Brown scored a career-high 34 points, posted a double-double with 12 rebounds, had a career-high six assists and blocked three shots in High Point's road win at Radford on Saturday. He also set the HPU record for perfect free throw percentage, going 14-of-14 from the line. It was High Point's first win at the Dedmon Center since 2007-08.

Wilson led Coastal to two come-from-behind wins last week, as he averaged 21.0 points against VMI and Gardner-Webb. He scored a career-high 26 points while knocking down 11-of-16 field goals in Coastal's 18-point comeback victory at VMI. Against Gardner-Webb, his 10 second-half points helped Coastal pull away with the victory after trailing by nine. For the week, Wilson was 17-of-27 from the field (=63.0 percent) and averaged 4.5 rebounds and 2.0 blocks.

**ANDREW ROWSEY • G**  
**Fr. • UNC Asheville**  
**Lexington, Va.**

Rowsey scored a Big South-freshman record 41 points at Radford and averaged 27.5 points in two games last week. He became just the sixth player in school history to score 40 points in a game and set the Dedmon Center scoring record as he was 14-of-28 from the field and 9-of-11 from the line. Rowsey was 17-of-19 from the charity stripe (=89.5) and averaged 3.0 assists and 2.5 boards in the two games.

**RISING ROWSEY**

UNC Asheville freshman **ANDREW ROWSEY** became the first frosh in League history to score 40 points in a game when he tallied a Big South-freshman record 41 last Thursday at Radford. It was his fourth game with at least 30 points and he now ranks fourth in the Conference with 19.6 points per game. In League games, Rowsey leads with 23.3 markers per contest.

**HOME WRECKER?**

With 71 of the 96 Conference games in the books, the visiting teams are 34-37 for a 47.9 winning percentage -- the first time over 45.0 since 2008-09 when visiting squads finished with a 46.7 winning mark (42-48). Last season, the home teams went 61-35 (=63.5 percent) during the Big South schedule.

**A GAME OF MARGINS**

Thus far, 42 of the 71 Conference games have been decided by less than 10 points (4.52 average) -- including 25 that have been decided by less than 5 points (2.64 margin). The remaining 29 contests have had double-digit victory margins (16.10). Through 71 Conference games, the average margin of victory in the League season is 9.25 points. High Point has had 10 of its 11 Big South contests decided by single digits, followed by VMI (9), Coastal Carolina (8), Liberty (8), Campbell (7), Radford (7), Gardner-Webb (7) and UNC Asheville (7).

**CROSSOVER DRIBBLE**

The final crossover division Conference game is Monday, Feb. 17 with the re-scheduled Charleston Southern at High Point contest. The South Division owns a 19-16 advantage and has "won" the Big South's crossover divisional match-ups for the second consecutive season. Last year, the South Division finished 22-14 (=61.1 percent) against the North Division. Here is a look at each team's crossover record in Big South games this year, in current standings order:

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 continues this week with the Liberty at Campbell game on Saturday, Feb. 22 live at 4:00pm. **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) will call the action from Gore Arena in Buies Creek, N.C. For the second consecutive year, ESPN3 will exclusively carry eight Big South match-ups, as well as all four quarterfinal games of the 2014 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Men's Basketball Championship for the first time.

**ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH -- FINAL "WILDCARD" BROADCAST IS FEB. 28**

ESPNU's third of three Big South "Wildcard" TV broadcast selections is Campbell at High Point on Friday, Feb. 28 at 7:00pm (game moved from March 1). For the first time in League history, four regular-season Big South games will appear on ESPNU in 2013-14. Included in the package were three "Wildcard" selections.

**20/20 TIMES 12**

All 12 Big South members have had at least one game with two 20-point scorers, as Gardner-Webb was the final team to achieve the feat Feb. 1 at Radford. It is the first time since 2008-09 that every Big South basketball member has had two 20-point scorers in a game. VMI has had at least two 20-point scorers in a game a League-high 9 times this season, with **RODNEY GLASGOW** and **OJ PETERSON** involved in seven of those efforts. The Keydets are also 6-1 when Glasgow and Peterson score 20 points in the same contest (4-0 in Big South games).

