Covington averaged 31.0 points, 10.5 rebounds and 2.5 blocks in leading the Keydets to two wins last week as well as clinching a bye into the quarterfinals of next week's VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Basketball Championship. He scored a career-high 33 points in the 84-81 win over Campbell on Feb. 19 and followed with his League-leading 14th double-double of the year when tallied 29 points and 13 rebounds against Radford on Feb. 22. For the week, Covington was 22-of-29 from the field (=75.9 percent) and 18-of-23 from the charity stripe (=78.3).

VMI CLINCHES FIRST ROUND BYE

VMI is the first team to clinch a bye into the quarterfinals of the VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Basketball Championship. The Keydets can finish no worse than 10-6, and if they tie Radford in the standings, VMI wins that tiebreaker based on sweeping the season series with the Highlanders. A three-way tie with High Point and Radford is not possible, as VMI or High Point will have at least 11 Big South wins following their head-to-head meeting this week.

Two North Division squads and four South Division clubs are still in contention for the remaining first round byes, which are bestowed upon the top two teams in each division. ESPNU GOING WILD FOR THE BIG SOUTH -- FINAL "WILDCARD" BROADCAST IS FRIDAY NIGHT

ESPNU's third of three Big South "Wildcard" TV broadcast selections is Friday's Campbell at High Point game at 7:00pm (game moved from March 1). **JIM BARBAR** (play-by-play) and **MALCOLM HUCKABY** (analyst) have the call from the Millis Center. For the first time in League history, four regular-season Big South games appeared on ESPNU in 2013-14. Included in the package were three "Wildcard" selections.

HOME WRECKER?

With 84 of the 96 Conference games in the books, the visiting teams are 38-46 for a 45.2 winning percentage -- the first time over 45.0 since 2008-09 when visiting squads finished with a 46.7 winning mark (42-48). Last season, the home teams went 61-35 (=63.5 percent) during the Big South schedule.

A GAME OF MARGINS

Thus far, 47 of the 84 Conference games have been decided by less than 10 points (4.70 average) -- including 26 that have been decided by less than 5 points (2.65 margin). The remaining 37 contests have had double-digit victory margins (16.51). Through 84 Conference games, the average margin of victory in the League season is 9.90 points. High Point has had 12 of its 14 Big South contests decided by single digits, followed by VMI (10), Liberty (9), Gardner-Webb (9), Campbell (8) and Coastal Carolina (8).

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

High Point redshirt-sophomore **JOHN BROWN** enters this week with 988 career points, and he is on the cusp of becoming the first player in Big South history to eclipse 1,000 points as a sophomore. Brown's current total is the highest two-year total by a freshman-sophomore in League annals, surpassing the previous high of 974 points by HPU's **NICK BARBOUR** during his freshman-sophomore seasons from 2008-10.

THE 20/20 EXPERIENCE

Seven different players have scored 20 points in a game at least 10 times this season, the most in the Big South since before 2004-05. VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** leads the League with 14 20-point games, while **JOHN BROWN** has a Conference-best eight games with at least 25 points. UNC Asheville freshman **ANDREW ROWSEY** is tops in 30-point games with four.

CROSSOVER DRIBBLE

The South Division "won" the Big South's crossover divisional match-ups for the second consecutive season, as the division finished with a 19-17 advantage. The teams with the top crossover division records this season were High Point (5-1), Coastal Carolina (5-1) and Gardner-Webb (5-1). Last year, the South Division finished 22-14 (=61.1 percent) against the North Division -- but a North Division squad (Liberty) won the Conference Tournament over a South Division member (Charleston Southern).

The Big South "Game of the Week" television package exclusively on ESPN3 concludes this week with the Gardner-Webb at UNC Asheville game on Saturday, March 1 live at 4:30pm. **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **RALPH PATTERSON** (analyst) will call the action from Kimmel Arena in Asheville, N.C. For the second consecutive year, ESPN3 exclusively carried eight Big South match-ups, and will air all four quarterfinal games of the 2014 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Men's Basketball Championship for the first time.

15-FOOTERS

UNC Asheville has won at least 15 games in seven consecutive seasons, the second-longest streak in Big South history. It is also their 16th 15-win season since the Conference was formed, which ties Winthrop for the second-most in League history. Meanwhile, Radford has recorded its first 15-win season since the 2009-10 season and record 18th overall as Big South members.

