Parker, a sophomore from Charlotte, N.C., averaged 18.5 points and 13.0 rebounds per game in Gardner-Webb's two Big South wins last week. She got her week going with 14 points on 63 percent from the floor to go along with 10 rebounds, one assist and one block in the win at Charleston Southern on Jan. 23. Two days later against Presbyterian, the forward poured in 23 points and ripped down 16 rebounds. She also chipped in a pair of steals and recorded one blocked shot in the win over the Blue Hose. The honor marks her first Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

FANNING THE FLAMES -- LIBERTY TABBED PRESEASON FAVORITE

Fort the 16th time in the last 17 years, Liberty is the preseason women's basketball favorite for the 2013-14 season. The Lady Flames received 13 of the 25 first-place votes and 261 out of a possible 275 points. Liberty will have two starters and nine letterwinners back from last year's Big South championship and NCAA Tournament squad. Winthrop was voted second with 256 points and 11 first-place bids. Campbell was picked third with 206 points.

MCCLANAHAN VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Winthrop senior **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** is the 2013-14 Big South Women's Hoops Preseason Player of the Year. McClanahan is the reigning two-time Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She is looking to become the first player with three consecutive Player of the Year Awards since Liberty's Katie Feenstra from 2003-05. McClanahan led the League in scoring for the second-straight year in 2012-13 with 19.8 points per game and was also tops with 5.8 assists per game.

PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH

Joining McClanahan on the Preseason All-Big South Team is Campbell's **KIERA GAINES**, High Point's **STACIA ROBERTSON**, Longwood's **DAEISHA BROWN** and Liberty's **EMILY FRAZIER**. Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** and **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** from Winthrop rounded out the Preseason All-Conference Team.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has two new coaches on the sideline this season. **JAIDA WILLIAMS** is the new skipper at Coastal Carolina, while **MIKE MCGUIRE** took over at Radford.

THRICE AS NICE

For the second-straight year and third time in the last four years, three Big South women's squads received berths in the NCAA postseason., tying the League record. Liberty was the League's representative in the NCAA Tournament, while Winthrop captured the Big South's automatic bid to the WNIT. Presbyterian College, in its first year of full Division I status and postseason eligibility, accepted an at-large invitation to the WBI.

TRIPLE CROWN

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan will attempt to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the Conference in scoring in three consecutive seasons., as Liberty's Elena Kisseleva is the only player to win three Big South scoring titles. Meanwhile, McClanahan will look to become the first player to ever lead the League in assists three-straight years in 2013-14.

MAGIC WAND-A

With Campbell's win over Western Carolina earlier this season, **WANDA WATKINS** picked up her 500th career win. She is currently the 27th active coach to reach the milestone, while being one of six that have been at the same institution for at least 33 years.

EAGLES, EAGLES, EAGLES!!!

Winthrop defeated Florida Gulf Coast, 65-61, in the first round of the WNIT last March, marking the Big South's first women's basketball postseason win since 2005. It was Winthrop's first postseason win in women's basketball since becoming a Division I member in 1986, and it is also the Big South's third-ever victory in the WNIT.

THE COUNT DOWN BEGINS

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** is currently for No. 2 all time with 2043 points. She is currently on pace to take over the top spot held by Elena Kisseleva of Liberty who finished her career with 2,154 points.

GREEN MACHINE

CATRINA GREEN of Gardenr-Webb currently the Big South's active leading rebounder with 865 career boards. She is currently No. 13 all-time in the Big South. Meanwhile, Green is became the 12th member of the Big South's 1,000 points, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shots club over the Christmas break. She currently has 1083 (No. 69 all-time) points and 139 rejections.

MILLIS CENTER NORTH

With High Point's 71-63 win at Liberty on Jan. 17, 2013 inside the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win back-to-back road games at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1995-96 and 1996-97 seasons.

IN RANGE WHEN SHE ENTERS THE GYM - 1,000 POINTS FOR CAREER

Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** ranks fourth all time in the Big South Conference in career three-pointers. She currently has 233 for her career. Taylor made 85 treys last season (7th most in League history). She also scored her 1,000th career point on Jan. 18. She is currently tied for No. 82 in the League with 1,032 points.

BROKE THE STREAK

With its win over Charleston Southern on Dec. 2, UNC Asheville snapped a 29-game conference losing streak that dated back to the 2011-12 season. The win marked head coach **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK**'s first career Big South win.

