Robertson averaged 21 points and 11.5 rebounds per game to lead the Panthers to a pair of Big South wins last week. She highlighted her week with 28 points on 79 percent shooting in the win over Coastal Carolina on Feb. 8. She also added nine rebounds, three assists, two blocks and two steals against the Chanticleers. On Feb. 6 against Campbell, the forward posted a 14-point, 14-rebound double-double in the victory over the Camels. She shot 50 percent from the floor and 80 percent from the line to go along with two assists, two blocks and two steals. The honor is her first Big South Player of the Week plaudit this season.

She got her week started with a double-double as she notched 10 points and 11 rebounds, as well as three assists, two blocks and a steal in the win over Gardner-Webb on Feb. 6. Two days later against UNC Asheville, Williams put in 19 points on 58 percent from the floor and 83 percent from the line. She also chipped in eight boards, one assist, one block and one steal in the win over the Bulldogs. The honor marks her sixth Big South Freshman of the Week nod this season.

FANNING THE FLAMES -- LIBERTY TABBED PRESEASON FAVORITE

Fort the 16th time in the last 17 years, Liberty is the preseason women's basketball favorite for the 2013-14 season. The Lady Flames received 13 of the 25 first-place votes and 261 out of a possible 275 points. Liberty will have two starters and nine letterwinners back from last year's Big South championship and NCAA Tournament squad. Winthrop was voted second with 256 points and 11 first-place bids. Campbell was picked third with 206 points.

MCCLANAHAN VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Winthrop senior **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** is the 2013-14 Big South Women's Hoops Preseason Player of the Year. McClanahan is the reigning two-time Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She is looking to become the first player with three consecutive Player of the Year Awards since Liberty's Katie Feenstra from 2003-05. McClanahan led the League in scoring for the second-straight year in 2012-13 with 19.8 points per game and was also tops with 5.8 assists per game.

PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH

Joining McClanahan on the Preseason All-Big South Team is Campbell's **KIERA GAINES**, High Point's **STACIA ROBERTSON**, Longwood's **DAEISHA BROWN** and Liberty's **EMILY FRAZIER**. Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** and **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** from Winthrop rounded out the Preseason All-Conference Team.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has two new coaches on the sideline this season. **JAIDA WILLIAMS** is the new skipper at Coastal Carolina, while **MIKE MCGUIRE** took over at Radford.

THRICE AS NICE

For the second-straight year and third time in the last four years, three Big South women's squads received berths in the NCAA postseason., tying the League record. Liberty was the League's representative in the NCAA Tournament, while Winthrop captured the Big South's automatic bid to the WNIT. Presbyterian College, in its first year of full Division I status and postseason eligibility, accepted an at-large invitation to the WBI.

TRIPLE CROWN

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan will attempt to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the Conference in scoring in three consecutive seasons., as Liberty's Elena Kisseleva is the only player to win three Big South scoring titles. Meanwhile, McClanahan will look to become the first player to ever lead the League in assists three-straight years in 2013-14.

MAGIC WAND-A

With Campbell's win over Western Carolina earlier this season, **WANDA WATKINS** picked up her 500th career win. She is currently the 27th active coach to reach the milestone, while being one of six that have been at the same institution for at least 33 years.

EAGLES, EAGLES, EAGLES!!!

Winthrop defeated Florida Gulf Coast, 65-61, in the first round of the WNIT last March, marking the Big South's first women's basketball postseason win since 2005. It was Winthrop's first postseason win in women's basketball since becoming a Division I member in 1986, and it is also the Big South's third-ever victory in the WNIT.

THE COUNT DOWN BEGINS

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** is currently for No. 2 all time in the Big South with 2104 points. She is currently on pace to take over the top spot held by Elena Kisseleva of Liberty who finished her career with 2,154 points.

GREEN MACHINE

CATRINA GREEN of Gardenr-Webb currently the Big South's active leading rebounder with 891 career boards. She is currently No. 11 all-time in the Big South. Meanwhile, Green is became the 12th member of the Big South's 1,000 points, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shots club over the Christmas break. She currently has 1,125 (No. 65 all-time) points and 142 rejections.

MILLIS CENTER NORTH - TIED 12 YEAR OLD RECORD

With High Point's 94-89 2OT win at Liberty on Jan. 30 inside the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win three-straight road games at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1994, 1995 and 1996 seasons.

IN RANGE WHEN SHE ENTERS THE GYM - 1,000 POINTS FOR CAREER

Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** ranks No. 3 all time in the Big South Conference in career three-pointers. She currently has 244 for her career. Taylor made 85 treys last season (7th most in League history). She also scored her 1,000th career point on Jan. 18. She is currently tied for No. 74 in the League with 1,074 points.