**RECO SUAVE**

Campbell forward **RECO McCARTER** is having a tale of two seasons in 2013-14. In 15 non-Conference games, he averaged 9.7 points -- including 7.8 markers through the first 13 contests, as well as 3.7 rebounds and 41.8 percent from the field. Through 12 League games, McCarter is averaging 16.5 points, 7.3 rebounds and 48.6 percent from the floor. In Conference games, he ranks 11th in points, tied for seventh in rebounds, eighth in FG percentage, ninth in assists (3.42), 11th in blocks (1.08), 13th in offensive rebounds (2.33) and 10th in defensive boards (4.92). McCarter has recorded three 20-point, 10-rebound games this season -- all in League play.

**SPEAKING OF FOUR-YEAR SCORING COMBOS**

VMI seniors **RODNEY GLASGOW** (1,258) and **D.J. COVINGTON** (1,239) are among the 18 four-year classmate combinations that have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period. They are the eighth-highest scoring four-year classmate duo with 2,497 points, and 49 points away from moving into seventh-place. Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN** and **CRAIG BRADSHAW** hold that spot with a combined scoring total of 2,545 points as teammates from 2003-07.

**BACK IN FAMILIAR TERRITORY**

VMI leads the Big South and the nation in scoring with 89.6 points per game, its highest average since 2008-09 when the Keydets scored a League- and NCAA-leading 93.8 a contest. VMI, which has led the Big South in scoring six out of the last seven years -- including last season, is second all-time for most times leading the Conference in scoring offense at six. Radford owns that record with nine times.

**DO THE CHARLESTON**

Charleston Southern is averaging 83.8 points this season, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest. Meanwhile, CSU and VMI could mark just the second time in League history that at least two teams averaged 80.0 points in the same year. The first (and only) time was in 1992-93 when three squads averaged 80.0 points -- Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3).

**WHAT IS YOUR Q SCORE?**

VMI freshman **OJ PETERSON** leads the Big South and is the nation's second-leading freshman scorer with 20.7 points per game, and is looking to become the first freshman ever to lead the Big South in scoring, as well as the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game. The first (and only) was Liberty's **SETH CURRY** in 2008-09 (20.2). UNC Asheville freshman **ANDREW ROWSEY** is looking to join Peterson in the 20.0 points per game club, as he is at 19.6 ppg.

**20/20 TIMES TWO ... OR FOUR**

VMI's **OJ PETERSON** (20.7) and High Point's **JOHN BROWN** (20.0) could give the Big South multiple 20-point scorers in the same season for the first time since 2008-09 and ninth time overall. In addition, Presbyterian College's **JORDAN DOWNING** is averaging 19.8 points and UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is at 19.6. The most Big South players to average 20.0 points in the same season is three in 1992-93 and 2006-07.

**BIG SOUTH MATCH PLAY**

Radford's 17 victories this season exceed its win total from all of last year (13), and the team has secured its first winning campaign since going 19-12 in 2009-10. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina and VMI have exceeded their 2012-13 win totals as well (14), while Winthrop has equalled its win output from last season (14). Campbell is one victory shy of matching last year's total of 13.

**RAISE YOUR GLASS FOR RODNEY**

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW**, who became the 23rd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 11 against Liberty, is currently 16th all-time with 466 and needs four more dimes to move into 15th-place. The first Keydet to join the Big South's 400-assist club, Glasgow eclipsed 1,000 career points Jan. 8 against Longwood and is now one of 14 players in League history with 1,000 career points (1,258) and 450 career assists (466).

**SAAH-SATIONAL**

Charleston Southern junior **SAAH NIMLEY** is 16 assists away from becoming the 24th player in Big South history with 400 career assists, and would be the 20th player with 1,000 points and 400 assists once he reaches the milestone. Nimley would become the first Buccaneer on the Big South's 400-assist list since **ED O'NEIL** (504 from 2000-04) and the third overall (**ERROL McPHERSON**, 403 from 1993-97).

**BIG SOUTH FRESHMEN FIVE FAB?**

Five freshmen players are among the Big South's top 23 scorers -- including three in the top 10. As previously mentioned, VMI frosh **QJ PETERSON** is the League's leader with 20.7 points. UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is fourth at 19.6 points, while Coastal Carolina's **ELIJAH WILSON** is ninth at 16.2 markers per game. Presbyterian College's **REGGIE DILLARD** is 21st at 12.2, with Winthrop freshman **KEON JOHNSON** in 23rd at 12.1.

**GREEN MACHINE**

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** needs 11 rebounds to become the 26th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds. Once he reaches the milestone, he would be the 23rd with 1,000 points (1,244) and 700 boards. Green is currently 28th all-time with 689 and 24 away from jumping into the Top 20. Meanwhile, Green is looking to become the eighth Highlander on the Big South's 1,000/700 list and first since **ART PARAKHOUSKI** in 2009-10.

