COASTAL CAROLINA GOING DANCING FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 21 YEARS

Big South champion Coastal Carolina is making its third-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, tied for the second-most in Big South history. The Chanticleers also went to the Big Dance in 1991 and 1993. Coastal ended the second-longest NCAA Tournament drought among the current Big South members that have made an appearance in the national event. Meanwhile, the Chanticleers are embarking on their fourth postseason berth in five seasons, as CCU participated in the NIT in 2010 and 2011, and the CIT in 2012.

CLIFF ELLIS JOINS ELITE NCAA TOURNAMENT COMPANY

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** -- the first head coach in Big South history to lead his program to three different postseason tournaments -- is now the 10th head coach in Division I history to take four different programs to the NCAA Tournament. He made NCAA appearances with South Alabama (2), Clemson (3) and Auburn (3) during his previous stops, and is embarking on his 23rd career postseason trip. Ellis joins **LON KRUGER** (5), **JOHN BEILEIN, LEFTY DRIESELL, LARRY EUSTACHY**, **JIM HARRICK**, **TOM PENDERS**, **RICK PITINO**, **TUBBY SMITH** and **EDDIE SUTTON** on the list.

BIG SOUTH SENDS RECORD-TYING FOUR TEAMS TO POSTSEASON

For the second consecutive year, a record four Big South men's basketball teams are playing in the postseason -- and the first time the League is represented in the four national postseason events. COASTAL CAROLINA received the Big South's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, while HIGH POINT is making the Conference's fifth NIT appearance. The Panthers are in the postseason for the second-straight year after appearing in the CIT in 2013. VMI has accepted an invitation to participate in the Collegeinsider.com Tournament (CIT), marking the fourth time the Big South will play in that event. VMI is appearing in the postseason for the first time since the 1977 NCAA Tournament. RADFORD is the Big South's first entrant into the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), and it is the Highlanders' first postseason berth since 2009. Overall, it is the seventh consecutive season that the Big South has multiple postseason participants.

3 X 20

The Big South Conference has three 20-win teams for just the fourth time in League history. Radford won 21 games this season -- its most since winning 21 in 2008-09. The Highlanders collected 20 wins during the regular-season for the first time since 1993-94. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina has 21 wins this year, marking the third time in five seasons the Chanticleers have reached 20 victories. Winthrop sits at 20 wins, its first year at the benchmark since 2007-08 (22 wins). The three previous times the Big South had three 20-win teams were 1985-86, 1993-94 and 2008-09.

HIGH POINT -- FIRST TEAM TO START 0-2 AND WIN BIG SOUTH REGULAR-SEASON TITLE

High Point University is the first team in Big South history to win the Regular-Season title after starting the League season 0-2. The Panthers dropped their Conference opener by three points to Campbell on Jan. 8, then suffered a nine-point home loss to Radford on Jan. 10. HPU recovered from that standpoint, winning 12 of their next 14 Big South contests -- including the last six to claim the outright regular-season Championship and the Conference's automatic bid to the NIT.

ROCKIN' ROWSEY

UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is on the cusp of becoming the first freshman ever to the lead the Big South in scoring, as he finished his 2013-14 campaign with a Big South freshman-record 20.3 points per game. Currently the nation's second-leading freshman scorer, Rowsey is the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game. The first was Liberty's **SETH CURRY** in 2008-09 (20.2). VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** is looking to join Rowsey in the 20.0 points per game club, as he is at 19.4.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

High Point redshirt-sophomore and Big South Player of the Year **JOHN BROWN** is the first player in Big South history to score 1,000 career points before the end of his sophomore season. He eclipsed the milestone Feb. 26 vs. VMI, and his total of 1,044 points is the eighth-highest output by a player in his first two years in the Conference. Brown surpassed the previous freshman-sophomore high of 974 points by HPU's **NICK BARBOUR** during his freshman-sophomore seasons from 2008-10.

HOME WRECKER?

During the Conference's 96-game League season, the visiting teams went 41-55 for a 42.7 winning percentage -- the highest since 2008-09 when visiting squads finished with a 46.7 winning mark (42-48). In 2012-13, the home teams went 61-35 (=63.5 percent) during the Big South schedule.