BROKE THE STREAK

With its win over Charleston Southern on Dec. 2, UNC Asheville snapped a 29-game conference losing streak that dated back to the 2011-12 season. The win marked head coach **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK**'s first career Big South win.

BROKE THE STREAK (PART TWO)

UNC Asheville broke another streak this season that dated back to the 2006-07 season. On Jan. 18, the Bulldogs knocked off Liberty, 83-80 in OT to snap a 16-game losing streak to the Lady Flames. The win also marked the first time Asheville had defeated Liberty in Asheville since the 1996-97 season.

PHENOMENAL FORTIFICATION

The Presbyterian College Blue Hose have made it extremely hard for opponents to put up points this season. The Blue Hose are currently No. 3 in the nation as they are holding opponents to just 53.7 points per game.

DIAPER DANDIES

Two Big South players have earned a combined 11-of-13 Big South Freshman of the Week nods this season. Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** of Winthrop has received the nod six times, while High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS** has earned the honor five times this season. Keys has eight 20-point games this season, including 32 points against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 18, and is averaging 16.9 points per game. Williams is posting 15.3 points per outing, to go along with a five of 20-point outings.

HISTORY REPEATING ITSELF - DIAPER DANDIES CONT.

During the 2010-11 season High Point and Winthrop battled back and forth for Freshman of the Week. Former Panther Cheyenne Parker and current Eagle **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** combined for 13 of the 16 selections. Parker earned the honor a League-high seven times, while McClanahan picked up the honor six times. Williams and Keys have three more weeks to either tie or take over Parker's record. During that season, McClanahan edged out Parker for Freshman of the Year.

KEY(S)FENSE

High Point freshman standout Keys has been HPU's go-to player for offense during the Conference season. She is currently ranked No. 1 among all Big South players with an average of 19.7 points per game in Conference-only contests.

JUMP AROUND

The Liberty Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the nation. The Lady Flames currently rank No. 1 in the nation as they are averaging a +14.7 rebound margin... Gardner-Webb is also ranked in the top 25 as the Runnin' Bulldogs are 16th with a +8.9 rebound margin.

WOMAN OF STEAL

Charleston Southern's **DJ FOWLER** has been creating havoc for opponents of the defensive side of the ball this season. She is currently ranked No. 7 in Division I with 3.09 steals per game.

DOYEN HER THING

Radford's **AYANA AVERY** leads the Big South Conference with 79 triples on the season... She is currently ranked No. 5 in Division I with 3.30 three-pointers per game. She tops the Radford roster and is ranked No. 2 in the League with 16.9 ppg in Conference-only contests.

CAMPBELL

Campbell's five-game win streak was snapped Thursday by High Point at the Millis Center, 64-59. **RAECHAUN EDWARDS** led the Lady Camels with 15 points, 7 assists, and 4 steals. CU stole the ball 16 times, tying its season high. **KIERA GAINES** notched her tenth game in double-digit rebounds this season with 10. Campbell shot below its average from the floor, beyond the arc, and at the stripe. **ROSALYN PRESLEY** netted her 700th career point in the contest, as she scored 13 points and added 6 rebounds. Campbell started the first half on an 8-0 run over 3:28, with four Lady Camels scoring in the streak. CU was held without a field goal for over nine minutes in the first half, scoring six free throws in the dry spell. HPU used those minutes to go on a 17-6 run, taking a 23-20 lead. The Lady Camels will make a two-game trip to the South Carolina coast this week, taking on Coastal Carolina Feb. 13 and Charleston Southern Feb. 15.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went 0-2 on the week, falling on the road to both Longwood and Liberty as the Buccaneers fell to 8-16 overall on the season with the losses. Charleston Southern tied the game up midway through the second half, but Longwood used a late run in pulling away from the Buccaneers on Thursday night inside Willett Hall, 71-59. **ERIN BRATCHER** led the Bucs with 18 points in the game, while Jarvis had 14 points in the loss. Saturday's action saw a late Liberty run put the game out of reach as Charleston Southern fell in Big South conference play to the Flames on Saturday afternoon, 66-45. Charleston Southern narrowed the margin all the way back to within eight points following a pair of free throws by **ANICIA DOTSON** at the 13:35 mark, but the Flames responded with a 20-8 run in going ahead 60-40 in pulling away from the Buccaneers and handing CSU their second loss to Liberty on the season. Jarvis led the Bucs with 13 points and a team-high four steals in the game. CSU closes out their home schedule this weekend against High Point on Thursday, before taking on Campbell for Senior Day on Saturday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina lost both of its contests on the road, suffering defeats to Liberty (64-46) and High Point (81-73). The Chanticleers are now 7-8 in the Big South after starting off league play with a program-best 4-0 record. CCU's **AJ JORDAN** (15.5), Angelica Henry (14.5) and **ALEX PUCKETT** (12.0) each averaged double-figures on the week. Jordan equaled her career-high with 27 points in the defeat at High Point as she scored 15 in the first half and 12 in the second. Jordan leads the Big South with 165 made field goals. Henry posted 16 points, 11 rebounds and nine assists against High Point, finishing a single helper away from CCU's first-ever triple-double. CCU's 73 points against the Panther was the team's first time eclipsing the 70-point plateau since scoring 75 against UNC Asheville on Jan. 23. Coastal is now 8-3 overall and 5-1 in Big South games when scoring 70-plus points. Henry's nine assists at High Point moved her into seventh on the CCU all-time list with 282 for her career. Coastal hosts Campbell on Thursday at 7 p.m. in its only game of the week.

