Presley averaged 26.5 points and 10.5 rebounds per game to lead the Camels to a pair of pivotal Big South road wins last week. She got her week started with career-high 29 points on 52 percent from the floor to go along with 10 boards, two assists and three steals to lead Campbell to the 82-81 win at Coastal Carolina on Feb. 13. Two days later at Charleston Southern, Presley stayed hot as the forward connected on 57 percent from the floor and 8-of-11 from the line to finish with 24 points as Campbell defeated the Buccaneers, 72-71. She also chipped in 11 rebounds, two helpers and a pair of steals in the win. The honor marks her first Big South Player of the Week nod this season.

FANNING THE FLAMES -- LIBERTY TABBED PRESEASON FAVORITE

Fort the 16th time in the last 17 years, Liberty is the preseason women's basketball favorite for the 2013-14 season. The Lady Flames received 13 of the 25 first-place votes and 261 out of a possible 275 points. Liberty will have two starters and nine letterwinners back from last year's Big South championship and NCAA Tournament squad. Winthrop was voted second with 256 points and 11 first-place bids. Campbell was picked third with 206 points.

McCLANAHAN VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Winthrop senior **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** is the 2013-14 Big South Women's Hoops Preseason Player of the Year. McClanahan is the reigning two-time Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She is looking to become the first player with three consecutive Player of the Year Awards since Liberty's Katie Feenstra from 2003-05. McClanahan led the League in scoring for the second-straight year in 2012-13 with 19.8 points per game and was also tops with 5.8 assists per game.

PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH

Joining McClanahan on the Preseason All-Big South Team is Campbell's **KIERA GAINES**, High Point's **STACIA ROBERTSON**, Longwood's **DAEISHA BROWN** and Liberty's **EMILY FRAZIER**. Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** and **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** from Winthrop rounded out the Preseason All-Conference Team.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has two new coaches on the sideline this season. **JAIDA WILLIAMS** is the new skipper at Coastal Carolina, while **MIKE MCGUIRE** took over at Radford.

THRICE AS NICE

For the second-straight year and third time in the last four years, three Big South women's squads received berths in the NCAA postseason., tying the League record. Liberty was the League's representative in the NCAA Tournament, while Winthrop captured the Big South's automatic bid to the WNIT. Presbyterian College, in its first year of full Division I status and postseason eligibility, accepted an at-large invitation to the WBI.

TRIPLE CROWN

Winthrop's Dequesha McClanahan will attempt to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the Conference in scoring in three consecutive seasons., as Liberty's Elena Kisseleva is the only player to win three Big South scoring titles. Meanwhile, McClanahan will look to become the first player to ever lead the League in assists three-straight years in 2013-14.

MAGIC WAND-A

With Campbell's win over Western Carolina earlier this season, **WANDA WATKINS** picked up her 500th career win. She is currently the 27th active coach to reach the milestone, while being one of six that have been at the same institution for at least 33 years.

EAGLES, EAGLES, EAGLES!!!

Winthrop defeated Florida Gulf Coast, 65-61, in the first round of the WNIT last March, marking the Big South's first women's basketball postseason win since 2005. It was Winthrop's first postseason win in women's basketball since becoming a Division I member in 1986, and it is also the Big South's third-ever victory in the WNIT.

THE COUNT DOWN BEGINS

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** is currently for No. 2 all time in the Big South with 2,116 points. She is currently on pace to take over the top spot held by Elena Kisseleva of Liberty who finished her career with 2,154 points.

GREEN MACHINE

CATRINA GREEN of Gardenr-Webb currently the Big South's active leading rebounder with 919 career boards. She is currently No. 8 all-time in the Big South. Meanwhile, Green is became the 12th member of the Big South's 1,000 points, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shots club over the Christmas break. She currently has 1,146 points (No. 63 all-time) and 145 rejections.

MILLIS CENTER NORTH - TIED 12 YEAR OLD RECORD

With High Point's 94-89 2OT win at Liberty on Jan. 30 inside the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win three-straight road games at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1994, 1995 and 1996 seasons.

