Covington averaged 27.0 points, 12.5 rebounds and 5.5 blocked shots in two wins last week. He opened his week with 28 points, 13 rebounds and five rejections in the Keydets' four overtime win over Gardner-Webb. Covington hit a buzzer-beater to force the third OT and assisted on the game-tying basket that led to the fourth overtime. He then scored 26 points, grabbed 12 boards and blocked six shots in VMI's win over Charleston Southern on Saturday. For the week, Covington was 21-of-29 from the field (=72.4 percent) and made 12 free throws -- including 10 vs. the Buccaneers.

He made a career-best 8-of-9 from the free throw line and pulled down 11 of his 25 boards on the offensive glass. Nelson then scored 13 points, had six rebounds and three blocked shots in the Runnin' Bulldogs' win over High Point Saturday. For the week, Nelson was 13-of-28 from the floor (=46.4) and 11-of-13 from the charity stripe (=84.6).

INSTANT CLASSIC

VMI and Gardner-Webb played the first four overtime game in League history last week, as the Keydets finally emerged with the 108-104 victory on Feb. 5. The Keydets made last-second shots to force the first overtime, the third overtime and a fourth extra period in what is the longest game in Division I this season. The Runnin' Bulldogs' 99 field goal attempts set the Big South single-game record for a Conference match-up, while the 212 combined points is tied for the eighth-highest single-game total for a League contest.

FULL NELSON

Gardner-Webb freshman forward **TYRELL NELSON** set the Big South freshman single-game record for most rebounds with his 25 caroms against VMI. He tied the League's all-time mark of 25 in the process that was first established by High Point's **ARIZONA REID** against the Keydets on Feb. 24, 2007. Nelson also tallied 24 points to register the Big South's first 20-point, 20-rebound game since Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** had 30 points and 22 boards at VMI on Feb. 2, 2010.

ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH -- SECOND "WILDCARD" BROADCAST IS THURSDAY

ESPNU's second of three Big South "Wildcard" TV broadcast selections is UNC Asheville at Radford this Thursday at 7:00pm (game moved from Feb. 12). **ROY PHILPOTT** (play-by-play) and **CORY ALEXANDER** (analyst) will call the action from the Dedmon Center. For the first time in League history, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2013-14. Included in the package are three "Wildcard" selections, and the final "Wildcard" game chosen was Campbell at High Point on Feb. 28 at 7:00pm (game moved from March 1).

HOME WRECKER?

With 60 of the 96 Conference games in the books, the visiting teams are 28-32 for a 46.7 winning percentage -- the first time over 45.0 since 2008-09 when visiting squads finished with a 46.7 winning mark (42-48). Last season, the home teams went 61-35 (=63.5 percent) during the Big South schedule.

A GAME OF MARGINS

Thus far, 38 of the 60 Conference games have been decided by less than 10 points (4.47 average) -- including 24 that have been decided by less than 5 points (2.71 margin). The remaining 22 contests have had double-digit victory margins (16.14). Through 60 Conference games, the average margin of victory in the League season is 8.75 points. High Point has had nine of its 10 Big South contests decided by single digits, followed by Campbell, Liberty, VMI, Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb with seven such games.

CROSSOVER DRIBBLE

Crossover divisional Conference games conclude this week. The South Division owns a 16-14 advantage, going 10-8 at home and 6-6 on the road. It is the first time this season that one division has the upperhand, as crossover play was 12-12 through games of Feb. 5. In 2012-13, the South Division "won" the first season of the Big South's crossover divisional match-ups in men's basketball, as the South teams finished 22-14 (=61.1 percent) against the North Division. All 12 Big South members have had at least one game with two 20-point scorers, as Gardner-Webb was the final team to achieve the feat Feb. 1 at Radford. It is the first time since 2008-09 that every Big South basketball member has had two 20-point scorers in a game. VMI has had at least two 20-point scorers in a game a League-high 9 times this season, with **RODNEY GLASGOW** and **OJ PETERSON** involved in seven of those efforts. The Keydets are also 6-1 when Glasgow and Peterson score 20 points in the same contest (4-0 in Big South games).

