Peterson averaged 31.0 points, 10.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists in leading the Keydets to two victories last week. He opened his week with 37 points and a career-high 15 rebounds at UNC Asheville, in addition to four assists and two steals. Peterson then scored 25 points, including 7 three-pointers, and grabbed five boards in the Keydets' victory over Presbyterian College. For the week, Peterson was 22-of-41 from the field (=53.7 percent), 10-of-16 from three-point range (=62.5) and 8-of-10 from the charity stripe (=80.0).

Rowsey averaged 33.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.5 steals in two games last week. He tied his career-high with 35 points against VMI, then scored 32 points with a personal-best seven rebounds in the Bulldogs' one-point victory at Longwood. Rowsey is the first player in Asheville's Division I history with back-to-back 30-point games. He also tied the school record with 8 three-point field goals against the Lancers. For the week, Rowsey was 20-of-37 from the floor (=54.1), 12-of-21 from beyond the arc (=57.1) and a perfect 15-of-15 from the free throw line.

HALFWAY HOME

At the halfway point of the Big South season, Coastal Carolina leads the South Division at 6-2, while a three-way tie for first-place exists in the North Division between Campbell, VMI and High Point at 5-3. The Chanticleers have won their last four League games -- the longest Conference winning streak this season. High Point's current streak of three-straight Big South wins is the second-longest. Last season at the halfway point, Campbell, VMI and High Point all shared the North Division lead at 5-3, while Charleston Southern was the South Division leader at 7-1.

A GAME OF MARGINS

With 48 of the 96 Conference games in the books, the visiting teams are 23-25 for a 47.9 winning percentage -- the first time over 45.0 since 2008-09 when visiting squads finished with a 46.7 winning mark (42-48). Thus far, 31 games have been decided by less than 10 points (4.29 average), while the remaining 17 contests have had double-digit victory margins (16.06). Through 48 Conference games, the average margin of victory in the League season is 8.46 points. Last season, the home teams went 61-35 (=63.5 percent) during the Big South schedule, while the average margin of victory in the Conference season was 10.72 points.

CROSSOVER DRIBBLE

Crossover divisional Conference games continues in the Big South through Feb. 13. At the halfway point, the divisions are 9-9 against each other -- the same record at the same point in 2012-13. The South Division "won" the first season of the Big South's crossover divisional match-ups in men's basketball last season, as the South teams finished 22-14 (=61.1 percent) against the North Division. Here is a look at each team's crossover record in Big South games this year, in current standings order:

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this week with the Campbell at Winthrop game on Saturday, Feb. 8 live at 4:00pm. **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **RALPH PATTERSON** (analyst) will call the action from the Winthrop Coliseum in Rock Hill, S.C. For the second consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry eight Big South match-ups, as well as all four quarterfinal games of the 2014 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Men's Basketball Championship for the first time.

ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH -- SECOND "WILDCARD" BROADCAST IS FEB. 13

ESPNU's second of three Big South "Wildcard" TV broadcast selections is UNC Asheville at Radford on Thursday, Feb. 13 at 7:00pm (game moved from Feb. 12). For the first time in League history, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2013-14. Included in the package are three "Wildcard" selections, and the final "Wildcard" game is Friday, Feb. 28 at 7:00pm. ESPNU will make its selection for that contest later this week.

20/20 TIMES 12

All 12 Big South members have had at least one game with two 20-point scorers, as Gardner-Webb was the final team to achieve the feat this past Saturday at Radford. It is the first time since 2008-09 that every Big South basketball member has had two 20-point scorers in a game. VMI has had at least two 20-point scorers in a game a League-high 7 times this season, with **RODNEY GLASGOW** and **OJ PETERSON** involved in six of those efforts. The Keydets are also 5-1 when Glasgow and Peterson score 20 points in the same contest (3-0 in Big South games).

BIG SOUTH FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORING COMBINATIONS

Since the Big South's first official men's basketball season in 1985-86, a total of 18 four-year classmate combinations have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period, with four pair reaching the mark as juniors -- including two this year in Charleston Southern junior tandem **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER**, and Radford junior duo **JAVONTE GREEN** and **R.J. SPEAKING OF FOUR-YEAR SCORING COMBOS

VMI seniors **RODNEY GLASGOW** (1,182) and **D.J. COVINGTON** (1,152) are among the 18 four-year classmate combinations that have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period. They are the 11th-highest scoring four-year classmate duo with 2,334 points, and 77 points away from moving into the Top 10. Coastal Carolina's **BRAD PENNY** and **ROBERT DOWDELL** are 10th with a combined scoring total of 2,410 points as teammates from 1987-91.

