Murphy batted .800 (8-for-10) with six runs batted in, five hits, six stolen bases, three doubles, a .867 on-base percentage and a 1.600 slugging percentage to help lead the Lancers to a 3-1 record last week. The sophomore shortstop started the week with a 3-for-3 performance against Towson - including a home run and a double, while adding two RBI and scoring three runs in a 9-1 win. She added another 3-for-3 game at the plate against Lafayette with a pair of doubles, two stolen bases and three RBI as the Lancers picked up a 7-2 win. Murphy added a triple in a 1-for-1 game in the second matchup of the week with Lafayette, driving in a run, stealing two bases and reaching on a walk and a hit-by-pitch in an 8-0 victory.

CAMPBELL

Campbell played Elon in a mid-week matchup Wednesday, Feb. 19 at Amanda Littlejohn Stadium and defeated the Phoenix 9-2. **MILLY MARTINET** had a three run home-run in the first inning, and then Campbell added a six run third inning to maintain a lead throughout the game ... Campbell traveled to the Frost Classic of Chattanooga to play in five games, Feb 21-23. The Camels went 2-3 in the tournament. CU defeated Toledo 6-1 and Middle Tennessee 6-3. **COURTNEY ROBERTS** was credited with the win for the Camels in the circle in the game against Toledo. Olivia Scarborough earned a save in that match up as well. Freshman **KATIE BAKER** earned the win in the game against Middle Tennessee, while **MORGAN EISENGA** earned a save ... Campbell was defeated by Tennessee Tech (6-5) in nine innings, and fell to Austin Peay (8-7) in eight innings. The final loss of the weekend came to Chattanooga 3-1 on Sunday to close out the Frost Invitational ... Campbell travels to N.C. Central to play a doubleheader, Tuesday starting at 3 p.m. The Fighting Camels then travel to Clearwater, Fla. to participate in the USF Under Armour Invitational.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went 1-3 overall last weekend, topping Wichita State on Friday afternoon, while falling to the Shockers, Florida State and Northern Iowa at the Unconquered Classic ... The Buccaneers move to 7-5-1 overall on the season heading into the third CSU Tournament this upcoming weekend ... **JESSICA BROCK** had a pair of hits in both games on Friday, while **GEORGI DELIO** and **HAYES HOLDSWORTH** both had doubles on the day, but the Bucs fell in both games ... Charleston Southern took the opening game of the Unconquered Classic on Saturday afternoon, topping Wichita State 3-2 behind a game-winning two-run blast by **ARI TEDESCO** and a strong pitching performance by **JENNIFER GILES** ... CSU was unable to keep the momentum in falling to the Panthers in the nightcap, 9-4 ... **STEPHANIE SBARDELLA** and **MARCI CHRISTIAN** both added home runs on the day for the CSU offense ... CSU hosts USC Upstate on Tuesday, before hosting Appalachian State, Eastern Illinois and Colgate over the weekend.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal went 1-2 in three games played in the Lipton Invitational at the University of Florida. The Chants fell to Georgia Southern on the opening day and Troy in their second game before evening the score vs. Georgia Southern with a 2-1 victory Saturday night ... **ASHLEY BAGWELL** pitched her first career one-hitter in the win, while also becoming the second Chanticleer pitcher to reach the 500 mark for career strikeouts. She had four in the game and now has 501 for her career ... **BRI CHIUSANO** batted a team-high 400 in the tournament, tallying at least one hit in each game and has now hit safely in all nine of CCU's games this season. Chiusano was caught stealing for the first time in her career in the second Georgia Southern game, ending a run of 38 consecutive successful stolen base attempts. Chiusano has had a hit in all six games this season and scored at least one run in five of the six contests. She leads the team with eight runs and seven stolen bases ... Freshman **AMANDA DANEKER** has a team-best three multi-hit games and is third on the squad with a .353 average.

GARDNER-WEBB

SAMANATHA MEENAGHAN continued her strong start to the season last week, batting .429 against perhaps the Runnin' Bulldogs' most difficult competition yet to raise her season batting average to .488 ... **JESSICA CHILDERS** is leading the pitching staff with a 2.10 earned run average this season, making six appearances and pitching five complete games ... Freshmen **MEGAN CHAMPION** and **MEGAN GIBBONS** have combined to drive in eight runs thus far, including a long ball for Champion ... Meenaghan has reached base in all but two games, recording a team-high eight multi-hit games thus far ... Gardner-Webb hosts North Carolina A&T on Wednesday before heading to Rock Hill, S.C. this weekend to take on Cleveland State, Robert Morris, Northern Colorado and Wagner College at the Winthrop University Tournament.