GARDNER-WEBB

Catrina Green posted a pair of double-doubles last week, her 11th and 12th of the season. The senior center reached a personal milestone in both games, moving into first on the program's Division I offensive rebounds list on Thursday, before jumping two spots to 14th on the school's all-time scoring list with a 21-point effort on Saturday. She needs just 69 rebounds to become the first player in GWU's NCAA I history to reach the 1,000-rebound plateau. Gardner-Webb hosts Longwood and Liberty this week in a pair of crucial Big South match ups. The Runnin' Bulldogs are 10-1 in Paul Porter Arena this season. Gardner-Webb has out rebounded its opponents by an average of 11 boards in its last five games.

HIGH POINT

The High Point University women's basketball team has won seven straight games after topping Campbell and Coastal Carolina this week. HPU and Campbell both had five-game win streaks heading in to Thursday's match-up. High Point topped CU 64-59 behind a double-double performance by **STACIA ROBERTSON**. HPU avenged an early season loss at Coastal Carolina by topping the Chanticleers 81-73 at the Millis Center on Saturday. Robertson had a career-high 28 points to go with nine rebounds, three assists, two blocks and two steals in the game. The performance moved Robertson in to No. 18 on HPU's Div. I scoring list with 609 career points. Junior **ASHANTE RICHARD** also posted a career-high 14 points and freshman Kaylah Keys added 13. Keys became HPU's all-time rookie scoring leader with 389 points this season. She passed **CHARLENA MARTIN** who had 385 points as a freshman in 2003-04. Keys has made her last 19 free-throw attempts and is shooting 83.3 percent from the charity stripe this season.

LIBERTY

Liberty went 2-0 last week, including its 42nd straight win over Coastal Carolina. That is the second-longest active winning streak against a single opponent in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Now 10-4 in Big South play, the Lady Flames have won 10 or more conference games in each of the last 15 seasons. **ASHLEY RINGER** notched a double-double (13 points, 10 rebounds) against Coastal Carolina, marking her 13th of the season. She is now tied with **MEGAN FRAZEE** (13 in 2006-07) for the most double-doubles in program history by a sophomore. Liberty leads the nation in rebound margin at +15.1 and has outrebounded 21 consecutive opponents. **CAREY GREEN** picked up career win No. 350 against Coastal Carolina and is now 34-0 all-time against his alma mater. Liberty is now 99-9 in February games under Green, including 2-1 this season. The Lady Flames will play road games at Presbyterian College and Gardner-Webb this week. Liberty's last three road contests (Winthrop, UNC Asheville and Campbell) have all gone to overtime. If Liberty wins both games this week, it will clinch its 18th straight winning season.

LONGWOOD

The Lancers snapped a six game skid with a 71-59 victory against Charleston Southern on Feb. 6 before falling, 66-61, against Presbyterian on Feb. 8. Through 24 games, sophomore **DAEISHA BROWN** paces the team with 15.9 points per game. Classmate **RAVEN WILLIAMS** has added to the offensive effort with 11.8 points per game, while sophomore Kyndal Skersick and redshirt-senior **HEATHER TOBECK** average 9.4 and 7.4 points, respectively. Sophomore **KHALILAH ALI** leads the Lancers on the glass with 6.3 rebounds per game, while Brown adds 5.1. As a team, Longwood is shooting 34.3% (481-1403) from the floor, including 27.1% (136-502) from beyond the arc, and 67.7% (275-406) from the foul line. Longwood will take its last road trip of the regular season this week, playing a pair of games in North Carolina. The team's first stop will be Gardner-Webb on Thursday, Feb. 13 for a 7 p.m. tilt.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Presbyterian College women's basketball team grabbed their first two road wins of the season and won two consecutive games for the first time this year by toppling Radford on Thursday (53-46) and besting Longwood on Saturday (66-61). The team's scoring defense continues to rank in the top five in the nation, allowing only 54.0 points per game. **KEYONNA ALLEN** posted her third career double-double on Saturday, scoring 16 points to go along with 12 rebounds. With six offensive rebounds against the Lancers, Allen set a new school Division I record with 70 in a season, passing Mariah Pietrowski's 2011-12 school record of 64. Sherece Smith dished out seven assists on Saturday, the 10th most in a PC Division I game. PC outrebounded the Lancers by a 40-13 margin, the fewest allowed in a PC Division I game as well. Freshman **KAYCIE REFFNER** hauled in nine rebounds on Thursday at Radford, a new career-high. PC completed the regular season sweep over Radford, its first-ever over the Highlanders. The Blue Hose play two of their final three home games this week, hosting Liberty on Thursday at 7 p.m. before welcoming High Point on Saturday in an ESPN3 PC hoops doubleheader.

