Matsumoto batted .545 (6-for-11) with a .545 on-base percentage, five runs scored and five stolen bases to help Charleston Southern to a 3-0-1 record. The freshman started her career with a triple, RBI and a run scored in the Buccaneers 5-1 victory over Maryland-Eastern Shore. She added another hit, a run and a stolen base in the 2-1 win against UNC-Wilmington. In CSU's second meeting of the weekend with UMES, Matsumoto recorded her first career multi-hit game (2-for-3) while adding three stolen bases and two runs. She followed that up with another 2-for-3 game at the plate with a run scored in a 5-5 tie against Elon.

Quolas pitched eight innings for the Chanticleers in two games against the College of Charleston last week. CAMPBELL

Campbell opened the season with a 2-2 record. The Camels two wins came against Valparaiso (3-0) and Seton Hall (11-2). The losses came at the hands of UMass Lowell (8-7) and IPFW (5-0) ... The leading hitters this weekend for Campbell were STEPHANIE JONES who hit for an average of .538, collecting seven hits in thirteen plate appearances, scoring five runs ... CU was led in the circle by COURTNEY ROBERTS who pitched a complete game shutout against Valparaiso, surrendering just 3 hits. Roberts' ERA over the two games she participated in was 2.72 and opponents batted .238 off of the right-hander.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers went 3-0-1 on the weekend, picking up a pair of wins over Maryland-Eastern Shore and a win over UNC Wilmington, while battling Elon to a 5-5 tie that was called due to nightfall in the first weekend of the CSU Softball Tournament ... HAYES HOLDSWORTH connected on a two-run home run in the season opener in support of LAUREN DARDEN's three shutout innings in relief as the Buccaneers rallied back to top the Hawks in the season opener, 5-1 ... The second game of the season saw freshman STEPHANIE BERGMANN with the big hit in support of CHEYENNE GANDARA, lacing a one-out double into the right centerfield gap to put the Bucs on top of UNCW by driving in LIZZY OLMSTEAD for the winning run in the eighth inning ... Game three saw a team pitching performance with CSU's staff recording 11 strikeouts, while JESSICA BROCK connected on a bases-loaded double to push CSU on top 7-1 ... In the weekend finale, with the Bucs trailing 5-0, Brock again had the big hit with a double in the bottom of the fifth to get the CSU offense on track against Elon. However, the game was called due to darkness ... The Bucs are back in action again this weekend at the CSU Softball Tournament, hosting St. Bonaventure, Jacksonville State and Maine.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal started the 2014 season with two non-seven inning victories against College of Charleston over the weekend, rolling to a 9-1 six-inning win in the opener before rallying to win 3-2 in eight innings ... KORY HAYDEN hit two HRs in Saturday's win, giving her 32 for her career. She moved into third place on CCU's all-time list ... KI-ANA QUOLAS recorded two wins in the circle and now has the third most victories in program history with 48 ... The Chanticleers won their season opener for the fifth straight year, but began 2-0 for just the third time in 12 seasons ... Coastal hosts the first of its four home tournaments this week, welcoming Syracuse, Towson, Purdue and La Salle.

GARDNER-WEBB

GWU split their season-opening doubleheader with Charlotte on Saturday, winning game two, 6-3 ... Freshman MEGAN CHAMPION launched a clinching two-run home run in the sixth inning for her first collegiate long ball ... Senior SAMANTHA MEENAGHAN went 6-for-8 in the twinbill, driving in one and stealing three bases.

LIBERTY

Liberty softball opened the DOT RICHARDSON Era this past weekend at the FGCU/Four Points by Sheraton Invitational. Playing against three teams that finished in the top 78 in RPI last season, Liberty went 0-5, including a pair of one-run setbacks ... Liberty is now 10-10-1 in softball season openers during its NCAA Division I era ... Senior outfielder KATIE ZAVODNY, broke STACY RADULOVICH's (1996-99) program record for career stolen bases on Friday, and Zavodny now has stolen 82 bases at Liberty ... Senior DP SAMMI SHIVOCK, moved into eighth place outright at Liberty with her 95th career RBI. She is tied for eighth all time in both runs scored (102) and home runs (23) ... Senior RHP ALYSSA DIMARTINO made her second career opening-day start (also 2012) against 2013 NCAA Regional finalist Western Kentucky ... Junior catcher KELBY ALLEN, batted .500 (5-10) on the weekend, with two doubles, a homer and three RBIs ... CORTNEY COOPER and MARYBETH SCIOLINO both recorded their first career hit this past weekend ... The Lady Flames next compete in three games at a tournament hosted by UNCW, Saturday and Sunday.

LONGWOOD

Longwood returns to action in 2014 on the heels of a record-setting season a year ago as the reigning Big South Tournament Champion ... The team set eight all-time records in 2013, including six new standards in hitting categories. In addition, eight individual records were set ... Six returning position starters and one returning pitcher, including Big South Preseason Player of the Year and USA Softball Top 50 Watch List selection Megan Baltzell ... The Lancers open 2014 with back-to-back home tournaments, starting on Feb. 15-16. Longwood welcomes St. Joseph's, Bucknell and Georgetown for first weekend of competition.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose have scored 11 runs in four games, seven of them coming in the first three innings ... Despite the 0-4 record, PC led in two of the games this past weekend, holding a 2-0 lead over Ohio in the first inning, and a 3-0 lead through three innings against UNCG

- PC collected 19 hits this weekend, wiht three doubles a triple and a home run ... the home run came from Miranda Rogers against Ohio in her first collegiate at-bat .. She took the second pitch of her career over the left field wall to drive in two runs .

Winthrop opened up the weekend against a very solid field at the Red and Black Showcase hosted by the University of Georgia ... The Eagles won their season opener for the third time in the last four seasons ... Senior MCKENZI CORN has reached base in all five games and tied her career-high for RBI in a game with 3 against JMU in the opener ... Winthrop has the opportunity to reach the program's 1,000th victory as it now sits at 986 after the opening weekend ... Head Coach MARK COOKE is also closing in on win #750 as he now has 741 in his 28 seasons as a collegiate coach ... Junior SUTTON WATSON earned her 20th career victory in her 60th appearance against North Texas ... Sophomore KIM RYDER set a career-high in runs with 3 in the win over JMU in just her seventh career start
