Glasgow averaged 28.0 points and 5.5 assists in two games last week. He opened with a career-high 36 points in the 101-88 win at Radford, shooting 13-of-16 from the floor and 10-of-10 from the line. Glasgow followed with 20 points and six assists at Campbell. For the week, he was 21-of-33 from the field (=63.6 percent) and 12-of-13 from the line (=92.3) to go along with 4.0 rebounds per game.

Green averaged 18.5 points and 16.0 rebounds in two games last week. He opened with 20 points and 13 boards against VMI, and followed with 17 points and a career-high 19 rebounds in the win over Longwood. For the week, Green was 10-of-20 from the floor (=50.0 percent) and 16-of-20 from the charity stripe (=80.0), in addition to averaging 2.0 steals per game.

NO UNDEFEATED TEAMS REMAIN IN CONFERENCE PLAY

For the first time since 2002-03 and just the second time overall in League history, no team will start 3-0 in Big South games, as this season's previous 2-0 squads Radford, Campbell, Winthrop and UNC Asheville all lost in their third League contest last Wednesday. Meanwhile, all four squads won over the weekend to create two-way ties atop each division at 3-1 -- Radford and Campbell in the North Division and Winthrop and UNC Asheville in the South Division. Two of those teams will gain sole possession of the division lead this week, as first-place showdowns are scheduled for Wednesday.

LUCKY 13

Radford's 13 victories this season already match its win total from all of last year, and the team needs just four more wins to secure its first winning campaign since going 19-12 in 2009-10.

ESPN GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH -- FEB. 1 SELECTION IS COASTAL AT CAMPBELL

For the first time in League history, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPN in 2013-14. Included in the package are three "Wildcard" selections, and the first game chosen is Coastal Carolina at Campbell on Feb. 1 at 11:00am (game moved up from original 4:00pm time). ESPN will make "Wildcard" selections of these broadcasts 21 days in advance, and the next "Wildcard" games are Thursday, Feb. 13 at 7:00pm, and Friday, Feb. 28 at 7:00pm.

BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK CONTINUES THIS WEEK

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this week with the next broadcast being the VMI at Winthrop game on Saturday, Jan. 25 live at 4:00pm. **RALPH PATTERSON** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from the Winthrop Coliseum in Rock Hill, S.C. For the second consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry eight Big South match-ups, as well as all four quarterfinal games of the 2014 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Men's Basketball Championship for the first time.

A GAME OF MARGINS

The first two weeks of Conference games has seen an even split, as the visiting teams are 12-12 after 24 Big South games. Sixteen games have been decided by less than 10 points (5.31 average), while the remaining eight contests have had double-digit victory margins (18.13). Through 24 Conference games, the average margin of victory in the League season is 9.58 points. Last season, the home teams went 61-35 (=63.5 percent) during the Big South schedule, while the average margin of victory in the Conference season was 10.72 points.

BIG SOUTH FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORING COMBINATIONS

Since the Big South's first official men's basketball season in 1985-86, a total of 18 four-year classmate combinations have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period, with four pair reaching the mark as juniors -- including two this year in Charleston Southern junior tandem **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER**, and Radford junior duo **JAVONTE GREEN** and **R.J. PRICE**. Below is a detailed look at the four sets of junior teammates and their overall career point totals:

BACK IN FAMILIAR TERRITORY

VMI leads the Big South and the nation in scoring with 90.1 points per game, its highest average since 2008-09 when the Keydets scored a League- and NCAA-leading 93.8 a contest. VMI, which has led the Big South in scoring six out of the last seven years -- including last season, is second all-time for most times leading the Conference in scoring offense at six. Radford owns that record with nine times.

DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern is averaging 86.2 points this season, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest. Meanwhile, CSU and VMI could mark just the second time in League history that at least two teams averaged 80.0 points in the same year. The first (and only) time was in 1992-93 when three squads averaged 80.0 points -- Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3).

WHAT IS YOUR Q SCORE?

VMI freshman **OJ PETERSON** leads the Big South with 20.1 points per game, and is looking to become the first freshman ever to lead the Big South in scoring, as well as the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game. The first (and only) was Liberty's **SETH CURRY** in 2008-09 (20.2). Peterson is the second-highest scoring freshman in the nation behind Fordham's **JON SEVERE** (20.9).

TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern is averaging a League- and national-leading 11.35 three-pointers per game this season, and is looking to become the first Big South team other than VMI to average at least 10 triples a game in a single-season. CSU's average of 11.35 threes is the highest in the Big South since VMI averaged 11.55 in 2009-10. The Buccaneers' current per game tally would be fifth-highest in the League record book.

RAISE YOUR GLASS FOR RODNEY

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW**, who became the 23rd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 11 against Liberty, is currently 20th all-time with 412 and needs six dimes to move into 19th-place. The first Keydet to join the Big South's 400-assist club, Glasgow eclipsed 1,000 career points Jan. 8 against Longwood and is now one of 19 players in League history with 1,000 career points (1,090) and 400 career assists (412).

