VMI IS FIRST BIG SOUTH TEAM TO WIN MULTIPLE GAMES IN POSTSEASON

VMI has advanced to the Semifinals of the Collegeinsider.com Tournament (CIT) following its 92-90 win at Ohio on March 26. The Keydets are now the first Big South team to play in the month of April and will host Yale on Tuesday, April 1 with a berth in the Championship game on the line. VMI opened with a 111-100 first round win at Canisius on March 18, and a 106-95 second round home victory over IPFW on March 22. It is the Big South's most victories in the CIT and fourth overall, joining Liberty's triumph in 2009. For VMI, it is the Keydets' most postseason wins since the 1976 NCAA Tournament. Coupled with Radford, the Big South's four postseason wins this year are a League record.

RADFORD SCORES BIG SOUTH'S FIRST CBI VICTORY

Radford advanced to the Quarterfinals of the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) following its 96-92 win at Oregon State on March 19. It was the Highlanders' first Division I postseason victory, and first postseason win since the 1981 NAIA District 19 Playoffs. Radford fell in the quarterfinal round at Old Dominion, 82-59, on March 24.

COASTAL CAROLINA DANCED FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 21 YEARS

Big South champion Coastal Carolina made its third-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, tied for the second-most in Big South history. The Chanticleers also went to the Big Dance in 1991 and 1993. Coastal ended the second-longest NCAA Tournament drought among the current Big South members that have made an appearance in the national event. The 16-seeded Chanticleers led No. 1 seed Virginia at halftime, 35-30 -- the ninth time the 16 seed led at intermission. CCU eventually fell to the Cavaliers, 70-59. It was Coastal's fourth postseason berth in five seasons, as the Chants participated in the NIT in 2010 and 2011, and the CIT in 2012.

CLIFF ELLIS JOINS ELITE NCAA TOURNAMENT COMPANY

Coastal Carolina head coach CLIFF ELLIS -- the first head coach in Big South history to lead his program to three different postseason tournaments -- is the 10th head coach in Division I history to take four different programs to the NCAA Tournament. He made NCAA appearances with South Alabama (2), Clemson (3) and Auburn (3) during his previous stops, and made his 23rd career postseason trip last week. Ellis joins LON KRUGER (5), JOHN BEILEIN, LEFTY DRIESELL, LARRY EUSTACHY, JIM HARRICK, TOM PENDERS, RICK PITINO, TUBBY SMITH and EDDIE SUTTON on the list.

RECORD-TYING FOUR BIG SOUTH TEAMS IN POSTSEASON

For the second consecutive year, a record four Big South men's basketball teams advanced to the postseason -- and the first time the League is represented in the four national postseason events. COASTAL CAROLINA received the Big South's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, while HIGH POINT made the Conference's fifth NIT appearance. The Panthers reached the postseason for the second-straight year after appearing in the CIT in 2013. VMI is participating in the Collegeinsider. com Tournament (CIT), marking the fourth time the Big South is playing in that event, as well as the school's first postseason appearance since the 1977 NCAA Tournament. RADFORD is the Big South's first-ever entrant into the 16-team College Basketball Invitational (CBI), and it is the Highlanders' first postseason berth since 2009. Overall, it is the seventh consecutive season that the Big South has multiple postseason participants.

4 X 20

The Big South Conference has four 20-win teams for the first time in League history. Radford won 22 games this season -- its first 20-win season since 2008-09. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina tallied 21 wins this year, marking the third time in five seasons the Chanticleers have reached 20 victories. Winthrop posted 20 wins, its first year at the benchmark since 2007-08 (22 wins). VMI's wins in the CIT have pushed the Keydets' total to 22, their first 20-win campaign since 2008-09. The previous League record for most 20-win teams was three in 1985-86, 1993-94 and 2008-09.

HIGH POINT -- FIRST TEAM TO START 0-2 AND WIN BIG SOUTH REGULAR-SEASON TITLE

High Point University is the first team in Big South history to win the Regular-Season title after starting the League season 0-2. The Panthers dropped their Conference opener by three points to Campbell on Jan. 8, then suffered a nine-point home loss to Radford on Jan. 10. HPU recovered from that standpoint, winning 12 of their next 14 Big South contests -- including the last six to claim the outright regular-season Championship and the Conference's automatic bid to the NIT.