BROKE THE STREAK (PART TWO)

UNC Asheville broke another streak this season that dated back to the 2006-07 season. On Jan. 18, the Bulldogs knocked off Liberty 80-83 in OT to snap a 16-game losing streak to the Lady Flames. The win also marked the first time Asheville had defeated Liberty in Asheville since the 1996-97 season.

HOT STARTS

Winthrop and Coastal Carolina began the Conference in record-breaking fashion. Coastal Carolina's and Winthrop's 4-0 starts to the League slates marked its best runs in school history.

DIAPER DANDIES

Two Big South players have earned a combined 9-of-11 Big South Freshman of the Week nods this season. High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS** has earned the honor four times this season, while **ERICA WILLIAMS** of Winthrop has received the nod five times. Keys has seven 20-point games this season, including 32 points against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 18, and is averaging 16.8 points per game. Williams is posting 15.3 points per outing, to go along with a four of 20-point outings.

KEY(S)FENSE

High Point freshman standout Keys has been HPU's go-to player for offense during the Conference season. She is currently ranked No. 1 among all Big South players with an average of 20.2 points per game in Conference-only contests.

JUMP AROUND

The Liberty Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the nation. The Lady Flames currently rank No. 1 in the nation as they are averaging a +16.1 rebound margin.

WOMAN OF STEAL

Charleston Southern's **DJ FOWLER** has been creating havoc for opponents of the defensive side of the ball this season. She is currently ranked No. 4 in Division I with 3.25 steals per game.

DOYEN HER THING

Radford's **AYANA AVERY** leads the Big South Conference with 66 triples on the season... She is currently ranked No. 6 in Division I with 3.30 three-pointers per game. She tops the Radford roster and is ranked No. 2 in the League with 16.9 ppg in Conference-only contests.

Campbell stands at 7-4 in the Big South after posting two victories this week, increasing its winning streak to three...Thursday the Lady Camels knocked off top-ranked Winthrop in an overtime thriller, 77-74 in Buies Creek...Senior **ROSLYN PRESLEY** led all scorers with 22 points...Presley scored 7 of CU's 9 overtime points...Senior **KIERA GAINES** narrowly missed registering a triple-double, notching 9 points, 12 rebounds, and 12 assists...Her 12 assists gave her a new season and career high...CU shot .478 from the field and .476 from three-point range in the contest...Campbell defeated Radford for the second time this season 75-61 at the Dedmon Center Saturday...Presley notched her third career double-double with 14 points and 12 rebounds...8 of her 12 rebounds were off the offensive glass...RaeChaun Edwards led the Lady Camels with 16 points and added 4 assists with five steals, tying her season high...Edwards scored 13 points in a 20-9 CU run that spanned halftime to extend the Lady Camels' lead...Kiera Gaines tacked on 15 points with 8 rebounds...10 Lady Camels scored in the contest...Campbell hosts two contests in the Creek this week, welcoming Longwood Thursday at 7 p.m. and Liberty Saturday at 2 p.m. in CU's "Camels for a Cure" game.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went 1-2 this past week as the Buccaneers wrapped up the first half of the conference schedule and began their second trip through Big South play with games against Presbyterian, Gardner-Webb and UNC Asheville. The Bucs topped visiting Presbyterian on Tuesday night, 68-50, behind six three-pointers by **ERIN BRATCHER** as the senior guard became the fourth CSU player in school history to hit the 200 mark in career three-pointers made in the night. Against Gardner-Webb, the Buccaneers held the halftime lead against the Runnin' Bulldogs behind **ANICIA DOTSON**'s third double-double of the season (14 points-10 rebounds) and the game came down to the final minute before the Bucs fell just short to GWU, 55-51. Sunday afternoon's action saw UNC Asheville jump out to a quick lead and CSU was unable to overcome the deep hole in falling to the Bulldogs. The Buccaneers are back in action at home this week as CSU hosts Winthrop on Thursday night, before taking on Radford on Saturday afternoon in front of a national audience on ESPN3.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 1-1 on the week with a home victory over UNC Asheville (75-65) and a road loss at Winthrop (61-90) ... Coastal is 6-5 in Big South play after jumping out to a 4-0 start ... The Chants are 3-3 in road conference games ... Angelica Henry scored 32 points in the win over UNC Asheville, becoming the first Chanticleer to break the 30-point plateau since Lacey Lyons scored 30 against Howard on Nov. 26, 2006 ... Henry's 32 points also tied High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS** for the highest point output by a conference player this season ... Henry is one assist shy from entering the CCU career top-10 list; she already ranks in the top-10 in steals and free throws attempted and free throws made ... Henry and **AJ JORDAN** each recorded double-doubles against UNC Asheville, moving Coastal's season double-double count to 10 -- Coastal had six double-doubles all of last season ... As a team, Coastal is shooting 40.6% from the floor, including 34.0% from beyond the arc and 72.2% from the foul line ... The Chants welcome Radford to The HTC Center on Thursday and Longwood on Saturday.

