CAMPBELL

Set school single-season record for team fielding % (.966) ... MILLY MARTINET (.417, 2 HR, 6 RBI in 4 games) and KATIE BAKER (1-1, 0.53 ERA, 2 BB, 14 Ks in 13.1 innings) were named to the all-tournament team at the Big South Championship ... SHAELA CHURCHILL (4.0 GPA) was named Big South scholar-athlete of the year ... Martinet named second-team all-conference, COURTNEY KLINGLER Honorable Mention all-conference and Baker all-freshman ... ERICKA NESBITT has moved into 4th place on CU's career stolen bases list (60), while STEPHANIE JONES is 7th (48) ... RAVEN LEE finished her career 3rd on school's career HR (37) and RBI (131) lists ... Martinet completed her freshman year with 17 homers, third-most in a year in CU history, and 49 RBI (7th on single-season list) ... DREW PETERSON collected his 400th coaching win at CU and 700th overall during the year.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern went undefeated through the 2014 Big South Conference Championships, defeating Longwood (twice) and Presbyterian, before topping Coastal Carolina on Sunday afternoon in the Championship game to earn their first-ever berth into the NCAA Tournament ... The Big South Championship was the second one in CSU program history with the previous one coming in the Big South's inaugural softball tournament in 1988 ... CHEYENNE GANDARA, the 2014 Big South Tournament MVP, went 3-0 on the week and added a save to her totals as the freshman ace paced the Bucs with a 1.47 ERA and complete game victories against Longwood and Coastal Carolina ... Gandara's three-hitter in the Championship game was the lowest hit total she had allowed in a complete game all season ... Recognized on the All-Tournament team were senior first baseman STEPHANIE SBARDELLA, freshman shortstop STEPHANIE BERGMANN and freshman centerfielder AMANDA MATSUMOTO, as well as Gandara ...The Buccaneers advance to the NCAA Regional in Knoxville, Tenn., and will face No. 10-seed Tennessee, Virginia Tech and Lipscomb in a double-elimination bracket running from May 16-18.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina finished as the runner-up in the Big South Tournament, falling to Charleston Southern in the championship game 3-1 ... The Chanticleers advanced to the final with victories over Liberty, Winthrop and Campbell. KIANA QUOLAS, MORGAN NOAD and SARA RASLEY were named to the All-Tournament team ... Coastal was not selected for at-large berth into the NCAA regionals and finished the season 41-15, the fourth 40-plus win season in program history ... The loss to Charleston Southern ended a season-high seven-game winning streak and was CCU's first defeat at home to a conference team in 16 games during the season.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb ends the season with a 16-36 overall record, bowing out of the Big South Tournament in the opening round after Liberty rallied for an 8-5 win ... SAMANTHA MEENAGHAN went 2-for-3 with two runs scored in her final collegiate game, ending her career as the program's all-time leader in batting average, hits, total bases and runs scored ... The senior utility player batted .435 this season to lead the team, driving in 24 runs with three home runs and 32 runs scored ... JESSICA CHILDERS went the distance for the Runnin' Bulldogs in the season finale, walking three and striking out two in seven innings of work ... KELLIE BERES and SAVANNAH BURNS each picked up a pair of hits in the contest, as Burns drove in three of Gardner-Webb's five runs ... Gardner-Webb is expected to return 11 letter-winners next season, including rising seniors Burns, Beres, TAYLAR PRIDGEN and AMANDA GOMES.

LIBERT\

Liberty completed its first season under head coach DOT RICHARDSON with an 11-46 record, after going 1-2 at the 2014 Big South Softball Championship. The Lady Flames opened the tournament with an 8-5 win over No. 8 seed Gardner-Webb, keyed by a five-run sixth inning that included a two-out grand slam by GRACE NORDAN ... The Lady Flames stole 92 bases this season, tying for second place in program history (1994), one behind the record of 93, set in 1996 ... Nordan's grand slam against Gardner-Webb was Liberty's first postseason grand slam since DAWN JEFFS did so in an 8-3 win over Winthrop, May 12, 2006 ... KELBY ALLEN hit two home runs in game one against Gardner-Webb, good for her third career two-homer game. She enters her senior season tied for ninth in program history with 23 career home runs, and 10th with 90 career RBIs ... MEGAN ROBINSON was voted to the Capital One Academic All-District III Team ... Robinson also was named to the Big South All-Conference first team, along with gaining All-Academic Team honors for the second year in a row. Three-time all-conference selection KATIE ZAVODNY was named to the All-Big South second team, while HANNA NICHOLS drew honorable mention from the conference ... ANNAH JO BRITTINGHAM picked up her third win in a row versus Gardner-Webb in the first round, and tossed 18 of Liberty's 19 innings on the week ... Zavodny, Liberty's career record holder in stolen bases with 111, ranks second in conference history. She also finishes her career third at Liberty in career runs scored (131) and fourth in hits (214) ... SAMMI SHIVOCK closes her career ranked fifth in program history with 26 career home runs, tied for fifth with 114 runs scored, seventh with 109 RBIs and ninth with 53 walks ... BLAIR LAWRENCE stole her 20th base this weekend, making it the first time that two Lady Flames recorded 20 or more steals in the same season. Lawrence enters her junior year eighth in program history with 30 career stolen bases.

