The junior started the week going 1-for-1 at the plate with a home run, an RBI and two walks in a 2-1 win. She recorded a 2-for-3 outing in game two of the series with a double, an RBI and a run scored in a 4-0 victory. Baltzell wrapped up the week with three walks and a run scored while leading the Lancers to a 3-1 triumph over the Highlanders. The award is her second Player of the Week nod this season.

McCarthy went 2-0 with a 0.50 ERA, 18 strikeouts, two walks, two runs and one earned run on three hits in 14.0 innings pitched against the Highlanders. The freshman left-hander added eight strikeouts, while surrendering two hits and one unearned run in a 3-1 victory. The honor is her third Pitcher of the Week accolade this season.

CAMPBELL

Campbell (29-25, 13-10 Big South) clinched its fourth-straight winning season and the fourth seed in this week's Big South Conference Championship. The Camels will open with fifth-seeded Winthrop Thursday in a 12 noon start at Conway, S.C. ... Winthrop took 2-of-3 in the season series between the schools ... Since re-joining the Big South Conference in 2011-12, Campbell stands 3-4 in league tournament play after going 2-2 in 2013 ... Campbell junior CF STEPHANIE JONES returned to the lineup Saturday at Charleston Southern after missing 20 games due to injury. The 2-time all-conference performer singled and stole a base in the series opener vs. the Bucs ... COURTNEY KLINGLER batted .400 over the weekend and slugged .500 with a double and 2 RBI ... Sunday's 1-0 triumph provided associate head coach TODD BRADLEY with his 300th coaching victory. The National Fastpitch Coaches Association recognizes coaching wins for associate head coaches.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went 1-2 against Campbell in their final tune-up before the Big South Conference Championships as the Buccaneers took the series opener, but were unable to hold off the Camels in the final two games ... CSU is the No. 7 seed in the Big South tournament this season and takes on No. 2 Longwood in the tournament opener ... The Bucs recognized their seven 2014 seniors in Sunday's pregame ceremony as ARI TEDESCO, MORGAN DOWDY, JESSICA BROCK, LIZZY OLMSTEAD, STEPHANIE SBARDELLA, HAYES HOLDSWORTH and LAUREN DARDEN all played in their final game at the CSU Softball Field ... The Bucs used a three-run rally in the bottom of the seventh in the opening game of the series, capped by BROOKE HOLCOMB's walk-off single to take the first game from Campbell ... In her final home start of her career, Dowdy held a no-hitter through the first six innings, retiring 15 batters in a row at one point before the Camels broke through with the winning run in the top of the 7th.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina was off last week after clinching its second straight regular-season championship and the No. 1 seed in this week's Big South Conference Championship. Coastal has now won eight regular-season titles and is looking for its seventh tournament championship. The Chanticleers finished the regular season with a record 20 league victories, including wins in nine of their last 10 games. CCU is hosting the conference tournament for the first time since 2010 and posted a 28-7 record at home during the regular-season, including 12-0 against Big South opponents. KIANA QUOLAS and ASHLEY BAGWELL combined for a conference-best 1.67 ERA during conference play, while the Chants hit .310 as a team and had six players bat over .300, led by AMANDA DANEKER at .384. Hayden led the team with eight home runs in Big South games, while MORGAN NOAD hit seven, Daneker six and Quolas five. Hayden, Noad and Daneker each totaled a team-high 22 RBIs.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb enters the Big South Tournament as the eighth seed, drawing an opening round matchup with Liberty, who the Runnin' Bulldogs swept in the teams' regular season series on April 11 and 12 ... Seniors SAMANTHA MEENAGHAN, JESSICA CHILDERS, and ASHLEY RHYNE lead the charge for the Runnin' Bulldogs, with Meenaghan entering the tournament as the second-leading hitter in the conference with a .431 batting average ... Freshmen MEGAN GIBBONS and MEGAN CHAMPION are tied for the team lead with Meenaghan with three home runs ... Five players have driven in double-digit runs, including Meenaghan (24) andChampion (22) ... Childers anchors the pitching staff with 19 complete games, 10 wins and a 3.41 ERA in 29 starts.

LIBERTY

Liberty (10-44, 4-20 Big South) opens the 2014 Big South Softball Championship against No. 8 seed Gardner-Webb in the first game of the championship, Thursday at 9 a.m. ... The Lady Flames are 2-0 all-time against Gardner-Webb in conference tournament play, downing the Runnin' Bulldogs twice during the 2011 Big South Softball Championship semifinals ... The Lady Flames hit .333 during their last 10 games of the regular season, scoring 5.6 runs per game while totaling 17 doubles, nine homers and 23 stolen bases ... Liberty tied a program record with eight stolen bases on April 26 at PC, and the Lady Flames have stolen 90 bases this season, three away from the program record (93) set in 1996 ... JAMIE CRISP was named Big South Player of the Week on April 28, after batting .500 with two doubles, three home runs, nine RBIs and seven runs scored in six games during the final week of Liberty's regularseason schedule ... KATIE HAN hit three doubles, one homer and added 10 RBIs in seven games during the last week of the regular season ... ANNAH JO BRITTINGHAM went 2-1 with a 2.23 ERA and .143 opponents' batting average on the week. Her strikeout with two outs and the bases loaded on April 26 at PC sent the game to extra innings, where the Lady Flames won, 6-4. It was Liberty's first extra-innings win this season, and HANNA NICHOLS hit a leadoff homer in the eighth ... KATIE ZAVODNY tied her career high with three stolen bases on April 26, giving her 31 for the season. She is the first Lady Flame to post multiple 30-stolen base seasons. With 29 career stolen bases, BLAIR LAWRENCE is now ranked 8th all-time at Liberty ... The Lady Flames earned victory in the season finale for the sixth time in the last seven years, downing PC, 7-5, on Sunday behind two-hit games from KELBY ALLEN, Katie Han, GRACE NORDAN and MARYBETH SCIOLINO and a four-RBI game by Jamie Crisp.

