FANNING THE FLAMES -- LIBERTY TABBED PRESEASON FAVORITE

Fort the 16th time in the last 17 years, Liberty is the preseason women's basketball favorite for the 2013-14 season. The Lady Flames received 13 of the 25 first-place votes and 261 out of a possible 275 points. Liberty will have two starters and nine letterwinners back from last year's Big South championship and NCAA Tournament squad. Winthrop was voted second with 256 points and 11 first-place bids. Campbell was picked third with 206 points.

McCLANAHAN VOTED PRESEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Winthrop senior **DEQUESHA McCLANAHAN** is the 2013-14 Big South Women's Hoops Preseason Player of the Year. McClanahan is the reigning two-time Big South Player of the Year and was the League's Freshman of the Year in 2010-11. She is looking to become the first player with three consecutive Player of the Year Awards since Liberty's Katie Feenstra from 2003-05. McClanahan led the League in scoring for the second-straight year in 2012-13 with 19.8 points per game and was also tops with 5.8 assists per game.

PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH

Joining McClanahan on the Preseason All-Big South Team is Campbell's **KIERA GAINES**, High Point's **STACIA ROBERTSON**, Longwood's **DAEISHA BROWN** and Liberty's **EMILY FRAZIER**. Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** and **SCHAQUILLA NUNN** from Winthrop rounded out the Preseason All-Conference Team.

NEW FACES ON THE SIDELINE

The Big South has two new coaches on the sideline this season. **JAIDA WILLIAMS** is the new skipper at Coastal Carolina, while **MIKE McGUIRE** took over at Radford.

MAGIC WAND-A

With Campbell's win over Western Carolina earlier this season, **WANDA WATKINS** picked up her 500th career win. She is currently the 27th active coach to reach the milestone, while being one of six that have been at the same institution for at least 33 years.

EAGLES, EAGLES, EAGLES!!!

Winthrop defeated Florida Gulf Coast, 65-61, in the first round of the WNIT last march, marking the Big South's first women's basketball postseason win since 2005. It was Winthrop's first postseason win in women's basketball since becoming a Division I member in 1986, and it is also the Big South's third-ever victory in the WNIT.