GREEN DAY

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** grabbed a Big South season-high 19 rebounds this past Saturday against Longwood, the most in a Conference game in nearly four years since Coastal Carolina's **JOSEPH HARRIS** corralled 19 boards against Charleston Southern on Feb. 20, 2010.

BIG SOUTH FRESHMEN FIVE FAB?

Five freshmen players are among the Big South's top 24 scorers -- including three in the top 10. As previously mentioned, VMI frosh **OJ PETERSON** is the League's leader with 20.1 points. UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is sixth at 17.2 points, while Coastal Carolina's **ELIJAH WILSON** is ninth at 15.7 markers per game. Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** is 19th in the League in scoring at 12.3, with Presbyterian College freshman **REGGIE DILLARD** in 24th at 11.8.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** became the 43rd player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the milestone this past Saturday against Longwood. He is currently 42nd all-time with 615. Meanwhile, Green is now one of 31 players in the Conference record books with 1,000 career points (1,107) and 600 boards. He is the 10th Highlander on the Big South's 1,000/600 list and first since **ART PARAKHOUSKI** and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** in 2009-10.

D.J.'s BLOCK PARTY - PART 1

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** became the 25th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday at Charleston Southern. He is now just the second player in League annals with 700 rebounds and 200 blocked shots. Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** was the first with 718 rebounds and 215 rejections from 1989-94. Meanwhile, Cunningham has recorded 33 of his 50 blocks this season in his last eight games (4.13 average) to increase his career total to 230 -- fourth all-time in the League record books. Cunningham leads the Big South with 3.33 rejections a game, which is currently the fourth-highest single-season total in League history.

D.J.'s BLOCK PARTY - PART 2

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON**, who is sixth in Big South history with 210 career blocked shots, became the 71st player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Dec. 19 at East Carolina. Meanwhile, Covington is the fourth player in League history with 1,000 career points (1,093), 500 career rebounds (559) and 200 career blocked shots (210). He has blocked a shot in 45 of his last 48 appearances, and since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (48 games), he has recorded 137 of his 210 career blocks in that span (=65.2 percent) for an average of 2.85 per contest.

BURRUS' BOARDS AND BLOCKS

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS**, who missed all of 2012-13 with an injury, became the 19th member of the Big South's 500-rebound, 100-blocked shot club when he surpassed the rebounding milestone Dec. 7 against Greensboro College -- becoming the 70th Big South player to grab 500 car-oms. Burrus has tallied 116 rejections in his career -- 25th in League annals, and is just the second Liberty player on the list. He joins Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97. Burrus is 16 points away from becoming the 14th player in League history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 100 blocked shots.

WATCH YOUR P'S AND Q'S

In addition to leading the Conference in scoring, VMI freshman **OJ PETERSON** is pacing the League in steals with 2.35 per game, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the League in steals per game. The last player to lead the Big South in scoring *AND* steals was VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** in 2008-09 (22.0 ppg, 3.39 spg).

Longwood sophomore **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** leads the League with 7.58 assists per game and has three-straight games with at least 10 helpers. Just 36 dimes away from matching his Big South freshman-record total of 180 last season, Woodhouse's per game average is currently the third-highest single-season clip in League history. The last player to average at least 7.0 assists in a season was Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** in 2011-12 (7.97).

THE PRICE IS RIGHT

Radford junior guard **R.J. PRICE** is 17 three-pointers away from becoming the 32nd player in Big South history with 200 career treys. Price has buried a three-pointer in 70 of his 81 career games, including a career-best streak of 26 consecutive games during the 2012-13 campaign. He has also made at least three three-pointers in a game 35 times.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,475 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. John Caleb is at 1,240 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11 and surpassed Jesse's total of 1,235 from 2008-12 this past Saturday. The 2013-14 season is the second and, for now, final season with Divisional play. It was a different story in the postseason, as the North Division finished 7-4 against South Division teams in the 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Basketball Championship, which included the Conference Championship trophy. This season's crossover divisional games will take place Jan. 25-Feb. 13.

CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

Campbell won for the 9th time in its last 10 overtime games (2-1 in 2013-14) when the Camels defeated VMI, 97-93 Saturday in a game that featured 25 lead changes and 13 ties. **DARIUS LEONARD** (21) and **LEEK LEEK** (19) both scored career highs, while **RECO McCARTER** added 21 points and grabbed a career-best 13 rebounds ... Each of Campbell's last 7 games has been decided by 10 or fewer points with the Camels winning 4 of those contests ... On Tuesday at Liberty, Campbell committed just 4 turnovers (none in the second half), the fewest in a game since the Camels set a school record for fewest turnovers (2) at Samford on Feb. 2, 1995 ... Over his last 6 games, McCarter is averaging 20 points, 7.8 rebounds, 4.5 assists and shooting 48% from the floor.