10-TAMOUNT

High Point has notched back-to-back 10-win Big South seasons for the first time as League members. VMI has recorded its first 10-win League campaign since 2010-11 and the third and final time as Big South members. UNC Asheville is one victory shy of its seventh consecutive 10-win Conference season and 10th overall -- which would tie Winthrop for the most in the League record books.

20/20 TIMES 12

All 12 Big South members have had at least one game with two 20-point scorers, as Gardner-Webb was the final team to achieve the feat Feb. 1 at Radford. It is the first time since 2008-09 that every Big South basketball member has had two 20-point scorers in a game. VMI has had at least two 20-point scorers in a game a League-high 10 times this season, with **RODNEY GLASGOW** and **QJ PETERSON** involved in seven of those efforts. The Keydets are also 6-1 when Glasgow and Peterson score 20 points in the same contest (4-0 in Big South games).

RECO SUAVE

Campbell forward **RECO McCARTER** is having a tale of two seasons in 2013-14. In 15 non-Conference games, he averaged 9.7 points -- including 7.8 markers through the first 13 contests, as well as 3.7 rebounds and 41.8 percent from the field. Through 14 League games, McCarter is averaging 16.1 points, 6.9 rebounds and 49.4 percent from the floor. In Conference games, he ranks 12th in points, ninth in rebounds, seventh in FG percentage, 10th in assists (3.07), 13th in blocks (1.00), tied for ninth in offensive rebounds (2.36) and 12th in defensive boards (4.57). McCarter has recorded three 20-point, 10-rebound games this season -- all in League play.

BIG SOUTH FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORING COMBINATIONS

Since the Big South's first official men's basketball season in 1985-86, a total of 18 four-year classmate combinations have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period, with four pair reaching the mark as juniors -- including two this year in Charleston Southern junior tandem **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER**, and Radford junior duo **JAVONTE GREEN** and **R.J. PRICE**. Below is a detailed look at the four sets of junior teammates and their overall career point totals:

SPEAKING OF FOUR-YEAR SCORING COMBOS

VMI seniors **RODNEY GLASGOW** (1,291) and **D.J. COVINGTON** (1,301) are among the 18 four-year classmate combinations that have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period. They are the 7th-highest scoring four-year classmate duo with 2,592 points, and 24 points away from moving into sixth-place. UNC Greensboro's **SCOTT HARTZELL** and **BRIAN BRUNSON** hold that spot with a combined scoring total of 2,615 points as teammates from 1992-96.

BACK IN FAMILIAR TERRITORY

VMI leads the Big South and the nation in scoring with 89.4 points per game, its highest average since 2008-09 when the Keydets scored a League- and NCAA-leading 93.8 a contest. VMI, which has led the Big South in scoring six out of the last seven years -- including last season, is second all-time for most times leading the Conference in scoring offense at six. Radford owns that record with nine times.

DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern is averaging 82.9 points this season, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest. Meanwhile, CSU and VMI could mark just the second time in League history that at least two teams averaged 80.0 points in the same year. The first (and only) time was in 1992-93 when three squads averaged 80.0 points -- Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3).

RAISE YOUR GLASS FOR RODNEY

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW**, who became the 23rd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 11 against Liberty, is currently 14th all-time with 478 and needs four more dimes to move into 13th-place. He is 22 helpers away from becoming the 13th player with 500 career assists.

WHAT IS YOUR Q SCORE?

VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** leads the Big South and is the nation's second-leading freshman scorer with 20.2 points per game, and is looking to become the first freshman ever to lead the Big South in scoring, as well as the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game. The first (and only) was Liberty's **SETH CURRY** in 2008-09 (20.2). UNC Asheville freshman **ANDREW ROWSEY** is looking to join Peterson in the 20.0 points per game club, as he is at 19.6.

BIG SOUTH FRESHMEN FIVE FAB?