**NO KNOCK ON WOOD**

Longwood sophomore **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** leads the League with 7.04 assists per game and has a League-high seven games with at least 10 helpers -- the most in the Big South since Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** had eight in 2011-12. He has surpassed his Big South freshman-record total of 180 last season (now at 190), and his per game average is currently the fifth-highest single-season clip in League history. The last player to average at least 7.0 assists in a season was Sanders in 2011-12 (7.97).

**D.J.'s BLOCK PARTY - PART 1**

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** leads the Big South and is fourth in the nation with 3.62 blocked shots per game -- currently the third-highest single-season average in League history. Cunningham has recorded 59 of his 76 blocks this season in his last 14 games (4.21 average) to increase his career total to 256 -- third all-time in the League record books. He surpassed former teammate **JOHN WILLIAMS** (255) to become Asheville's career leader. Now 15th all-time in League history with 748 career rebounds, Cunningham is the first player in League annals with 700 rebounds and 250 blocked shots.

**D.J.'S BLOCK PARTY - PART 2**

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON**, who is fifth in Big South history with 246 career blocked shots, became the 44th player with 600 career boards Feb. 5 at Gardner-Webb. Meanwhile, Covington is the fourth player in League history with 1,000 career points (1,239), 600 career rebounds (643) and 200 career blocked shots (246). He has blocked a shot in 53 of his last 56 appearances, and since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (56 games), he has recorded 173 of his 246 career blocks in that span (=70.3 percent) for an average of 3.09 per contest.

**DISCOUNT DOUBLE CHECK**

UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is the League's active leader for consecutive double-figure scoring games at 22. VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** is second to Rowsey at 18 games, followed by High Point's **JOHN BROWN** (13).

**BURRUS' BOARDS AND BLOCKS**

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS** is the 14th member of the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shot club. Burrus has scored 1,091 points, and is tied for 49th in League history with 590 rebounds while ranking 25th all-time with 121 blocked shots. He joins Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 1,715 points, 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97, as the only Flames on the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shot list.

**THE PRICE IS RIGHT**

Radford junior guard **R.J. PRICE** is two three-pointers away from becoming the 32nd player in Big South history with 200 career treys. Price has buried a three-pointer in 77 of his 88 career games, including a career-best streak of 26 consecutive games during the 2012-13 campaign. He has also made at least three 3-pointers in a game 37 times -- including nine times this year.

**BAND OF BROTHERS**

Liberty senior **JOHN CALEB SANDERS** and his brother and former teammate **JESSE** have combined to score 2,554 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. John Caleb is at 1,319 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11 and surpassed Jesse's total of 1,235 from 2008-12 on Jan. 18. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

## IT'S ACADEMIC

Coastal Carolina sophomore **MICHEL ENANGA** was named to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District Team Jan. 30, and now moves onto the national ballot for Academic All-America honors. Enanga's selection marks the third-straight year and eight out of the last nine years a Big South men's basketball player has earned Academic All-District honors. He is the first Chanticleer with this distinction since **SAM McLAURIN** in 2011-12.

## TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern is third in the nation with a League-leading 10.29 three-pointers per game this season, and is looking to become the first Big South team other than VMI to average at least 10 triples a game in a single-season. CSU's average of 10.29 threes is the highest in the Big South since VMI averaged 11.32 in 2010-11. The Buccaneers' current per game tally would be sixth-highest in the League record book.

## BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Longwood's **TRISTAN CAREY** is one point away from becoming the ninth player this season and 126th overall to reach 1,000 career points in the Big South Conference (Carey has scored 1,415 points at Longwood, including 416 prior to the Lancers' membership). The League currently has nine active 1,000-point scorers, and below is a look at where those nine rank, as well as two players inching closer to the list:

Meanwhile, Baucum is fifth all-time in Big South history with 133 victories at the Institute, while Coastal Carolina's **CLIFF ELLIS** is tied for sixth-place with his 129 wins at Coastal Carolina. ## COVETED COVINGTON

VMI senior **D.J. COVINGTON** needs three field goals to become the 42nd player in Big South history with 500 in a career. He would become the seventh VMI Keydet on the list, which would tie Coastal Carolina for the most among the membership.

Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' 2012-13 season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 129. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 663 Division I wins and is 31st all-time in Division I victories. ## DEVANTE'S TREYS

High Point junior **DEVANTE WALLACE** tied the Big South single-game record for highest three-point field goal percentage in a League contest with his 8-of-9 performance from beyond the arc at Presbyterian on Jan. 28. Wallace's 88.9 percentage (based on 7 made three-pointers) matches the mark set by Charleston Southern's **JEREMY SEXTON** against the Panthers a year ago on Jan. 19, 2013. Wallace's mark is tied for third-highest in all games in League history. Meanwhile, Wallace has made at least three 3FG in a game nine times this season, and has hit at least one trey in all 11 of High Point's Big South games. He is shooting 61.8 percent (34-of-55) from beyond the arc in League action.

## IN WILLIAM WE TRUSS

Presbyterian College's **WILLIAM TRUSS** tied a Big South single-game record with his perfect 10-of-10 field goal performance against High Point on Jan. 28. He is the sixth player in League history to post 100.0 percent from the field with at least 10 field goals, and the first since Radford's **TOM GALLAHER** (10-of-10) against UMBC on Feb. 10, 1993. Truss is just third to achieve the feat in a Conference game.

## LONGWOOD SCORES BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG 12 WIN IN 15 SEASONS

Longwood's 82-79 win at TCU on Nov. 12 was the Big South's first win over a member of the Big 12 Conference since the 1999-00 season. That year, Winthrop defeated Missouri, 51-46.

## WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern junior guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 16 times in their career (nine times last season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 13-3 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 16 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

## BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

With the Big South having 12 men's basketball members and divisional play, the Conference has a 16-game League schedule this season. Each team will play its divisional opponents twice (a 10-game round-robin schedule), and one game against each crossover division opponent (six games total -- three home and three road).

The Conference's tiebreaker for the divisional format, which will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship Tournament, is as follows:

## TOURNAMENT SEEDING

The top two teams with the best overall Conference won-loss percentage in both the North and South Divisions shall receive the top four seeds in the Conference Championship Tournament. Other seeds shall be based on division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed will be determined within each division as noted below.

## TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

(A) If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;

(B) If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie;

(C) If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;

(D) If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(E) In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;

(F) If the teams are still tied, the teams' records against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie would be considered, and so forth until the tie is broken;

(G) If there is still a tie, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(H) For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie, and;

(I) For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

(J) If the process reduces the number of tied teams, the remaining tie will be broken by starting the tiebreaking process over.

**COVER CHARGE**

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** has a League-high seven 20-point, 10-rebound games this season, including four in League contests. It is the most 20-point, 10-rebound games in the Big South since former teammate **STAN OKOYE** had nine such efforts last year.

**BIG BYRON**

Gardner-Webb senior **MIKE BYRON** became the 32nd player in Big South history with 100 career blocks when he surpassed the milestone Feb. 11 at Liberty. Byron ranks 32nd in League annals with 101 rejections and is the first Gardner-Webb player on the list.

**INSTANT CLASSIC**

VMI and Gardner-Webb played the first four overtime game in League history on Feb. 5, as the Keydets finally emerged with the 108-104 victory. The Keydets made last-second shots to force the first overtime, the third overtime and a fourth extra period in what is the longest game in Division I this season. The Runnin' Bulldogs' 99 field goal attempts set the Big South single-game record for a Conference match-up, while the 212 combined points is tied for the eighth-highest single-game total for a League contest.

**FULL NELSON**

Gardner-Webb freshman forward **TYRELL NELSON** set the Big South freshman single-game record for most rebounds with his 25 caroms against VMI on Feb. 5. He tied the League's all-time mark of 25 in the process that was first established by High Point's **ARIZONA REID** against the Keydets on Feb. 24, 2007. Nelson also tallied 24 points to register the Big South's first 20-point, 20-rebound game since Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** had 30 points and 22 boards at VMI on Feb. 2, 2010.

**CLASS ACT**

High Point graduate student **ALLAN CHANEY**, who is out for the season, was among the initial 30 candidates for the national Senior CLASS Award. He is the Big South's first official candidate since Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** in 2011-12.