RECO SUAVE

Campbell forward **RECO McCARTER** is having a tale of two seasons in 2013-14. In 15 non-Conference games, he averaged 9.7 points -- including 7.8 markers through the first 13 contests, as well as 3.7 rebounds and 41.8 percent from the field. Through 10 League games, McCarter is averaging 16.5 points, 7.2 rebounds and 46.3 percent from the floor. In Conference games, he ranks 11th in points, eighth in rebounds, ninth in FG percentage, eighth in assists (3.5), 10th in blocks (1.3), 11th in offensive rebounds (2.4) and eighth in defensive boards (4.8).

BIG SOUTH FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORING COMBINATIONS

Since the Big South's first official men's basketball season in 1985-86, a total of 18 four-year classmate combinations have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period, with four pair reaching the mark as juniors -- including two this year in Charleston Southern junior tandem **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER**, and Radford junior duo **JAVONTE GREEN** and **R.J. PRICE**. Below is a detailed look at the four sets of junior teammates and their overall career point totals:

SPEAKING OF FOUR-YEAR SCORING COMBOS

VMI seniors **RODNEY GLASGOW** (1,221) and **D.J. COVINGTON** (1,206) are among the 18 four-year classmate combinations that have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period. They are the 11th-highest scoring four-year classmate duo with 2,427 points, and 36 points away from moving into the Top 10. Winthrop's **MARK HAILEY** and **EDDIE GAY** are 10th with a combined scoring total of 2,463 points as teammates from 1989-93.

BACK IN FAMILIAR TERRITORY

VMI leads the Big South and the nation in scoring with 90.7 points per game, its highest average since 2008-09 when the Keydets scored a League- and NCAA-leading 93.8 a contest. VMI, which has led the Big South in scoring six out of the last seven years -- including last season, is second all-time for most times leading the Conference in scoring offense at six. Radford owns that record with nine times.

DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern is averaging 83.7 points this season, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest. Meanwhile, CSU and VMI could mark just the second time in League history that at least two teams averaged 80.0 points in the same year. The first (and only) time was in 1992-93 when three squads averaged 80.0 points -- Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3).

WHAT IS YOUR Q SCORE?

VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** leads the Big South and is the nation's highest-scoring freshman with 21.1 points per game, and is looking to become the first freshman ever to lead the Big South in scoring, as well as the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game. The first (and only) was Liberty's **SETH CURRY** in 2008-09 (20.2).

BIG SOUTH MATCH PLAY

Radford's 16 victories this season exceed its win total from all of last year (13), and the team needs just one more win to secure its first winning campaign since going 19-12 in 2009-10. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina and VMI have matched their win totals for 2012-13 (14). Winthrop is one win away from equaling its win output for last season (14), while Campbell is two victories shy of matching last year's total of 13.

RAISE YOUR GLASS FOR RODNEY

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW**, who became the 23rd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 11 against Liberty, is currently 16th all-time with 453 and needs 17 more dimes to move into 15th-place. The first Keydet to join the Big South's 400-assist club, Glasgow eclipsed 1,000 career points Jan. 8 against Longwood and is now one of 14 players in League history with 1,000 career points (1,221) and 450 career assists (453).

BIG SOUTH FRESHMEN FIVE FAB?

Five freshmen players are among the Big South's top 22 scorers -- including three in the top 10. As previously mentioned, VMI frosh **QJ PETERSON** is the League's leader with 21.1 points. UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is sixth at 18.9 points, while Coastal Carolina's **ELIJAH WILSON** is ninth at 15.8 markers per game. Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** is 19th at 12.4, with Presbyterian College freshman **REGGIE DILLARD** in 22nd at 12.3.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** became the 43rd player in Big South history with 600 career rebounds when he eclipsed the milestone Jan. 18 against Longwood. He is currently 34th all-time with 667 and 10 away from jumping into 30th-place. Meanwhile, Green is now one of 31 players in the Conference record books with 1,000 career points (1,210) and 600 boards. He is the 10th Highlander on the Big South's 1,000/600 list and first since **ART PARAKHOUSKI** and **JOEY LYNCH-FLOHR** in 2009-10.