IN RANGE WHEN SHE ENTERS THE GYM - 1,000 POINTS FOR CAREER

Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** ranks No. 3 all time in the Big South Conference in career three-pointers. She currently has 250 for her career. Taylor made 85 treys last season (7th most in League history). She also scored her 1,000th career point on Jan. 18. She is currently ranked No. 66 in the League with 1,108 points.

BROKE THE STREAK

With its win over Charleston Southern on Dec. 2, UNC Asheville snapped a 29-game conference losing streak that dated back to the 2011-12 season. The win marked head coach **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK**'s first career Big South win.

BROKE THE STREAK (PART TWO)

UNC Asheville broke another streak this season that dated back to the 2006-07 season. On Jan. 18, the Bulldogs knocked off Liberty, 83-80 in OT to snap a 16-game losing streak to the Lady Flames. The win also marked the first time Asheville had defeated Liberty in Asheville since the 1996-97 season.

PHENOMENAL FORTIFICATION

The Presbyterian College Blue Hose have made it extremely hard for opponents to put up points this season. The Blue Hose are currently No. 3 in the nation as they are holding opponents to just 53.3 points per game.

DIAPER DANDIES

Two Big South players have earned a combined 12-of-14 Big South Freshman of the Week nods this season. Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** of Winthrop has received the nod seven times, while High Point's **KAYLAH KEYS** has earned the honor five times this season. Keys has nine 20-point games this season, including 32 points against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 18, and is averaging a Conference best 17.0 points per game. Williams is posting 15.4 points per outing, to go along with a five of 20-point outings.

HISTORY REPEATING ITSELF - DIAPER DANDIES CONT.

During the 2010-11 season High Point and Winthrop battled back and forth for Freshman of the Week. Former Panther Cheyenne Parker and current Eagle **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** combined for 13 of the 16 selections. Parker earned the honor a League-high seven times, while McClanahan picked up the honor six times. Williams has tied Parker's record, while Keys would have to win the next to selections to tie the honor.

KEY(S)FENSE

High Point freshman standout Keys has been HPU's go-to player for offense during the Conference season. She is currently ranked No. 1 among all Big South players with an average of 19.7 points per game in Conference-only contests.

JUMP AROUND

The Liberty Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the nation. The Lady Flames currently rank No. 2 in the nation as they are averaging a +14.1 rebound margin... Gardner-Webb is also ranked in the top 25 as the Runnin' Bulldogs are 23rd with a +8.1 rebound margin.

WOMAN OF STEAL

Charleston Southern's **DJ FOWLER** has been creating havoc for opponents of the defensive side of the ball this season. She is currently ranked No. 7 in Division I with 3.04 steals per game.

DOYEN HER THING

Radford's **AYANA AVERY** leads the Big South Conference with 79 triples on the season... She is currently ranked No. 10 in Division I with 3.12 three-pointers per game. She tops the Radford roster and is ranked No. 4 in the League with 15.9 ppg in Conference-only contests.

Coastal Carolina fell to Campbell 82-81 in its only contest of the week...Coastal's 81 points were the team's most since scoring 83 in its win over High Point on Jan. 2...The Chanticleers were led in the game by **AJ JORDAN**'s 26 points, marking her league-leading 10th 20-plus point performance of the season...Jordan, who entered the contest with six made threes on the season, finished the contest 4-of-5 from 3-point range...**ANGELICA HENRY** recorded her fifth double-double of the season with 19 points and 10 assists...Henry now ranks sixth on the CCU all-time list with 292 career helpers...Freshman **KARSEN SIMS** returned to the Coastal lineup after missing three games with an injury...Sims scored 12 points and notched a pair of rebounds and steals in her return...Jordan is on pace to become the first player to lead the Chants in both points and rebounds per game since Sydney Moss did so during the 2010-11 season...The Chanticleers will take on Charleston Southern on Thursday before hosting Presbyterian on Saturday afternoon...Coastal fell to the Blue Hose, 68-71 in overtime, on Jan. 16 then defeated the Buccaneers on Jan. 18, 77-63.

