### CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**ALEX ROSS • QB • R-Junior**  
Coastal Carolina • Alharetta, Ga.

Ross led Coastal Carolina to a 31-3 win over Elon with a school-record 426 yards of offense -- fourth-highest in Big South history -- with three total touchdowns. He was 34-of-47 passing for 338 yards and two scores, and gained 88 yards on nine carries with a 24-yard TD scamper. Ross was 21-of-29 for 202 yards in the first half while going 13-of-18 for 136 yards in the second stanza against the Phoenix, which entered the game allowing just 212.7 passing yards. With Coastal clinging to a 10-3 lead late in the third quarter, he accounted for three consecutive TD drives to put the game out of reach by going 12-of-14 for 136 yards with 2 TDs, and rushing twice for 32 yards and a score.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**QUINN BACKUS • LB • Senior**  
Coastal Carolina • Greenwood, S.C.

Backus tallied 13 tackles (eight solo, five assisted), 2.5 tackles-for-loss, one sack, two pass break-ups and two quarterback hurries in Coastal's 31-3 win over Elon. On Elon's first drive, Backus had four tackles, including a sack on third down to force a punt. He had back-to-back pass break-ups in the second quarter, and helped prevent Elon from scoring a touchdown with a stop on 2nd-and-goal. In the fourth quarter, Backus had a tackle-for-loss on a completion and two plays later hurried the quarterback to force an incompleton and turnover on downs.

**BIG SOUTH HAS TWO 5-0 TEAMS FOR SECOND CONSECUTIVE YEAR**

Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern each are 5-0 -- the second time in Big South football history that two teams opened the season 5-0 in the same year (the same two teams accomplished the feat the first time in 2013). In fact, the Big South is currently the only FCS Conference with two 5-0 teams. It is the fifth and sixth time that a Big South member has opened 5-0 -- with the Buccaneers being the first team in League history to do it three different times (2006, 2013, 2014).

**NO FRESHMAN 15**

The Big South is 15-4 through 19 games against FCS opponents, one year after opening 14-5 vs. FCS foes through the first five weeks of the 2013 campaign. The League is one win away from matching the Conference record of 16 regular-season non-conference FCS victories with eight games remaining. Last season, the Big South set a Conference record with a 16-9 regular-season mark against FCS competition (18-10 including postseason).

**THREE-AND-OUT**

Coastal Carolina is the first team in Big South history to hold three consecutive opponents to three points-or-less, as the Chanticleers have limited each of their last three opponents to a field goal while outscoring the opposition 109-9. The Chants have matched the League record for most times allowing no more than three points (three times), joining Charleston Southern (2002) and Liberty (2006, 2008).

**BIG SOUTH'S STREAK WITH NATIONALLY-RANKED PROGRAM CONTINUES**

The Big South has had a football squad ranked for 42 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24). The Conference has had a Top 5 team in nine of the last 14 rankings. Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 3 in this week's FCS Coaches poll and No. 3 in *The Sports Network* ranking -- tied for the highest spot in Big South and school history, as the Chanticleers were No. 3 for three-straight weeks in the 2013 FCS Coaches poll from Oct. 21-Nov. 4. It is CCU's and the League's highest position in *The Sports Network* poll.

Charleston Southern returned to the Top 25 last week, as the Buccaneers were No. 25 in the FCS Coaches poll. CSU, which was No. 22/24 in the final 2013 polls and ranked the final nine weeks last year, is No. 24 in this week's Coaches ranking. The Big South has two nationally-ranked teams in the same week for the third time in four seasons. In fact, the League has had two teams ranked at the same time 15 of the last 22 weeks. The Conference had its earliest duo-ranking ever the week of Sept. 15 when Liberty joined Coastal Carolina in *The Sports Network* Top 25.

