CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KWABENA ASANTE • RB • R-Senior
Monmouth • Silver Spring, Md.

Asante became the first player in Big South football history to score four touchdowns in a season opener as he led Monmouth to a 52-21 win over Delaware State. He rushed for a career-best three touchdowns and finished with 152 yards on 22 carries for an impressive 6.9 yards per rush, with a long of 26 yards. It was his sixth career 100-yard rushing game and the second-highest output in his career. Asante also caught two passes out of the backfield, including an 18-yard screen pass that found paydirt in the second quarter that put the Hawks ahead for good at 28-21.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

QUINN BACKUS • LB • Senior
Coastal Carolina • Greenwood, S.C.

Backus finished with a team-high 14 tackles (9 solo) and two forced fumbles in the Chanticleers' 31-16 season-opening win at The Citadel. The Buck Buchanan Award candidate had 11 of his 14 tackles -- and one forced fumble -- through the third quarter as CCU's defense allowed just three points and 231 yards of total offense against the Bulldogs' triple option. For his efforts, Backus was named a National All-Star by *College Sporting News*.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LUCAS SANTANGELO • PK • Junior
Monmouth • Jamaica Estates, N.Y.

Santangelo, who spent his first two seasons as Monmouth's kickoff man, had 14 points in his first game as the Hawks' starting placekicker. Santangelo, who had not attempted a field goal prior to Saturday, converted 3-of-4 field goals and was a perfect 5-5 on extra points. The junior converted back-to-back 23-yard field goals at the end of the first quarter to bring Monmouth within one point at 14-13, and later hit a career-long 35-yard field goal in the fourth quarter to cap a 12-play 56-yard drive.

THE CRONS BRAND FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

TODD MACON • RB • R-Freshman
Liberty • St. Petersburg, Fla.

Macon scored two rushing touchdowns at North Carolina and led the Flames with 67 rushing yards on 13 carries in his first college football game. He averaged 5.2 yards per carry and scored Liberty's first touchdown of the season on a 1-yard run that tied the game at 7-7 in the first quarter. Macon's second score was also from a yard out during the fourth quarter and was Liberty's final score of the day.

FOR OPENERS

Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina and Monmouth were victorious in their respective season openers this past Saturday. The Chanticleers won their fourth consecutive season opener and seventh in their 12-year history. The Buccaneers claimed their second consecutive season-opening win, while the Hawks won their Big South debut and first season opener since 2006.

MORE ON THE 1-0 TEAMS

As mentioned above, Coastal Carolina is 1-0 for the fourth-straight year and seventh time in the history of the program. The Chants are looking for their fourth consecutive 2-0 start this week. Charleston Southern last started 2-0 in 2013 when the Bucs opened 7-0. Monmouth has not been 2-0 since opening the 2006 campaign 4-0.

TDs FOR KB

Monmouth redshirt-senior RB **KWABENA (KB) ASANTE** became the first player in Big South football history to score four touchdowns in a season opener when he reached the end zone four times against Delaware State this past Saturday. Asante is the 12th different player in League annals to score four touchdowns in a game, and the first to do so in the month of August.

HOME SWEET HOME

Two teams played their home openers last week (Charleston Southern and Monmouth) and Presbyterian College will play its home opener this Saturday. Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb and Liberty all open their home slate Sept. 13. Below is a look at the four teams' last home-opening win and current home opening streaks.

NOT YOUR TYPICAL EXTENDED STAY

Coastal Carolina is opening the season with back-to-back FCS road games for the first time in program history. In 2010, the Chanticleers also played its first two games away from Brooks Stadium, with the season opener at FBS West Virginia. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb is starting the season with two road games for the first time since 2004, while Liberty is on the road for its first two games for the first time since 2003.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 98, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (32). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's active leader for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 42, tied for the second-longest streak in Big South history. That record is 45 games, established by the Flames from Sept. 23, 2006 - Sept. 18, 2010.