Five freshmen players are among the Big South's top 24 scorers -- including three in the top 10. As previously mentioned, VMI frosh **QJ PETERSON** is the League's leader with 20.2 points. UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is third at 19.6 points, while Coastal Carolina's **ELIJAH WILSON** is ninth at 16.6 markers per game. Presbyterian College's **REGGIE DILLARD** is tied for 20th at 12.2, with Winthrop freshman **KEON JOHNSON** in 24th at 11.9.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** became the 26th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Feb. 19 at Longwood. He is now the 23rd player with 1,000 points (1,287) and 700 boards (709). Green is currently 21st all-time in League annals in career rebounds, and needs 13 caroms to move into the Top 20. He is also the eighth Highlander on the Big South's 1,000/700 list and first since **ART PARAKHOUSKI** in 2009-10.

NO KNOCK ON WOOD

Longwood sophomore **LUCAS WOODHOUSE** leads the League with 6.97 assists per game and has a League-high seven games with at least 10 helpers -- the most in the Big South since Liberty's **JESSE SANDERS** had eight in 2011-12. With 202 assists on the year -- seventh-most in a single-season -- Woodhouse is just the eighth Big South player all-time to eclipse 200 assists in a season and first since Sanders in 2011-12. Woodhouse enters this week 18 assists shy of 400 in his career.

D.J.'s BLOCK PARTY - PART 1

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** leads the Big South and is fourth in the nation with 3.57 blocked shots per game -- currently the third-highest single-season average in League history. Cunningham has recorded 65 of his 82 blocks this season in his last 16 games (4.06 average) to increase his career total to 262 -- third all-time in the League record books. He surpassed former teammate **JOHN WILLIAMS** (255) to become Asheville's career leader. Now 14th all-time in League history with 767 career rebounds, Cunningham is the first player in League annals with 700 rebounds and 250 blocked shots.

D.J.'S BLOCK PARTY - PART 2

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON**, who is fifth in Big South history with 251 career blocked shots, needs five rejections to move into fourth-place. Meanwhile, Covington is the fourth player in League history with 1,000 career points (1,301), 600 career rebounds (664) and 200 career blocked shots (251). He has blocked a shot in 55 of his last 58 appearances, and since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (58 games), he has recorded 178 of his 251 career blocks in that span (=70.9 percent) for an average of 3.07 per contest.

DISCOUNT DOUBLE CHECK

UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is the League's active leader for consecutive double-figure scoring games at 24. VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** is second to Rowsey at 20 games, followed by High Point's **JOHN BROWN** (16).

THE PRICE IS RIGHT

Radford junior guard **R.J. PRICE** became the 32nd player in Big South history with 200 career treys when he eclipsed the milestone Feb. 19 at Longwood. Price has buried a three-pointer in 79 of his 90 career games, including a career-best streak of 26 consecutive games during the 2012-13 campaign. He has also made at least three 3-pointers in a game 38 times -- including 10 times this year.

RISING ROWSEY

UNC Asheville freshman **ANDREW ROWSEY** became the first frosh in League history to score 40 points in a game when he tallied a Big South-freshman record 41 at Radford on Feb. 13. It was his fourth game with at least 30 points. In League games, Rowsey leads with 22.9 markers per contest.

BURRUS' BOARDS AND BLOCKS

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS** is the 14th member of the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shot club. Burrus has scored 1,120 points, and is 46th in League history with 598 rebounds while ranking tied for 24th all-time with 122 blocked shots. He joins Big South Hall of Famer **PETER ALUMA**, who had 1,715 points, 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97, as the only Flames on the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shot list.

IT'S ACADEMIC

Coastal Carolina sophomore **MICHEL ENANGA** was named to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District Team Jan. 30, and now moves onto the national ballot for Academic All-America honors. Enanga's selection marks the third-straight year and eight out of the last nine years a Big South men's basketball player has earned Academic All-District honors. He is the first Chanticleer with this distinction since **SAM McLAURIN** in 2011-12.

TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern is third in the nation with a League-leading 10.26 three-pointers per game this season, and is looking to become the first Big South team other than VMI to average at least 10 triples a game in a single-season. CSU's average of 10.26 threes is the highest in the Big South since VMI averaged 11.32 in 2010-11. The Buccaneers' current per game tally would be sixth-highest in the League record book.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

Longwood's **TRISTAN CAREY** became the ninth player this season and 126th overall to reach 1,000 career points in the Big South Conference (Carey has scored 1,450 points at Longwood, including 416 prior to the Lancers' membership). BIG SOUTH MATCH PLAY

Radford's 18 victories this season exceed its win total from all of last year (13), and the team has secured its first winning campaign since going 19-12 in 2009-10. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina, VMI and Winthrop have exceeded their 2012-13 win totals as well (14). Campbell is one victory shy of matching last year's total of 13.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' 2012-13 season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 129. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 663 Division I wins and is 31st all-time in Division I victories. DEVANTE'S TREYS

High Point junior **DEVANTE WALLACE** tied the Big South single-game record for highest three-point field goal percentage in a League contest with his 8-of-9 performance from beyond the arc at Presbyterian on Jan. 28. Wallace's 88.9 percent (based on 7 made three-pointers) matches the mark set by Charleston Southern's **JEREMY SEXTON** against the Panthers a year ago on Jan. 19, 2013. Wallace's mark is tied for third-highest in all games in League history. Meanwhile, Wallace has made at least three 3FG in a game 11 times this season, and has hit at least one trey in all 14 of High Point's Big South games. He is shooting 59.7 percent (46-of-77) from beyond the arc in League action.

IN WILLIAM WE TRUSS

Presbyterian College's **WILLIAM TRUSS** tied a Big South single-game record with his perfect 10-of-10 field goal performance against High Point on Jan. 28. He is the sixth player in League history to post 100.0 percent from the field with at least 10 field goals, and the first since Radford's **TOM GALLAHER** (10-of-10) against UMBC on Feb. 10, 1993. Truss is just third to achieve the feat in a Conference game.

WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern junior guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 16 times in their career (nine times last season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 13-3 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 16 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

BIG SOUTH TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

With the Big South having 12 men's basketball members and divisional play, the Conference has a 16-game League schedule this season. Each team will play its divisional opponents twice (a 10-game round-robin schedule), and one game against each crossover division opponent (six games total -- three home and three road).

The Conference's tiebreaker for the divisional format, which will be used to determine the seeding of teams for the Big South Championship Tournament, is as follows:

TOURNAMENT SEEDING

The top two teams with the best overall Conference won-loss percentage in both the North and South Divisions shall receive the top four seeds in the Conference Championship Tournament. Other seeds shall be based on division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed will be determined within each division as noted below.

TIEBREAKER PROCEDURE

(A) If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;

(B) If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie;

(C) If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;

(D) If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(E) In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;

(F) If the teams are still tied, the teams' records against the highest seeded team in the division not involved in the tie would be considered, and so forth until the tie is broken;

(G) If there is still a tie, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's RPI as published by RPIRatings.com after the completion of the regular season;

(H) For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie, and;

(I) For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.

(J) If the process reduces the number of tied teams, the remaining tie will be broken by starting the tiebreaking process over.

SAAH-SATIONAL

Charleston Southern junior **SAAH NIMLEY** is 15 assists away from becoming the 24th player in Big South history with 400 career assists, and would be the 20th player with 1,000 points and 400 assists once he reaches the milestone. Nimley would become the first Buccaneer on the Big South's 400-assist list since **ED O'NEIL** (504 from 2000-04) and the third overall (**ERROL McPHERSON**, 403 from 1993-97).

30 FOR 30

Against UNC Asheville on Jan. 28, VMI guards **OJ PETERSON** (37) and **RODNEY GLASGOW** (35) became the first Big South teammates to score 30 points in the same game since VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (43) and **CHAVIS HOLMES** (30) did it against Newport News Apprentice on Dec. 10, 2007. Peterson and Glasgow were the first pair to achieve the feat in a Big South game since the 2006-07 campaign, when Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** (30) and **DWIGHT BREWINGTON** (30) reached the total against VMI on Jan. 27, 2007.

COVER CHARGE

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** has a League-high eight 20-point, 10-rebound games this season, including five in League contests. It is the most 20-point, 10-rebound games in the Big South since former teammate **STAN OKOYE** had nine such efforts last year.

BIG BYRON

Gardner-Webb senior **MIKE BYRON** became the 32nd player in Big South history with 100 career blocks when he surpassed the milestone Feb. 11 at Liberty. Byron ranks 32nd in League annals with 102 rejections and is the first Gardner-Webb player on the list.