ROCKIN' ROWSEY

UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** is on the cusp of becoming the first freshman ever to the lead the Big South in scoring, as he finished his 2013-14 campaign with a Big South freshman-record 20.3 points per game. Currently the nation's second-leading freshman scorer, Rowsey is the second freshman in Big South history to average 20 points a game. The first was Liberty's **SETH CURRY** in 2008-09 (20.2). VMI freshman **QJ PETERSON** is looking to join Rowsey in the 20.0 points per game club, as he is at 19.4.

BIG SOUTH IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

Coastal Carolina is 0-3 all-time in the NCAA Tournament. The Chanticleers made their third trip to the Big Dance, tied for second-most in Big South history.

The Big South Conference first secured an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament in 1992, sending its postseason tournament champion to the Big Dance every year, with the exception of 1995.

Winthrop garnered the League's highest seed at No. 11 in 2007. Below is a look at the Conference's NCAA Tournament history:

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

High Point redshirt-sophomore and Big South Player of the Year **JOHN BROWN** is the first player in Big South history to score 1,000 career points before the end of his sophomore season. He eclipsed the milestone Feb. 26 vs. VMI, and his total of 1,063 points is the eighth-highest output by a player in his first two years in the Conference. Brown surpassed the previous freshman-sophomore high of 974 points by HPU's **NICK BARBOUR** during his freshman-sophomore seasons from 2008-10.

THE 20/20 EXPERIENCE

Nine different players have recorded at least 10 games with 20 points this season, the most in the Big South since before 2004-05. VMI teammates **QJ PETERSON** and **D.J. COVINGTON** lead the League with 16 20-point games, while Covington has a Conference-best 10 games with at least 25 points. UNC Asheville freshman **ANDREW ROWSEY** is tops in 30-point games with five.

20/20 TIMES TWO ... OR THREE OR FOUR?

UNC Asheville's **ANDREW ROWSEY** (20.3) and Presbyterian College's **JORDAN DOWNING** (20.2) give the Big South multiple 20-point scorers in the same season for the first time since 2008-09 and ninth time overall. In addition, VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** is at 20.2 points and would need to score 13 points in his next contest to remain at the 20-point mark. The most Big South players to average 20.0 points in the same season is three in 1992-93 and 2006-07.

CROSSOVER DRIBBLE

The South Division "won" the Big South's crossover divisional match-ups for the second consecutive season, as the division finished with a 19-17 advantage over the North squads. The teams with the top crossover division records this season were High Point (5-1), Coastal Carolina (5-1) and Gardner-Webb (5-1). Last year, the South Division finished 22-14 (=61.1 percent) against the North Division.

20/20 TIMES 12

All 12 Big South members had at least one game with two 20-point scorers, as Gardner-Webb was the final team to achieve the feat Feb. 1 at Radford. It is the first time since 2008-09 that every Big South basketball member has had two 20-point scorers in a game. VMI has had at least two 20-point scorers in a game a League-high 14 times this season, with **RODNEY GLASGOW** and **QJ PETERSON** involved in eight of those efforts. The Keydets are 7-1 when Glasgow and Peterson score 20 points in the same contest (4-0 in Big South games).

BIG SOUTH FOUR-YEAR CLASSMATE 1,000-POINT SCORING COMBINATIONS

Since the Big South's first official men's basketball season in 1985-86, a total of 18 four-year classmate combinations have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period, with four pair reaching the mark as juniors -- including two this year in Charleston Southern junior tandem **SAAH NIMLEY** and **ARLON HARPER**, and Radford junior duo **JAVONTE GREEN** and **R.J. PRICE**. Below is a detailed look at the four sets of junior teammates and their overall career point totals:

SPEAKING OF FOUR-YEAR SCORING COMBOS

VMI seniors **RODNEY GLASGOW** (1,420) and **D.J. COVINGTON** (1,499) are among the 18 four-year classmate combinations that have scored 1,000 points during the same four-year period. They are the 5th-highest scoring four-year classmate duo in Big South history with 2,919 points, and five points away from moving into fourth-place. UNC Asheville's **MATT DICKEY** and **CHRIS STEPHENSON** hold that spot with a combined scoring total of 2,923 points as teammates from 2008-12.