BIG SOUTH'S STREAK WITH NATIONALLY-RANKED PROGRAM CONTINUES

With Coastal Carolina ranked No. 4 in this week's FCS Coaches poll and No. 5 in *The Sports Network* ranking, the Big South has had a football squad ranked for 38 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24). The Conference has had a Top 5 team in five of the last 10 rankings.

MAN CAVE


Charleston Southern is the first program in Big South history to open the season with four consecutive home games. The last time the Buccaneers played four-straight home games was in 2006, which were all wins as part of CSU's 9-0 start to the season that year. The last Big South football member to play four home games in a row was Stony Brook in 2011.

LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION!!

Charleston Southern and Presbyterian College both added lights to their football stadiums during the offseason. CSU won its first-ever home night game this past week, while PC's first night game at Bailey Memorial Stadium is this Saturday vs. Bluefield at 7:00pm. The Buccaneers will have four home night contests in 2014 (1-0 thus far), with the Blue Hose scheduled for two.

HOME RUNS

Coastal Carolina has the League's longest active home win streak at nine, their longest since winning 12 consecutive home games from Sept. 11, 2004 - Nov. 12, 2005.

INSIDE THE TACKLE BOX

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the active leading tackler in FCS with 328 career stops, which ranks sixth in League history. He is 72 away from becoming just the second player in Big South annals with 400. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College's **DONELLE WILLIAMS** is 29th with 221. On the cusp of joining the Big South's 200-tackle club are Liberty's **NICK SIGMON** (181) and Charleston Southern's **DEMARIS FREEMAN** (180).

SOLO ARTIST

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is third all-time in Big South history with 181 career solo tackles, and needs 15 to move past Charleston Southern's **JADA ROSS** for second-place. Ross had 195 solo hits from 2004-07. Backus needs 19 solo stops to break the Big South career record of 199 that is held by former Presbyterian DB and current Arizona Cardinal **JUSTIN BETHEL** (2008-11).

ELIMINATING THE MIDDLE MAN

Charleston Southern LB **GABE MIDDLEBROOK** returned a fumble 85 yards for a touchdown in the Buccaneers' season-opening win over Point. It is the fourth-longest fumble return in Big South history, and the longest in the League since Presbyterian's **BRANDON LESTON** had a 91-yard fumble return against Georgia Tech in 2012. Middlebrook's fumble return is the longest by a CSU player during the Big South's football era (since 2002). The previous longest was a 77-yard fumble return for a TD by **JADA ROSS** against Gardner-Webb in 2007.

CALL HIM MR. FUMBLEROOSKIE

Liberty's **JACOB HAGEN** returned a fumble 27 yards for a touchdown at North Carolina this past Saturday -- his second career fumble return TD. He is now the first player in Big South history to return two fumbles for scores. Hagen's first career fumble return TD was a 44-yard return vs. Stony Brook in 2012.

SEASON'S GREETINGS

New Big South member Monmouth became just the third League program with two 100-yard rushers in a season opener against an FCS opponent. **KWABENA ASANTE** led the Hawks with 152 rushing yards against Delaware State, while **LAVON CHANEY** added 127 yards on the ground. In 2008, both Stony Brook (vs. Colgate) and VMI (vs. St. Francis-Pa.) had two players rush for 100 yards in their respective season openers.

CAKE ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** recorded his sixth career game with 300 yards of offense this past Saturday as he amassed 321 at The Citadel. Ross is now tied for fifth all-time in Big South history for most games with 300 total offensive yards. Meanwhile, Ross is 10th in League annals for most rushing yards by a quarterback with 722. He is 58 away from moving past former CCU signal-caller **ZACH MacDOWELL** (779) for ninth-place. Ross is 278 rushing yards away from becoming the seventh Big South quarterback with 1,000 career rushing yards.