**MID-MAJOR MANIA**

The Big South has had six teams receive consideration for the *CollegeInsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 ranking this season. Below is a look at where the Big South has stood each week:

## CAMPBELL FIGHTING CAMELS

The Camels play 3 of their final 4 regular season games on the road, starting Wednesday at VMI. The Camels are 0-3 all-time in Lexington (0-1 since re-joining the Big South in 2011-12) ... CU hosts Liberty Saturday (ESPN3) in the final home playing appearance for seniors **MARVELLE HARRIS**, **ANTONIO KALPIC**, **LEEK LEEK** and **ANTWON OLIVER** ... **RECO McCARTER** logged his third double-double of the year with 21 points, 10 rebounds and 5 assists in Wednesday's 77-66 win over Presbyterian ... Over the last 5 games, **LUKE MOYER** has made 11-of-21 threes (52.4) and is averaging 9.2 points off the bench ... **ANDREW RYAN** is just 4 three-pointers shy of moving into 10th place on CU's all-time 3s made list ... Since Longwood joined the Big South last year, neither Campbell (2-0 in Farmville) nor the Lancers (2-0 in Buies Creek) has defeated the other on its home floor.

## HIGH POINT PANTHERS

**JOHN BROWN** scored a career-high 34 points and had a career-high six assists in HPU's win at Radford. His previous scoring high was 28 points twice, and his previous high in assists was four twice. Brown also had 12 rebounds for his fifth double-double of the season ... Brown set the HPU record for perfect free-throw percentage for the second time this season, going 14-for-14 from the line at Radford on Saturday. He previously went 11-for-11 against Stephen F. Austin on Dec. 1 ... As a team, High Point set a single-game record, going 21-for-22 from the free-throw line at Radford. The previous record was 20-for-21 against St. Andrews on Nov. 21, 2013 ... HPU's win over Radford was its first at the Dedmon Center since Jan. 28, 2008 and broke a six-game losing streak at the venue. High Point's only longer road losing streak against a Big South team is at UNC Asheville, the most recent win at Asheville coming on Feb. 14, 2007 (0-8 since then).

## LIBERTY FLAMES

The Flames have now lost six straight ... Against the Keydets this past Saturday, **ANTWAN BURRUS** led the Flames' offensive attack with 23 points. VMI now leads the all-time series, 16-15 after taking the final Big South regular-season meeting between the two squads. The Flames concluded the night shooting 47.0 percent (31-of-66), compared to 38.8 percent (26-of-67) for VMI. The Flames outscored VMI in the paint, 50-28. However, Liberty struggled from the foul line (6-of-17) and the three-point arc (2-of-8). Liberty's free throw percentage (35.3) against the Keydets was its lowest on the season.

## LONGWOOD LANCERS

Longwood's win at Campbell stopped a five-game losing streak and gave the Lancers a season split against the Fighting Camels ... **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** led Longwood with his game-high 18 points at Campbell, adding a game-high five assists. He now totals a school season-record 190 assists, and his 370 career assists rank 4th all-time ... **TRISTAN CAREY** finished with 17 points and a game-high 13 rebounds at CU for his third double-double this season, adding three assists and three steals. He now totals 1,415 career points to rank 8th all-time, and his 220 career three-pointers rank 2nd all-time ... The 23-point margin of victory over Campbell was the largest by the Lancers against a Big South opponent since joining the League. The 13 first-half points scored by Campbell were the fewest allowed by Longwood as a member of Division I (2007-08), and the fewest points allowed in a half since beginning Division I scheduling in 2004-05 (17).

## RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

Radford is assured of its 29th winning season out of 40 as a program ... **JAVONTE GREEN** now has 23 career double-doubles ... RU overcame its largest deficit of the season (15 points) to defeat UNC Asheville. **BRANDON HOLCOMB** set a career high with 4 blocks vs. Asheville ... For the first time in the **MIKE JONES** era, two players -- other than **R.J. PRICE** or Green -- scored 20 points in the same game, as **YA YA ANDERSON** and **RASHUN DAVIS** each scored 21 points to lead RU to the win over Asheville ... Radford has suffered four of its five Conference losses at home.

## VMI KEYDETS

VMI has won six of its last eight games and closes out its home schedule with back-to-back games against Campbell and Radford this week ... **D.J. COVINGTON** continues his steady play and has posted double-doubles in five-straight games and 13 for the season. In two games last week, Covington averaged 16.5 points, 11.5 rebounds, and 4.5 blocks ... Freshman **OJ PETERSON** posted his third double-double of the season with 18 points and 12 rebounds against Liberty. His driving layup in the final minute gave VMI the lead for good in the 77-70 win at the Vines Center ... **JORDAN WEETHEE** had back-to-back double-figure scoring games last week for the first time since December 3-7. He averaged 13.0 points and shot 35% from 3-point range ... VMI has won four road Conference games -- matching last year's mark in that category ... The Keydets have hit 10 or more 3-pointers in six consecutive games -- the longest such streak this season (69-163, 42.3 percent).

