Bratcher a senior from Raleigh, N.C., averaged 22.5 points per game and shot 43 percent from downtown to lead the Buccaneers to a pair of Big South wins last week. The guard got her week started with 26 points on 50 percent from the floor, 50 percent from long range and 3-of-5 from the line in the win at Campbell on Jan. 9. She also dished out an assist and came away with three rebounds and two steals against the Camels. Two days later at High Point, Bratcher recorded 19 points, six rebounds, one assist and one steal as Charleston Southern pulled out the 56-53 win over the Panthers. The honor marks her first Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

Jarvis, a forward from Winston-Salem, N.C., notched 14.5 points per game on 75 percent shooting in Charleston Southern's two wins last week. On the road at Campbell, she connected on 80 percent from the floor, 75 percent from three-point land and 5-of-6 from the line to finish with 16 points. She followed that effort with 13 points on 5-of-7 from the field and a perfect 3-of-3 from downtown at High Point. She also chipped in six rebounds and a pair of steals in the win. The honor is her first Big South Freshman of the Week plaudit this season.

**FANNING THE FLAMES -- LIBERTY TABBED PRESEASON FAVORITE**

Fort the 16th time in the last 17 years, Liberty is the preseason women's basketball favorite for the 2013-14 season. The Lady Flames received 13 of the 25 first-place votes and 261 out of a possible 275 points. Liberty will have two starters and nine letterwinners back from last year's Big South championship and NCAA Tournament squad. Winthrop was voted second with 256 points and 11 first-place bids. Campbell was picked third with 206 points.

**MCCLANAHAN VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR**

Winthrop senior **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** is the 2013-14 Big South Women's Hoops Preseason Player of the Year. McClanahan is the reigning two-time Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She is looking to become the first player with three consecutive Player of the Year Awards since Liberty's Katie Feenstra from 2003-05. McClanahan led the League in scoring for the second-straight year in 2012-13 with 19.8 points per game and was also tops with 5.8 assists per game.

**PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH**

Joining McClanahan on the Preseason All-Big South Team is Campbell's **KIERA GAINES**, High Point's **STACIA ROBERTSON**, Longwood's **DAEISHA BROWN** and Liberty's **EMILY FRAZIER**. Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** and **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** from Winthrop rounded out the Preseason All-Conference Team.

**NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE**

The Big South has two new coaches on the sideline this season. **JAIDA WILLIAMS** is the new skipper at Coastal Carolina, while **MIKE MCGUIRE** took over at Radford.

**THRICE AS NICE**

For the second-straight year and third time in the last four years, three Big South women's squads received berths in the NCAA postseason., tying the League record. Liberty was the League's representative in the NCAA Tournament, while Winthrop captured the Big South's automatic bid to the WNIT. Presbyterian College, in its first year of full Division I status and postseason eligibility, accepted an at-large invitation to the WBI.

**TRIPLE CROWN**

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan will attempt to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the Conference in scoring in three consecutive seasons., as Liberty's Elena Kisseleva is the only player to win three Big South scoring titles. Meanwhile, McClanahan will look to become the first player to ever lead the League in assists three-straight years in 2013-14.

**MAGIC WAND-A**

With Campbell's win over Western Carolina earlier this season, **WANDA WATKINS** picked up her 500th career win. She is currently the 27th active coach to reach the milestone, while being one of six that have been at the same institution for at least 33 years.

**EAGLES, EAGLES, EAGLES!!!**

Winthrop defeated Florida Gulf Coast, 65-61, in the first round of the WNIT last March, marking the Big South's first women's basketball postseason win since 2005. It was Winthrop's first postseason win in women's basketball since becoming a Division I member in 1986, and it is also the Big South's third-ever victory in the WNIT.

## THE COUNT DOWN BEGINS

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan is currently tied for No. 5 all time with 1,950 points. She is currently on pace to take over the top spot held by Elena Kisseleva of Liberty who finished her career with 2,154 points.

## GREEN MACHINE

CATRINA GREEN of Gardenr-Webb currently the Big South's active leading rebounder with 830 career boards. She is currently No. 14 all-time in the Big South. Meanwhile, Green is became the 12th member of the Big South's 1,000 points, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shots club over the Christmas break. She currently has 1034 (No. 82 all-time) points and 133 rejections.

## MILLIS CENTER NORTH

With High Point's 71-63 win at Liberty on Jan. 17 inside the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win back-to-back road games at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1995-96 and 1996-97 seasons.

