Love averaged 16.5 points per game and shot 63 percent from the field to lead the Bulldogs to a 1-1 record last week, including an overtime win against Liberty on Jan. 18. She got her week started with 19 points on 64 percent shooting to go along with seven rebounds, two assists and a steal against High Point on Jan. 16. Two days later against Liberty, the guard poured in 14 points as she connected on 63 percent from the floor and 4-of-4 from the line. She also chipped in six rebounds and four helpers against the Lady Flames. The win snapped a 16-game losing streak to the Lady Flames that dated back to the 2006-07 season.

FANNING THE FLAMES -- LIBERTY TABBED PRESEASON FAVORITE

Fort the 16th time in the last 17 years, Liberty is the preseason women's basketball favorite for the 2013-14 season. The Lady Flames received 13 of the 25 first-place votes and 261 out of a possible 275 points. Liberty will have two starters and nine letterwinners back from last year's Big South championship and NCAA Tournament squad. Winthrop was voted second with 256 points and 11 first-place bids. Campbell was picked third with 206 points.

MCCLANAHAN VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Winthrop senior **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** is the 2013-14 Big South Women's Hoops Preseason Player of the Year. McClanahan is the reigning two-time Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She is looking to become the first player with three consecutive Player of the Year Awards since Liberty's Katie Feenstra from 2003-05. McClanahan led the League in scoring for the second-straight year in 2012-13 with 19.8 points per game and was also tops with 5.8 assists per game.

PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH

Joining McClanahan on the Preseason All-Big South Team is Campbell's **KIERA GAINES**, High Point's **STACIA ROBERTSON**, Longwood's **DAEISHA BROWN** and Liberty's **EMILY FRAZIER**. Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** and **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** from Winthrop rounded out the Preseason All-Conference Team.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has two new coaches on the sideline this season. **JAIDA WILLIAMS** is the new skipper at Coastal Carolina, while **MIKE MCGUIRE** took over at Radford.

THRICE AS NICE

For the second-straight year and third time in the last four years, three Big South women's squads received berths in the NCAA postseason, tying the League record. Liberty was the League's representative in the NCAA Tournament, while Winthrop captured the Big South's automatic bid to the WNIT. Presbyterian College, in its first year of full Division I status and postseason eligibility, accepted an at-large invitation to the WBI.

TRIPLE CROWN

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan will attempt to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the Conference in scoring in three consecutive seasons, as Liberty's Elena Kisseleva is the only player to win three Big South scoring titles. Meanwhile, McClanahan will look to become the first player to ever lead the League in assists three-straight years in 2013-14.

MAGIC WAND-A

With Campbell's win over Western Carolina earlier this season, **WANDA WATKINS** picked up her 500th career win. She is currently the 27th active coach to reach the milestone, while being one of six that have been at the same institution for at least 33 years.

EAGLES, EAGLES, EAGLES!!!

Winthrop defeated Florida Gulf Coast, 65-61, in the first round of the WNIT last March, marking the Big South's first women's basketball postseason win since 2005. It was Winthrop's first postseason win in women's basketball since becoming a Division I member in 1986, and it is also the Big South's third-ever victory in the WNIT.

THE COUNT DOWN BEGINS

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan is currently for No. 4 all time with 2005 points. She is currently on pace to take over the top spot held by Elena Kisseleva of Liberty who finished her career with 2,154 points.

GREEN MACHINE

CATRINA GREEN of Gardenr-Webb currently the Big South's active leading rebounder with 850 career boards. She is currently No. 13 all-time in the Big South. Meanwhile, Green is became the 12th member of the Big South's 1,000 points, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shots club over the Christmas break. She currently has 1066 (No. 75 all-time) points and 136 rejections.

MILLIS CENTER NORTH

With High Point's 71-63 win at Liberty on Jan. 17, 2013 inside the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win back-to-back road games at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1995-96 and 1996-97 seasons.

IN RANGE WHEN SHE ENTERS THE GYM - 1,000 POINTS FOR CAREER

Presbyterian College's KARLEE TAYLOR ranks fifth all time in the Big South Conference in career three-pointers. She currently has 225 for her career. Taylor made 85 treys last season (7th most in League history). She also scored her 1,000th career point on Jan. 18. She is currently tied for No. 86 in the League with 1,004 points.

BROKE THE STREAK

With its win over Charleston Southern on Dec. 2, UNC Asheville snapped a 29-game conference losing streak that dated back to the 2011-12 season. The win marked head coach BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK's first career Big South win.

BROKE THE STREAK (PART TWO)

UNC Asheville broke another streak this season that dated back to the 2006-07 season. On Jan. 18, the Bulldogs knocked off Liberty 80-83 in OT to snap a 16-game losing streak to the Lady Flames. The win also marked the first time Asheville had defeated Liberty in Asheville since the 1996-97 season.

HOT STARTS

Winthrop and Coastal Carolina began the Conference in record-breaking fashion. Coastal Carolina's and Winthrop's 4-0 starts to the League slates marked its best runs in school history.

DIAPER DANDIES

Two Big South players have earned a combined 7-of-8 Big South Freshman of the Week nods this season. High Point's KAYLAH KEYS has earned the honor four times this season, while ERICA WILLIAMS of Winthrop has received the nod four times. Keys has seven 20-point games this season, including 32 points against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 18, and is averaging 17.0 points per game. Williams is posting 14.6 points per outing, to go along with a three of 20-point outings.

