dec. 30 vs. Houghton. He is the 12th Highlander on the Big South's 1,000/500 list, and enters the week 49th in League annals with 583 career boards -- 17 away from becoming the 43rd player with 600. Green is the first Highlander with 1,000 points and 500 rebounds since **ART PARAKHOUSKI** and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** in 2009-10.

D.J. - PART 1

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** became the sixth player in Big South history with 200 career blocked shots when he surpassed the milestone Dec. 20 against Virginia Intermont. He is averaging 5.0 blocks in his last six games to raise his career total to 227 -- fourth all-time in the League record books. Cunningham leads the Big South with 3.62 rejections a game, which is currently the third-highest single-season total in League history. Meanwhile, Cunningham is tied for 29th on the Big South's career rebounding list with 676, and is 24 rebounds away from becoming just the second player in League history with 700 rebounds and 200 blocks.

D.J. - PART 2

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON**, who is sixth in Big South history with 209 career blocked shots, became the 71st player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Dec. 19 at East Carolina. Meanwhile, Covington is the fourth player in League history with 1,000 career points (1,048), 500 career rebounds (540) and 200 career blocked shots (209). He has blocked a shot in 44 of his last 46 appearances, and since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (46 games), he has recorded 136 of his 209 career blocks in that span (=65.1 percent) for an average of 3.09 per contest.

BURRUS' BOARDS AND BLOCKS

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS**, who missed all of 2012-13 with an injury, became the 19th member of the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club when he surpassed the rebounding milestone Dec. 7 against Greensboro College -- becoming the 70th Big South player to grab 500 caroms. Burrus has tallied 115 rejections in his career -- tied for 25th in League annals, and is just the second Liberty player on the list. He joins Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97. Burrus is 29 points away from becoming the 14th player in League history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots.

WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern junior guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 16 times in their career (nine times last season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 13-3 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 16 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

WATCH YOUR P'S AND Q'S

In addition to leading the Conference in scoring, VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** is pacing the League in steals with 2.40 per game, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the League in steals per game. The last player to lead the Big South in scoring *AND* steals was VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** in 2008-09 (22.0 ppg, 3.39 spg).

TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern is averaging a League-leading and 11.47 three-pointers per game this season -- second-highest in the nation, and is looking to become the first Big South team other than VMI to average at least 10 triples a game in a single-season. CSU's average of 11.47 threes is the highest in the Big South since VMI averaged a Conference-record 13.69 in 2008-09. The Buccaneers' current per game tally would be fifth-highest in the League record book.

It was a different story in the postseason, as the North Division finished 7-4 against South Division teams in the 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Basketball Championship, which included the Conference Championship trophy. This season's crossover divisional games will take place Jan. 25-Feb. 13.

LONGWOOD SCORES BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG 12 WIN IN 15 SEASONS

Longwood's 82-79 win at TCU on Nov. 12 was the Big South's first win over a member of the Big 12 Conference since the 1999-00 season. That year, Winthrop defeated Missouri, 51-46.

NORTH DIVISION

CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

The Camels dealt a season-high 25 assists on 28 baskets (89%) in the win over High Point, the third time this year that Campbell has produced 80% assists-or-better on its made field goals ... CU led by as many as 17 in the first half against the Panthers and never trailed, while its 13-point second-half deficit marked the largest comeback win for the Camels under first-year head coach **KEVIN McGEEHAN** ... Over the last 4 games, **RECO McCARTER** is averaging 21.3 points, 6.3 rebounds, 4.8 assists, 2.3 steals and shooting 53% from the floor and 77% from the line ... The Camels return to action Tuesday at defending Big South Tournament champ Liberty. CU has never won at the Vines Center, going 0-6 all-time at the facility.