NO KNOCK ON WOOD

Longwood sophomore **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** leads the League with 7.24 assists per game and has a League-high seven games with at least 10 helpers -- the most in the Big South since Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** had eight in 2011-12. He has surpassed his Big South freshman-record total of 180 last season (now at 181), and his per game average is currently the fourth-highest single-season clip in League history. The last player to average at least 7.0 assists in a season was Sanders in 2011-12 (7.97).

D.J.'S BLOCK PARTY - PART 1

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** leads the Big South and is third in the nation with 3.74 blocked shots per game -- currently the third-highest single-season average in League history. Cunningham has recorded 54 of his 71 blocks this season in his last 12 games (4.50 average) to increase his career total to 251 -- fourth all-time in the League record books. He is four rejections away from tying **JOHN WILLIAMS** for third-place at 255, which is also Asheville's school record. Now 16th all-time in League history with 732 career rebounds, Cunningham is the first player in League annals with 700 rebounds and 250 blocked shots.

D.J.'S BLOCK PARTY - PART 2

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON**, who is fifth in Big South history with 237 career blocked shots, became the 44th player with 600 career boards Feb. 5 at Gardner-Webb. Meanwhile, Covington is the fourth player in League history with 1,000 career points (1,206), 600 career rebounds (620) and 200 career blocked shots (237). He has blocked a shot in 51 of his last 54 appearances, and since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (54 games), he has recorded 164 of his 237 career blocks in that span (=69.2 percent) for an average of 3.04 per contest.

DISCOUNT DOUBLE CHECK

UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is the League's active leader for consecutive double-figure scoring games at 20. VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** is second to Rowsey at 16 games, followed by High Point's **JOHN BROWN** (12).

WATCH YOUR P'S AND Q'S

In addition to leading the Conference in scoring, VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** is pacing the League in steals with 2.00 per game, and is looking to become the first freshman to lead the League in steals per game. The last player to lead the Big South in scoring *AND* steals was VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** in 2008-09 (22.0 ppg, 3.39 spg).

BURRUS' BOARDS AND BLOCKS

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS** is the 14th member of the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shot club. Burrus has scored 1,064 points, and is 51st in League history with 583 rebounds while ranking 25th all-time with 121 blocked shots. He joins Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 1,715 points, 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97, as the only Flames on the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shot list.

THE PRICE IS RIGHT

Radford junior guard **R.J. PRICE** is five three-pointers away from becoming the 32nd player in Big South history with 200 career treys. Price has buried a three-pointer in 75 of his 86 career games, including a career-best streak of 26 consecutive games during the 2012-13 campaign. He has also made at least three 3-pointers in a game 37 times -- including nine times this year.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,533 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. John Caleb is at 1,298 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11 and surpassed Jesse's total of 1,235 from 2008-12 on Jan. 18. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

IT'S ACADEMIC

Coastal Carolina sophomore **MICHEL ENANGA** was named to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District Team Jan. 30, and now moves onto the national ballot for Academic All-America honors. Enanga's selection marks the third-straight year and eight out of the last nine years a Big South men's basketball player has earned Academic All-District honors. He is the first Chanticleer with this distinction since **SAM McLAURIN** in 2011-12.

TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern is third in the nation with a League-leading 10.35 three-pointers per game this season, and is looking to become the first Big South team other than VMI to average at least 10 triples a game in a single-season. CSU's average of 10.35 threes is the highest in the Big South since VMI averaged 11.32 in 2010-11. The Buccaneers' current per game tally would be sixth-highest in the League record book.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Longwood's **TRISTAN CAREY** is 29 points away from becoming the ninth player this season and 126th overall to reach 1,000 career points in the Big South Conference (Carey has scored 1,387 points at Longwood, including 416 prior to the Lancers' membership). The League currently has nine active 1,000-point scorers, and below is a look at where those nine rank, as well as two players inching closer to the list:

VMI's **DUGGAR BAUCOM** and Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH** are the longest-tenured Big South coaches, as each is in his ninth year. Baucum's Big South tenure will end after this season with VMI's departure to the Southern Conference on July 1, 2014. Meanwhile, Baucum is fifth all-time in Big South history with 132 victories at the Institute, while Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is in seventh-place with his 127 wins at Coastal Carolina. COVETED COVINGTON