INSTANT CLASSIC

VMI and Gardner-Webb played the first four overtime game in League history on Feb. 5, as the Keydets finally emerged with the 108-104 victory. The Keydets made last-second shots to force the first overtime, the third overtime and a fourth extra period in what is the longest game in Division I this season. The Runnin' Bulldogs' 99 field goal attempts set the Big South single-game record for a Conference match-up, while the 212 combined points is tied for the eighth-highest single-game total for a League contest.

FULL NELSON

Gardner-Webb freshman forward **TYRELL NELSON** set the Big South freshman single-game record for most rebounds with his 25 caroms against VMI on Feb. 5. He tied the League's all-time mark of 25 in the process that was first established by High Point's **ARIZONA REID** against the Keydets on Feb. 24, 2007. Nelson also tallied 24 points to register the Big South's first 20-point, 20-rebound game since Radford's **ART PARAKHOUSKI** had 30 points and 22 boards at VMI on Feb. 2, 2010.

LONGWOOD SCORES BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG 12 WIN IN 15 SEASONS

Longwood's 82-79 win at TCU on Nov. 12 was the Big South's first win over a member of the Big 12 Conference since the 1999-00 season. That year, Winthrop defeated Missouri, 51-46.

The Camels close out the regular season with road games at Radford, and at High Point on ESPNU. The HPU contest marks the fourth time the Camels will appear on the ESPN family of networks in February ... Campbell stands 4-0 vs. Radford since re-joining the Big South in 2011-12, including a 65-63 victory at Gore Arena on Jan. 22. In that game, the Camels rallied from a 13-point deficit in the second half ... The Camels defeated High Point, 74-71 in the Big South opener for both teams on Jan. 8. CU held the Panthers without a field goal over the last 4:07 of play ... CU has not won at High Point since re-joining the League (0-2). Friday's game marks the 3rd-straight year the Camels have closed the regular season at High Point ... **D.J. MASON** returned to action last Wednesday in CU's 84-81 loss at VMI and contributed 17 points and 7 rebounds ... Campbell changed its starting lineup for the first time in 28 games on Saturday when **ANTONIO KALPIC** and **ANTWON OLIVER** joined fellow senior **LEEK LEEK** in the first five. CU's fourth senior, **MARVELLE HARRIS**, missed his 11th-straight game due to injury.

HIGH POINT PANTHERS

High Point tied the program record with 26 assists at Longwood on Saturday. The Panthers also had 26 assists against Allen on Nov. 21, 2003 ... **JOHN BROWN** averaged 0.7 assists last year but is averaging 2.0 this season. He has averaged 4.5 assists in the last four games, with at least four assists each time ... High Point is 10-4 in the Big South with two regular-season games remaining and has a chance to match its 12-4 mark from last season. The 12 wins last year were a program record and HPU won its first Big South regular-season title ... HPU's current four-game winning streak matches the team's four-game streak from Jan. 25-Feb. 5. The last time High Point had two winning streaks of at least four games was 2006-07. The Panthers have won 10 of their last 12 games.

LIBERTY FLAMES

Five Flames finished with double figures scoring for the first time in the win, led by **DAVON MARSHALL**'s game-high 15 points ... Averaging 13.4 turnovers per game this year (13.0 in the Big South play), Liberty has finished with eight turnovers in each of the last two games, marking the lowest two-game total (16) this season ... The Flames' seven three-pointers on Saturday were the most since knocking down seven at Charleston Southern. Liberty's seven treys against the Camels snapped a five-game streak in which the Flames made less than five three-pointers in a contest ... Marshall (782) needs 20 points to crack The top 30 on Liberty's all-time scoring list.

LONGWOOD LANCERS

LUCAS WOODHOUSE led the Lancers with 19 points and game-high six assists against Radford last week, and now totals 382 career assists to move up to 3rd all-time in school history ... **TRISTAN CAREY** finished with 18 points and 12 rebounds for his fourth double-double of the season. Carey's highlight reel dunk late in the RU contest was No. 4 on ESPN's SportsCenter Top 10 Plays and has received more than 28,500 views on YouTube in less than five days ... Carey led Longwood with 17 points and eight rebounds against High Point, and now totals 1,450 career points to rank 8th all-time. He is 2nd in school history with 224 career three-pointers, while also establishing a single-season record for three-pointers with 88.

RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

RU had its four-game road winning streak in the Big South snapped at VMI ... Over the last six games, **JAVONTE GREEN** is averaging 20.8 points, 10.7 rebounds and 2.3 steals per game. He now has 24 career double-doubles, including four in the last six games ... With 11 points at VMI, **BRANDON HOLCOMB** has now scored in double figures in four games this season ... For the first time this season, the Highlanders have four players averaging double figures scoring -- Green (17.0), **R.J. PRICE** (12.7), **YA YA ANDERSON** (11.0) and **RASHUN DAVIS** (10.1) ... Despite coming off the bench in each of RU's 29 games this season, Davis leads the team with 3.3 assists per game ... **KYLE NOREEN** boasts a 3.7 assist to turnover ratio ... Radford leads the Big South in two-point field goal shooting (624-1185) at 52.7 percent.

VMI KEYDETS

Seniors **D.J. COVINGTON** and **RODNEY GLASGOW** accounted for 55 of VMI's 88 points in the Senior Day win over Radford. Senior guard **DREW ABSHER** also made his first career start in the contest ... VMI's 10-4 Big South record marks just the fourth time since 1954 that the Keydets have reached double-digit Conference wins in a season. Three of those efforts have come under head coach **DUGGAR BAUCOM** ... The Keydets completed the 2013-14 home slate at Cameron Hall with a 13-2 mark, which equaled the most home wins at Cameron Hall in a season ... In VMI's two wins last week, the Keydets out-rebounded foes by a margin of +11.

SOUTH DIVISION

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN BUCCANEERS

Charleston Southern capped a stretch of four games in a week -- three on the road in six days -- with a convincing 86-47 win at Presbyterian on Saturday. The win was the Bucs' sixth straight over PC, and second this year by 37+ points. The 47 points CSU allowed were the third-fewest permitted this season, and the least against a Division I opponent ... CSU's rebounding differential (+13) vs. PC was also a season-high against Division I opponents. The Bucs were particularly active on the offensive glass, grabbing 13 offensive rebounds to post a 21-2 edge in second chance points ... **ALHAJI FULLAH** tallied a career-high 14 points in Saturday's win over Presbyterian. WARREN GILLIS and freshman **ELIJAH WILSON** led the Chants in scoring last week, averaging 23.5 and 22.5 points per game, respectively ... Wilson's 45 points brought his season total to 465, which broke the CCU single-season freshman scoring record held by **JACK LEASURE** at 420 points ... Gillis scored a career-high 25 points in the loss to Winthrop while knocking down 14-15 from the free throw line ... Wilson led the way at UNC Asheville as he scored a career-high 28 points while hitting 14-19 from the charity stripe ... **BADOU DIAGNE** led the Chants on the boards as he averaged 6.5 rebounds a contest last week ... The Chants close out the regular season at home this week. CCU host Presbyterian on Wednesday and Charleston Southern on Saturday.

GARDNER-WEBB RUNNIN' BULLDOGS

Gardner-Webb improved to 3-2 this season in overtime games with its bonus time win over Winthrop. GWU also has a road overtime win over Radford and a neutral site overtime win over Morehead State. GWU's overtime loss was the legendary 4 OT duel with North Division leader VMI on February 5 ... Four Gardner-Webb players averaged double figures last week, including reserve guards **JARVIS DAVIS** (10.5 ppg) and **JOSH CASTELLANOS** (10.5 ppg, 5.0 assists per game) ... Castellanos had just one turnover in 25.5 minutes per game during last week's two wins ... GWU held a +7.5 rebounding margin in its two wins and averaged 82.0 points per game ... Saturday's win over Winthrop saw GWU dish off 22 assists on 30 made baskets with just eight turnovers in a tight game.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE BLUE HOSE

REGGIE DILLARD posted his sixth 20-point game of the season with a career-high 24 against Gardner Webb, surpassing his previous high of 23 set at VMI at the end of January ... The 39-point loss to Charleston Southern was the largest this season, the second-largest being the 37-point loss to the same Bucs in Charleston earlier this year. It was the largest overall defeat since a 45-point loss at the hands of Wisconsin in November of 2012 ... The Blue Hose look to avenge a couple of comeback losses this week with contests at Winthrop and Coastal Carolina. The Bucs dropped a 71-67 decision to the Eagles and an 84-72 decision to Coastal Carolina in the first meetings of the season. PC led both games at the half.