A GAME OF MARGINS

A total of 54 of the 96 Conference games (56.3 percent) were decided by less than 10 points (4.56 average) -- including 32 that were decided by less than 5 points (2.72 margin). The remaining 42 contests had double-digit victory margins (16.62). The average margin of victory in the League season was 9.83 points. High Point had 14 of its 16 Big South contests decided by single digits, followed by VMI (11), Liberty (10), Gardner-Webb (10) and Campbell (10).

BIG SOUTH IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

Coastal Carolina is 0-2 all-time in the NCAA Tournament. The Chanticleers are making their third trip to the Big Dance, tied for second-most in Big South history.

The Big South Conference first secured an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament in 1992, sending its postseason tournament champion to the Big Dance every year, with the exception of 1995.

Winthrop garnered the League's highest seed at No. 11 in 2007. Below is a look at the Conference's NCAA Tournament history:

THE 20/20 EXPERIENCE

Nine different players have recorded at least 10 games with 20 points this season, the most in the Big South since before 2004-05. UNC Asheville freshman **ANDREW ROWSEY**, Presbyterian College junior **JORDAN DOWNING**, VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** and Longwood senior **TRISTAN CAREY** lead the League with 14 20-point games, while **JOHN BROWN** has a Conference-best nine games with at least **25** points. Rowsey is tops in 30-point games with five.

20/20 TIMES TWO ... OR FOUR

UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** (20.3) and Presbyterian College's **JORDAN DOWNING** (20.2) give the Big South multiple 20-point scorers in the same season for the first time since 2008-09 and ninth time overall. In addition, High Point's **JOHN BROWN** is averaging 19.5 points and VMI'S **QJ PETERSON** is at 19.4. The most Big South players to average 20.0 points in the same season is three in 1992-93 and 2006-07.

CROSSOVER DRIBBLE

The South Division "won" the Big South's crossover divisional match-ups for the second consecutive season, as the division finished with a 19-17 advantage over the North squads. The teams with the top crossover division records this season were High Point (5-1), Coastal Carolina (5-1) and Gardner-Webb (5-1). Last year, the South Division finished 22-14 (=61.1 percent) against the North Division.

15-FOOTERS

UNC Asheville won at least 15 games for the seventh consecutive season, the second-longest streak in Big South history. It was also their 16th 15-win season since the Conference was formed, which ties Winthrop for the second-most in League history. A League-record seven programs won at least 15 games this season, surpassing the previous high of six that was accomplished in 2009-10.

10-TAMOUNT

High Point notched back-to-back 10-win Big South seasons for the first time as League members. VMI has recorded its first 10-win League campaign since 2010-11 and the third and final time as Big South members. UNC Asheville notched its seventh consecutive 10-win Conference season and 10th overall, while Winthrop won 10 Big South games for the first time since 2009-10 and 11th overall -- extending its League record for most 10-win Conference seasons.

20/20 TIMES 12

All 12 Big South members had at least one game with two 20-point scorers, as Gardner-Webb was the final team to achieve the feat Feb. 1 at Radford. It is the first time since 2008-09 that every Big South basketball member has had two 20-point scorers in a game. WMI has had at least two 20-point scorers in a game a League-high 11 times this season, with **RODNEY GLASGOW** and **QJ PETERSON** involved in seven of those efforts. The Keydets are also 6-1 when Glasgow and Peterson score 20 points in the same contest (4-0 in Big South games).

BIG SOUTH FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORING COMBINATIONS

Since the Big South's first official men's basketball season in 1985-86, a total of 18 four-year classmate combinations have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period, with four pair reaching the mark as juniors -- including two this year in Charleston Southern junior tandem **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER**, and Radford junior duo **JAVONTE GREEN** and **R.J. PRICE**. Below is a detailed look at the four sets of junior teammates and their overall career point totals:

SPEAKING OF FOUR-YEAR SCORING COMBOS

VMI seniors **RODNEY GLASGOW** (1,349) and **D.J. COVINGTON** (1,392) are among the 18 four-year classmate combinations that have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period. They are the 6th-highest scoring four-year classmate duo with 2,741 points, and 94 points away from moving into fifth-place. **UNC Asheville's J.P. PRIMM** and **CHRIS STEPHENSON** hold that spot with a combined scoring total of 2,834 points as teammates from 2008-12.