VMI senior **D.J. COVINGTON** needs 14 field goals to become the 42nd player in Big South history with 500 in a career. He would become the seventh VMI Keydet on the list, which would tie Coastal Carolina for the most among the membership.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' 2012-13 season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 127. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 661 Division I wins and is 31st all-time in Division I victories. DEVANTE'S TREYS

High Point junior **DEVANTE WALLACE** tied the Big South single-game record for highest three-point field goal percentage in a League contest with his 8-of-9 performance from beyond the arc at Presbyterian on Jan. 28. Wallace's 88.9 percentage (based on 7 made three-pointers) matches the mark set by Charleston Southern's **JEREMY SEXTON** against the Panthers a year ago on Jan. 19, 2013. Wallace's mark is tied for third-highest in all games in League history. Meanwhile, Wallace has made at least three 3FG in a game nine times this season, and has hit at least one trey in all 10 of High Point's Big South games. He is shooting 62.7 percent (32-of-51) from beyond the arc in League action.

IN WILLIAM WE TRUSS

Presbyterian College's **WILLIAM TRUSS** tied a Big South single-game record with his perfect 10-of-10 field goal performance against High Point on Jan. 28. He is the sixth player in League history to post 100.0 percent from the field with at least 10 field goals, and the first since Radford's **TOM GALLAHER** (10-of-10) against UMBC on Feb. 10, 1993. Truss is just third to achieve the feat in a Conference game.

LONGWOOD SCORES BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG 12 WIN IN 15 SEASONS

Longwood's 82-79 win at TCU on Nov. 12 was the Big South's first win over a member of the Big 12 Conference since the 1999-00 season. That year, Winthrop defeated Missouri, 51-46.

WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern junior guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 16 times in their career (nine times last season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 13-3 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 16 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

With the Big South having 12 men's basketball members and divisional play, the Conference has a 16-game League schedule this season. Each team will play its divisional opponents twice (a 10-game round-robin schedule), and one game against each crossover division opponent (six games total -- three home and three road).

The Conference's tiebreaker for the divisional format, which will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship Tournament, is as follows:

TOURNAMENT SEEDING

The top two teams with the best overall Conference won-loss percentage in both the North and South Divisions shall receive the top four seeds in the Conference Championship Tournament. Other seeds shall be based on division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed will be determined within each division as noted below.

TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

(A) If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;

(B) If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie;

(C) If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;

(D) If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(E) In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;

(F) If the teams are still tied, the teams' records against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie would be considered, and so forth until the tie is broken;

(G) If there is still a tie, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(H) For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie, and;

(I) For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

(J) If the process reduces the number of tied teams, the remaining tie will be broken by starting the tiebreaking process over.

CLASS ACT

High Point graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY**, who is out for the season, is among the 30 candidates for the national Senior CLASS Award. He is the Big South's first official candidate since Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** in 2011-12.

Campbell seeks to end its longest losing streak (3) in two months this week ... **RECO McCARTER** scored 25 points and grabbed 10 rebounds at Asheville for his second double-double of the year ... **LUKE MOYER** had a career-high 5 assists at Asheville and shot 5-of-9 from 3-point range in two games last week ... **LEEK LEEK** blocked a career-high 6 shots at Asheville, 1 shy of Campbell's Division I era record ... Campbell ranks 2nd among Big South schools in home attendance for League contests (2,347) ... CU is averaging 9.3 three-pointers made in League games, tied with VMI for tops in the Conference ... Campbell is seeking its first-ever two-game season sweep of Longwood after winning 75-67 last month at Farmville ... Campbell has won its last 2 games against PC, defeating the Blue Hose last year at Clinton and scoring an OT victory in the first round of the 2013 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Championship.