RADFORD

Radford split its two games at home last week. After falling 53-46 to PC, the Highlanders rebounded for a 55-53 victory over Gardner-Webb. Against the Blue Hose, RU led by as many as 13, but was unable to hold on for its third win in a row. **RACHAEL ROSS'** layup with 18:59 to go in the game provided Radford with that 13-point margin, but PC was able to gradually chip away at its deficit. Trailing 35-25, the Blue Hose (6-17, 4-10 Big South) embarked on an 18-8 run to tie the contest at 43 with 6:40 showing on the clock. It was the first tie of the game. PC finally grabbed its first lead of the contest two minutes later and never surrendered it. Two days later, Radford found itself in a similar situation against the Runnin' Bulldogs. Up 14 just three minutes into the final frame, the Highlanders seemed to be in control of the contest. However, Gardner-Webb clamped down defensively, which allowed it to chip away at its deficit. **BRESHARA GORDON's** pull-up jumper in the lane with 6:15 to go was Radford's final made field goal of the game. At that point, RU's advantage was seven (51-44). Nearly two minutes later, **AISHA FOY**, who finished 8-for-9 at the charity stripe, converted her seventh and eighth free throws of the afternoon to push the Highlanders' advantage to 55-48. Gardner-Webb, which scored five straight points to make it a one-possession game with 1:32 showing on the clock, forced a turnover to regain control of the ball. On the Runnin' Bulldogs' ensuing play, Catrina Green was in great scoring position when she attempted the game-tying shot, but Ross delivered the biggest block of her career to deny Green the basket. RU missed a pair of free throws in the waning seconds, which gave Gardner-Webb two more chances to tie or take the lead. However, both were off the mark and rebounded by the Highlanders.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Against Winthrop the Bulldogs fell behind early but cut the deficit to 50-48 with 7:37 remaining. However, the Eagles were able to stifle the Asheville comeback en route to the 62-55 victory. **PAIGE LOVE** scored a team-high 16 points with **LEAH WORMACK** chipping in 10. With the victory WU wins the season series with the Bulldogs and have won six in a row over Asheville. Asheville is currently leading the Big South and is 18th in the nation in free throw percentage with a mark of 76.2 percent. The nine wins for Asheville are the most since the 2010-11 season, when the Bulldogs won 12 games. The 25-point victory for the Bulldogs over the Charleston Southern on Jan. 26 was the largest margin of victory for Asheville since the 2008-09 season, when the Bulldogs defeated Presbyterian 62-36 on Jan. 12, 2009. The Bulldogs will take on Radford on Thursday before hosting Longwood on Saturday afternoon. Asheville defeated the Lancers on Jan. 9, 69-65, and then won at Radford, 68-61, on Jan. 11.

WINTHROP

Winthrop moved up to No. 24 last week in the CollegeInsider.com Top 25 Mid-Major Poll. The Eagles have now won a season-high five straight games to improve to 18-6 overall and 12-3 in conference, maintaining first place by a half game over High Point in the standings. **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** continued her climb toward becoming the all-time leading scorer in Big South history. She now has 2,104 points and needs 51 more to break former Liberty standout Elena Kisseleva's record of 2,154. McClanahan also regained her lead in the Big South scoring race as she attempts to become the season scoring champion and assist leader for a third straight year. She is the first player in Big South history to have more than 2,000 points (2,104), 600 rebounds (603), 600 assists (693) and 250 steals (253). Sophomore center **SCHAUQUILLA NUNN** surpassed 500 career rebounds (510) and moved back into first place among the league's rebounding leaders at 10.8. She continues her hold on first place in blocked shots with 3.0 per game. She also recorded her 13th double-double of the season and fifth in the last six games with a 10-point, 11-rebound effort against Asheville. Freshman **ERICA WILLIAMS** had another strong week as she averaged 15 points, 9.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists. She collected her 7th double-double of the season this past week. Winthrop's defense has held opponents below 36 percent field goals shooting over the past five games, including two games below 30 percent.