BEATTY OR NOT, HERE HE COMES

Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** needs 264 passing yards to become the eighth player in Big South history with 6,000 in a career. He currently ranks eighth all-time with 5,736. Beatty also ranks in the Conference's career Top 10 with 518 completions (4th) and 852 pass attempts (5th). He is on pace to become the second Big South quarterback with 600 career completions. Meanwhile, Beatty is among the League's all-time leaders in total offense for plays (8th - 1,000) and yardage (10th - 5,461).

HE'S GOT THE WILL

Presbyterian College redshirt-junior LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** recorded his 10th career 10-tackle game in Week 1 with 12 stops at Northern Illinois. Williams, who has played 26 career games, has averaged 8.50 tackles per game in his career, which is tied for seventh in Big South history. Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS** owns a per game average of 8.41 (328 in 39), which is the ninth-highest average in the record books.

BIG SIG

Liberty redshirt-senior LB **NICK SIGMON** needs one tackle-for-loss to become the 11th player in Big South history with 30 career TFL. Sigmon would be the second Liberty player on the list, as **STEVEN ACKLEY** recorded 30 stops behind the line of scrimmage from 2004-07.

CHIMA CHEWS IT UP

Liberty junior DL **CHIMA UZOWIHE** recorded his 10th career quarterback sack this past Saturday at North Carolina, becoming the 19th Big South player with double figure sacks in a career. Uzowihe is officially tied for 16th in League history, and can move into a tie for 13th with his next full sack.

WELCOME MAT

The Big South Conference welcomes **MONMOUTH UNIVERSITY** as an associate member in 2014. Next season, start-up program **KENNESAW STATE UNIVERSITY** begins play and associate membership, returning the League to seven football members.

KENNESAW STATE UPDATE

As Kennesaw State continues to build its program during the 2014 season, the Big South will include details of the Owls' progress throughout the season leading up to their 2015 kickoff. On August 28, KSU's football uniforms and the team's inaugural 2015 season logo were unveiled. The ceremony included the unveiling of a 15-foot gold jersey and three different uniform combinations.

The gold jersey includes gray numbers outlined in black and features the Big South Conference logo on the right chest and the inaugural season logo on the left chest. The Owls' uniform ensemble also includes a black jersey with gray numbers outlined in gold and a white jersey with gold numbers outlined in black. The team also has black, white and gold pants along with a gold helmet with black stripes and a gold "KS" insignia.

The gold and white jerseys have Kennesaw State written across the chest above the numbers in black lettering while the white jersey has Kennesaw State written in black lettering. The pants have a gold "KS" logo sewn on the top of the left leg.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO ESPN3 IN 2014

The Big South Conference will televise eight football games exclusively on ESPN3 this season. The "Game of the Week" package includes a non-Conference broadcast for the second time and begins Oct. 4 when Gardner-Webb hosts Charlotte. The first League game will be Oct. 11 with the Coastal Carolina at Presbyterian College contest.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL TO AIR ON AMERICAN SPORTS NETWORK

Big South football will appear on the new American Sports Network (ASN) in 2014, as six contests -- five of them between Conference members, will be broadcast on affiliates and stations owned by Sinclair Broadcast Group. The six broadcasts push the League's overall package to a Big South-record 14 this season (12 League games). In addition, the final five weeks of the 2014 regular-season will now feature two televised games each week.

MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR THIS ONE

Coastal Carolina and Liberty will meet in the season-finale for the first time, as their Nov. 22 match-up in Conway will mark their 12th meeting. Coastal leads the series, 6-5, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship nine times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Coastal won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2013, as well as 2010 and 2012.

GOOD WORK YOUNG MEN

For the first time in Big South history, two football players have been nominated for the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team®, as Charleston Southern's **CHRISTIAN REYES** and Liberty's **JONATHAN BURGESS** are among the 182 candidates from every subdivision and classification. The Big South has had one honoree named to the team -- Charleston Southern's **JORDAN LANCASTER** in 2010.

