She went 3-for-4 against Youngstown State with four RBI, three hits and a homerun in an 8-6 win. In a 5-4 victory over Wright State, Andrea posted two hits and scored a run. She went 1-for-3 with an RBI and a run scored in Winthrop's 5-3 triumph over Marist, before adding another run score and two RBI in a 2-for-3 game at the plate against Eastern Kentucky (5-1) to cap a perfect week for the Eagles. The award is her first of the Player of the Week honor this season.

CAMPBELL

The Camels traveled to participate in the Tennessee Invitational in Knoxville, Tenn. Campbell went 0-4 on the weekend falling to Western Kentucky, No. 2 Tennessee, Georgia Southern, and College of Charleston ... CU fell to No. 2 Tennessee 1-0 in the second game of the Invitational. The game was scoreless going into the bottom of the seventh, when the Volunteers scored one run to win the game ... Campbell travels to play North Carolina, Tuesday March 11. CU returns home March 12 to take on Syracuse.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went 1-4 overall on the week, falling in the first four games of the UCLA/CSUN Invitational before topping tournament host Cal State Northridge in the finale, 2-1 ... JESSICA BROCK led the Buccaneers on the week with a .400 batting average, including hitting three doubles over the series, while GEORGI DELIO had two RBI and two runs scored to pace the CSU offense on the week ... CHEYENNE GANDARA led the CSU pitching inside the circle, picking up her second complete game of the season in the Buccaneers 2-1 victory over the Matadors ... Charleston Southern opens up Big South play this week, traveling to Winthrop on Wednesday and Thursday, while hosting Longwood during the weekend series.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 3-1 in four games played at the Chanticleer Classic, which was delayed two days by rain ... The Chanticleers won five straight before Sunday's loss to Furman ... Coastal plays games Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday this week, totaling eight games in that span, which completes its pre-conference schedule

GARDNER-WEBB

AMANDA GOMES batted .417 last week as Gardner-Webb battled Furman and Samford, posting a 1-4 record while falling by a combined seven runs in the four losses ... Gomes drove in four runs with five hits on the week, including three doubles ... She opened the week with a 2-for-4 effort in the second game against Furman, driving in a run with two doubles ... The junior from Coral Gables, Fla. added to her totals in the second game of a doubleheader against Samford, going 2-for-3 with a double and three RBI as the Runnin' Bulldogs walked off with a 12-11 win ... Gomes reached base four times in the series finale on Sunday, drawing three walks and adding a base hit.

LIBERTY

Liberty (2-18) went 0-3 at the Courtyard Marriott Oklahoma Tournament, falling to No. 20/21 Tulsa, defending national champion No. 19/13 Oklahoma and Western Illinois ... First-year head coach DOT RICHARDSON threw out the ceremonial first pitch prior to Liberty's game at No. 19/13 Oklahoma. She then coached against WIU, where she was an AlAW All-American before transferring to UCLA ... SAMMI SHIVOCK reached base on six out of her seven plate appearances on the weekend, and also stole two bases. She drew three walks against Western Illinois, and is the 11th player in program history with 50 or more career walks ... Facing the defending national champions for the first time in program history, Liberty took a 3-0 lead on a first-inning three-run homer by Kelby Allen, before the Oklahoma Sooners came back to win, 18-3 ... KATIE ZAVODNY stole her team-leading 14th base of the season, increasing her program record to 93 (one shy of third all-time in Big South history) ... Sophomore RHP ANNAH JO BRITTINGHAM tossed a complete game against Western Illinois Sunday, and also batted 2-for-3 against the Leathernecks ... The Lady Flames travel to the nation's capital, and will face George Washington in a doubleheader on Wednesday, before opening up conference play at home against Campbell on Friday and Saturday.

LONGWOOD

The Lancers went 3-2 last week to improve to 9-5 overall this year ... After dropping a hard-fought, 1-0 decision in the bottom of the seventh at Arizona State on March 4, the squad won three of four games at its Longwood Invitational Tournament over the weekend. The Lancers split a pair of games on March 8, defeating Rhode Island, 9-1, in six innings before falling to Delaware State, 9-4. On March 9, the team wrapped up the tournament with bad-to-back, 8-4 wins against Delaware State and the University of Delaware ... Last week, Megan Baltzell went 7-15 (.467) at the plate, while Adams hit .353 (6-17). Each of the team's three pitchers picked up one win in the circle, led by Jenna Carnes, who allowed no earned runs with three strikeouts in the win against URI ... Through 14 games, Megan Baltzell paces Longwood with a .463 average and 12 RBI. Emily Murphy is also hitting .405 with a team-best 10 walks. Chelsea Sciacca leads the squad with eight doubles, while Carly Adams totals three home runs ... The squad is slated to host George Mason in a doubleheader beginning at 3:30 on Wednesday, but that may change to Tuesday due to expected inclement weather.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC went 2-1 on the week, earning wins over Georgia State ... Freshman Hope Rogers continues to lead the Blue Hose offensively with a .429 batting average ... In 16 games as the starting shortstop she has collected 21 hits, including five doubles and three home runs ... She has hit three home runs and driven in 13 RBI, posting a .714 slugging percentage and a .451 on base percentage ... The 4-3 win over Georgia State marked the first time this season the Blue Hose have rallied after trailing past the fourth inning ... PC rallied with three runs in the fifth to erase a two-run deficit and take the one-run lead.

RADFORD

Radford picked up an 11-inning win (2-1) over Towson (at Elon) and went 1-2 this weekend in three contests at Elon ... Senior JESSIE HUTCHENS had a strong weekend, going 6-for-10 with two home runs, including the game-winner in the top of 11th vs. the Tigers ... She also made her debut in the leadoff spot in the final two games and was 3-for-5 at the plate and reached base safely in six of her eight plate appearances (.750 OBP) ... Freshman KAYLA BISHTON recorded her first collegiate home run, a two-run shot against Towson on Sunday ... Radford's pitching staff held Towson and Elon, who both bat above .300, to a .217 average, including ABBY MORROW and RACHAEL WALTERS with identical .182 average.

WINTHROP

Winthrop is in the midst of its longest winning streak since 2007. The Eagles extended the streak to eight last week, going 4-0 at the Winthrop/Adidas Invitational in Rock Hill, S.C. ... WU defeated Youngstown State (8-6), Wright State (5-4), Marist (5-3) and Eastern Kentucky (5-1) ... MEL ANDREA paced the Eagles, going 8-for-14 with six RBI and four runs scored ... In the circle, SUTTON WATSON went 2-0 striking out eight ... Winthrop kicks off Conference play on March 12 when Charleston Southern travels to Terry Field for a doubleheader starting at 5:00pm.