15-FOOTERS

UNC Asheville won at least 15 games for the seventh consecutive season, the second-longest streak in Big South history. It was also their 16th 15-win season since the Conference was formed, which ties Winthrop for the second-most in League history. A League-record seven programs won at least 15 games this season, surpassing the previous high of six that was accomplished in 2009-10.

10-TAMOUNT

High Point notched back-to-back 10-win Big South seasons for the first time as League members. VMI recorded its first 10-win League campaign since 2010-11 and the third and final time as Big South members. UNC Asheville posted its seventh consecutive 10-win Conference season and 10th overall, while Winthrop won 10 Big South games for the first time since 2009-10 and 11th overall -- extending its League record for most 10-win Conference seasons.

BACK IN FAMILIAR TERRITORY

VMI leads the Big South and the nation in scoring with 89.0 points per game, its highest average since 2008-09 when the Keydets scored a League- and NCAA-leading 93.8 a contest. VMI, which has led the Big South in scoring six out of the last seven years -- including last season, is second all-time for most times leading the Conference in scoring offense at six. Radford owns that record with nine times.

DO THE CHARLESTON

Charleston Southern averaged 81.4 points this season, its first time averaging more than 80 points since 1993-94 when the Buccaneers scored 83.3 points per contest. Meanwhile, CSU and VMI could mark just the second time in League history that at least two teams averaged 80.0 points in the same year. The first (and only) time was in 1992-93 when three squads averaged 80.0 points -- Winthrop (83.6), UMBC (81.8) and Radford (81.3).

RAISE YOUR GLASS FOR RODNEY

VMI senior **RODNEY GLASGOW** became the 13th player in Big South history with 500 career assists when he surpassed the milestone at Canisius during the first round of the CIT on March 18. He is currently 10th all-time with 523. Already the first Keydet on the League's 400-career assist chart, Glasgow is one of 11 players in Conference annals with 1,000 points (1,420) and 500 assists (523).

BIG SOUTH FRESHMEN FIVE FAB?

Five freshmen players are among the Big South's top 23 scorers -- including three in the top 10. As previously mentioned, UNC Asheville frosh **ANDREW ROWSEY** is the League's leader with 20.3 points. VMI's **QJ PETERSON** is fifth at 19.4 points, while Coastal Carolina's **ELIJAH WILSON** is 10th at 15.8 markers per game. Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** is 21st at 12.3, while Presbyterian College freshman **REGGIE DILLARD** is 23rd with 12.1.

GREEN MACHINE

Radford junior **JAVONTE GREEN** became the 26th player in Big South history with 700 career rebounds when he surpassed the milestone Feb. 19 at Longwood. He is now the 23rd player with 1,000 points (1,386) and 700 boards (757). Green is currently 15th all-time in League annals in career rebounds, and will enter his senior season of 2014-15 as the League's returning leading career scorer and 243 caroms away from becoming the third Big South player with 1,000 career rebounds.

D.J.'s BLOCK PARTY - PART 1

UNC Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM** is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 career points, 800 career rebounds and 200 career blocked shots. He led the Big South and is fourth in the nation with 3.63 blocked shots per game -- the third-highest single-season average in League history. Cunningham recorded 81 of his 98 blocks this season in his last 20 games (4.05 average) to increase his career total to 278 -- third all-time in the League record books. He surpassed former teammate **JOHN WILLIAMS** (255) to become Asheville's career leader. Now 10th all-time in League history with 819 career rebounds, Cunningham's final points in the Big South Tournament gave him exactly 1,000 for his career.

D.J.'S BLOCK PARTY - PART 2

VMI's **D.J. COVINGTON** is fourth in Big South history with 267 career blocked shots. He is the third player in League history with 1,000 career points (1,499), 700 career rebounds (740) and 200 career blocked shots (267), joining Radford's **TYRONE TRAVIS**, who had 1,313 points, 718 boards and 215 blocked shots from 1989-94, and Asheville's **D.J. CUNNINGHAM**. Covington has blocked a shot in 59 of his last 65 appearances, and since the start of the 2012-13 campaign (65 games), he has recorded 194 of his 267 career blocks in that span (=72.7 percent) for an average of 2.98 per contest. Meanwhile, he is the third player in Big South history to block 100 shots in a single-season, and his 101 rejections are third-most in a campaign. He is also one point shy of becoming the ninth player in League annals with 1,500 points and 700 boards.