BACK IN FAMILIAR TERRITORY

VMI leads the Big South and the nation in scoring with 89.8 points per game, its highest average since 2008-09 when the Keydets scored a League- and NCAA-leading 93.8 a contest. VMI, which has led the Big South in scoring six out of the last seven years -- including last season, is second all-time for most times leading the Conference in scoring offense at six. Radford owns that record with nine times.

DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern is averaging 84.1 points this season, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest. Meanwhile, CSU and VMI could mark just the second time in League history that at least two teams averaged 80.0 points in the same year. The first (and only) time was in 1992-93 when three squads averaged 80.0 points -- Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3).

30 FOR 30

Against UNC Asheville on Jan. 28, VMI guards **QJ PETERSON** (37) and **RODNEY GLASGOW** (35) became the first Big South teammates to score 30 points in the same game since VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (43) and **CHAVIS HOLMES** (30) did it against Newport News Apprentice on Dec. 10, 2007. Peterson and Glasgow were the first pair to achieve the feat in a Big South game since the 2006-07 campaign, when Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** (30) and **DWIGHT BREWINGTON** (30) reached the total against VMI on Jan. 27, 2007.

WHAT IS YOUR Q SCORE?

VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** leads the Big South with 21.1 points per game, and is looking to become the first freshman ever to lead the Big South in scoring, as well as the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game. The first (and only) was Liberty's **SETH CURRY** in 2008-09 (20.2). Peterson is almost the highest scoring freshman in the nation.

BUILDING A WINNER

Radford's 14 victories this season exceed its win total from all of last year, and the team needs just three more wins to secure its first winning campaign since going 19-12 in 2009-10. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina is one victory shy of matching its win total for 2012-13 (14), and Campbell is two wins away from equalling its win output for last season (13).

TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern is second in the nation with a League-leading 10.81 three-pointers per game this season, and is looking to become the first Big South team other than VMI to average at least 10 triples a game in a single-season. CSU's average of 10.81 threes is the highest in the Big South since VMI averaged 11.32 in 2010-11. The Buccaneers' current per game tally would be sixth-highest in the League record book.

RAISE YOUR GLASS FOR RODNEY

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW**, who became the 23rd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 11 against Liberty, is currently 17th all-time with 434 and needs 13 more dimes to move into 16th-place. The first Keydet to join the Big South's 400-assist club, Glasgow eclipsed 1,000 career points Jan. 8 against Longwood and is now one of 19 players in League history with 1,000 career points (1,182) and 400 career assists (434).

BIG SOUTH FRESHMEN FIVE FAB?

Five freshmen players are among the Big South's top 20 scorers -- including three in the top 10. As previously mentioned, VMI frosh **QJ PETERSON** is the League's leader with 21.1 points. UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is sixth at 18.5 points, while Coastal Carolina's **ELIJAH WILSON** is ninth at 15.8 markers per game. Presbyterian College's **REGGIE DILLARD** is 19th at 12.43, with Winthrop freshman **KEON JOHNSON** in 20th at 12.35.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** became the 43rd player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the milestone Jan. 18 against Longwood. He is currently 38th all-time with 645 and 16 away from jumping into 35th-place. Meanwhile, Green is now one of 31 players in the Conference record books with 1,000 career points (1,162) and 600 boards. He is the 10th Highlander on the Big South's 1,000/600 list and first since **ART PARAKHOUSKI** and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** in 2009-10.

NO KNOCK ON WOOD

Longwood sophomore **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** leads the League with 7.43 assists per game and has a League-high seven games with at least 10 helpers -- the most in the Big South since Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** had eight in 2011-12. Just nine dimes away from matching his Big South freshman-record total of 180 last season, Woodhouse's per game average is currently the third-highest single-season clip in League history. The last player to average at least 7.0 assists in a season was Sanders in 2011-12 (7.97).

