Avery averaged 18.5 points per game and shot 65 percent from the field to lead the Highlanders to a 2-0 record last week. She got her week started with 19 points on 64 percent from the floor and a perfect 4-of-4 from downtown in the win at Coastal Carolina on Jan. 30. She also added eight rebounds, a block and a steal in the victory. Two days later in the win at Charleston Southern, the guard stayed hot with 18 points as she connected on 67 percent from the floor, 4-of-6 from long range and 2-of-2 at the line, to go along with four rebounds, one assist, one block and a steal. The wins marked the first time since 2007 that Radford swept the "Beach Series."

With 28 seconds left in the first overtime, Keys hit a huge shot as she stepped back and buried a contested trey to send the game into a second overtime. Keys chipped in two rebounds, two assists and a steal in the contest and scored nine points in the overtime periods. The honor is her fifth Big South Freshman of the Week plaudit this season.

FANNING THE FLAMES -- LIBERTY TABBED PRESEASON FAVORITE

Fort the 16th time in the last 17 years, Liberty is the preseason women's basketball favorite for the 2013-14 season. The Lady Flames received 13 of the 25 first-place votes and 261 out of a possible 275 points. Liberty will have two starters and nine letterwinners back from last year's Big South championship and NCAA Tournament squad. Winthrop was voted second with 256 points and 11 first-place bids. Campbell was picked third with 206 points.

McCLANAHAN VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Winthrop senior **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** is the 2013-14 Big South Women's Hoops Preseason Player of the Year. McClanahan is the reigning two-time Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She is looking to become the first player with three consecutive Player of the Year Awards since Liberty's Katie Feenstra from 2003-05. McClanahan led the League in scoring for the second-straight year in 2012-13 with 19.8 points per game and was also tops with 5.8 assists per game.

PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH

Joining McClanahan on the Preseason All-Big South Team is Campbell's **KIERA GAINES**, High Point's **STACIA ROBERTSON**, Longwood's **DAEISHA BROWN** and Liberty's **EMILY FRAZIER**. Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** and **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** from Winthrop rounded out the Preseason All-Conference Team.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has two new coaches on the sideline this season. **JAIDA WILLIAMS** is the new skipper at Coastal Carolina, while **MIKE McGUIRE** took over at Radford.

THRICE AS NICE

For the second-straight year and third time in the last four years, three Big South women's squads received berths in the NCAA postseason., tying the League record. Liberty was the League's representative in the NCAA Tournament, while Winthrop captured the Big South's automatic bid to the WNIT. Presbyterian College, in its first year of full Division I status and postseason eligibility, accepted an at-large invitation to the WBI.

TRIPLE CROWN

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan will attempt to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the Conference in scoring in three consecutive seasons., as Liberty's Elena Kisseleva is the only player to win three Big South scoring titles. Meanwhile, McClanahan will look to become the first player to ever lead the League in assists three-straight years in 2013-14.

MAGIC WAND-A

With Campbell's win over Western Carolina earlier this season, **WANDA WATKINS** picked up her 500th career win. She is currently the 27th active coach to reach the milestone, while being one of six that have been at the same institution for at least 33 years.

EAGLES, EAGLES, EAGLES!!!

Winthrop defeated Florida Gulf Coast, 65-61, in the first round of the WNIT last March, marking the Big South's first women's basketball postseason win since 2005. It was Winthrop's first postseason win in women's basketball since becoming a Division I member in 1986, and it is also the Big South's third-ever victory in the WNIT.

THE COUNT DOWN BEGINS

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** is currently for No. 2 all time with 2066 points. She is currently on pace to take over the top spot held by Elena Kisseleva of Liberty who finished her career with 2,154 points.

GREEN MACHINE

CATRINA GREEN of Gardenr-Webb currently the Big South's active leading rebounder with 869 career boards. She is currently No. 13 all-time in the Big South. Meanwhile, Green is became the 12th member of the Big South's 1,000 points, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shots club over the Christmas break. She currently has 1091 (No. 68 all-time) points and 140 rejections.

MILLIS CENTER NORTH - TIED 12 YEAR OLD RECORD

With High Point's 94-89 2OT win at Liberty on Jan. 30 inside the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win three-straight road games at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1994, 1995 and 1996 seasons.