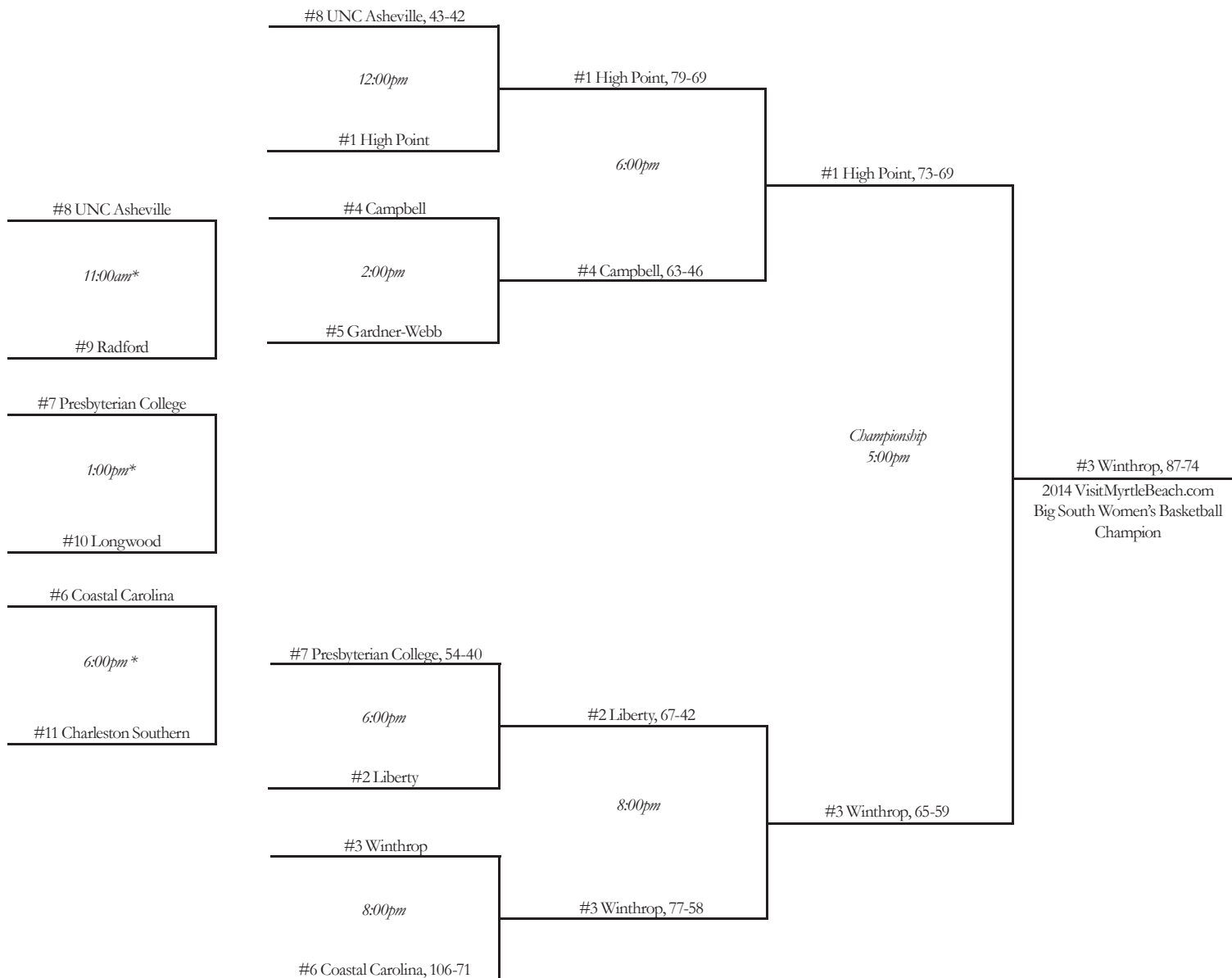

THE COUNT DOWN BEGINS

Winthrop's **DEQUESHA MCCLANAHAN** became the League's all-time leading scorer this season as she currently has 2,255 career points. The old record of 2,154 points is held by Elen Kisseleva of Liberty who held the record for 13 years.

GREEN MACHINE

CATRINA GREEN of Garden-Webb currently the Big South's active leading rebounder with 1,012 career boards. She is currently tied for No. 6 all-time in the Big South. Meanwhile, Green is became the 12th member of the Big South's 1,000 points, 500-rebound and 100-blocked shots club over the Christmas break. She currently has 1,241 points (No. 43 all-time) and 162 rejections.

MILLIS CENTER NORTH - TIED 12 YEAR OLD RECORD

With High Point's 94-89 2OT win at Liberty on Jan. 30 inside the Vines Center, the Panthers became the first Big South team to win three-straight road games at Liberty since UNC Greensboro posted wins during the 1994, 1995 and 1996 seasons.

IN RANGE WHEN SHE ENTERS THE GYM - 1,000 POINTS FOR CAREER

Presbyterian College's **KARLEE TAYLOR** ranks No. 2 all time in the Big South Conference in career three-pointers. She currently has 264 for her career. Taylor made 85 treys last season (7th most in League history). She also scored her 1,000th career point on Jan. 18. She is currently ranked No. 53 in the League with 1,179 points.

BROKE THE STREAK

With its win over Charleston Southern on Dec. 2, UNC Asheville snapped a 29-game conference losing streak that dated back to the 2011-12 season. The win marked head coach **BRENDA MOCK KIRKPATRICK**'s first career Big South win.

BROKE THE STREAK (PART TWO)

UNC Asheville broke another streak this season that dated back to the 2006-07 season. On Jan. 18, the Bulldogs knocked off Liberty, 83-80 in OT to snap a 16-game losing streak to the Lady Flames. The win also marked the first time Asheville had defeated Liberty in Asheville since the 1996-97 season.

PHENOMENAL FORTIFICATION

The Presbyterian College Blue Hose have made it extremely hard for opponents to put up points this season. The Blue Hose are currently No. 2 in the nation as they are holding opponents to just 53.5 points per game.

DIAPER DANDIES

Two Big South players have earned a combined 14-of-16 Big South Freshman of the Week nods this season. Winthrop's **ERICA WILLIAMS** of Winthrop and **KAYLAH KEYS** of High Point each set the Big South standard for Freshman of the Week nods in a season as each player earned seven nods.

KEY(S)FENSE

High Point freshman standout Keys has been HPU's go-to player for offense during the Conference season. She is currently ranked No. 1 among all Big South players with an average of 20.3 points per game in Conference-only contests.

JUMP AROUND

The Liberty Flames have established themselves as one of the top rebounding teams in the nation. The Lady Flames currently rank No. 1 in the nation as they are averaging a +15.2 rebound margin... Gardner-Webb ranks just outside the Top 25 as it is ranked 26th with a +7.3 rebound margin.

WOMAN OF STEAL

Charleston Southern's **DJ FOWLER** has been creating havoc for opponents of the defensive side of the ball this season. She is currently ranked No. 3 in Division I with 3.04 steals per game.

DOYEN HER THING

Radford's **AYANA AVERY** leads the Big South Conference with 95 triples on the season... She is currently ranked No. 9 in Division I with 3.17 three-pointers per game. She tops the Radford roster and is ranked No. 3 in the League with 16.3 ppg in Conference-only contests.