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

JOHN BROWN has scored at least 21 points in four of the last five games and is averaging 21.2 points in that stretch. **ADAM WEARY** is on a similar stretch, having scored at least 21 points in four of the last six games. TRISTAN CAREY led the Lancers at High Point with his team-high 15 points, adding a game-high seven rebounds. **KARL ZIEGLER** finished with 14 points, all scored in the second half, while **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** and **LERON FISHER** each had 13 points. Woodhouse added a game-high 10 assists for a double-double ... Carey led Longwood with his game-high 27 points at Radford, making 5-9 three-pointers. He now totals 1,254 career points and is tied for 10th all-time, and ranks third with 193 career three-pointers ... Woodhouse finished with 17 points and a game-high 12 assists for his second-straight and fourth overall double-double this season. His 324 career assists already rank fifth all-time ... The Lancers and first-year head coach **JAYSON GEE** look for their first Big South win this week, returning home to host North Division opponent and in-state arch-rival Liberty on Wednesday.

RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

JAVONTE GREEN set a career-high with 19 rebounds vs. Longwood, and is now 10th in school history with 615 career boards. Green also ranks eighth in program annals with 148 steals ... **R.J. PRICE** became RU's 21st all-time 1,000-point scorer on Jan. 15 vs. VMI. He now has 1,018 points. Price is also climbing the ranks in three-point field goals made, as he is now 7th all-time at RU with 183. In addition, he has moved into the Top 10 all-time at RU in assists (10th - 253) ... **BRANDON HOLCOMB** set a career-high with 14 points vs. Longwood ... The Highlanders have hit 49 of 54 free throws in the last two games (=90.7) ... **KYLE NOREEN** set a career-high with 12 points vs. VMI and recorded back-to-back double-digit scoring games for the first time in his career with 10 points vs. Longwood ... **RASHUN DAVIS** tallied a career-high with 25 points vs. VMI.

SOUTH DIVISION

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

CSU played one of its best halves of the season in the opening stanza of Wednesday's 95-58 win over Presbyterian. The Bucs shot 62 percent from the floor and assisted 13 of their 21 made field goals to build a 52-26 halftime lead. CSU also held PC to 40.6% shooting ... The 37-point margin of victory over PC was CSU's largest in a Big South game during head coach **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH**'s tenure ... **MATT KENNEDY** recorded his second 20-point game of the season and second of his career with 21 points in Wednesday's win over Presbyterian. Kennedy has scored in double figures 11 times this year after having none in his first three seasons ... For the season, CSU's bench is outscoring the opponent's bench by a 692-347 margin.

COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

JOSH CAMERON led the Chants last week as he averaged 23 points in the two games. He scored a career-high 29 points in the victory over Asheville. Cameron was 10-18 from the field against the Bulldogs, including 5-6 from 3-point range ... **WARREN GILLIS** led the offensive attack against Winthrop as he scored 19 points while hitting 9-10 from the free throw line ... On the season, freshman **ELIJAH WILSON** continues to pace the CCU offensive attack as he is averaging 15.7 points per game ... Cameron is inching closer to that top spot as he sits in second at 14.1 points per game ... The Chants hit the road for a pair of games this week at Presbyterian and Radford. CCU is 12-6 all-time against PC, including 6-2 in Clinton. The Chants are 21-34 all-time against Radford, including 8-18 on the road.

GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb evened its Big South record at 2-2 after winning consecutive road games at Winthrop and Presbyterian ... **NAJI HIBBERT** averaged a solid 14.5 points in the two games, including 18 in the win at Presbyterian on Saturday -- just Gardner-Webb's third win in Clinton since 1996 ... **TYLER STRANGE** matched his career-high with 17 points at Presbyterian ... GWU has won four Big South Conference road games in a row, and six of the last seven, dating back to last season. The only two South Division road losses for GWU last season came at Winthrop and Presbyterian ... GWU will host South Division favorite Charleston Southern on Wednesday. The two teams twice played to overtime last season, with GWU winning each time. The Runnin' Bulldogs lead the all-time series with Charleston Southern, 11-3, and are 5-0 against the Bucs in Paul Porter Arena since 2008-09.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

If **JORDAN DOWNING**'s 18.1 ppg continues for the remainder of the season, he will eclipse the PC Division I record of 16.9 set in 2012 by **AL'LONGZO COLEMAN** ... Downing would also shatter the season points record of 501 set by **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** last year ... The Blue Hose host Coastal Carolina Wednesday before taking to the road to face Liberty Saturday. CCU owns the 11-6 record over PC and has won the last eight straight, including a 60-53 decision in the last meeting. The Blue Hose won the first six of nine meetings to open the series back in 1975, but haven't won since a 65-62 victory in 2009 ... PC has fared better against Liberty, owning an 8-6 mark, including last year's 68-60 win at The Templeton Center ... PC has won the last three of four meetings, the lone loss a 77-64 decision at Liberty Feb. 11, 2012.

UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

DAVID ROBERTSON tied a career-high with 18 points in the Coastal Carolina loss last week. **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** finished with a double-double for the second-straight game with 10 points and 10 rebounds.