BACK IN FAMILIAR TERRITORY

VMI leads the Big South and the nation in scoring with 87.7 points per game, its highest average since 2008-09 when the Keydets scored a League- and NCAA-leading 93.8 a contest. VMI, which has led the Big South in scoring six out of the last seven years -- including last season, is second all-time for most times leading the Conference in scoring offense at six. Radford owns that record with nine times.

Big South Men's Basketball Postseason Report • Conference Notebook • March 17, 2014

DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern averaged 81.4 points this season, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest. Meanwhile, CSU and VMI could mark just the second time in League history that at least two teams averaged 80.0 points in the same year. The first (and only) time was in 1992-93 when three squads averaged 80.0 points -- Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3).

RAISE YOUR GLASS FOR RODNEY

VMI senior RODNEY GLASGOW, who became the 23rd player in Big South history with 400 career assists when he surpassed the milestone Jan. 11 against Liberty, is two assists away from becoming the 13th player in Big South history with 500 in a career. He is the first Keydet to crack the League's 400-career assist chart.

BIG SOUTH FRESHMEN FIVE FAB?

Five freshmen players are among the Big South's top 23 scorers -- including three in the top 10. As previously mentioned, UNC Asheville frosh **ANDREW ROWSEY** is the League's leader with 20.2 points. VMI's QJ PETERSON is fourth at 19.4 points, while Coastal Carolina's ELIJAH WILSON is 10th at 16.1 markers per game. Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** is 21st at 12.3, while Presbyterian College freshman **REGGIE DILLARD** is 23rd with 12.1.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** became the 26th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Feb. 19 at Longwood. He is now the 23rd player with 1,000 points (1,350) and 700 boards (741). Green is currently 17th all-time in League annals in career rebounds, and needs 14 caroms to move into the Top 15. He is also the eighth Highlander on the Big South's 1,000/700 list and first since ART PARAKHOUSKI in 2009-10.

NO KNOCK ON WOOD

Longwood sophomore LUCAS WOODHOUSE led the League with 6.66 assists per game and had a League-high seven games with at least 10 helpers -- the most in the Big South since Liberty's JESSE SANDERS had eight in 2011-12. With 213 assists this year -- sixth-most in a single-season -- Woodhouse is just the eighth Big South player all-time to hand out 200 assists in a season and first since Sanders in 2011-12. Woodhouse enters the 2014-15 season seven assists shy of 400 in his career.

D.J.'s BLOCK PARTY - PART 1

UNC Asheville's D.J. CUNNINGHAM is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 800 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. He led the Big South and is fourth in the nation with 3.63 blocked shots per game -- the third-highest single-season average in League history. Cunningham recorded 81 of his 98 blocks this season in his last 20 games (4.05 average) to increase his career total to 278 -- third all-time in the League record books. He surpassed former teammate JOHN WILLIAMS (255) to become Asheville's career leader. Now 10th all-time in League history with 819 career rebounds, Cunningham's final points in the Big South Tournament gave him exactly 1,000 for his career.

D.J.'S BLOCK PARTY - PART 2

VMI's D.J. COVINGTON is fourth in Big South history with 262 career blocked shots. He is the third player in League history with 1,000 career points (1,392), 700 career rebounds (713) and 200 career blocked shots (262), joining Radford's TYRONE TRAVIS, who had 1,313 points, 718 boards and 215 blocked shots from 1989-94, and Asheville's D.J. CUNNINGHAM. He has blocked a shot in 58 of his last 62 appearances, and since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (62 games), he has recorded 189 of his 262 career blocks in that span (=72.1 percent) for an average of 3.05 per contest.