Campbell finished with a 19-12 overall record, going 13-7 in the conference and making the semifinals of the league tournament...The Lady Camels defended their home court this year, posting an 11-3 record in Gore Arena...The team is 31st in the nation with 16.2 assists per game...Senior **ROSLYN PRESLEY** and junior **KIERA GAINES** were named second team all-conference and Gaines was also named Defensive Player of the Year... Presley posted five double-doubles this season... and was second in the BSC for scoring (16.5), sixth for offensive rebounds (3.45), and sixth for FG pct. (48.7) in league games... Gaines finished ranked No. 2 in the League with 6.10 defensive rebounds per game and was third in the Big South in total rebounding with 9.1 rebounds per outing...She is No. 6 in the Big South with 1.84 steals per contest...Gaines and senior **ASHLEY JAMES** each met the 500 rebound milestone this season...Coach **WANDA WATKINS** claimed her 500th career win with a 73-60 win over Western Carolina and is one of six DI head coaches to complete 32 seasons at the same institution.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern saw their season come to an end in the first round of the 2014 Big South Conference Tournament, falling to Coastal Carolina.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina, under the direction of first-year head coach Jaida Williams, concluded its season with a 15-16 overall record ... The Chanticleers finished even in Big South play with a 10-10 mark, earning the No. 6 seed in the 2014 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South basketball Championship ... Coastal defeated 11th-seeded Charleston Southern 106-71 in the tournament's opening round before falling 77-58 to No. 3 seed and eventual tournament championship Winthrop in the quarterfinal round ... The win over Charleston Southern was Coastal's first conference tournament victory since 2010 ... The 106 points scored against the Buccaneers were the most by a single team in a Big South Tournament game ... **ANGELICA HENRY** turned in a historic effort against the Bucs, recording the first triple-double in both conference tournament and Coastal Carolina history with 30 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists ... In addition, Henry became the 12th Chanticleer to score 1,000-plus points with her basket at the 5:03 mark in the second half against the Bucs ... **ALEX PUCKETT** and **AJ JORDAN** joined Henry in Coastal's record setting offensive onslaught with 28 and 26 points, respectively, making the trio the first in league history to score 20-plus points in a tournament game ... Coastal shot a season and conference tournament record 63.3 percent from the field in the opening round ... Coastal Carolina's senior class of Henry, Puckett and **KATELYN CONNOR** concluded their careers with a 51-66 overall record.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Runnin' Bulldogs capped the 2013-14 season with a 16-14 overall record, finishing fifth in the Big South regular season standings with an 11-9 mark in league play ... Gardner-Webb made Paul Porter Arena a fortress this season, winning 13 of 15 on its home floor ... Senior **CATRINA GREEN** closed out her Runnin' Bulldog career with her best season to date, averaging a double-double with 14.3 points and 10.9 rebounds per game while earning a spot on the Big South All-Conference Second Team ... The Greensboro, N.C. native became the first player in the school's Division I era to record 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in her career, finishing her tenure with the Runnin' Bulldogs ranked 11th in scoring (1,241 points) and first in rebounding (1,012) while also recording 162 career blocks ... Fellow senior **JASMINE DALE** averaged a career-high 11.2 points this season to conclude her career with 1,057 points, which ranks 17th on the program's all-time scoring list ... Junior **JESSICA HEILIG** averaged 10.3 points and 5.7 rebounds per game, while sophomores **OLIVIA PARKER** and **CANDACE BROWN** each averaged at least 6.9 points and 6.0 rebounds per game.

HIGH POINT

The High Point University women's basketball team won the Big South regular season championship and advanced to the tournament title game before falling to Winthrop ... The Panthers set a program record with 22 overall wins and 16 Big South wins ... HPU will play in its third WNIT on Thursday at Bowling Green ... This is the first-ever meeting between HPU and the Falcons ... HPU has never won a WNIT game with losses to Charlotte in 2007 and NC State in 2012 ... Freshman **KAYLAH KEYS** set HPU's single-season scoring record with 570 points, breaking **CHEYENNE PARKER**'s record of 536 from last year ... Keys went 17-of-17 from the free-throw line in the Big South Tournament and was named to the All-Tournament team along with **STACIA ROBERTSON** ... Keys set the HPU single-season record for free-throws made with 146 this season.