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

In 15 seasons in the Big South, High Point has been above .500 after 10 games five times. At 6-4, it's the second year in a row HPU is above .500 through 10 games. HPU went 7-3 through 10 last year ... High Point has played five of its last seven games on the road. Of HPU's last six games of the regular season, four are at home ... **JOHN BROWN** posted his fourth double-double of the season and eighth of his career (19 points, 10 rebounds) at Gardner-Webb on Saturday. Brown's six blocks at Gardner-Webb were a career-high and the first time an HPU player had at least five blocks since **CRUZ DANIELS** had five on Feb. 27, 2010 against Presbyterian College ... In 11 games since the calendar flipped to 2014, Brown is averaging 21.5 points, 7.3 rebounds and is shooting 56.6 percent from the floor and 78.9 percent from the free throw line.

LIBERTY FLAMES

Liberty is currently on a four-game skid after dropping contests to Winthrop and UNC Asheville last week ... **ANDREW SMITH** is leading the team offensively in Conference play with 12.3 points per game. He is coming off his third-straight double-double Saturday, finishing with 14 points and 10 rebounds vs. Asheville. He also had a career-high five steals and four blocks in the contest ... Smith's five thefts mark the second time a Liberty player has garnered five steals this season, as **JOE RETIC** did so on Jan. 8 at Radford ... Smith's four blocks are also the most by a Liberty player this year ... **ANTWAN BURRUS** started the Asheville game and finished with 22 points and 12 rebounds in his first start since Jan. 1 ... Liberty finished with a season-high 10 steals and nine blocks Saturday.

LONGWOOD LANCERS

TRISTAN CAREY and **JEYLANI DUBLIN** led the Lancers at PC with their respective team-highs of 14 points, Dublin also added a team-high six rebounds off the bench ... Carey led Longwood at Coastal Carolina with his team-high 16 points, adding a team-high nine rebounds. He now totals 1,387 career points to rank 8th all-time in school history, and his 217 career three-pointers rank 2nd all-time ... Freshman **DARRION ALLEN** matched his season-high with 12 points at Coastal ... **LUCAS WOODHOUSE**'s 181 season assists are a program record, and the sophomore now totals 361 career assists to rank 5th all-time ... The Lancers return home to welcome South Division opponent Winthrop on Feb. 12, and will play four of their final six regular-season games at home.

RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

With his 15 points at Presbyterian, **JAVONTE GREEN** moved into 12th all-time at Radford with 1,210 points, surpassing **ART PARAKHOUSKI**. Green set a career-high with 33 points at Charleston Southern -- his first career 30-point performance. Green's back-to-back double-doubles last week were the 21st and 22nd of his career ... **KYLE NOREEN** tied a season-high with 7 rebounds at Charleston Southern ... Radford has won 3-straight road games for the first time in the **MIKE JONES** era ... For just the second time this season (Binghamton), Radford came back to win after trailing at the half (37-36 at Presbyterian) ... Radford is now assured of not having a losing season (16-9 with at least 7 games remaining).

VMI KEYDETS

VMI's 4OT game at Gardner-Webb was VMI's second in the record books in the modern era, and the first time the Keydets had prevailed in a game that went that long. VMI and The Citadel played four overtimes in 1967 with the Bulldogs outlasting the Keydets, 81-78 in Charleston ... VMI is now 11-1 at home and has posted the most home wins since going 13-2 in 2011-12. The Keydets overall four-game win streak is the longest of the year ... **RODNEY GLASGOW** played 97 of a possible 100 minutes in VMI's two games last week ... **BRIAN BROWN** posted back-to-back double-digit games last week and averaged 18.0 points while shooting 62% (10-16) from 3-point range ... VMI logged its 250th win at Cameron Hall Saturday with the 94-82 win over Charleston Southern. Cameron Hall opened in 1981.

SOUTH DIVISION

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

Charleston Southern's bench continued its outstanding scoring production by posting 26-16 and 48-10 advantages in bench points this past week. For the season, CSU's bench is now outscoring the opponent's bench, 821-418 ... **SAAH NIMLEY** returned from missing two games due to injury, and came off the bench to score 17 points and four assists in 28 minutes of action at VMI ... Nimley moved past **DAVE KIRK** for 16th place on CSU's all-time scoring list with 1,189 points, and is just 15 away from moving into 15th place. Nimley also tied **TONY FAIRLEY** for fourth place in CSU history in assists, and needs three more helpers to assume sole possession of third place in that category ... **MALCOLM BERNARD** enjoyed one of the most productive weeks of his career. He moved back into the starting lineup vs. Radford and scored eight points and matched a then career-high with nine rebounds in 27 minutes of action. Bernard was better in Saturday's loss to VMI, recording his first career double-double with 16 points and 12 rebounds.

COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

Coastal went 1-1 at home last week with a 77-74 loss versus High Point and a 67-58 win over Longwood ... **BADOU DIAGNE** emerged as a fourth option for the Chants as he led the team in scoring, averaging 18.5 points per game. He also led the team in rebounding with 8.5 per game. Diagne shot over 70 percent from the field while knocking down two 3-pointers and going 1-1 at the free throw line ... Diagne, freshman **ELIJAH WILSON**, **WARREN GILLIS** and **JOSH CAMERON** all averaged double-figures last week. Wilson averaged 15.0, Gillis averaged 13.0 and Cameron averaged 12.5 ... Diagne has raised his season averages to 7.0 points and 5.2 rebounds per game ... CCU is 17-6 all-time against VMI, including 6-4 on the road. The Chants are 7-6 all-time against Gardner-Webb, including 3-3 in Conway.

GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb has won six of its last eight games and has scored 80 points three times in the last four contests ... Wednesday's 108-104 loss to VMI in four overtimes marked the longest game in school and Big South history. GWU is 2-2 this season in overtime games, and is 4-3 in overtime games combined over the past two seasons ... Gardner-Webb's last three games have been decided by an average of 3.0 points, with GWU posting a 2-1 record in those decisions ... The Runnin' Bulldogs have five players averaging in double digits in the last six games -- **JEROME HILL** (20.8 ppg), **NAJI HIBBERT** (11.8 ppg), **TYLER STRANGE** (11.7 ppg), **TYRELL NELSON** (10.5 ppg) and **DONTA HARPER** (10.2 ppg). In the same stretch, Gardner-Webb has made more free throws (98) than its opponents have attempted (90).

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

The Blue Hose have several players ranked in the Top 35 in the national rankings. **JORDAN DOWNING** ranks in total points (463), field goals made (163) and field goal attempts (379). **WILLIAM TRUSS** ranks in total rebounds (206) ... Truss has increased his rebounding from 4.6 a game in 2012-13 to 8.5 and currently is 3rd in the Big South. He is averaging almost a double-double with his 11.5 ppg ... If Downing's 19.4 ppg continues for the remainder of the season, he will eclipse the PC Division I record of 16.9 set in 2012 by **AL'LONZO COLEMAN**. Downing is 16 points away from breaking PC's single-season Division I points record of 501 set by **KHALID MUTAKABBIR** last year.

UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

The Bulldogs have won three straight Big South games for the first time this season ... Asheville is 12-4 since beginning the season 1-7 ... The Bulldogs will be on the road twice this week and both games will be on the ESPN Networks. Asheville is at Radford Thursday night on ESPNU and then plays at Presbyterian College on ESPN3 Saturday evening ... Freshman **ANDREW ROWSEY** has scored in double figures in 20-straight games and has four-straight games of 23 points-or-more ... **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** blocked seven shots on Saturday vs. Liberty and now has 251 career blocks. He needs five to move past **JOHN WILLIAMS** for the school's all-time lead.

WINTHROP EAGLES

Winthrop won three games in five days with wins at Liberty and at home over Barber-Scotia and Campbell ... The Eagles defeated Campbell by 26 points, which is the largest margin of victory over a Division I opponent during **PAT KELSEY**'s brief head coaching career at Winthrop. It was the second-straight game the Eagles won without a single player scoring more than 13 points ... The win over Campbell was Winthrop's first in a regular-season matchup since Campbell rejoined the Big South in 2011-12 ... Winthrop shot 51 percent against Campbell, which was the third-straight game the Eagles shot 50 or more percent in the game -- marking the first time since 2006-07 when it occurred Feb. 10-16 against Radford, Charleston Southern and at Missouri State ... The Campbell victory was Winthrop's ninth home win, keeping the Eagles within reach of back-to-back seasons with 10 or more home victories for the first time since 2006-07 and 2007-08.