DISCOUNT DOUBLE CHECK

UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is the League's active leader for consecutive double-figure scoring games at 28. VMI's D.J. COVINGTON is second to Rowsey at 24 games, followed by High Point's JOHN **BROWN** (19).

THE PRICE IS RIGHT

Radford junior guard R.J. PRICE became the 32nd player in Big South history with 200 career treys when he eclipsed the milestone Feb. 19 at Longwood. Price has buried a three-pointer in 83 of his 94 career games, including a career-best streak of 26 consecutive games during the 2012-13 campaign. He has also made at least three 3-pointers in a game 41 times -- including 13 times this year.

RISING ROWSEY

UNC Asheville freshman ANDREW ROWSEY set a Big South-freshman record with 106 three-point field goals this season. He became the first frosh in League history to score 40 points in a game when he tallied a Big South-freshman record 41 at Radford on Feb. 13. It was his fourth game with at least 30 points. In League games, Rowsey finished with a Conference-best 23.0 markers per contest.

BURRUS' BOARDS AND BLOCKS

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS** ends his career one of 13 players in Big South's 1,000-point, 600-rebound and 100-blocked shot club. Burrus scored 1,170 points (T-91st), grabbed 616 rebounds (44th) and blocked 124 shots (T-23rd). He joined Big South Hall of Famer PETER ALUMA, who had 1,715 points, 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97, as the only Flames on the Big South's 1,000-point, 600-rebound and 100-blocked shot list.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty senior JOHN CALEB SANDERS and his brother and former teammate JESSE combined to score 2,619 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. John Caleb finished at 1,384 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11 and surpassed Jesse's total of 1,235 from 2008-12 on Jan. 18. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

IT'S ACADEMIC

Coastal Carolina sophomore MICHEL ENANGA was named to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District Team Jan. 30. Enanga's selection marks the third-straight year and eight out of the last nine seasons a Big South men's basketball player has earned Academic All-District honors. He is the first Chanticleer with this distinction since **SAM McLAURIN** in 2011-12.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

UNC Asheville's D.J. CUNNINGHAM became the 11th player this season and 128th overall in League history to reach 1,000 career points when he hit the milestone March 8 vs. Winthrop in the Conference Tournament. CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

VMI's DUGGAR BAUCOM and Charleston Southern's BARCLAY RADEBAUGH are the longest-tenured Big South coaches, as each is in his ninth year. Baucom's Big South tenure will end after this season with VMI's departure to the Southern Conference on July 1, 2014. Meanwhile, Baucom is fifth all-time in Big South history with 137 victories at the Institute, while Coastal Carolina's CLIFF ELLIS is sixthplace with his 134 wins at Coastal Carolina. BIG SOUTH MATCH PLAY

Radford's 21 victories this season were a +8 improvement over last season's total (13), and the team secured its first winning campaign since going 19-12 in 2009-10. It was also the Highlanders' first 20-win season since 2008-09 (also 21 wins). Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina (+7), Winthrop (+6), VMI (+5) and UNC Asheville (+1) all exceeded their 2012-13 win totals as well. High Point enters the NIT with a chance to match last season's total of 17 victories.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' 2012-13 season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 134. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 668 Division I wins and is tied with **GARRY WILLIAMS** for 29th all-time in Division I victories. DEVANTE'S TREYS

High Point junior **DEVANTE WALLACE** tied the Big South single-game record for highest three-point field goal percentage in a League contest with his 8-of-9 performance from beyond the arc at Presbyterian on Jan. 28. Wallace's 88.9 percentage (based on 7 made three-pointers) matches the mark set by Charleston Southern's **JEREMY SEXTON** against the Panthers a year ago on Jan. 19, 2013. Wallace's mark is tied for third-highest in all games in League history. Meanwhile, Wallace has made at least three 3FG in a game 12 times this season, and hit at least one trey in all 16 of High Point's Big South games. He shot a League-best 59.3 percent (51-of-86) from beyond the arc in League action.