GARDNER-WEBB

OLIVIA PARKER paced the Runnin' Bulldogs to a pair of wins over Charleston Southern and Presbyterian last week, averaging 18.5 points and 13 rebounds per game while recording two double-doubles ... Gardner-Webb has won two straight, keeping pace in a tie for fourth in the conference standings with Campbell ... The Runnin' Bulldogs are 9-1 in Paul Porter Arena this season and 3-6 on the road, with all three road wins coming in Big South play ... Senior center **CATRINA GREEN** has tallied 10 double-doubles this season and 32 in her career, just missing her 11th of the season on Saturday as she tallied 12 points and nine rebounds, while becoming the second player in GWU's NCAA I era to reach the 900-rebound plateau.

HIGH POINT

High Point is on a four-game win streak after beating Radford and Longwood this week ... The Panthers have won six of their last seven ... Three freshmen, Kaylah Keys, **TEDDY VINCENT** and **DEANNEISHA JACKSON** have carried the scoring load during the hot streak ... Freshman **KAYLAH KEYS** recorded her first career double-double with 12 points and 11 assists against Radford ... Her 11 assists are the fourth most in a single game in HPU's Div. I era ... Freshman **DEANNEISHA JACKSON** scored a career-high 15 points with nine rebounds against Radford and topped it with 18 points in the win at Longwood ... Keys is nearing in on the HPU freshman scoring mark of 385 points set by Charlena Martin in 2003-04 ... Keys already has 335 points this season ... High Point takes a four-game win streak to Liberty on Thursday ... The Flames currently sit in first place in the league with the Panthers one game behind ... HPU topped the Flames 75-70 on Dec. 30 at the Millis Center ... The Panthers have also won the last two meetings at the Vines Center ... High Point is the first Big South team to defeat Liberty at the Vines Center in back-to-back years since UNC Greensboro posted four straight wins at the Vines Center between 1993-94 and 1996-97 ... HPU has swept the season series with Liberty once before in 2007.

LIBERTY

Liberty won its only game last week, posting a 74-41 home victory over Longwood to reclaim sole possession of first place in the Big South standings at 8-2 ... The Lady Flames have still not lost back-to-back Big South games since Feb. 20 and 22, 1997 ... Liberty has now posted 10 straight wins over Longwood and six consecutive home victories ... The Lady Flames matched a season high with 10 three-pointers against Longwood and fell just two shy of the program single-game record of 12 triples ... LONGWOOD

Through 20 games, sophomore **DAEISHA BROWN** paces the team with 15.9 points per game. As a team, Longwood is shooting 34.1% (400-1174) from the floor, including 26.2% (116-443) from beyond the arc, and 67.3% (216-321) from the foul line. Longwood will take to the road for a pair of league games this week beginning at Campbell on Thursday, Jan. 30. Tipoff is scheduled for 7 p.m.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Presbyterian College women's basketball team dropped both of its games last week, falling to Charleston Southern on Tuesday, 68-50, before coming up short at Gardner-Webb on Saturday, 59-56... The Blue Hose have dropped seven games by five points or fewer this season... **KEYONNA ALLEN** posted her second career double-double on Tuesday with 10 points and 10 rebounds and nearly got her third on Saturday with 10 rebounds and nine points... PC erased an 11-point second half deficit against Gardner-Webb but the Runnin' Bulldogs took their final lead in the final minutes... **KARLEE TAYLOR** has scored in double-digits in 10 straight games and 12 out of the last 13... The Blue Hose host UNC Asheville on Thursday and Winthrop on Saturday afternoon.

RADFORD

Despite a stellar week by junior guard **AYANA AVERY**, the Highlanders were unable to pick up wins at High Point (62-73) and vs. Campbell (61-75)... Avery, who leads the Big South with her 66 3-pointers, knocked down 15 in her two games this week. The Cleveland, N.C. native connected on 7-of-7 from 3-point land in the second half against the Panthers on her way to a program single-game record eight. Avery finished with a career-high 26 points. As a team, Radford dialed up 10 of their 14 3-point attempts, which is an eye-popping 71.4 percent. Against Campbell, Avery added seven treys en route to a game-high 21 points...