## SOUTH DIVISION

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

CSU snapped a two-game losing streak with a 84-64 win over Winthrop on Saturday. The Bucs led by as many as 23 and never let the Eagles get closer than eight points in the second half, as an early 8-0 run opened a 16-point lead and Winthrop never threatened again ... **ARLON HARPER** scored 17 points to pace five players in double figures. Harper hit his first three shots of the game and keyed CSU's 8-0 second half run to open up a 51-35 lead. He hit a three, had a steal and layup and found **SHELDON STRICKLAND** for a three off a baseline drive ... Freshman **TY'QUAN BITTING** played one of his best games of the year in the Winthrop win. He matched a career-high with 8 points and added four rebounds and three blocked shots in 14 minutes of playing time.

## COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

Coastal went 2-0 last week with a pair of come-from-behind victories. CCU trailed by as much as 18 at VMI before storming back and winning 83-78 Wednesday night. The Chants trailed by as much as nine points at home against Gardner-Webb before shooting 71.4 percent in the second half and running away with a 75-60 win ... Freshman **ELIJAH WILSON** led the way for the Chants as he averaged 21.0 points per game. His 42 points brought his season total to 420, which ties the CCU single season freshman scoring record held by **JACK LEASURE**. Wilson also now has 161 made field goals, which bests the previous CCU freshman record of 156 held by **WILLIAM CALVIN**, which was set during the 1984-85 season ... Wilson, **WARREN GILLIS**, **JOSH CAMERON** and **BADOU DIAGNE** all averaged double-figures last week. Wilson averaged 21.0, Gillis averaged 17.0, Cameron averaged 15.5 and Diagne averaged 11.5.

## GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb had its seven-game Big South Conference road win streak snapped at Coastal Carolina, losing the lead in the final eight minutes to fall, 75-60. Gardner-Webb led for most of the game's first 22 minutes and held a seven-point lead just after the 8-minute media timeout ... GWU picked up its first ever win at the Vines Center last Tuesday, handling Liberty a 68-52 defeat ... Coastal Carolina is the only League team to post a double-figure win over Gardner-Webb this season, and has done so twice ... GWU will play its final two home games of the regular season this week, hosting Presbyterian and Winthrop. GWU will honor seniors **ONZIE BRANCH**, **MIKE BYRON**, **JOSH CASTELLANOS** and **NAJI HIBBERT** prior to the Winthrop game on Saturday night.

## PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

The Blue Hose travel up the road to Boiling Springs to take on Gardner Webb for the second time this season. The teams split the series last year with both teams winning at home. GWU won at the Templeton Center this season for the first time since 2010. PC last won at Paul Porter Arena in 2012 ... The one-point, 72-71 win over UNC Asheville was PC's closest margin of victory since a 67-66 win over Eastern Kentucky on Nov. 20, 2010 ... **WILLIAM TRUSS** has increased his rebounding from 4.6 a game in 2012 to 9.1 this season (currently 2nd the Big South) ... If **JORDAN DOWNING**'s 19.8 ppg continues for the remainder of the season, he will eclipse the PC Division I record of 16.9 set in 2012 by **AL LONZO COLEMAN**. With 535 points this year, Downing has already surpassed the PC season scoring record of 501.

## UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

UNC Asheville has dropped two straight to fall in a three-way tie for second-place in the South Division. Asheville finishes the season up with three out of four games at home, including two this week ... **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** became the school's all-time leader in blocked shots vs. PC and now has 256 ... The Bulldogs host Charleston Southern Wednesday night and Coastal Carolina Saturday.