GARDNER-WEBB

CATRINA GREEN posted another double-double with a 12-point, 14-rebound performance in Gardner-Webb's 74-73 overtime win over Longwood on Thursday, her 13th of the season...The senior center is now just 41 boards away from becoming the first player in GWU's Division I era to record 1,000 career rebounds...Senior **JASMINE DALE** joined elite company on Saturday afternoon, pouring in 13 points to eclipse the 1,000-point plateau for her career...The Runnin' Bulldogs lost the battle on the glass for the first time in 10 games on Saturday, as Liberty out-rebounded Gardner-Webb, 44-36, in a 72-62 win at Paul Porter Arena...Gardner-Webb hits the road for two games this week, traveling to High Point on Thursday and Campbell on Saturday for two pivotal Big South Conference match ups.

HIGH POINT

High Point had its seven-game win streak snapped on Saturday at Presbyterian College...The Panthers played just one game due to snow postponing Thursday's contest at Charleston Southern to Monday...HPU's seven-game win streak was the longest for the program since winning nine in a row in 2011-12...**KAYLAH KEYS** scored 20 points in the loss at PC, she has scored 20 or more points in eight of High Point's 15 Big South games this season...She has totaled 409 points this season to become HPU's rookie scoring leader...Charlena Martin previously held the record for freshman scoring with 385 points (13.8 per game in 28 games) in 2003-04.

LIBERTY

Liberty lost for the first time ever at Presbyterian College's Templeton Center on Thursday, falling to 4-1 at the facility...The Lady Flames then snapped a three-game losing skid two days later by becoming just the second visiting team to win at Gardner-Webb's Paul Porter Arena this season...Liberty's next victory will accomplish two things...It will clinch the Lady Flames' 18th consecutive winning season and will wrap up a top-five seed and first-round bye at the Big South Women's Basketball Championship...Liberty's 13 points in the first half at PC marked the Lady Flames' lowest-scoring half since the Lady Flames managed only 13 points during the first half at Virginia on Dec. 7, 2011...The Lady Flames are now 0-6 in games decided by 5 points or fewer this year and 15-4 in all other games...Liberty still leads the nation in rebound margin (+14.1), but PC ended the Lady Flames' streak of 21 straight games winning the rebounding battle...On Saturday at 7 p.m., Liberty will host conference-leading Winthrop for its final home game of the season...The Lady Flames will try to complete a regular-season sweep of the Eagles and defeat Winthrop inside the Vines Center for the 22nd consecutive time...Liberty is 100-10 in February games under head coach **CAREY GREEN**.

LONGWOOD

The Lancers battled back and forth against Gardner-Webb and forced overtime with a bucket from sophomore **DEBORAH HEADEN** before falling 74-73 on Feb. 13. The team then faced a 69-52 setback at UNC Asheville in its final road game of the season on Feb. 15. Through 26 games, sophomore **DAEISHA BROWN** paces the team with 15.5 points per game. Classmate **RAVEN WILLIAMS** has added to the offensive effort with 11.6 points per game, while sophomore **KYNDAL SKERSICK** and redshirt-senior **HEATHER TOBECK** average 9.4 and 7.3 points, respectively. Sophomore **KHALILAH ALI** leads the Lancers on the glass with 6.0 rebounds per game, while Brown adds 5.0. As a team, Longwood is shooting 34.2% (524-1533) from the floor, including 26.5% (143-540) from beyond the arc, and 66.6% (307-461) from the foul line. Longwood will play its final three games of the regular season at home beginning on Thursday, Feb. 20 when the team welcomes Winthrop to Willett Hall for a 7 p.m. tilt.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College women's basketball toppled Liberty (46-43) on Thursday and High Point (56-48) on Saturday to run its winning streak to four games, currently the second-longest in the Big South Conference...PC held both of its opponents under 50 points to improve its League-best scoring defense to 53.3 points per game...With four three-pointers on Saturday, senior guard **KARLEE TAYLOR** passed Jill Neumann's (1997-2000) second-place mark of 248 career three-pointers in PC program history. The senior guard now sits 20 behind Chris Mitchum (1992-96) for the all-time school record...The Blue Hose held Liberty to 13 points in the first half and a 30.0 percent shooting percentage on the night, both season-lows for the Lady Flames...All of the team's nine wins have come when PC outrebounded its opponent...Senior guard **SHERECE SMITH** grabbed nine rebounds to push her to fifth in PC's Division I history, with 375 career boards (now at 379). Smith also scored her 500th career point on Saturday against High Point...PC scored a season-high 27 points off of turnovers on Saturday against High Point...PC's four-game win streak marks the program's longest since a run of six wins to end the regular season last year...The Blue Hose hit the road for the final regular season road trip of 2013-2014, taking on Campbell on Thursday before facing Coastal Carolina on Saturday.