LONGWOOD

The Lancers went 3-0 this week to move to 38-14 overall this year and 17-6 in Big South games, clinching the No. 2 seed for the upcoming 2014 Big South Conference Championship on May 8-11 in Conway, S.C. ... The team swept a three-game series at home against Big South and in-state rival Radford on May 3-4 to wrap up the regular season. Freshman ELIZABETH MCCARTHY and junior LIBBY MORRIS combined for 16 strikeouts with just three hits and one run in the circle to lead Longwood to 2-1 and 4-0 decisions against RU on May 3. The Lancers then played small ball in the series finale on May 4, taking a 2-1 lead in the fifth inning before junior KATIE SHINROCK robbed what would have been a game-tying home run in the sixth en route to the squad's 3-1 victory ... Last week, MEGAN BALTZELL (3-5) paced Longwood with a .600 average, five walks, three runs and a .800 on-base percentage. Sophomore JAMIE BARBOUR hit .500 (3-6), while classmate EMILY MURPHY (.333) led the team with three RBI ... Through 52 games, Megan Baltzell paces Longwood with a .473 average, 69 hits, 47 RBI, 38 walks, 10 home runs, an .836 slugging percentage and a .590 on-base percentage. Juniors Katie Shinrock (.316) and CHELSEA SCIACCA (.311) add to the offense, while sophomore Emily Murphy, who is hitting .305, leads the squad with 22 stolen bases. As a whole, the Lancers are hitting .297 ... In the circle this season, freshman Elizabeth McCarthy, who is 19-5 so far, leads the team with a 1.55 ERA, 139 strikeouts and four shutouts. Junior Libby Morris (2.95 ERA) owns an 16-9 record with a pair of saves and four shutouts ... The Lancers will take on No. 7 Charleston Southern in the first round of the Big South Championship on Thursday, May 8 at 5 p.m.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose enter the tournament as the No. 6 seed and face No. 3 Radford Thursday ... PC is 1-7 in tournament play, dating back to the 2010 season ... The Blue Hose earned their first tournament win in 2-12, posting a 4-1 win over Liberty ... PC dropped a 7-2 decision in a single elimination round game against Charleston Southern in last season's tournament ... Radford earned the three-game sweep over PC in the last meetings, at Radford ... PC is 5-5 in its last 10 games, taking the 8-5 win over Liberty in the first game of the series, before dropping the last two ... Leading the Blue Hose is JILL MCLEAN who is tops in batting average, hits, on base percentage and triples ... Her six triples is top five in the nation ... pacing the team in RBI is KERSTEN LEGACKI with 35 ... Leading in home runs is ERIN RUFF and HOPE ROGERS, both with eight apiece

RADFORD

Radford finished third in the regular season after being picked sixth in the preseason poll. This is the fifth time the Highlanders have earned the third seed, first since 2007. In 2007, RU went 5-2 overall, falling to Winthrop in the "if necessary" Big South Championship game at CCU Softball Field, the site of the 2014 tournament. The Highlanders are 10-8 as the three seed. Senior JESSIE HUTCHENS enters the tournament one shy of the single-season home run record and two RBI shy of 50, joining one other Highlander.

WINTHROP

Winthrop is the No. 5 seed for the 2nd straight season and is 9-7 all-time as the fifth seed ... The Eagles advanced to the Big South title game in 2013 as the No. 5 seed ... Winthrop's next win in the Big South Tournament will give Winthrop head coach MARK COOKE a Big South record 49 tournament victories ... The Eagles averaged 5.38 runs per game in league play, the most they have done so against Big South competition since averaging 7.2 runs in 2009 ... Winthrop has 7 players with 20 or more RBI this season, which is the most since the 2007 team had 8 players with 20 or more ... The last time the Big South Championship was held in Conway, SC the Eagles were the #3 seed and advanced to the championship before falling 5-2 against #1 Radford ... Winthrop and Campbell meet for just the third time in the Big South Tournament as that series stands at 1-1 ... The Eagles lead the all-time series with Campbell 27-14 and 21-11 in league games but have lost nine of the last 11 meetings ... Campbell won 10-9 the last time these two teams met in the tournament in Radford, Va. in 2012 ... Senior MCKENZI CORN is 9-for-19 (.474) with five runs and three RBI all-time in Big South Tournament play ... Senior ALEX WHITE has five career hits, three runs and two RBI in the Big South Championship.