D.J.'s BLOCK PARTY - PART 1

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** leads the Big South and is fourth in the nation with 3.71 blocked shots per game -- currently the third-highest single-season average in League history. Cunningham has recorded 46 of his 63 blocks this season in his last 10 games (4.60 average) to increase his career total to 243 -- fourth all-time in the League record books. He is 12 rejections away from tying **JOHN WILLIAMS** for third-place at 255, which is also Asheville's school record. Now 18th all-time in League history with 722 career rebounds, Cunningham is just the second player in League annals with 700 rebounds and 200 blocked shots. Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS** was the first with 718 rebounds and 215 rejections from 1989-94.

D.J.'s BLOCK PARTY - PART 2

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON**, who is fifth in Big South history with 226 career blocked shots, is five rebounds away from becoming the 44th player with 600 career boards. Meanwhile, Covington is the fourth player in League history with 1,000 career points (1,152), 500 career rebounds (595) and 200 career blocked shots (226). He has blocked a shot in 49 of his last 52 appearances, and since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (52 games), he has recorded 153 of his 226 career blocks in that span (=67.7 percent) for an average of 2.94 per contest.

DOUBLE DRIBBLES

UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is the League's active leader for consecutive double-figure scoring games at 18. Coastal Carolina's **JOSH CAMERON** is second to Rowsey at 16 games, followed by VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** at 14.

WATCH YOUR P'S AND Q'S

In addition to leading the Conference in scoring, VMI freshman **OJ PETERSON** is pacing the League in steals with 2.14 per game, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the League in steals per game. The last player to lead the Big South in scoring *AND* steals was VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** in 2008-09 (22.0 ppg, 3.39 spg).

BURRUS' BOARDS AND BLOCKS

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS** is the 14th member of the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shot club. Burrus has scored 1,026 points, and is tied for 57th in League history with 566 rebounds while ranking 25th all-time with 119 blocked shots. He joins Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 1,715 points, 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97, as the only Flames on the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shot list.

THE PRICE IS RIGHT

Radford junior guard **R.J. PRICE** is 10 three-pointers away from becoming the 32nd player in Big South history with 200 career treys. Price has buried a three-pointer in 73 of his 84 career games, including a career-best streak of 26 consecutive games during the 2012-13 campaign. He has also made at least three 3-pointers in a game 36 times -- including eight times this year.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,514 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. John Caleb is at 1,279 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11 and surpassed Jesse's total of 1,235 from 2008-12 on Jan. 18. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

IT'S ACADEMIC

Coastal Carolina sophomore **MICHEL ENANGA** was named to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District Team last week, and now moves onto the national ballot for Academic All-America honors. Enanga's selection marks the third-straight year and eight out of the last nine years a Big South men's basketball player has earned Academic All-District honors. He is the first Chanticleer with this distinction since **SAM McLAURIN** in 2011-12.

IN WILLIAM WE TRUSS

Presbyterian College's **WILLIAM TRUSS** tied a Big South single-game record with his perfect 10-of-10 field goal performance against High Point on Jan. 28. He is the sixth player in League history to post 100.0 percent from the field with at least 10 field goals, and the first since Radford's **TOM GALLAHER** (10-of-10) against UMBC on Feb. 10, 1993. Truss is just third to achieve the feat in a Conference game.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Liberty's **ANTWAN BURRUS** became the eighth player this season to reach 1,000 career points when he eclipsed the milestone Jan. 25 against Presbyterian. Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' 2012-13 season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. LONGWOOD SCORES BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG 12 WIN IN 15 SEASONS

Longwood's 82-79 win at TCU on Nov. 12 was the Big South's first win over a member of the Big 12 Conference since the 1999-00 season. That year, Winthrop defeated Missouri, 51-46.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

With the Big South having 12 men's basketball members and divisional play, the Conference has a 16-game League schedule this season. Each team will play its divisional opponents twice (a 10-game round-robin schedule), and one game against each crossover division opponent (six games total -- three home and three road).

The Conference's tiebreaker for the divisional format, which will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship Tournament, is as follows:

TOURNAMENT SEEDING

The top two teams with the best overall Conference won-loss percentage in both the North and South Divisions shall receive the top four seeds in the Conference Championship Tournament. **Other seeds shall be based on division finish.** In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed will be determined within each division as noted below.

TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

(A) If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;

(B) If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie;

(C) If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;

(D) If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(E) In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;

(F) If the teams are still tied, the teams' records against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie would be considered, and so forth until the tie is broken;

(G) If there is still a tie, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(H) For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie, and;

(I) For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

(J) If the process reduces the number of tied teams, the remaining tie will be broken by starting the tiebreaking process over.