LONGWOOD

Longwood, who went into the 2014 Big South Championship as the defending champion and the No. 2 seed, was eliminated in the semifinals by the tournament's eventual winner Charleston Southern University on May 10. The Lancers finish their 2014 campaign with a 40-16 overall record, marking their second-consecutive 40-win season ... The team went 2-2 at the conference championship, dropping a 5-2 decision against CSU in the first round of the double-elimination tournament on May 8. Longwood then played a pair of elimination games on May 9, knocking off No. 3 Radford (6-4) and No. 5 Winthrop (2-1) to earn a place in the semifinals on May 9. In that contest, the Lady Bucs used a three-run homer to score what would be the winning-run in the 7-2 decision ... Sophomores Jamie Barbour and Carly Adams were named to the Big South All-Tournament Team following the conclusion of the championship on May 11. Barbour paced the Lancers last week with a .545 batting average (6-11), a .545 onbase percentage and two runs. Adams, who hit .333 (3-9) added two runs and a team-best three RBI and a .556 slugging percentage ... Seven Lancers earned All-Big South Conference accolades in 2014. Junior Megan Baltzell was named the Big South Player of the year, as well as a member of the All-Big South First Team. Sophomore Emily Murphy was all a First Team selection, while junior Libby Morris, along with freshmen Elizabeth McCarthy and Justina Augustine received Second-Team All-Conference recognition. Junior Casey Lifsey was an All-Conference Honorable Mention, and senior Amy Putnam was named to the All-Academic Team ... In 2014, Megan Baltzell led Longwood with a .448 average, 69 hits, 45 RBI, 44 walks, 10 home runs, an .792 slugging percentage and a .581 on-base percentage. Juniors Katie Shinrock (.315) and Chelsea Sciacca (.317) added to the offense, while Emily Murphy, who hit .295, was first on the squad with 23 stolen bases. As a whole, the Lancers are hitting .293 ... In the circle this season, ELIZABETH MCCARTHY, who finished 20-6, led the team with a 1.79 ERA, 145 strikeouts and four shutouts. LIBBY MORRIS (2.95 ERA) recorded a 17-10 record with a pair of saves and four shutouts.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose went 1-2 at the 2014 Big South Championships, earning a first round win over No. 3 Radford, 4-2, beforing dropping the next two contests to eventually champion No. 7 Charleston Southern, 4-3 and No. 4 Campbell, 2-1. HOPE ROGERS and JILL MCLEAN earned post season honors, Rogers was named second team all-conference and a member of the all-freshman team while McLean was named honorable mention all-conference.

RADFORD

After being picked sixth in the preseason poll, Radford finished the regular season in third place ... The Highlanders hit the most home runs since 2010, launching 56, which is the fourth most in a single season ... Nine Highlanders either hit their first collegiate home run or improved on their career-best total ... Senior JESSIE HUTCHENS tied the school record with 18 and will finish tied for the conference's home run crown. Her 49 RBI and .750 slugging percentage are second highest in a RU single season, while hit by pitches (16) and OBP (.453) are third and seventh, respectively ... With 132 and 118 strikeouts, RACHAEL WALTERS and ABBY MORROW is the first RU pitching tandem to reach 100-plus strikeouts for the first time since 2007. Walters' 132 punchouts is the ninth best single season total and the most since 2010 ... BECKY MANTEL was hit a program record 37 times, more than any other team in the Big South ... She's been plunked 57 times in just two seasons.

WINTHROP

Winthrop's MARK COOKE is now tied for the most Big South Conference tournament wins with 49 after the opening round victory over Campbell ... Winthrop shutout Campbell in its opening round game of the tournament, which was the first shutout by an Eagle team in the tourney since a 4-0 victory over Liberty in 2010 ... That game also happened to be in Conway, SC as the Eagles went on to lose in the Championship game that season to top-seeded Radford ... The shutout was the 12th all-time by Winthrop in conference tournament history ... MCKENZI CORN's career came to an end as she ends up ranked 7th all-time at Winthrop in total walks (60), first in hit-by-pitch (33) and the seventh best career batting average in school history (.332) ... Corn just missed cracking Winthrop's all-time Top 10 in runs (2 shy) and doubles (3 shy) ... Corn played in her 200th career game on Thursday in the win over Campbell and finished with 202 career games played ... MADDIE ANTONE's chase for the best batting average by a freshman at Winthrop came up short as she finished with a .365 average (LESLIE MCALISTER) has the record at .375 in 1998) ... Antone, Corn and Alex White were all named to the College Sports Madness Big South First Team ... The Field of 64 was selected on Sunday and six opponents the Eagles faced this season were selected as they were 2-7 against those opponents ... Winthrop finished with five grand slams as a team this season, which is a school record ... The Eagles hit a total of 48 home runs, the fourth most by a Winthrop team (64 is record set in 2013) ... Winthrop hit that number after White followed nine home runs in 2013 with four this season and KRISTY NOBLE entering the season with 15 career home runs and connected on just one this year ... MEL ANDREA had more home runs and RBI this season than she totaled in her first three years (nine home runs, 38 RBI) ... Winthrop finished at 27-26 on the year, which is the first winning record since 2009

BIG SOUTH IN THE NCAA STATISTICS