THE PRICE IS RIGHT

Radford junior guard **R.J. PRICE** became the 32nd player in Big South history with 200 career treys when he eclipsed the milestone Feb. 19 at Longwood. Price has buried a three-pointer in 84 of his 96 career games, including a career-best streak of 26 consecutive games during the 2012-13 campaign. He has also made at least three 3-pointers in a game 42 times -- including 14 times this year. Price is currently 23rd all-time with 221 career treys.

RISING ROWSEY

UNC Asheville freshman **ANDREW ROWSEY** set a Big South-freshman record with 106 three-point field goals this season. He became the first frosh in League history to score 40 points in a game when he tallied a Big South-freshman record 41 at Radford on Feb. 13. It was his fourth game with at least 30 points. In League games, Rowsey finished with a Conference-best 23.0 markers per contest.

BURRUS' BOARDS AND BLOCKS

Liberty redshirt-senior **ANTWAN BURRUS** ends his career one of 13 players in Big South's 1,000-point, 600-rebound and 100-blocked shot club. Burrus scored 1,170 points (T-91st), grabbed 616 rebounds (44th) and blocked 124 shots (T-23rd). He joined Big South Hall of Famer PETER ALUMA, who had 1,715 points, 682 rebounds and 366 blocked shots from 1994-97, as the only Flames on the Big South's 1,000-point, 600-rebound and 100-blocked shot list.

BAND OF BROTHERS

Liberty senior JOHN CALEB SANDERS and his brother and former teammate JESSE combined to score 2,619 points during their respective careers with the Flames -- the third-highest scoring brother combination in Big South history. John Caleb finished at 1,384 since joining the program as a freshman in 2010-11 and surpassed Jesse's total of 1,235 from 2008-12 on Jan. 18. Below are the Brothers Sanders with the top two combos:

IT'S ACADEMIC

Coastal Carolina sophomore MICHEL ENANGA was named to the Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District Team Jan. 30. He is the first Chanticleer with this distinction since **SAM McLAURIN** in 2011-12.

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

UNC Asheville's D.J. CUNNINGHAM became the 11th player this season and 128th overall in League history to reach 1,000 career points when he hit the milestone March 8 vs. Winthrop in the Conference Tournament. BIG SOUTH MATCH PLAY

Radford's 22 victories this season were a +9 improvement over last season's total (13), and the team secured its first winning campaign since going 19-12 in 2009-10. It was also the Highlanders' first 20-win season since 2008-09 (21 wins). Meanwhile, VMI (+8), Coastal Carolina (+7), Winthrop (+7) and UNC Asheville (+1) all exceeded their 2012-13 win totals as well.

CLIFF NOTES

Coastal Carolina head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** is one of two coaches in NCAA history with 100 wins at four different Division I programs, joining **LEFTY DRIESELL**. Ellis recorded his 100th win as Coastal Carolina's head coach with the Chanticleers' 2012-13 season-opening 74-70 overtime victory over Akron. His school-by-school breakdown: South Alabama - 171, Clemson - 177, Auburn - 186, Coastal Carolina - 134. Ellis is 10th among all active coaches with 668 Division I wins and is tied with **GARRY WILLIAMS** for 29th all-time in Division I victories. DEVANTE'S TREYS

High Point junior **DEVANTE WALLACE** has set the Big South single-season record for three-point percentage, as he ends the 2013-14 campaign with a 49.1 clip from beyond the arc. Wallace was 78-of-159 from long distance and made the required 2.50 3FG per game to qualify for the League leaders, as he averaged 2.52 treys. Also this season, Wallace tied the Big South single-game record for highest three-point field goal percentage in a League contest with his 8-of-9 performance at Presbyterian on Jan. 28 (88.9 percentage). He made at least three 3FG in a game 13 times this season, and hit at least one trey in all 16 of High Point's Big South games. He shot a League-best 59.3 percent (51-of-86) from beyond the arc in Conference action.

IN WILLIAM WE TRUSS

Presbyterian College's **WILLIAM TRUSS** tied a Big South single-game record with his perfect 10-of-10 field goal performance against High Point on Jan. 28. He is the sixth player in League history to post 100.0 percent from the field with at least 10 field goals, and the first since Radford's **TOM GALLAHER** (10-of-10) against UMBC on Feb. 10, 1993. Truss is just the third to achieve the feat in a Conference game.