LIBERTY

Liberty finished the 2013-14 season with a 20-11 record, winning 20 or more games for the seventh consecutive season and the 16th time in the last 18 years ... However, the Lady Flames will not play in a postseason tournament for just the second time in the last 18 seasons (also 2006-07) ... Liberty went 15-5 in Big South play to tie Winthrop for second place in the conference standings ... It was the Lady Flames' 15th straight season with 10 or more conference victories ... Liberty reached the Big South Championship semifinal round for the 18th year in a row ... At +15.2, Liberty is on track to lead the nation in rebound margin for the third year in a row ... If things end up that way, the Lady Flames would become the first team to do so since Louisiana Tech topped the nation in rebound margin for four straight seasons between 1987 and 1990 ... Liberty also got the job done on the perimeter, setting a program single-season record with 175 three-pointers made ... **ASHLEY RININGER** was a first team All-Big South performer, giving the Lady Flames a first team all-conference member for the 18th straight season ... The redshirt sophomore also became Liberty's first Big South Scholar-Athlete of the Year since **MEGAN FRAZEE** in 2009 ... **MICKAYLA SANDERS** and **SIMONE BROWN** were both voted to the Big South All-Freshman Team, giving Liberty multiple all-freshman honorees for the first time since 2002.

LONGWOOD

Longwood finished 2013-14 with an 8-22 overall record. The squad earned the No. 10 seed for the VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Championship before facing a 54-40 setback against No. 7 Presbyterian in a first-round game on March 4. The teams battled back-and-forth for much of the contest with 12 lead changes, and were tied for the final time at 36-36, before the Blue Hose outscored the Lancers, 18-4, in the last seven minutes of play. Sophomore **DAEISHA BROWN** paced the team with 15.3 points per game this season. Classmate **RAVEN WILLIAMS** has added to the offensive effort with 11.4 points per game, while sophomore **KYNDAL SKER-SICK** and redshirt-senior Heather Tobeck average 9.1 and 7.0 points, respectively. Sophomore **KHALILAH ALI** led the Lancers on the glass with 5.9 rebounds per game, while Brown added 4.9. Redshirt-sophomore **JESSICA PARKER** was named to the league's All-Academic Team prior to the start of the tournament. As a team, Longwood shot 33.9% (591-1741) from the floor, including 26.2% (162-619) from beyond the arc, and 68.2% (352-516) from the foul line.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Presbyterian College women's basketball team went 1-1 at the 2014 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Championship, picking up a first round win over Longwood, 54-40, before falling to Liberty, 67-42. PC picked up its Division I Big South Championship win with Tuesday's victory... **KEYONNA ALLEN** scored 16 points against Longwood, setting a new Big South Championship record for the Blue Hose... **KARLEE TAYLOR** ends the season as the team's scoring leader, averaging 12.1 points per game... **KEYONNA ALLEN** set a new PC Division I record with 7.0 rebounds per game and 218 rebounds, becoming the first PC player in the Division I era to tally 300 points and 200 rebounds... The Blue Hose ended the season with eight wins in their final 11 games. The Blue Hose graduate three seniors in Taylor, **SHERECE SMITH** and **MEGAN SCHAFF** and will return 11 players to the roster in 2014-15.

RADFORD

UNC Asheville used a 16-3 run and a buzzer-beater by Shonese Jones to complete a late second-half comeback Tuesday as the Bulldogs prevailed, 43-42, over Radford in the first round of the 2014 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Women's Basketball Championship at The HTC Center... **AYANNA AVERY** nearly finished with a double-double, scoring 11 points and snaring nine rebounds. She knocked down 3-of-6 from long range to finish the season with 95, which is a single-season record for the Highlanders. Ross also flirted with a double-double, tallying eight points and eight rebounds. Radford shot 35.8 percent for the game... The Highlanders have nine players eligible to return for their 2014-15 season.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 1-1 on the week, defeating Radford in the opening round of the 2014 VisitMyrtleBeach.com Big South Championship on Tuesday before falling to High Point on Thursday to end the season... The 11 wins for Asheville are the most since the 2010-11 season, when the Bulldogs won 12 games. The seven conference victories for the Bulldogs are also to most wins in league play since they went 7-9 during the 2008-09 season... Junior guard **SHONESE JONES** reached 1,000 points for her career on Saturday against Coastal Carolina, becoming the 14th player in school history to reach that mark... Freshman **KJ WEAVER** led the team and was fourth in the Big South in blocks with 46 on the season.

WINTHROP

Winthrop will be facing Duke in the first round of the Women's NCAA Championship, but the two teams will need to have an early wake up call as game time is set for 11 a.m. on ESPN2. The Eagles will have a 6:30 a.m. shoot-around on Saturday at Cameron Indoor Stadium. The Eagles and Blue Devils have played just once. That game came back on Dec. 9, 1986—the first year at Winthrop was an NCAA Div. I member. Duke won that game 80-45. About 250 fans joined the team on Monday night for a Selection Show Party.