NORTH DIVISION

CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

Campbell set a Gore Arena (capacity 3,095) attendance record when 3,220 fans and a national TV audience on ESPNU witnessed CU's game vs. Coastal Carolina Saturday. The old record was set in November 2009 when 3,205 were in attendance when Campbell hosted Virginia Tech ... Saturday's contest was also the first nationally-televised home game for the Camel program ... Seven of Campbell's eight Big South games have been decided by 8 points-or-less ... **ANDREW RYAN** (102 in 88 games) needs 8 more 3-point field goals to move into 10th place in school history ... Campbell blocked a season-high 10 shots vs. Charleston Southern, one shy of the arena record vs. N.C. A&T in 2011 ... **LUKE MOYER** scored a career-high 13 points (4-5 threes) vs. CSU ... **DARIUS LEONARD** made a career-high 5 threes and finished with 16 points vs. Coastal Carolina ... With 5 victories in his first eight Conference games, **KEVIN MCGEEHAN** is off to the most successful League start of any Campbell coach at the Division I level.

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

High Point put on one of its best three-point shooting performances in the team's Division I history at Presbyterian. In Div. I annals, the team's 14 total three-pointers and the 63.6 (14-for-22) three-point percentage both rank No. 3 in a single game. **DEVANTE WALLACE** went 8-for-9 from three-point range at PC, the second-most in a game while his 88.9 three-point percentage ranks third ... Freshman point guard **JORGE PEREZ-LAHAM** had 12 assists with no turnovers against Presbyterian, the second-most in a game behind **MIKE JEFFERSON**'s 15 on Dec. 14, 2007. Perez-Laham had the most assists without a turnover in HPU history ... High Point has won three games in a row and five of its last six games. It's HPU's first three-game winning streak of the season and the best stretch since winning seven games in a row last year ... High Point had its largest crowd of the season on Saturday vs. Winthrop -- 1,780 -- with the addition of standing-room-only guests to the 1,750-seat Millis Center.

LIBERTY FLAMES

Liberty dropped to 3-5 in Conference play with losses to Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern ... Against the Chanticleers, **ANTWAN BURRUS** paced the Flames with 15 points, followed by **ANDREW SMITH** (11), **TOMASZ GIELO** (10) and **DAVON MARSHALL** (10). The loss snapped Liberty's four-game win streak inside The HTC Center ... At Charleston Southern, Marshall and Smith paced Liberty with 15 points apiece, followed by **JOHN CALEB SANDERS**, who had 11 points. Smith also added a career-high 13 rebounds ... Liberty lost the rebounding battle against CSU, the first time since its Conference opener versus Radford (Jan. 8).

LONGWOOD LANCERS

TRISTAN CAREY scored a game-high 26 points against Gardner-Webb, making 5-10 three-point field goals, while adding a game-high three steals. **JEYLANI DUBLIN** had 16 points, making 8-11 field goals in 20 minutes of action, adding four rebounds ... Carey led the Lancers against UNC Asheville with his game-high 33 points, including 25 (6-8 3FGs) in the second half, making 7-13 three-pointers overall, while adding a game-high eight rebounds in front of the largest home crowd this season of a near-capacity 1,757 ... Carey has three 30-point games among his 13 20-point efforts this season -- including 96 points (32.0) in his last three games. He is now 8th in school history with 1,357 career points, while his 213 career three-pointers rank 2nd all-time ... **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** now totals 351 career assists to rank fifth all-time in school history.

RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Radford's 76-64 win at Winthrop Jan. 29 was the 600th victory in RU's 40-year basketball history ... **JALEN CARETHERS** scored a career-high 16 points against Gardner-Webb, with six rebounds and three blocked shots against the Runnin' Bulldogs ... **R.J. PRICE** grabbed a career-high seven rebounds against GWU ... The starting lineup of Price, **YA YA ANDERSON**, **KYLE NOREEN**, **JAVONTE GREEN**, and **BRANDON HOLCOMB** has started together 26 times overall (15-11 record) and 21 times this season (13-8).