RADFORD

Radford split its two-game road series through the Carolinas. The Highlanders upended UNC Asheville (64-52) before dropping a 57-40 decision to Winthrop...Against the Bulldogs, each Radford player who logged minutes, scored at least four points. Rebounding was huge for the Highlanders as they cleaned up the glass for a 43-29 advantage, marking just the sixth time this season RU won the battle of the boards. Radford finished at 46.9 percent shooting, including a 51.7 percent mark in the first half. Three double-figure scorers dotted the stat sheet: **AISHA FOY** (14), **BRESHARA GORDON** (11) and **KERMISHA CLARK** (10) for the Highlanders...Two days later in Rock Hill, S.C., Radford couldn't stop the terrific trio of Dequesha McClanahan, Schaquilla Nunn and Erica Williams as they combined for 47 of the Eagles' 57 points. Foy led RU in scoring for the second straight game with 12 points, while Clark contributed 10 off the bench.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Against Radford the Bulldogs struggled to get their offense on track in the first half, falling behind 33-17 at the break. Asheville then outscored the Highlanders 35-31 in the second half, but could not overcome the deficit. **SHONESE JONES** scored a team-best 14 points with **TIANNA KNUCKLES** chipping in 10 to the Bulldogs' total. With the victory the Highlanders avenge a 68-61 loss to the Bulldogs on Jan. 11...With the win over Longwood the Bulldogs snapped a four-game losing skid, while also sweeping the Lancers on the season. The 69-52 victory also marked the first time since the skid started that Asheville scored more than 55 points in a contest...Asheville is currently leading the Big South and is 21st in the nation in free throw percentage with a mark of 76 percent...The 10 wins for Asheville are the most since the 2010-11 season, when the Bulldogs won 12 games. The seven conference victories for the Bulldogs are also to most wins in league play since they went 7-9 during the 2008-09 season...The Bulldogs will be on the road for their final two regular season games away from Kimmel Arena this week, taking on Liberty on Thursday before squaring off against High Point on Saturday. Asheville defeated the Flames 83-80 in overtime on Jan. 18, the first victory for the Bulldogs over the flames in seven seasons. The Blue & White fell to High Point on Jan. 16, 71-66.

WINTHROP

Winthrop moved up to No. 22 in last week's CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll. Winthrop extended its winning streak to a season-high six in a row with a 57-40 win over Radford. The 40 points by Radford was the lowest point total by an opponent this season. Winthrop entered the game ranked 8th nationally in field goal percentage defense (34.7) and held Radford to 32.7. Sophomore center Schaquilla Nunn surpassed 500 career points in the RU game. She has now entered the 500/500 club for points (510) and rebounds (522). **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** continued her climb to become the all-time scoring leader in Big South history. She now has 2,116 points and needs just 39 more to pass Elena Kisseleva for the top spot. McClanahan needs just three more assists to reach 700. That will give her over 2,000 points, 600 rebounds, 700 assists and 250 steals for her career.