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

ADAM WEARY has scored at least 21 points in three of the past four games, including a career-high 22 in HPU's game at Campbell last Wednesday. He averaged 19.0 points and shot 55.1 percent in those four games. Prior to scoring 21 at Wofford on Dec. 30, Weary's career-high was 19 at Charleston Southern on Jan. 19, 2013 ... DEJUAN McGAUGHY has scored in double digits the past two games after scoring less than 10 points in each of the last 12 games. He also averaged 3.5 assists to 1.5 turnovers in those two games ... High Point is 8-1 all-time in home games against Longwood. HPU's only loss to the Lancers at the Millis Center came by one point, 58-57, on Jan. 11, 1993 ... The Panthers' game against Radford last Friday on ESPNU was High Point's first-ever nationally-televised home game during the regular season.

LIBERTY FLAMES

Liberty's 85-80 win over VMI marked its first victory inside Cameron Hall since Jan. 2, 2010 (110-102). The Flames outrebounded the Big South's No. 1 rebounding team by a margin of 21 (52-31). JR CORONADO finished with a career-high 20 points and a season-high 13 rebounds. DAVON MARSHALL also played a huge role, hitting four key three-pointers to finish with 16 tallies ... JOHN CALEB SANDERS needs 13 points to surpass his brother JESSE SANDERS (1,235 career points) for 15th on Liberty's all-time scoring list ... Liberty's loss at Radford snapped a six-game overall win streak against the Highlanders and five-game win streak inside the Dedmon Center ... Campbell has not defeated Liberty on the Flames' home turf since the very first meeting on Jan. 5, 1976, when the Camels defeated Liberty, 85-78. At the time, Liberty played its home games at Jefferson Forest High School in Forest, Va.

LONGWOOD LANCERS

LUCAS WOODHOUSE led the Lancers against VMI with his team-high 17 points, and added a game-high eight assists, while **KARL ZIEGLER** finished with 15 points ... **TRISTAN CAREY** led Longwood with his game-high 26 points at Campbell, including six three-pointers, in addition to a game-high nine rebounds. He now totals 1,212 career points to rank 12th all-time and ranks third with 185 career three-pointers ... Woodhouse had a game-high 12 assists against the Camels ... Longwood continues League play this week with road games at High Point on Wednesday and at Radford on Saturday. The game against the Highlanders will be televised on ESPN3.

RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

R.J. PRICE needs one more basket to become the 21st player in Radford history to reach 1,000 career points, as he enters the week at 998. Price is also climbing the ranks in three-point field goals made. Now with 179 for his career, he moved into 7th place all-time at RU ... **JAVONTE GREEN** needs 21 rebounds to move into the Top 10 at RU all-time. He is currently 11th with 583 career caroms. Green ranks 8th all-time at RU with 144 career steals ... Radford is 12-5 for the first time since the 1993-94 season ... With Big South opening wins both at home and on the road last week, the Highlanders snapped a three-game losing skid for each ... RU has won 7-straight games at the Dedmon Center and is 7-0 at home this season ... The Highlanders are 3-1 against NCAA Tournament teams from last year.

VMI KEYDETS

Since an 0-8 outing from 3-point range at Clemson, **RODNEY GLASGOW** has gone 9-of-17 from beyond the arc (=52.9%) since ... VMI started 8-0 at home for the second time in three years but had its nine-game Cameron Hall winning streak halted with the loss to Liberty Jan. 11 ... **BRIAN BROWN** returned to action Jan. 8 against Longwood after missing two games with an injury ... **D.J. COVINGTON** logged his sixth double-double of the season with 15 points and a season-high 16 rebounds against Longwood. Covington has averaged 16.0 points and 8.9 rebounds, while shooting 60% (45-75) from the floor in his last seven games ... VMI hoisted 39 three-point shots against Liberty, which was the most against a Division I opponent this year ... The eight turnovers committed against the Flames was the second-lowest by VMI this season.

SOUTH DIVISION

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

SAAH NIMLEY moved into 18th place on the program's all-time scoring list last week with 1,100 ... CSU led by as many as 23 points in the win over Coastal and held Coastal to 39 percent shooting, including a 3-of-16 mark from three (0-for-7 in the second half). CSU also out-rebounded (38-33) a Coastal team that was 2nd in the Big South with a +6.1 rebounding margin. It was CSU's second-straight win over the Chanticleers after dropping seven straight in the series ... **WILL SAUNDERS** was 11-for-16 from three-point range and scored 39 points in 36 minutes of action in three games last week ... Three of CSU's next four games are at home, beginning with Presbyterian and UNC Asheville this Wednesday and Saturday. Four of the Bucs' first six Big South games are at home, while five of their last seven are on the road.

COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

Coastal went 1-1 last week with a 70-58 loss at Charleston Southern and a 81-69 win at Gardner-Webb ... Freshman **ELIJAH WILSON** led the way averaging 15.0 points per game. He opened the week with just nine points at CSU before scoring a teamhigh 21 points at Gardner-Webb. Wilson was 8-11 from the field against the Runnin' Bulldogs while connecting on all four of his attempts from three-point range ... On the season, Wilson leads the Chants with 15.4 points per game ... CCU opens up the home portion of its Big South schedule this week as the Chants host UNC Asheville and Winthrop. CCU is 33-31 all-time against Asheville, including 22-12 at home. The Chants are 39-36 against Winthrop and 26-11 at home.

GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

TYLER STRANGE has 22 assists and just one turnover in his last two games and paces the Big South in assist/turnover ratio so far this season (3.63) and ranks 12th nationally with 6.4 assists per game. Strange has the top assist/turnover ratio of any player in the nation with at least 100 assists to date ... Gardner-Webb is 0-2 in Big South play for the first time since the 2009-10 season, when the team started League play 0-3 ... The Runnin' Bulldogs started last season 2-4 in Big South games before going on a stretch that resulted in 10 wins in the final 11 regular season contests.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

If **JORDAN DOWNING** can maintain his 19.3 ppg, he will eclipse the PC Division I record of 16.9 set in 2012 by **AL'LONZO COLEMAN**. Downing would also shatter the season total points record of 501 set by **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** last season. With 328 points already this season, Downing is on pace to finish the season with more than 550 points ... PC will look to snap a four-game losing streak to CSU with its upcoming game Wednesday. In those four meetings, the Blue Hose have lost by an average of 14 points, the closest margin a seven-point decision Jan. 12, 2012. CSU owns an 11-6 mark overall in the series ... The Blue Hose have fared a little better as of late against Gardner Webb, their second opponent of the week. PC has earned wins over the Runnin' Bulldogs three of the last five meetings.

UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

The Bulldogs have won seven of their last eight games to even their record at 8-8 ... The Bulldogs won at Gardner-Webb in their first League game and are now 17-1 in their last 18 League lid-lifters. Head Coach NICK McDEVITT is now 16-1 in Big South openers as a player, assistant coach and head coach ... The Bulldogs are 19-8 in their last 27 Big South road games. However, Asheville goes to two places it has had a hard time winning at in League play this week. The Bulldogs have lost two-straight at Coastal Carolina and dropped three-straight games at Charleston Southern ... D.J. CUNNINGHAM enjoyed his fifth double-double on Saturday against Presbyterian with 13 points and 18 rebounds. He tied a career-high with 18 rebounds vs. PC, and it also marked the most rebounds by any Asheville player in the Division I era ... COREY LITTLEJOHN enjoyed his first double-double on Saturday with 11 points and 11 rebounds.

WINTHROP EAGLES

KEON MOORE scored a team-high 16 points in the win at PC, including two big free throws with five seconds to play in the game. He then tallied a career-high 23 points in the win over Charleston Southern ... Moore led five Eagles in double-figures vs. CSU as the Eagles posted 85 points -- the most against a League team other than VMI since scoring 87 against UNC Asheville on Jan. 17, 2009 ... In addition to Moore connecting on a career-high five threes, **CHRISTIAN FARMER** and **ANDRE SMITH** set career-highs with five made threes each ... Winthrop is 8-2 in its last 10 Big South games scoring 80-plus points and 13-2 in the last 15 ... The win at PC ended a 12-game Conference road losing streak ... In the win over the Bucs, Winthrop connected on 15-of-28 threes (=53.6%). The mark was two shy of tying the school record of 17 ... The 15 threes were the most by a Winthrop team since it had 15 at Wisconsin on Dec. 4, 2006.