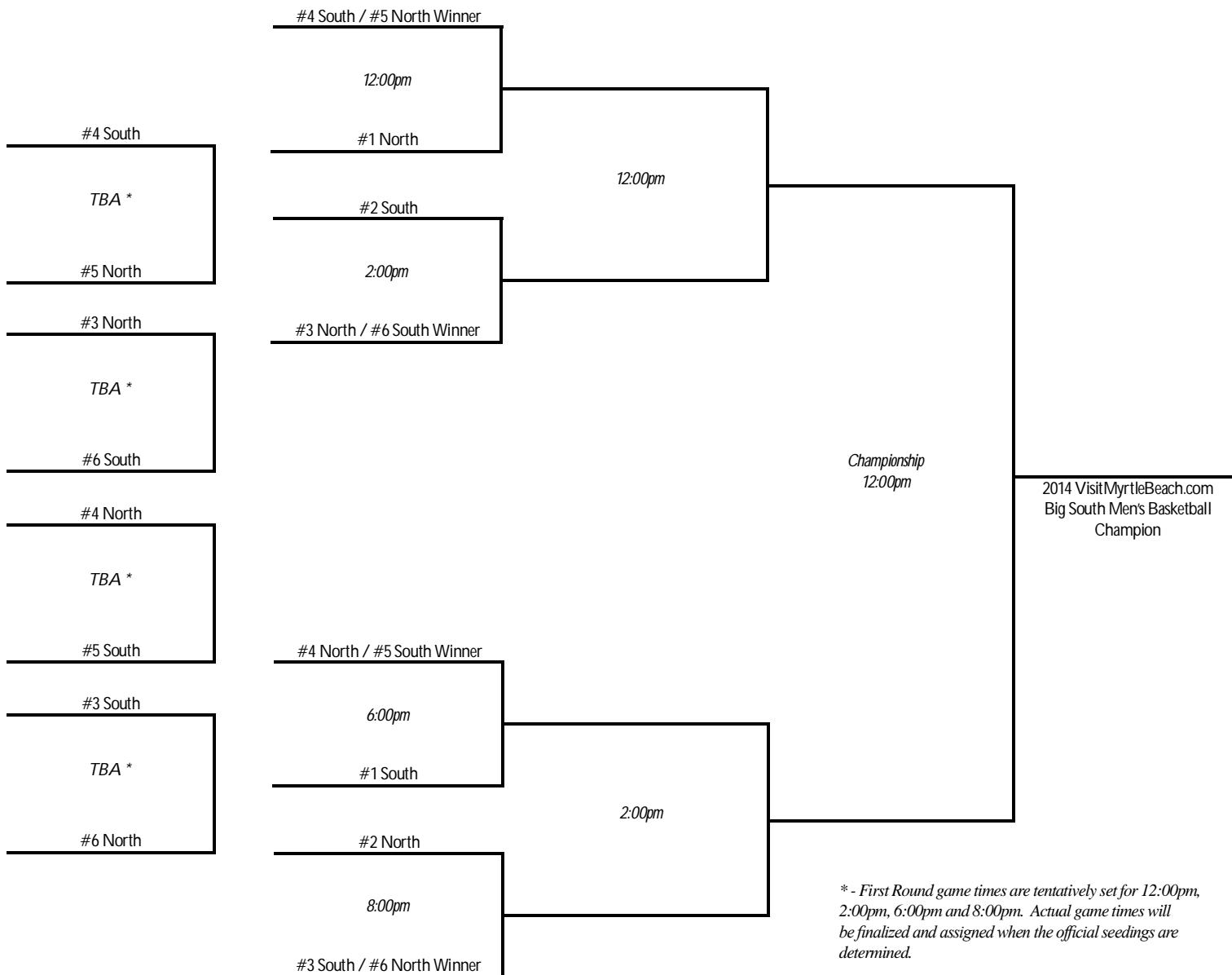