A GAME OF MARGINS

A total of 54 of the 96 Conference games (56.3 percent) were decided by less than 10 points (4.56 average) -- including 32 that were decided by less than 5 points (2.72 margin). The remaining 42 contests had double-digit victory margins (16.62). The average margin of victory in the League season was 9.83 points. High Point had 14 of its 16 Big South contests decided by single digits, followed by VMI (11), Liberty (10), Gardner-Webb (10) and Campbell (10).

Big South Men's Basketball Postseason Report • Conference Notebook • March 31, 2014

SAAH-SATIONAL

Charleston Southern junior SAAH NIMLEY will enter the 2014-15 season 15 assists away from becoming the 20th player with 1,000 points and 400 assists once he reaches the milestone. Nimley would become the first Buccaneer on the Big South's 400-assist list since ED O'NEIL (504 from 2000-04) and the third overall (ERROL McPHERSON, 403 from 1993-97).

Against UNC Asheville on Jan. 28, VMI guards QJ PETERSON (37) and RODNEY GLASGOW (35) became the first Big South teammates to score 30 points in the same game since VMI's REGGIE WILLIAMS (43) and CHAVIS HOLMES (30) did it against Newport News Apprentice on Dec. 10, 2007. Peterson and Glasgow were the first pair to achieve the feat in a Big South game since the 2006-07 campaign, when Liberty's LARRY BLAIR (30) and DWIGHT BREWINGTON (30) reached the total against VMI on Jan. 27, 2007.

COVER CHARGE

VMI's D.J. COVINGTON has a League-high 11 20-point, 10-rebound games this season, including six in League contests. It is the most 20-point, 10-rebound games in the Big South since Radford's ART PARAKHOUSKI had 18 in 2009-10. Covington also turned in the Big South's first 40-point, 10-rebound effort (41-10 vs. IPFW on March 22) since Longwood's TRISTAN CAREY had 40 points and 12 boards against Liberty on Feb. 19, 2013.

BIG BYRON

Gardner-Webb senior **MIKE BYRON** became the 32nd player in Big South history with 100 career blocks when he surpassed the milestone Feb. 11 at Liberty. Byron ends his career 28th in League annals with 110 rejections and is the first Gardner-Webb player on the list.

INSTANT CLASSIC

VMI and Gardner-Webb played the first four overtime game in League history on Feb. 5, as the Keydets finally emerged with the 108-104 victory. The Keydets made last-second shots to force the first overtime, the third overtime and a fourth extra period in what is the longest game in Division I this season. The Runnin' Bulldogs' 99 field goal attempts set the Big South single-game record for a Conference match-up, while the 212 combined points is tied for the eighth-highest single-game total for a League contest.

FULL NELSON

Gardner-Webb freshman forward TYRELL NELSON set the Big South freshman single-game record for most rebounds with his 25 caroms against VMI on Feb. 5. He tied the League's all-time mark of 25 in the process that was first established by High Point's ARIZONA REID against the Keydets on Feb. 24, 2007. Nelson also tallied 24 points to register the Big South's first 20-point, 20-rebound game since Radford's ART PARAKHOUSKI had 30 points and 22 boards at VMI on Feb. 2, 2010.

MID-MAJOR MANIA

CIT VMI KEYDETS (3-0)

RU Tightanders

CBI RADFORD HIGHLANDERS (1-1)

Sparked by **RODNEY GLASGOW**'s 30 points, the VMI Keydets rallied from a 17-point first half deficit and went on to defeat the Ohio Bobcats, 92-90, in the quarterfinals of the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT).

Glasgow led the way for the Keydets for the first time in the tournament, scoring 30 points on 11-of-19 shooting. He added five assists and is now just two shy of becoming the ninth player in Big South history to post 200 in a single season. **D.J. COVINGTON** added 29 markers and 11 rebounds to notch his 19th double-double this season.

