Hayden batted .385 (5-for-13) with a nine runs batted in, five hits, three home runs and a 1.154 slugging percentage to help lead CCU to a 4-1 record last week. The junior started the week with a 1-for-3 effort against Purdue and a two-run home run in a 3-0 win. Hayden followed with a multi-hit effort in CCU's next outing, going 2-for-4 with three runs batted in and a second two-run blast against Purdue in as many games. Against Towson, she drove in three runs on her third home run of the week in a 6-2 win. Hayden added another RBI in a 9-1 win against Virginia. Four of her five hits last week were extra-base

CAMPBELL

The Camels went 2-2 last weekend, losing to Stetson and Bethune-Cookman. The victories came against Elon and Stetson. KATIE BAKER pitched a seven inning shutout to earn the win against Elon. Campbell came back from a 3-0 deficit in the top of the seventh to beat Stetson 7-3. Campbell takes on Elon again this Wednesday at Amanda Littlejohn Stadium in Buies Creek.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went 3-2 overall on the weekend, picking up shutout victories in their first three games against St. Bonaventure and Jacksonville State, before falling in their final two games over the weekend ... The Buccaneers move to 6-2-1 overall on the season following the weekend and travel to Florida State for the Unconquered Classic next week ... MARCI CHRISTIAN led the CSU hitters on the weekend, hitting .385 overall with two home runs, five RBI and five runs scored, while AMANDA MAT-SUMOTO, JESSICA BROCK and STEPHANIE SBARDELLA all hit over .300 on the weekend. On the mound, JENNIFER GILES went 2-0 on the week with a 1.27 earned run average to lead the Buccaneers.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal notched victories in three of four games over the weekend to improve to 5-1 on the season, marking its best start through six games since 2003 ... KORY HAYDEN homered in three of the four games and already has five this season and 35 for her career, two away from tying for second place on the school's all-time list. She also has totaled a team-high 12 RBIs ... KIANA QUOLAS notched two more victories in the circle to give her 50 for her career ... BRI CHIUSANO has had a hit in all six games this season and scored at least one run in five of the six contests. She leads the team with eight runs and seven stolen bases ... Freshman AMANDA DANEKER has a team-best three multi-hit games and is third on the squad with a .353 average ... Coastal hits the road for the first time this season as it travels to the University of Florida for the Lipton Invitational. The Chants will play two games against Georgia Southern and one each against Indiana, Troy and the top-ranked host Gators.

GARDNER-WEBB

SAMANTHA MEENAGHAN had a 16-game hitting streak, dating back to last season, snapped on Sunday ... Meenaghan went 3-for-4 in each of the first four games of the season, currently leading the team with a .545 batting average, two triples, and four RBI ... MAHAILA IRVIN and JESSICA CHILDERS each hit their first collegiate home run last weekend at Alabama State's Hornet Invitational ... Gardner-Webb is home against USC Upstate on Wednesday before traveling to Columbia, S.C. this coming weekend for the South Carolina Gamecock Invitational, where the Runnin' Bulldogs will take on Georgetown and host South Carolina on Friday, Boston University on Saturday, and UNC Wilmington on Sunday.

LIBERTY

First-year head coach **DOT RICHARDSON** picked up her first two coaching wins on Saturday, as the Lady Flames (2-6) went 2-1 at the Seahawk Invitational, hosted by UNCW ... Liberty defeated Norfolk State, 5-1, on Saturday, for the first win of the Dot Richardson Era. The Lady Flames then posted a 12-0 shutout victory over UMBC, before falling to UNCW, 3-1, on Sunday ... **KATIE ZAVODNY** went 3-for-3 against Norfolk State, tying the program record with four runs scored while stealing two bases and hitting her first career home run ... With her six runs scored this weekend, Zavodny became the 11th player in program history to score 100 or more runs ... RHP **AN-NAH JO BRITTINGHAM** allowed just four hits to Norfolk State, picking up her first win of the season ... On Saturday against UMBC, the Lady Flames stole a season-high seven bases, the most by Liberty since March 19, 2002 versus Fairleigh Dickinson ... **HANNA NICHOLS** batted 4-for-4 with a career-high four RBIs against UMBC, while **BLAIR LAWRENCE** went 3-for-3 with two runs scored ... RHP **ALYSSA DIMARTINO** threw her first career complete-game shutout versus the Retrievers. She has allowed just one earned run this season, with a 0.41 ERA ... The Lady Flames next compete in four games at the Spartan Classic, hosted by USC Upstate, Friday through Sunday.

LONGWOOD

Longwood returns to action in 2014 on the heels of a record-setting season a year ago as the reigning Big South Tournament Champion ... The team set eight all-time records in 2013, including six new standards in hitting categories. In addition, eight individual records were set ... Six returning position starters and one returning pitcher, including Big South Preseason Player of the Year and USA Softball Top 50 Watch List selection Megan Baltzell ... After getting snowed out last weekend, the Lancers open 2014 with its annual Spring Classic on Feb. 22-23. Longwood welcomes Towson and Lafayette for first weekend of competition.

PRESBYTERIAN

With the region seeing snow and ice this past week, the Blue Hose had five games, inclouding three as part of the Spartan Invitational in Spartanburg, S.C., cancelled or postponed ... PC was able to play one contest on Sunday night, a 4-1 loss to Appalachian State ... PC out-hit the Mountaineers 8-6, but gave up a solo home run in the fourth and a three-run homer in the sixth to fall by three.

RADFORD

Radford's opening weekend at the Blue/Gold Triad Challenge was canceled due to the winter storm that hit the southeast ... The Highlanders will open their season on Wednesday, Feb. 19 at Charlotte.

WINTHROP

Winthrop had its schedule altered due to the winter storm and ended up playing only four of the five originally scheduled games at the Tiger Invitational. The Eagles were unable to get outdoors for practice all week and the storm prevented them from departing until Friday ... Winthrop was just 1-3 on the weekend with the lone victory coming against Marshall as **SUTTON WATSON** earned her third victory of the season in the pitching circle ... The Eagles had a good opening weekend at Georgia as the pitching staff threw very well, but over the past weekend the Eagles gave up 40 runs in four games. The 16 runs allowed were the most in a game since late last season in a 16-3 loss to Radford and it's the most runs allowed to a non-conference opponent since falling 17-5 to Ohio State in the 2013 opener ... Senior **ALEX WHITE** tied her career-high of four RBI in a single-game in the win over Marshall as she was 3-for-4 ... Junior **HOLLI RYAN** had her first career pinch-hit in the loss to Auburn