IN WILLIAM WE TRUSS

Presbyterian College's **WILLIAM TRUSS** tied a Big South single-game record with his perfect 10-of-10 field goal performance against High Point on Jan. 28. He is the sixth player in League history to post 100.0 percent from the field with at least 10 field goals, and the first since Radford's **TOM GALLAHER** (10-of-10) against UMBC on Feb. 10, 1993. Truss is just the third to achieve the feat in a Conference game.

WINNING COMBINATION

Charleston Southern junior guards **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER** have scored 15 points in the same game 16 times in their career (nine times last season including three consecutive), and the Buccaneers are 13-3 in those games. The duo has surpassed 20 points in the same contest in four of those 16 outings, and CSU is 3-1 when they both score 20 in the same game.

SAAH-SATIONAL

Charleston Southern junior SAAH NIMLEY will enter the 2014-15 season 15 assists away from becoming the 20th player with 1,000 points and 400 assists once he reaches the milestone. Nimley would become the first Buccaneer on the Big South's 400-assist list since ED O'NEIL (504 from 2000-04) and the third overall (ERROL McPHERSON, 403 from 1993-97).

Against UNC Asheville on Jan. 28, VMI guards QJ PETERSON (37) and RODNEY GLASGOW (35) became the first Big South teammates to score 30 points in the same game since VMI's REGGIE WILLIAMS (43) and CHAVIS HOLMES (30) did it against Newport News Apprentice on Dec. 10, 2007. Peterson and Glasgow were the first pair to achieve the feat in a Big South game since the 2006-07 campaign, when Liberty's LARRY BLAIR (30) and DWIGHT BREWINGTON (30) reached the total against VMI on Jan. 27, 2007.

COVER CHARGE

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** has a League-high nine 20-point, 10-rebound games this season, including six in League contests. It is the most 20-point, 10-rebound games in the Big South since former teammate **STAN OKOYE** had nine such efforts last year.

BIG BYRON

Gardner-Webb senior MIKE BYRON became the 32nd player in Big South history with 100 career blocks when he surpassed the milestone Feb. 11 at Liberty. Byron ends his career 28th in League annals with 110 rejections and is the first Gardner-Webb player on the list.

INSTANT CLASSIC

VMI and Gardner-Webb played the first four overtime game in League history on Feb. 5, as the Keydets finally emerged with the 108-104 victory. The Keydets made last-second shots to force the first overtime, the third overtime and a fourth extra period in what is the longest game in Division I this season. The Runnin' Bulldogs' 99 field goal attempts set the Big South single-game record for a Conference match-up, while the 212 combined points is tied for the eighth-highest single-game total for a League contest.

FULL NELSON

Gardner-Webb freshman forward TYRELL NELSON set the Big South freshman single-game record for most rebounds with his 25 caroms against VMI on Feb. 5. He tied the League's all-time mark of 25 in the process that was first established by High Point's ARIZONA REID against the Keydets on Feb. 24, 2007. Nelson also tallied 24 points to register the Big South's first 20-point, 20-rebound game since Radford's ART PARAKHOUSKI had 30 points and 22 boards at VMI on Feb. 2, 2010.

LONGWOOD SCORES BIG SOUTH'S FIRST BIG 12 WIN IN 15 SEASONS

Longwood's 82-79 win at TCU on Nov. 12 was the Big South's first win over a member of the Big 12 Conference since the 1999-00 season. That year, Winthrop defeated Missouri, 51-46.

CIT VMI KEYDETS

RUI Tightenders

CBI RADFORD HIGHLANDERS

VMI last participated in postseason play in 1977 when it advanced to the Sweet 16 before falling to Kentucky in the East Regional in College Park, Md. The 2014 CIT will the fourth basketball postseason tourney overall in program history, as the Keydets also participated in the 1964 and 1976 NCAA Tournaments, reaching the Elite Eight in '76 ... The Keydets last played a Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) opponent on Feb. 23, 2013 when they traveled to Marist to participate in an ESPN BracketBusters match-up.

The game will be the first ever meeting in basketball between the Keydets and the Golden Griffins. Canisius currently holds a 21-12 record and advanced to the MAAC Semifinals before bowing to Iona, 75-72, on March 9. The Golden Griffins tied for third in the MAAC race with a 14-6 league mark ... VMI currently stands 19-12 on the season after reaching the Big South Tournament Semifinals for the sixth time in the last eight years. The Keydets, who currently lead Division I in scoring with an 87.7 average, have clinched their third winning season over the last four years.