LIBERTY

Liberty (2-10) went winless at the Spartan Classic, hosted by USC Upstate, a team receiving votes in the most recent national polls ... The Lady Flames got two hits from **KATIE ZAVODNY**, **SAMMI SHIVOCK** and **BLAIR LAWRENCE** in an 8-7 setback to Western Carolina on Saturday, while Cassidy McCoy had two hits against the Catamounts on Sunday ... Zavodny was named to the Spartan Classic All-Tournament team ... Zavodny stole her team-leading eighth base of the season, increasing her program record to 87 (fourth all-time in Big South history). She also entered ninth place at Liberty with 103 career runs ... Following last week's games, Shivock moved into seventh place in program history in both career runs scored (105) and career RBIs (97) ... The Lady Flames look to get back on the winning track, heading to Charlotte for the 49er Invitational to compete in five games.

LONGWOOD

Longwood went 3-1 in its first outing of the year at its annual Spring Classic Tournament ... The team defeated Towson, 9-1, in six innings and Lafayette, 7-2, on Saturday before defeating Lafayette, 8-0, in five innings and falling to Towson, 1-0, in eight innings on Sunday ... Each of Longwood's three pitchers recorded one win in the circle over the weekend, including freshman Jenna Carnes, who allowed just one hit with two outs in the final inning of the squad's mercy-rule victory ... Following the first weekend of competition sophomore Emily Murphy leads the team offensively with an .800 average (8-10), 6 RBI and a 1.600% slugging percentage ... The Lancers will travel to Tucson, Ariz. to play five games as part of the Wildcat Invitational hosted by the University of Arizona from Feb. 28-March 2.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian played just twice last week, splitting a series with Furman ... **SHELBY PETIK** highlighted a 12-5 win over the Paladins with a grand slam in the third inning to give the Blue Hose the early 5-0 lead ... **KATIE BROWN** pitched a complete game in the one-run extra-inning loss, striking out two and surrendering just one unearned run off four hits ... Early in the season, a couple of players are already making their mark offensively ... **KERSTEN LEGACKI** leads the team with a .409 batting average with her nine-of-22 effort at the plate ... **MIRANDA ROGERS**, a freshman, is eight-of-22 with two doubles, a home run and seven RBI ... She is batting .364

RADFORD

Radford finally got its season started last week and went 2-4, picking up wins against Charlotte and Middle Tennessee ... In the opener at Charlotte, RU rallied from a 4-1 deficit and hung on for the one-run win ... Freshman **JULIE GARDNER** doubled and homered in her first two collegiate at bats with the long ball putting RU ahead for good in the fourth ... Freshman **ABBY MORROW** earned the save in her first collegiate appearance and two after two appearances ... Seven of RU's nine newcomers appeared for the Highlanders with six of them starting at least one game ... **BECKY MANTEL** got hit on the first pitch of the season and was plunked five times in the first three games, including three against Middle Tennessee, matching her own single game mark... She entered the season tied for third with 20 and moved into second surpassing **Nichole Beall** (24) with her 25th against the Blue Raiders... Freshmen, **KAYLA BISHTON**, **SUMMER ROBINSON** and Gardner all recorded their first collegiate hits, while sophomore **HAYLEY TABORA** recorded her first three RBI on first collegiate extra base hit.

WINTHROP

MCKENZI CORN extended her current hitting streak to six games as she has reached base in 12-of-13 games this season en route to being named to the All-Tournament team ... The Eagles will play their first home games of the season this coming weekend as they host the Combat Inv. Beginning Friday ... Winthrop is 3-2 in the last five home openers ... Winthrop suffered its fourth straight shutout in the loss to Furman Saturday evening (3-0 loss) and have now lost five straight for the first time since the team lost the last six of the 2012 season ... It was the first time the Eagles were shutout in four straight games since 1992 ... The Eagles were scoreless for 32.2 innings before **ALEX WHITE**'s RBI single in the 6th inning vs. Western Carolina ... During the four game losing streak the Eagles managed just 13 hits and left 15 runners stranded and were 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position ... Of the 13 hits during the losing streak, only one was for extra bases ... The offense wasn't the only struggle during the losing streak as the pitching staff posted an 8.59 ERA during that stretch ... The pitchers combined for 18 strikeouts, 11 walks and 10 extra base hits (5 homers) during that four-game stretch.
