#### JOHN BROWN • F R-Soph. • High Point Jacksonville, Fla.

Brown averaged 27.0 points, 7.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists, 2.0 blocks and 1.5 steals as High Point split a pair of games last week. He tied his career highs with 28 points and four assists in an overtime loss at VMI on Wednesday. Brown also had a game-high nine rebounds along with two blocks and two steals, while shooting 12-for-19 from the floor and 4-for-5 from the line against the Keydets. In HPU's win over UNC Asheville on Saturday, Brown scored 26 points and pulled down five rebounds. His reverse alley-oop dunk in the first half was featured as ESPN SportsCenter's No. 2 play. For the week, Brown was 23-of-35 from the field ( =65.7 percent) and 8-of-11 from the free throw line (=72.7).

Wilson led the Chants as he averaged 19.5 points and 6.0 rebounds in two wins last week. He opened with 17 points and five rebounds at Presbyterian, as he was 7-of-12 from the field and 3-of-7 from long range. In CCU's win at Radford, Wilson scored a game-high 22 points and hit three 3-pointers, while going 5-of-6 from the charity stripe. He scored 17 of his 22 points in the second half, and made four free throws in the final minute of play to help preserve the victory.

#### ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH -- FIRST "WILDCARD" BROADCAST IS SATURDAY

ESPNU's first of three Big South "Wildcard" TV broadcast selections is this Saturday's Coastal Carolina at Campbell game live at 11:00am. ROY PHILPOTT (play-by-play) and PAUL BIANCARDI (analyst) have the call from Buies Creek. For the first time in League history, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2013-14. Included in the package are three "Wildcard" selections, and the next game chosen was UNC Asheville at Radford on Feb. 13 at 7:00pm (game moved from Feb. 12). The final "Wildcard" game is Friday, Feb. 28 at 7:00pm, and ESPNU will make its selection 21 days in advance.

#### A GAME OF MARGINS

With 36 of the 96 Conference games in the books, the visiting teams are 16-20 for a 44.4 winning percentage. Thus far, 23 games have been decided by less than 10 points (4.61 average), while the remaining 13 contests have had double-digit victory margins (16.38). Through 36 Conference games, the average margin of victory in the League season is 8.86 points. Last season, the home teams went 61-35 (=63.5 percent) during the Big South schedule, while the average margin of victory in the Conference season was 10.72 points.

#### **CROSSOVER DRIBBLE**

From Jan. 25-Feb. 13, crossover divisional Conference games will be all the rage in the Big South. Following the first round of contests this past Saturday, the divisions are 3-3 against each other -- with each division going 2-1 at home. During the 2012-13 regular-season, the South Division "won" the first season of the Big South's crossover divisional match-ups in men's basketball, as the South teams finished 22-14 (=61.1 percent) against the North Division. #### BIG SOUTH'S ESPN3 GAME OF THE WEEK CONTINUES THIS WEEK

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this week with the Liberty at Charleston Southern game on Saturday, Feb. 1 live at 5:30pm. **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from the CSU Field House in Charleston, S.C. For the second consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry eight Big South match-ups, as well as all four quarterfinal games of the 2014 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Men's Basketball Championship for the first time.

#### **BIG SOUTH FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORING COMBINATIONS**

Since the Big South's first official men's basketball season in 1985-86, a total of 18 four-year classmate combinations have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period, with four pair reaching the mark as juniors -- including two this year in Charleston Southern junior tandem **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER**, and Radford junior duo **JAVONTE GREEN** and **R.J. PRICE**. Below is a detailed look at the four sets of junior teammates and their overall career point totals:

#### **BACK IN FAMILIAR TERRITORY**

VMI leads the Big South and the nation in scoring with 87.9 points per game, its highest average since 2010-11 when the Keydets scored a League- and NCAA-leading 87.9 a contest. VMI, which has led the Big South in scoring six out of the last seven years -- including last season, is second all-time for most times leading the Conference in scoring offense at six. Radford owns that record with nine times.

#### DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern is averaging 85.7 points this season, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest. Meanwhile, CSU and VMI could mark just the second time in League history that at least two teams averaged 80.0 points in the same year. The first (and only) time was in 1992-93 when three squads averaged 80.0 points -- Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3).

#### **BURRUS' BOARDS AND BLOCKS**

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS** is now the 14th member of the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shot club, as he surpassed the scoring milestone this past Saturday against Presbyterian. Burrus is 60th in League history with 561 rebounds and 25th with 117 blocked shots. He joins Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 1,715 points, 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97, as the only Flames on the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shot list.

#### WHAT IS YOUR Q SCORE?

VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** leads the Big South with 20.1 points per game, and is looking to become the first freshman ever to lead the Big South in scoring, as well as the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game. The first (and only) was Liberty's **SETH CURRY** in 2008-09 (20.2). Peterson is the third-highest scoring freshman in the nation behind Howard's **JAMES DANIEL** (21.2) and Fordham's **JON SEVERE** (20.2).

#### LUCKY 13

Radford's 13 victories this season already match its win total from all of last year, and the team needs just four more wins to secure its first winning campaign since going 19-12 in 2009-10. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina is three victories shy of matching its win total for 2012-13 (14), and Campbell is three wins away from equalling its win output for last season (13).

#### TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern is second in the nation with a League-leading 11.11 three-pointers per game this season, and is looking to become the first Big South team other than VMI to average at least 10 triples a game in a single-season. CSU's average of 11.11 threes is the highest in the Big South since VMI averaged 11.32 in 2010-11. The Buccaneers' current per game tally would be sixth-highest in the League record book.

#### RAISE YOUR GLASS FOR RODNEY

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW**, who became the 23rd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 11 against Liberty, is currently tied for 19th all-time with 417 and needs 13 more dimes to move into 18th-place. The first Keydet to join the Big South's 400-assist club, Glasgow eclipsed 1,000 career points Jan. 8 against Longwood and is now one of 19 players in League history with 1,000 career points (1,121) and 400 career assists (417).

#### **BIG SOUTH FRESHMEN FIVE FAB?**

Five freshmen players are among the Big South's top 24 scorers -- including three in the top 10. As previously mentioned, VMI frosh **QJ PETERSON** is the League's leader with 20.1 points. UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is sixth at 17.0 points, while Coastal Carolina's **ELIJAH WILSON** is ninth at 16.1 markers per game. Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** is 19th in the League in scoring at 12.2, with Presbyterian College freshman **REGGIE DILLARD** in 24th at 11.8.

#### **GREEN MACHINE**

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** became the 43rd player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the milestone Jan. 18 against Longwood. He is currently tied for 40th all-time with 630. Meanwhile, Green is now one of 31 players in the Conference record books with 1,000 career points (1,132) and 600 boards. He is the 10th Highlander on the Big South's 1,000/600 list and first since **ART PARAKHOUSKI** and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** in 2009-10.

#### D.J.'s BLOCK PARTY - PART 1

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** became the 25th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 18 at Charleston Southern. He is now just the second player in League annals with 700 rebounds and 200 blocked shots. Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** was the first with 718 rebounds and 215 rejections from 1989-94. Meanwhile, Cunningham has recorded 33 of his 50 blocks this season in his last eight games (4.13 average) to increase his career total to 230 -- fourth all-time in the League record books. Cunningham leads the Big South with 3.33 rejections a game, which is currently the fourth-highest single-season total in League history.

### D.J.'S BLOCK PARTY - PART 2

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON**, who is fifth in Big South history with 218 career blocked shots, became the 71st player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Dec. 19 at East Carolina. Meanwhile, Covington is the fourth player in League history with 1,000 career points (1,122), 500 career rebounds (577) and 200 career blocked shots (218). He has blocked a shot in 47 of his last 50 appearances, and since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (50 games), he has recorded 145 of his 218 career blocks in that span (=66.5 percent) for an average of 2.90 per contest.