Canisius is led by senior guard Billy Baron, who averages 24.2 points per game and is hitting 88.2% from the free throw line and 42% from 3-point range. Senior guard Chris Perez averaged 12.4 points and senior forward Chris Manhetz tops the rebounding charts with 7.1 rebounds per game.

VMI and Canisius had one common opponent in 2013-14 -- Elon. The Golden Griffins edged the Phoenix, 86-85 on Nov. 19 before the Keydets fell at Elon, 87-70, on Dec. 3.

Both teams have tasted victory in marathon games this year. VMI outlasted Gardner-Webb in 4 overtimes, 108-104 on Feb. 5, and the Golden Griffins beat Siena, 92-88, in a 3OT contest on Feb. 16.



NIT HIGH POINT PANTHERS

High Point is making its first appearance in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT). HPU's only other Division I postseason appearance was in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT) last year. HPU traveled to UC Irvine and suffered an 80-71 loss in the CIT.

Redshirt-sophomore **JOHN BROWN** has scored 584 points this season, which ranks fourth in HPU's Div. I era (since 1999-2000). The record is 742 by **ARIZONA REID** in 2007-08 ... Brown has 1,044 points in his career, which ranks 26th all-time and seventh in HPU's Division I era ... Freshman **JORGE PEREZ-LAHAM** became HPU's starting point guard for the last 15 games of the season and had 75 assists and just 21 turnovers (3.57:1 ratio) over those 15 games.

High Point has been eliminated from the Big South Tournament by a team that reached the Championship game four times in a row: UNC Asheville in 2010-11 and 2011-12 (champion both times), Liberty in 2012-13 (champion) and Winthrop in 2013-14 (runner-up).

Radford has been selected for participation in its first postseason tournament in the **MIKE JONES** era. The Highlanders will play in the 16-team College Basketball Invitational (CBI). RU opens at Oregon State on Wednesday night at 10:00pm ET.

This will be Radford's first appearance in the CBI, which is in its seventh year. Radford last appeared in the postseason in the 2009 NCAA Tournament. The Highlanders also earned a berth in the 1998 NCAA Tournament. RU is 2-5 all-time in postseason play, including games in the 1980, 1981 and 1982 NAIA District playoffs.

For the first time since the 1993-94 season, Radford won 20 regular season games and enters Wednesday's game at 21-12 ... For the second-straight year, RU increased its win total by at least seven games ... The Highlanders won six games in Jones' first season in 2010-11 and 13 in 2012-13 ... The 21 wins is tied with Coastal Carolina for the most of any team in the Big South this season ... RU is 8-7 overall on the road this season -- the lone Big South member with a .500-or-better road record in 2013-14.




NCAA TOURNAMENT COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS

The Chants are heading to their third NCAA Tournament and first since 1993. Coastal is 0-2 all-time in NCAA Tournament games, having lost to No. 2 seed Indiana (79-69) in 1991 and falling to No. 1 seed Michigan (84-53) in 1993

Freshman **ELIJAH WILSON** has crushed **CCU**'s freshman scoring and field goals made records and currently sits 10th on the CCU single-season all-time scoring list with 531 points ... Junior **WARREN GILLIS** became just the second player in CCU men's basketball history to be named Big South Tournament MVP after **TONY DUNKIN** won the award in both 1991 and 1993.

Head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** will lead a team to the NCAA Tournament for the eighth time in his head coaching career, where he holds a 6-7 record ... With Coastal's bid to the NCAA Tournament, Ellis becomes the 10th coach in NCAA Division I history to take four different programs (South Alabama, Clemson, Auburn and Coastal Carolina) to the Big Dance. He is the only coach to take four programs hailing from just two states (Alabama and South Carolina). Ellis and Syracuse head coach **JIM BOEHEIM** are also the only two active head coaches who both coached in the 1979 NCAA Tournament.