VMI KEYDETS

In two games last week, **QJ PETERSON** averaged 31 points, 10.0 rebounds, and 3.0 assists, while **RODNEY GLASGOW** averaged 30.5 points and 8.5 assists ... VMI matched its season-low in turnovers with four against Presbyterian Jan. 31. The Keydets had four turnovers twice earlier this season ... VMI's block party continues as the Keydets rejected 16 shots in two games last week and have 22 blocks over their last four games. The 10 blocks against Asheville was the fourth double-digit block game this year for VMI ... The Keydets shot 49% (26 of 53) from 3-point range in two games last week, and posted double-digit 3's in back-to-back games for the first time since Dec. 19 and the first time this season against consecutive Division I foes.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

CSU snapped a two-game losing streak with a resounding 80-66 win over Liberty on Saturday. The Bucs snapped a four-game homecourt losing streak to the Flames in the process as they sprinted to leads of 29-9 and 40-17 before leading by as many as 27 in the second half ... CSU held Liberty to 33.8 percent from the field -- the lowest of any Division I opponent the Bucs have played this season ... **SHELDON STRICKLAND** tallied a career-high 35 points against the Flames on a 13-of-18 effort from the field and a 7-of-11 clip from three-point range. Strickland's previous career-high was 27 as a freshman in 2010 against College of Charleston ... Even after being outscored against Campbell last week, Charleston Southern's bench continues to score at an excellent rate. For the season, CSU's bench has out-scored the opponent's bench, 747-392.

COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

Coastal went 2-0 last week with a 66-64 victory at home over Liberty that snapped the Flames' unbeaten streak inside The HTC Center, and a 61-58 road victory over Campbell, which ended the Camels' Conference home unbeaten streak ... CCU now has four Big South road victories, which is two more than the entire 2012-13 season ... **WARREN GILLIS** led the Chants as he averaged 18.0 points per game on the week. He scored a team-high 18 points in each of the wins. He was nearly perfect at the free throw line (12-13), and dished out a team-high seven assists ... The Chants host a pair of home games this week against High Point and Longwood. CCU is 18-14 all-time against High Point, including 10-5 at home. The Chants are 1-1 all-time against Longwood and have never played the Lancers in Conway.

GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb got a career-best 25 points in the Radford win from **TYLER STRANGE**. He made a career-best six 3-point baskets, and finished the week by going 8-of-14 from long distance (57.1 percent). Strange was 9-of-14 from the floor at Radford, and made a trey with 2.2 seconds left in regulation to tie the score and force overtime ... Gardner-Webb has won six consecutive Big South road games, dating back to last season, and eight of its last nine on the road in League play (4-0 in 2013-14) ... Gardner-Webb has as many wins against North Division foes (3) as it had in six tries last season (3-3) ... GWU made 11 of its first 14 field goals at Longwood, and did not dip below 60 percent shooting after the game's opening four minutes ... Gardner-Webb welcomes the League's most potent offensive team on Wednesday, as VMI invades Paul Porter Arena.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

If **JORDAN DOWNING**'s 19.0 ppg continues for the remainder of the season, he will eclipse the PC Division I record of 16.9 set in 2012 by **AL' LONZO COLEMAN**. Downing would also shatter the season total points record of 501 set by **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** last year, as he is 115 points away from that mark ... PC hosts Longwood for the first time in the history of both programs. The Blue Hose are 1-0 over the Lancers, having earned the 82-71 win in Farmville, Va., last season.

UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

The Bulldogs won their third Big South road game of the year with an exciting 67-66 victory at Longwood Saturday afternoon. **SAM HUGHES** hit the winning free throws with 17.7 seconds left ... **ANDREW ROWSEY** tied his career high in points with 35 in a 109-105 loss to VMI on Tuesday night. **JARON LANE** set a career-high in points (27) and rebounds (15) against the Keydets. Lane moved into 27th place on Asheville's career points list as he now has 1,081 ... **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** became the school's all-time Division I leader in rebounds and now has 722 rebounds. He has blocked 13 shots in the last two games, and has recorded at least five blocks in a game seven times this season ... The Bulldogs are home twice this week as they'll host Campbell on Wednesday and Liberty on Saturday.

WINTHROP EAGLES

Winthrop went 0-2 last week with losses at home to Radford and on the road at High Point. He now ranks third all-time for threes in a season by a freshman as he approaches the freshman mark of 52 set by **TYSON WATERMAN** in 1995-96. His scoring average of 12.4 is second to Waterman's 12.5 average as a freshman ... Winthrop's game with Barber Scotia, which was postponed on Jan. 4, has been rescheduled for this Thursday, Feb. 6 at 4 p.m.