KEY(S)FENSE

High Point freshman standout Keys has been HPU's go-to player for offense during the Conference season. She is currently ranked No. 1 among all Big South players with an average of 21.4 points per game in Conference-only contests.

JUMP AROUND

The Liberty Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the nation. The Lady Flames currently rank No. 1 in the nation as they are averaging a +15.6 rebound margin.

WOMAN OF STEAL

Charleston Southern's DJ FOWLER has been creating havoc for opponents of the defensive side of the ball this season. She is currently ranked No. 5 in Division I with 3.29 steals per game.

CAMPBELL

Campbell has tallied a 10-8 overall and 5-4 in Big South record with a loss at Gardner-Webb, 56-54, and a victory at Presbyterian, 46-42...A trio of double-digit scorers - **RAECHAU EDWARDS** (14), **ROSLYN PRESLEY** (13) and **KIERA GAINES** (12) - paced the Lady Camels in the loss at Gardner-Webb, where the Bulldogs hit two free throws to clinch the win with four seconds left...Presley (16) and Amanda Coffey (10) led Campbell in the tight 46-43 win at Presbyterian...The 89 total points was tied for the second-lowest total in a league game this year with Longwood securing a 46-43 win at PC...Campbell has posted a +2.7 rebounding margin with 63.3 points per game and yielding opponents to 60.6 points...The Lady Camels have pulled down 40.4 rebounds per contest, leading to a +3.4 advantage on the glass...From three-point range, Campbell is one of the most-consistent teams in the league with 103 made at a 33.8 rate...The Lady Camels return home to host first-place Winthrop on Thursday before traveling to Radford on Saturday.

The High Point University women's basketball team picked up a pair of Big South road wins at UNC Asheville and Gardner-Webb, moving the team in to third place in the league ... The Panthers trailed Asheville by one point at halftime but went on to win 71-66 ... Redshirt-junior **STACIA ROBERTSON** scored a season-high 23 points to lead all three forwards in double-figure scoring ... Junior **LATRICE PHELPS** added 14 points and freshman **DEANNEISHA JACKSON** chipped in 10 ... The Panthers pulled off a tough win at Gardner-Webb on Saturday, 81-77, led by a career-high 32 point performance from Kaylah Keys ... She sealed the game with four free throws in the final 26 seconds and she grabbed the final rebound of the game ... Keys made free throws at the end of both wins this week ... Keys' 32 points are the fourth most in a single game in HPU's division I era ... She is the first player to score 30 points in a game for HPU since Cheyenne Parker scored 34 at Longwood on Feb. 7, 2013 ... **DEANNEISHA JACKSON** and **LATRICE PHELPS** also scored in double-figures for the second straight game adding 12 and 11 points, respectively.

LIBERTY

Liberty went 1-1 during its road trip to Winthrop and UNC Asheville, with both contests going to overtime ... It marked the Lady Flames' first back-to-back overtime games since Dec. 9 and 10, 1983 at Navy and College of Notre Dame ... Liberty's 83-80 overtime setback at Asheville on Saturday was the Lady Flames' first road setback against the Bulldogs since Feb. 8, 1997 ... Saturday's loss was Liberty's first this month, and the Lady Flames fell to 106-14 in January contests under head coach **CAREY GREEN** ... Redshirt sophomore **ASHLEY RININGER**'s streak of five straight double-doubles ended on Saturday, but she has 12 double-doubles in 18 games this season ... Rininger's next double-double will tie her with Megan Frazee (2006-07) for the program single-season record among sophomores ... Rininger has scored 533 points during her first season and a half and needs 11 markers to become one of Liberty's top 50 career scorers. She also needs only two rebounds to become the 40th Lady Flame ever to grab 400 career boards ... During Saturday's game, **REAGAN MILLER** became the 40th Lady Flame ever to score 600 or more career points ... **EMILY FRAZIER**'s nine rebounds at Winthrop on Thursday were the most by a Liberty point guard since Danina Staugaitiene had nine against DePaul in the second round of the NCAA Tournament on March 22, 2005.

The Presbyterian College women's basketball team split two close home games last week, knocking off Coastal Carolina in overtime (71-68) before falling to Campbell on Saturday, 46-43... **KARLEE TAYLOR** hit a three-pointer with 8:08 left in the second half on Saturday to score her 1,000th career point, becoming the second person in the school's Division I history to accomplish that feat. She joins Mariah Pietrowski (2009-13) in the PC Division I 1,000 point club... On Thursday night, **Sherece Smith** scored a career-high 25 points to help PC knock off Coastal Carolina in overtime. Her 25 marked the third-most in PC's Division I history, second to the two-time record of 26 points. Her 10 field goals tied Katlin Moore and Mariah Pietrowski for most in a PC Division I game... **Aianna Kelly** also delivered a big game for PC on Thursday, playing all 45 minutes—another PC Division I record—and grabbing a career-high 16 rebounds, one shy of that school Division I record. She also scored 11 points to post her first career double-double... The Blue Hose travel to Charleston Southern on Tuesday night before beginning the second half of league action with a rematch at Gardner-Webb on Saturday afternoon.

RADFORD

The Highlanders ended their 15-game losing streak Thursday night with a 57-51 victory over Longwood. Radford's defense held the Lancers to a season-low 23.9 percent shooting... **AYANA AVERY** has 51 treys on the season, which is tied for the seventh-best single-season mark in program history and well on pace to break the single-season school record.