UNC ASHEVILLE BULLDOGS

Winthrop has hit 10 or more threes in a game nine times this season and have 218 through 27 games. -- fifth-most in program history. **ANDRE SMITH** leads the team with 62 threes while **KEON JOHNSON** is second with 51. **KEON MOORE** has 47, and is three away from giving the program its first trio with 50 3FG in the same season.

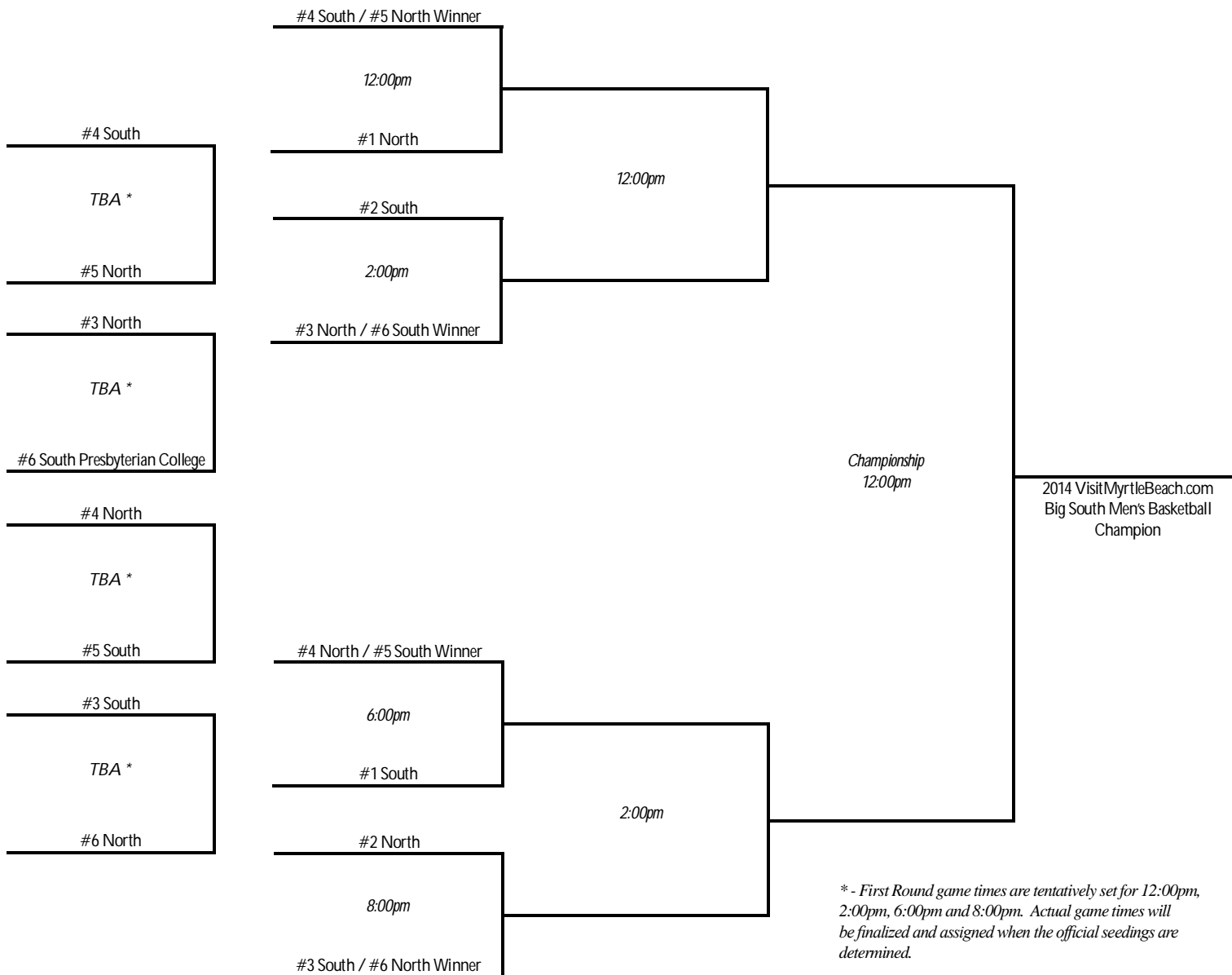