IN RANGE WHEN SHE ENTERS THE GYM - 1,000 POINTS FOR CAREER

Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** ranks fourth all time in the Big South Conference in career three-pointers. She currently has 236 for her career. Taylor made 85 treys last season (7th most in League history). She also scored her 1,000th career point on Jan. 18. She is currently tied for No. 78 in the League with 1,046 points.

BROKE THE STREAK

With its win over Charleston Southern on Dec. 2, UNC Asheville snapped a 29-game conference losing streak that dated back to the 2011-12 season. The win marked head coach **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK**'s first career Big South win.

BROKE THE STREAK (PART TWO)

UNC Asheville broke another streak this season that dated back to the 2006-07 season. On Jan. 18, the Bulldogs knocked off Liberty 80-83 in OT to snap a 16-game losing streak to the Lady Flames. The win also marked the first time Asheville had defeated Liberty in Asheville since the 1996-97 season.

HOT STARTS

Winthrop and Coastal Carolina began the Conference in record-breaking fashion. Coastal Carolina's and Winthrop's 4-0 starts to the League slates marked its best runs in school history.

DIAPER DANDIES

Two Big South players have earned a combined 10-of-12 Big South Freshman of the Week nods this season. High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS** has earned the honor five times this season, while **ERICA WILLIAMS** of Winthrop has received the nod five times. Keys has eight 20-point games this season, including 32 points against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 18, and is averaging 17.2 points per game. Williams is posting 15.4 points per outing, to go along with a five of 20-point outings.

KEY(S)FENSE

High Point freshman standout Keys has been HPU's go-to player for offense during the Conference season. She is currently ranked No. 1 among all Big South players with an average of 20.7 points per game in Conference-only contests.

JUMP AROUND

The Liberty Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the nation. The Lady Flames currently rank No. 1 in the nation as they are averaging a +15.4 rebound margin.

WOMAN OF STEAL

Charleston Southern's **DJ FOWLER** has been creating havoc for opponents of the defensive side of the ball this season. She is currently ranked No. 3 in Division I with 3.29 steals per game.

DOYEN HER THING

Radford's **AYANA AVERY** leads the Big South Conference with 74 triples on the season... She is currently ranked No. 4 in Division I with 3.33 three-pointers per game. She tops the Radford roster and is ranked No. 2 in the League with 17.2 ppg in Conference-only contests.

The Panthers swept the season series from Liberty, becoming just the third Big South team to do so in the last 15 seasons ... High Point also swept the Flames in 2006-07 and Gardner-Webb swept LU in 2009-10 ... High Point has beat Liberty at the Vines Center in each of the last three seasons The last conference team to win at the Vines Center in three seasons was UNC Greensboro between 1993-94 and 1996-97 ... High Point's 94 points were the most ever by a visiting team at the Vines Center and were the most scored by a Liberty opponent since Dec. 20, 2001 ... That day, Duke recorded a 95-53 victory over the Lady Flames at Cameron Indoor Stadium ... The Panthers have now won five in a row on the season.

LIBERTY

Liberty lost overtime games to High Point and Campbell last week, dropping back-to-back Big South contests for the first time since Feb. 20 and 22, 1997 ... The Lady Flames have now played four overtime games in their last five outings, and have set a new program record for most overtime tilts in a season (4), eclipsing the previous standard of three ... Liberty trailed by double digits in both of last week's games before forcing overtime ... The Lady Flames have also won twice this season after falling behind by double digits ... Liberty's 89 points against High Point equaled the most points the Lady Flames have ever scored in a loss ... On Thursday, Liberty will aim for its 42nd straight win in its head-to-head series with Coastal Carolina ... Additionally, **CAREY GREEN** will aim for his 350th career coaching victory against his alma mater (Coastal Carolina) ... Liberty is 97-9 all-time in February games under Green ... Freshman **MICKAYLA SANDERS** has made three or more triples in each of her last four appearances, including a game-tying three-pointer with 0.6 seconds left in regulation against High Point and four triples as part of a career-high 19-point effort at Campbell.