## IN RANGE WHEN SHE ENTERS THE GYM

Presbyterian College's KARLEE TAYLOR is four three-pointers away from becoming the 10th player in Big South history with 200 triples. Taylor made 85 treys last season (7th most in League history).

## BROKE THE STREAK

With its win over Charleston Southern on Dec. 2, UNC Asheville snapped a 29-game conference losing streak that dated back to the 2011-12 season. The win marked head coach BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK's first career Big South win.

## HOT STARTS

Winthrop and Coastal Carolina began the Conference in record-breaking fashion. Coastal Carolina's and Winthrop's 4-0 starts to the League slates marked its best runs in school history.

## DIAPER DANDIES

Two Big South players have earned a combined 7-of-8 Big South Freshman of the Week nods this season. High Point's KAYLAH KEYS has earned the honor four times this season, while ERICA WILLIAMS of Winthrop has received the nod three times. Keys has six 20-point games this season and is averaging 16.6 points per game. Williams is posting 14.1 points per outing, to go along with a pair of 20-point outings.

## KEY(S)FENSE

High Point freshman standout Keys has been HPU's go-to player for offense during the Conference season. She is currently ranked No. 1 among all Big South players with an average of 21.7 points per game in Conference-only contests.

## JUMP AROUND

The Liberty Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the nation. The Lady Flames currently rank No. 2 in the nation as they are averaging a +15.5 rebound margin.

## WOMAN OF STEAL

Charleston Southern's DJ FOWLER has been creating havoc for opponents of the defensive side of the ball this season. She is currently ranked No. 2 in Division I with 3.47 steals per game.

**CAMPBELL**

Campbell stands at 9-7 overall and 4-3 in Big South play after snapping a three-game winning streak with a 75-68 victory over Coastal Carolina...**KIERA GAINES** registered a pair of double-doubles, which included a season-high 26 points and 17 rebounds against the Chanticleers...Gaines added 15 points and 11 boards at North Carolina A&T...**ROSLYN PRESLEY** averaged 19 points and 7.3 rebounds during the three games this week...The Lady Camels shot a season-best 63 pct. (17-27) overall and 6-of-10 from beyond the three-point arc vs. Coastal Carolina...Charleston Southern set a pair of Gore Arena/John W. Pope Jr. Convocation Center records for women's basketball for three pointers made by a team (17) and individual (Erin Bratcher - 7)...Campbell has posted a +3.0 rebounding margin with 65 points per game and yielding opponents to 62 points...The Lady Camels have pulled down 41.1 rebounds per contest, leading to a +3.6 advantage on the glass...From three-point range, Campbell is one of the most-consistent teams in the league with 96 made at a 35.2 rate...The Lady Camels travel to Gardner-Webb on Thursday for a special 11 a.m. tip for Education Day before traveling to Presbyterian on Saturday at 5 p.m.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern went 2-0 on the week, improving to 3-4 overall in Big South play on the year and 6-9 on the season overall as the Buccaneers with wins on the road against both Campbell and High Point...Thursday night against Campbell saw guard **ERIN BRATCHER** break the Gore Arena record with seven three-pointers as Charleston Southern connected on 15 shots from behind the arc in recording the 81-71 victory...Bratcher's sharpshooting broke the previous Gore Arena record of six, and is the second gym this year in which the senior guard has either broke or tied the record after connecting on six earlier this year in tying the Dedmon Center record in CSU's 84-64 win over Radford...CSU hit 10 three-pointers in the first half in building a 36-31 halftime lead and connected on their first three triples from the second half in pulling away from the Camels...Saturday saw the Buccaneers hold off a late charge from the Panthers in picking up the 56-53 victory...Bratcher again led CSU with 19 points, connecting on five three-pointers in the game as Charleston Southern held on despite losing a double-digit lead with nearly seven minutes remaining in picking up their third Big South win...CSU is back in action this week as the Bucs host Trinity Baptist on Thursday and Coastal Carolina on Saturday.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina went 0-1 on the week with a road loss at Campbell (68-75) ... The defeat was Coastal's first on the road in Big South play this season ... **ANGELICA HENRY** led Coastal against Campbell with a season high 25 points ... Freshman **KARSEN SIMS** scored 12 points on four second-half 3-pointers ... Coastal surrendered a halftime lead for the first time this season ... **AJ JORDAN** leads the Big South with 112 made baskets this season and owns the league's best shooting percentage for a guard at 48.9 percent ... GWU is 2-2 so far away from home against Big South foes ... Thursday's home game with Campbell (1/16) will tip at 11:30 am as part of Gardner-Webb's Education Day ... More than 1,000 elementary school students are scheduled to attend the game.

