BIG SOUTH KICKS OFF 13TH SEASON THIS WEEK

The Big South Conference begins Year 13 of its football history this week with all six teams in action. Big South football teams are a combined 33-37 in season openers since 2002, including a League-best four wins in 2005, 2006 and 2010. Seventeen of the 37 losses have been against FBS members. Coastal Carolina has the current longest season-opening win streak in the Conference at three games, while Gardner-Webb has won eight season openers since the Conference began football.

WELCOME MAT

The Big South Conference welcomes **MONMOUTH UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2014. Next season, start-up program **KENNESAW STATE UNIVERSITY** begins play and associate membership, returning the League to seven football members. Monmouth is officially 0-3 against Big South programs, having gone 0-2 against Coastal Carolina and 0-1 vs. Liberty.

TEAM-BY-TEAM OPENERS

Charleston Southern is opening the campaign at home for the first time since 2010 and just the second time in the last 11 seasons ... Coastal Carolina is opening on the road for the second consecutive year ... Gardner-Webb is opening on the road for the first time since 2008 ... Liberty will play its season opener on the road for the fifth time in six years -- all at FBS opponents ... Monmouth is opening the season at home for the first time since 2011 and just the sixth time in the program's 22-year history ... Presbyterian College is opening its season on the road for the second-straight year at an FBS foe. Below is a team-by-team look at season openers:

COASTAL CAROLINA PICKED TO WIN IT ALL IN 2014

For the second consecutive season, defending Conference co-champion **COASTAL CAROLINA UNIVERSITY** has been tabbed the favorite in the Big South Conference's annual preseason football poll for the 2014 campaign, as voted by the League's head coaches and media panel. The Chanticleers have won or shared six Big South titles since the program's first season in 2003.

BIG SOUTH CONTINUES PRESEASON TREND OF RANKED TEAMS

Coastal Carolina's appearance in the preseason Top 25 rankings marks the fifth consecutive year that a Big South member has opened the season as a nationally-ranked program. The Chants' season-opening rank of No. 6/7 (FCS Coaches and *The Sports Network*, respectively) is the highest in League history and first time inside the Top 10. Meanwhile, the Big South has had a football squad ranked for 37 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24).

GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

For the first time in Big South history, two football players have been nominated for the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team®, as Charleston Southern's **CHRISTIAN REYES** and Liberty's **JONATHAN BURGESS** are among the 182 candidates from every subdivision and classification. The Big South has had one honoree named to the team -- Charleston Southern's **JORDAN LANCASTER** in 2010.

ROSS, COOK ON INITIAL WALTER PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST


For the second time in Big South history, two players open the season as official candidates for the Walter Payton Award, as Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** and Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** are among the initial 20 candidates for the top individual award in FCS. In 2011, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** and Flames' WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** opened the campaign among the initial candidates.

RECORD THREE PLAYERS ON BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD WATCH LIST

A record three Big South players are among the initial 20 candidates for the Buck Buchanan Award, which honors the top defensive player in FCS. Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS**, who finished seventh in the voting last year, headlines the Big South's trio. Joining him are Gardner-Webb DL **O.J. MAU** and Liberty DB **JACOB HAGEN**. The Big South is tied with the Big Sky Conference for the most Buchanan Award candidates.

TWO-POINT CONVERSION

The Big South Conference is one of two FCS Conferences (Big Sky) to have two teams -- Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb -- with both a Walter Payton and Buck Buchanan Award candidate.

LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION!!

Charleston Southern and Presbyterian College both added lights to their football stadiums during the offseason. CSU's first-ever home night game will be the season opener against Point, while PC's first night game at Bailey Memorial Stadium is Week 2 vs. Bluefield on Sept. 6. The Buccaneers will have four home night contests in 2014, with the Blue Hose scheduled for two.

COASTAL'S ROSS TABBED PRESEASON OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Coastal Carolina redshirt-junior quarterback **ALEX ROSS** has been voted the Big South's 2014 Preseason Offensive Player of the Year. The first quarterback since 2011 to receive the Conference's preseason honor, Ross was the 2013 First-Team All-Big South quarterback and is among the initial 20 candidates for the Walter Payton Award, which is given to the top player in FCS. He is coming off an impressive sophomore campaign -- his first year as the Chanticleers' starting quarterback. He helped the program win its sixth Big South title and set 24 single-season offensive records, including 18 Big South single-season marks. Coastal additionally won 12 games, reached the NCAA Division I Championship quarterfinals and a final national ranking of seventh -- all CCU and Big South firsts. Ross, who completed 232-of-358 passes for 3,093 yards and 26 scores in 2013, led the Big South in seven offensive categories last season. He additionally ranked sixth in the Big South with six rushing TDs and seventh in the League with 540 rushing yards.

CCU'S BACKUS PICKED AS PRESEASON DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Coastal Carolina senior linebacker **QUINN BACKUS**, a 2014 Buck Buchanan Award candidate who has already been named preseason All-American by *The Sports Network*, has been voted the 2014 Big South Preseason Defensive Player of the Year. The reigning two-time Big South Defensive Player of the Year enters 2014 as the NCAA FCS active leader in both career total tackles (314) and career solo tackles (172). Backus is a two-time tackles leader in the Big South. This past season, he set the school and tied the Big South single-season records with 144 total tackles, including 10.5 tackles for loss, and established school and League single-season marks with 85 solo tackles. He scored two touchdowns in 2013, tallied four interceptions, and set a CCU record with 127 interception return yards in 2013, which ranks second on the Big South single-season list. Through three seasons, Backus has additionally amassed 20 tackles for loss, 10 pass break ups, six interceptions, four sacks, three forced fumbles and three fumble recoveries.

MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR THIS ONE

Coastal Carolina and Liberty will meet in the season-finale for the first time, as their Nov. 22 match-up in Conway will mark their 12th meeting. Coastal leads the series, 6-5, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship nine times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Coastal won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2013, as well as 2010 and 2012.

RANK AND FILE

The Big South has advanced in the FCS Playoffs three consecutive years -- including its first quarterfinal appearance in 2013 -- and is 5-6 all-time in the postseason. Four of those victories have been against ranked opponents, and the Big South is 6-8 all-time when a ranked Big South member plays a ranked non-Conference foe -- including 3-1 last season. Meanwhile, the Big South had a League-record five wins over nationally-ranked non-Conference opponents in 2013.

SOLO ARTIST

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is fourth all-time in Big South history with 172 career solo tackles, and needs five to move into third-place. Backus had a League single-season record 85 solo stops last year. He enters his final season needing 28 solo stops to break the Big South career record of 199 solo tackles that is held by former Presbyterian DB and current Arizona Cardinal **JUSTIN BETHEL** (2008-11).

INSIDE THE TACKLE BOX

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the active leading tackler in FCS with 314 career stops, which ranks seventh in League history. He is 86 away from becoming just the second player in Big South annals with 400. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb LB **TANNER BURCH** is 24th all-time with 237 tackles, while Presbyterian College's **DONELLE WILLIAMS** is tied for 34th with 209. On the cusp of joining the Big South's 200-tackle club are Liberty's **NICK SIGMON** (175) and Charleston Southern's **DEMARIS FREEMAN** (173).

BIG MEN ON CAMPUS

The six Big South Conference football members have a total of 39 players on its collective rosters weighing at least 300 lbs. Liberty has the most with 10, followed by Coastal Carolina with nine. Last season, the Big South had 44 players at the 300-pound threshold.