ROSS, COOK ON INITIAL WALTER PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST

For the second time in Big South history, two players open the season as official candidates for the Walter Payton Award, as Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** and Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** are among the initial 20 candidates for the top individual award in FCS. In 2011, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** and Flames' WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** opened the campaign among the initial candidates.

RECORD THREE PLAYERS ON BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD WATCH LIST

A record three Big South players are among the initial 20 candidates for the Buck Buchanan Award, which honors the top defensive player in FCS. Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS**, who finished seventh in the voting last year, headlines the Big South's trio. Joining him are Gardner-Webb DL **O.J. MAU** and Liberty DB **JACOB HAGEN**. The Big South is tied with the Big Sky Conference for the most Buchanan Award candidates.

The Big South Conference is one of two FCS Conferences (Big Sky) to have two teams -- Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb -- with both a Walter Payton and Buck Buchanan Award candidate.

*Charleston Southern meets Newberry for the ninth time on Saturday. The Wolves lead the series, 7-1. It is the first meeting between the schools since 1999.

* CSU's win in the series occurred in 1993, a 15-10 win at Newberry. CSU is looking for its first home win over the Wolves (0-4).

* Charleston Southern beat Point, 61-9, on Thursday in the first night game at Buccaneer Field. The Bucs scored on their first nine possessions and reeled off the first 61 points in the game.

* Junior transfer QB **AUSTIN BROWN** was 9-of-12 passing for 160 yards and two TDs. He added 41 yards on the ground and two rushing TDs, and finished with 201 yards of offense.

* The Bucs had six rushing TDs and 336 yards rushing in the win over Point. The 336 rushing yards were the 11th-most in school history.

* After leading the nation in time of possession last season, CSU held the ball for 35:02 against Point.

* The 61 points were the first time CSU eclipsed the 40-point mark in the **JAMEY CHADWELL** era. It was also the third-most points in school history and the most by CSU since 2005.

* The Buccaneer defense held Point to 152 yards, 3.1 yards per play and zero touchdowns. Point scored its points on a PAT return and a punt return. The Bucs scored on defense on an 85-yard fumble return by **GABE MIDDLEBROOK**, the second-longest in school history.

* Coastal Carolina meets North Carolina A&T for the fifth time on Saturday. The Chanticleers lead the series, 4-0 -- including 2-0 in Greensboro. The teams last met in 2012.

* The Chanticleers are 17-1 all-time against MEAC opponents, and have won the last 10 match-ups.

* Coastal won its season opener for the fourth straight year, including 3-0 under head coach **JOE MOGLIA**, and is 7-5 all-time in season openers including a 4-4 mark when opening on the road.

* CCU is now 16-1 over its last 17 regular-season games versus FCS opponents, including wins over its last seven non-Conference foes.

* Coastal shutout The Citadel in the first half (leading 14-0) and allowed just 155 yards of total offense. Coastal led 21-3 through three quarters and held the Bulldogs to just 231 yards of total offense in that span.

* WR **BRUCE MAPP** tied a CCU single-game record with 10 receptions at The Citadel and posted his first career 100-yard receiving game (108). He also hauled in a 9-yard TD pass to give Coastal the 21-3 lead.

* QB **AARON AIKEN**, a graduate transfer from Georgetown, scored a 6-yard TD run on his first -- and only -- snap under center to give CCU a 14-0 lead in the first quarter.

* The Runnin' Bulldogs played the final three quarters of Saturday's opener without the services of pre-season All-America WR **KENNY COOK**. Defensively, GWU was without preseason All-America LB **TANNER BURCH** and CB **JONATHAN SHERRILL**, as neither dressed for action.

* DE **TYLER HOUGH-JENKINS** had a career-high seven tackles and a TFL Saturday.

* DL **O.J. MAU** totaled four tackles, 3.0 tackles for loss, a sack, a forced fumble and one pressure in his 2014 debut.