High Point split a pair of Big South Conference games, beating Presbyterian and losing to Charleston Southern ... The Panthers led the entire way en route to a 75-64 win over Presbyterian on Thursday ... HPU's freshman duo of **KAYLAH KEYS** and **TEDDY VINCENT** led the way, leading the team in scoring, rebounding and assists ... Keys finished with 21 points, marking the fifth time in seven conference games she has scored 20 or more points ... She also had five assists and four rebounds while going 12-of-13 from the foul line ... Vincent scored 16 point with six rebounds and four assists, all career highs ... The Panthers helped secure the win by going 23-of-26 from the free-throw line as a team ... Keys added 18 points and two assists to her totals against Charleston Southern ... Another freshman, **DEANNEISHA JACKSON**, scored 10 points, all in the second half against CSU ... Redshirt-junior **STACIA ROBERTSON** grabbed 15 rebounds in the game to go with seven points and three blocks.

**LIBERTY**

Liberty has been the Big South's hottest team in recent weeks, winning four games in a row and nine of its last 10 ... As a result, the Lady Flames, who have also posted five straight home wins, have claimed sole possession of first place in the conference standings at 6-1 entering the week ... Liberty has outrebounded 14 straight opponents and ranks No. 2 nationally in rebound margin at latest report ... The Lady Flames will play at Winthrop (Thursday) and UNC Asheville (Saturday) this week ... Liberty is 4-1 in its last five road games ... The Lady Flames are 104-13 in January under **CAREY GREEN**, including 4-0 this season ... **ASHLEY RININGER** recorded a pair of double-doubles last week, giving the redshirt sophomore four in a row, 11 this season and 14 in her career ... Megan Frazee owns the Liberty sophomore class record with 13 double-doubles in 2006-07 ... Post players Rininger, **KATELYN ADAMS** and **CATHERINE KEARNEY** have combined for 10 double-doubles in seven Big South games this year ... Rininger sits just eight points shy of 500 for her career.

**LONGWOOD**

Longwood is currently 6-10 overall this season, including 3-4 in Big South Conference action, after splitting a pair of home games last week. The Lancers made a valiant comeback effort against UNC Asheville before eventually succumbing to a 69-65 loss on Jan. 9. As a team, Longwood is shooting 35.9% (334-931) from the floor, including 26.1% (93-356) from beyond the arc, and 69.0% (165-239) from the foul line. The squad will hit the road for a pair of league games this week beginning at in-state rival Radford University on Thursday, Jan. 16. Tipoff is slated for 7 p.m.

**PRESBYTERIAN**

The Presbyterian College women's basketball team dropped both of its games last week despite strong second-half comebacks, coming up short at High Point, 75-64, and Liberty, 59-51... Senior guard **KARLEE TAYLOR** scored 24 points against the Flames, the third-most in a PC Division I game and her six three-pointers tied a school Division I record as well, a feat she accomplished for the third time on Saturday. Taylor also grabbed a career-high eight rebounds and tied a career-high with seven field goals made. With her 24 points, Taylor passed Dria David (2009-13) for second-place in PC's Division I career points ledger and currently stands at 978... PC trailed by 16 in the second half at Liberty and cut the gap to four, just two days after shaving 14 points off of a 16-point first-half deficit against High Point... Redshirt sophomore forward **KEYONNA ALLEN** blocked five shots against High Point to set a new career-high and tie the most ever in a Division I game for PC. She becomes only the second Division I player with five blocks, joining Shonda Burnside, who swatted away five shots against NC Central on November 20, 2010... PC returns home this week to host Coastal Carolina on Thursday night before welcoming Campbell on Saturday.

**RADFORD**

The Highlanders are still in search of their first Division I win after dropping contests to Winthrop and UNC Asheville... **AYANA AVERY** has 47 treys on the season, well on pace to break the single-season school record.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

The Bulldogs picked up their first win ever at Longwood on Thursday evening, earning a 69-65 victory over the Lancers. Sophomore **PAIGE LOVE** scored a career-high 22 points including a go-ahead 3-pointer with just over 10 seconds remaining in the game. With the victory the Blue & White snapped a four-game losing skid to the Lancers, improving to 2-4 lifetime against Longwood... Asheville earned a 68-61 victory over Radford on Saturday afternoon. Coach **KEVIN COOK** says he plans to suit up sophomore guard **ALIYAH KILPATRICK** against Liberty this week. Kilpatrick underwent surgery last summer to repair a torn Achilles tendon that she suffered during a July pick-up game. Her availability will be on a day-to-day basis.