Covington is leading the Keydets in the CIT with 35.7 points and 9.0 rebounds through three games. He is 38-of-56 from the field (=67.9 percent) and 31-of-37 from the charity stripe (=83.8). Glasgow is pouring in 23.7 points and has handed out 25 assists in the CIT (8.3 per game). Freshman **QJ PETERSON** is contributing 19.7 points and 8.0 boards. As a team, the Keydets are averaging 103.0 points and are making 52.0 percent from the floor.

VMI last participated in postseason play in 1977 when it advanced to the Sweet 16 before falling to Kentucky in the East Regional in College Park, Md. The 2014 CIT is the fourth basketball postseason tourney overall in program history, as the Keydets also participated in the 1964 and 1976 NCAA Tournaments, reaching the Elite Eight in '76.



NIT HIGH POINT PANTHERS (0-1)

High Point made its first appearance in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) on March 18, falling at No. 1 seed Minnesota, 88-81 in the first round. HPU's only other Division I postseason appearance was in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT) last year. HPU traveled to UC Irvine and suffered an 80-71 loss in the CIT.

DEVANTE WALLACE led the team with 20 points against the Gophers, while **JOHN BROWN** scored 19. Brown scored his 19 points and had five rebounds in just 21 minutes. Wallace hit four three-pointers en route to his 20 points and **LORENZO CUGINI** scored 16 points and went 4-of-7 from beyond the arc against the Golden Gophers.

High Point outrebounded Minnesota, 31-30, and hit 12 three-pointers. The Golden Gophers shot 49.1 percent (26-for-53) from the floor and hit 30-of-36 free throws. They scored 36 points in the paint to HPU's 18.

High Point finishes with a 16-15 record, its second winning season in a row. The Panthers have been eliminated from the Big South Tournament the last four years by a team that reached the Championship game: UNC Asheville in 2010-11 and 2011-12 (champion both times), Liberty in 2012-13 (champion) and Winthrop in 2013-14 (runner-up).

Radford played Old Dominion for the first time on the hardwood in the Quarterfinals of the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) at the Constant Center in Norfolk, Va. The Monarchs came away with the 82-59 victory to end the Highlanders' season.

JAVONTE GREEN posted a double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds, and YA YA ANDERSON added 11 points to lead the Highlanders, who allowed the Monarchs to open the game with a 27-9 push and never recovered. In the first round, RU collected a 96-92 wire-to-wire triumph over Oregon State on March 19. Led by Anderson's 23, and 20 apiece from Green and R.J. PRICE, Radford played and defeated its first opponent from the Pac-12. The Highlanders erupted for 57 points in the first half, led by Anderson's five three-pointers and 17 points. In all, the Highlanders buried 13 from behind the arc, including seven from Anderson and four from Price.

Radford's 22 victories on the season ties the mark for most in a season as a Division I squad and was one shy of matching the school record of 23 set by the 1978-79 Highlanders. RU went 9-7 overall on the road this season -- the lone Big South member with a .500-or-better road record in 2013-14.




NCAA TOURNAMENT COASTAL CAROLINA CHANTICLEERS (0-1)

Coastal Carolina's attempt at history fell short, as the 16th seeded Chanticleers fell to No. 1 seed Virginia, 70-59 in the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Coastal enjoyed a five-point lead at halftime, 35-30, thanks to 52 percent shooting from the field in the opening half, including 5-of-10 from beyond the arc. The Chanticleers held the Cavaliers to 40 percent from the field in the first 20 minutes and limited UVA to 28.6 percent from long distance.

The second half was a different story, as Virginia was a blistering 65.0 percent from the field, including 6-of-10 three-point attempts. The Cavs' defense also limited Coastal to 32.0 percent shooting in the second half. After Virginia grabbed a four-point lead at 45-41 with 11:47 remaining, the Chanticleers would tie the game for the fourth and final time at 47-47 with 8:52 left. Virginia used a 13-3 run over the next 3:50 to pull away for good.

BADOU DIAGNE led Coastal with 14 points, while **WARREN GILLIS** added 13 before fouling out. The Chants finished the night 9-of-19 from three-point range (=47.4).

Head coach **CLIFF ELLIS** led a team to the NCAA Tournament for the eighth time in his head coaching career, where he now stands 6-8 in the Big Dance. Ellis is the only coach to take four programs hailing from just two states (Alabama and South Carolina). He and Syracuse head coach **JIM BOEHEIM** are also the only two active head coaches who both coached in the 1979 NCAA Tournament.