## WINTHROP EAGLES

Winthrop's four-game winning streak ended Saturday at Charleston Southern. It was the longest winning streak under second-year head coach **PAT KELSEY** and the longest since 2009-10 when the team captured seven in a row ... Last week's win at Longwood was the first time Winthrop had won three-straight Big South games by double figures since 2007-08 ... Before the Charleston Southern loss, Winthrop had not trailed but for 4:37 in the previous four league games (160 total minutes) ... Winthrop now has four road wins in League play after going 0-8 in Big South road games in 2012-13 ... **JOAB JEROME** passed the 800-point and 400-rebound plateau against Charleston Southern and is also closing in on 200 assists (194) ... **ANDRE SMITH** moved into ninth-place on Winthrop's career list for three-pointers made ... The Eagles' 204 threes on the year are the ninth-most in the program's history for a single-season ... Freshman **KEON JOHNSON** is just 23 points away from scoring the most points by a freshman, and is five 3FG away from breaking the freshman record of 52 set by **TYSON WATERMAN** in 1995-96.

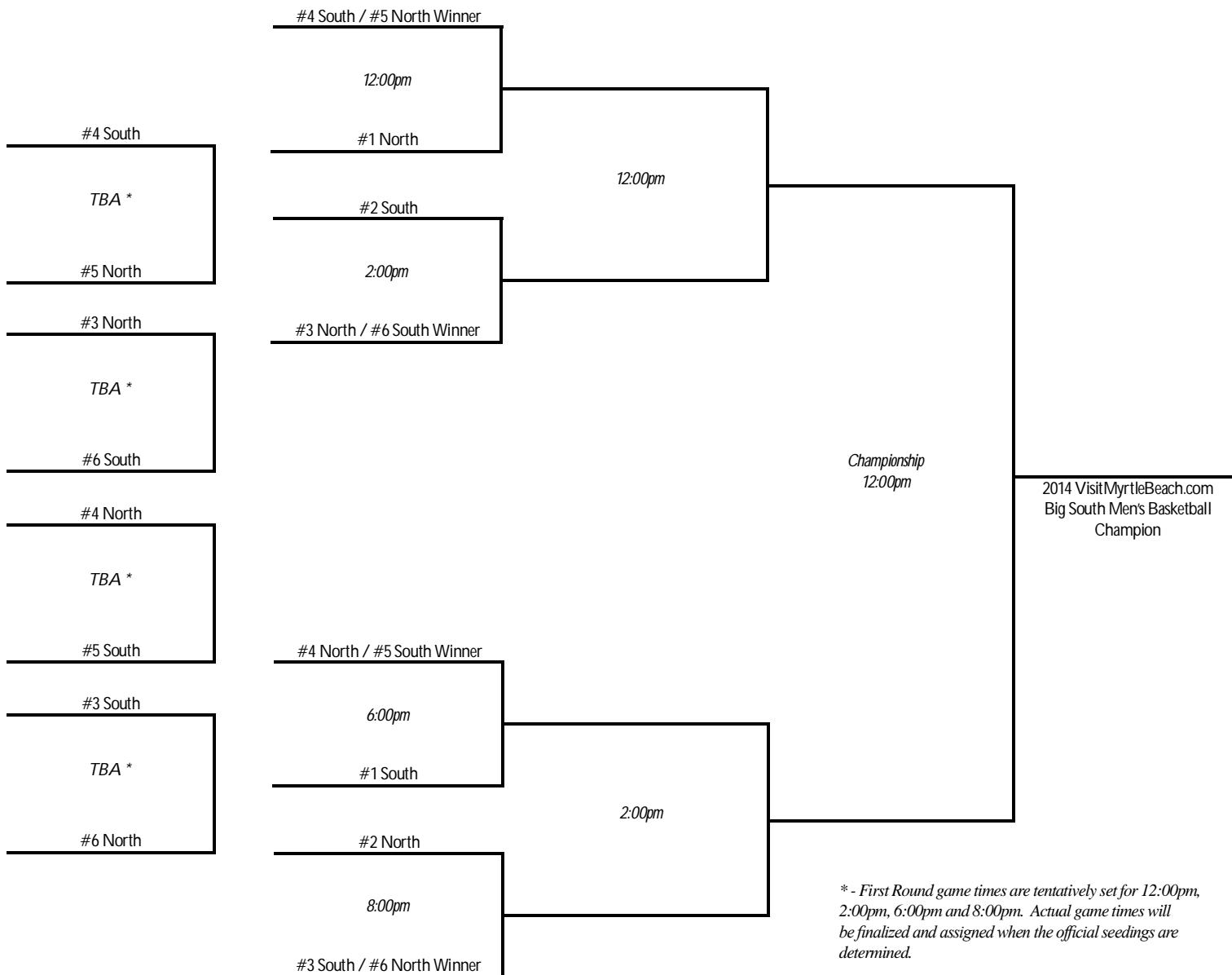