#### NO KNOCK ON WOOD

Longwood sophomore **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** leads the League with 7.52 assists per game and has a League-high seven games with at least 10 helpers -- the most in the Big South since Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** had eight in 2011-12. Just 22 dimes away from matching his Big South freshman-record total of 180 last season, Woodhouse's per game average is currently the third-highest single-season clip in League history. The last player to average at least 7.0 assists in a season was Sanders in 2011-12 (7.97).

#### WATCH YOUR P'S AND Q'S

In addition to leading the Conference in scoring, VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** is pacing the League in steals with **2.26** per game, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the League in steals per game. The last player to lead the Big South in scoring *AND* steals was VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** in 2008-09 (22.0 ppg, 3.39 spg).

#### THE PRICE IS RIGHT

Radford junior guard **R.J. PRICE** is 12 three-pointers away from becoming the 32nd player in Big South history with 200 career treys. Price has buried a three-pointer in 72 of his 83 career games, including a career-best streak of 26 consecutive games during the 2012-13 campaign. He has also made at least three 3-pointers in a game 36 times -- including eight times this year.

#### BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,495 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. John Caleb is at 1,260 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11 and surpassed Jesse's total of 1,235 from 2008-12 on Jan. 18. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

#### **NORTH DIVISION**

#### **CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS**

Campbell concludes a stretch of 4 home games in a 5-game span this week with home games against preseason South Division favorite Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina ... Saturday's ESPNU game vs. Coastal is Campbell's first-ever nationally-televised contest from Gore Arena ... The Camels are 3-0 at home vs. Big South schools this year with those wins coming by an average of 3.0 points ... Campbell rallied from 13 points down to defeat Radford, 65-63 last Wednesday, matching the team's largest comeback win of the season ... LEEK LEEK blocked a career-high 5 shots Saturday at Gardner-Webb and now tops the squad with 22 blocks in 21 games ... RECO McCARTER is averaging 18.5 points and 7.3 rebounds over the last 8 games ... The Camels are committing just 9.8 turnovers in Conference games, lowest in the League.

#### HIGH POINT PANTHERS

JOHN BROWN has averaged 22.9 points on 56.1 percent field-goal shooting in seven games in 2014. He scored at least 21 points in six of those seven games, his low scoring effort a 15-point, 10-rebound performance at Campbell on Jan. 8 ... Brown tied his career-high with 28 points and added nine rebounds in HPU's overtime loss to VMI last Wednesday ... DEVANTE WALLACE scored 20 points against UNC Asheville on Saturday, the second 20-plus point game of his career. He has averaged 17.0 points and 3.8 three-pointers, shooting 62.5 percent (15-for-24) from three-point range over the last four games ... Freshman JORGE PEREZ-LAHAM scored a career-high 16 points with a career-high three 3-pointers at VMI. It was just his second double-digit scoring effort of the season. He has averaged 5.0 assists in the last four games ... High Point has won three of its last four games, the only loss coming in overtime at VMI on Jan. 22.

#### LIBERTY FLAMES

ANTWAN BURRUS finished with 12 points against Presbyterian and became the 24th member of Liberty's 1,000-point club in the process. He joined teammate JOHN CALEB SANDERS in the exclusive club, as the tandem is the sixth pair of Liberty players to share the honor simultaneously ... Sanders tied his career-high with 10 helpers against PC ... At Longwood, TOMASZ GIELO tied a career-high with 20 points ... In Conference games, Liberty is No. 2 in rebounding offense (39.5 rpg) behind VMI, and No. 1 in rebounding defense (27.3). The Flames also own a rebounding margin of +12.2 versus Big South opponents.

#### LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood put together back-to-back Division I wins for the first time this season and won its first two Conference games last week ... LUCAS WOODHOUSE made the game-winning three-point field goal with 2.9-seconds remaining against Liberty, and scored a career-high 27 points, including a career-high 7 three-pointers ... TRISTAN CAREY scored a season-high and game-high 37 points against Charleston Southern, making 13-21 field goals, including 7-10 three-pointers, while grabbing a game-high eight rebounds ... Carey now has 1,298 career points to rank 10th all-time at Longwood, and is second in school history with 201 career three-pointers ... Woodhouse finished with 13 points, a game-high 10 assists and a game-high three steals at CSU for his fifth double-double this season. He now totals 338 career assists to rank fifth all-time ... The Lancers host a pair of South Division opponents this week -- Gardner-Webb on Wednesday and UNC Asheville on Saturday.

#### RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Radford dropped back-to-back games for just the second time this season with losses at Campbell and vs. Coastal Carolina last week ... With 11 points and 10 rebounds vs. Campbell, **JAVONTE GREEN** extended his double-double streak to 3 games before having it snapped against Coastal. He now owns 20 double-doubles in his career ... Green set a career high with 4 blocked shots vs. Coastal Carolina ... **RASHUN DAVIS** has come off the bench in 2 of the last 4 games to lead the Highlanders in scoring (25 vs. VMI and 16 vs. Coastal) ... With its next win, Radford will record the 600th victory in program history (40th season).

#### VMI KEYDETS

**QJ PETERSON** hit four key free throws in the last minute of regulation to keep VMI in contention before falling at Winthrop. His 7-of-7 effort from the stripe was the second-best free throw shooting performance by a Keydet this year ... VMI's 82-80 overtime win over High Point marked the second straight game the Keydets had gone to overtime. The last time VMI played back-to-back overtime games was Feb. 2-4, 2009. The High Point OT win also snapped a VMI two-game losing streak in overtime games ... VMI's 57 points at Winthrop was its second-lowest offensive point total of the season. Winthrop's 58 points was also the second-lowest point total allowed by VMI this year ... VMI has blocked 23 shots over the last three games, including 9 against Winthrop -- tying the most against a Division I foe this year (9 vs. The Citadel on Nov. 8).

#### **SOUTH DIVISION**

#### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

CSU placed six players in double-figures scoring in the win over Gardner-Webb. It was the third game this season the Bucs placed six players in double digits ... AR-LON HARPER had scored one basket in the second half before his foul line pull-up jumper provided the difference against GWU with 2.7 seconds left ... ALHAJI FULLAH had one of his best games as a Buc in the win over Gardner-Webb. He scored 10 points and established season-highs with eight rebounds and four blocked shots ... CEDRICK BOWEN and Fullah have been remarkably efficient over CSU's last four games. They have combined to go 31-of-39 from the floor for 66 points. Bowen is 18-of-24 for 37 points during the stretch, while Fullah is 13-of-15 for 29.

#### COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

Coastal went 2-0 last week with a pair of road victories. CCU now has three Conference road victories, which is one more than the entire 2012-13 season ... Freshman ELIJAH WILSON led the Chants as he averaged 19.5 points per game on the week ... JOSH CAMERON led the way at PC as he scored 24 while going 5-6 from 3-point range ... On the season, Wilson continues to pace the CCU offensive attack as he is averaging 16.1 points per game, while Cameron is second at 14.6 ... EL HADJI NDIEGUENE is averaging 8.1 rebounds per game while sitting in fifth in scoring at 5.8 ppg ... The Chants return home on Wednesday to take on Liberty before hitting the road on Saturday for an ESPNU game at Campbell. CCU is 23-28 all-time against Liberty, including 12-12 at home. The Chants are 14-21 all-time against Campbell, but just 3-16 on the road.

#### GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb is ahead of last season's pace through six Big South games played, posting a 3-3 record. GWU was 2-4 after six games last season ... Gardner-Webb has won four consecutive league road games, dating back to last season and six of its last seven. GWU will have that streak tested heavily this week with road games at Longwood and at Radford ... Over the last four games, **NAJI HIBBERT** has powered Gardner-Webb's 3-1 record, averaging 14.5 points and making 44.0 percent of his 3-point attempts (50.0 percent of his overall FG attempts) ... GWU has limited teams to just 25.6 percent from the 3-point arc over the past four games, which has helped the team post the Big South's top marks so far in 3-point field goal percentage defense and scoring defense.