**PROTECTING THEIR HOUSE**

The Big South is undefeated at home thus far at 14-0. Coastal Carolina has the League's longest active home win streak at 11, tied for the third-longest home win streak in Big South history. It is the Chanticleers' longest home win streak since winning 12 consecutive home games from Sept. 11, 2004 - Nov. 12, 2005. Liberty's home win streak stands at five, followed by Charleston Southern (4), Gardner-Webb (4), Presbyterian (2) and Monmouth (2).

**HE CRAN CATCH**

Gardner-Webb TE **SETH CRANFILL** became the Big South's all-time receptions leader among tight ends this past Saturday during The Citadel game. Cranfill caught seven passes to increase his career total to 69, breaking the old mark of 65 that was established by former Coastal Carolina TE **DAVID DURAN** (2009-12). Cranfill's 685 career receiving yards are second-most among tight ends in League history behind Duran's 910. Cranfill caught two touchdown passes against Wofford in Week 4, which tied the Big South single-game record for TD receptions by a tight end.

**TREASURE CHEST**

Charleston Southern gained 617 yards of offense this past Saturday at Charlotte, its most-ever against an FCS opponent. The Bucs rushed for 333 yards against the 49ers for their second 300-yard rush game of the season and 10th during its Big South era (since 2002). CSU and Charlotte (573) combined for 1,190 yards of offense, the second-highest single-game total in League history and the most in a regular-season contest. The record is 1,212, set by Coastal Carolina (572) and Old Dominion (672) during the 2012 FCS Playoffs.

**SOLO ARTIST**

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the Big South's all-time leader for solo tackles with 201. He broke the record this past weekend during the Elon game with eight solo stops -- vaulting ahead of both Charleston Southern's **JADA ROSS** (195) and previous record holder **JUSTIN BETHEL** (Presbyterian - 199) for the top spot.

**INSIDE THE TACKLE BOX**

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the active leading tackler in FCS with 365 career stops, which is a school record and second-most in League history. He is 35 away from becoming just the second player in Big South annals with 400. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College's **DONELLE WILLIAMS** is tied for 26th with 234, while Charleston Southern's **DEMARIS FREEMAN** (204) and Liberty's **NICK SIGMON** (200) joined the Big South's 200-tackle club this past Saturday.

**KING OF THE HILL**

Monmouth QB **BRANDON HILL** passed for 390 yards this past Saturday at Lehigh, the most by a Big South quarterback since Charleston Southern's **RICHARD MOUNCE** had 397 vs. Coastal Carolina on Nov. 12, 2011. Hill has thrown at least two touchdown passes in four-straight games (9 total), the longest streak in the Big South since 2012 when Stony Brook's **KYLE ESSINGTON** recorded five consecutive multi-TD pass games (15 in that span). Hill leads the Big South with 270.25 passing yards per game and has eclipsed 200 passing yards in each contest.

**CAN'T FUMBLE THIS NOTE**

Big South football members have already returned five fumbles for touchdowns this year, setting the Big South single-season record for most fumble return scores. The previous record was four in 2002, 2004, 2007, 2009 and 2011. A record four different teams -- Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina (2), Liberty and Presbyterian -- have the fumble return TDs this season. The previous best was three.

**POINT OF ORDER**

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 102, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (36). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 46, breaking its old mark of 45 from Sept. 23, 2006 - Sept. 18, 2010.

**BANG THE DRUM**

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** has thrown for 300 yards in three consecutive games (327-319-308), the first Big South QB to do so since Gardner-Webb's **DEVIN CAMPBELL** in 2008. Woodrum now has six career 300-yard passing games, tied for the most in Big South history. Former Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** was the first player with six 300-yard passing games from 2003-06.

**CAKE ROSS**

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** set a school-record with 426 yards of offense this past Saturday against Elon, the fourth-highest single-game total in Big South history. Ross now has two career 400-yard games -- tied for second-most in League history, and eight career games with at least 300, which ranks fourth all-time. Meanwhile, Ross is seventh in League annals for most rushing yards by a quarterback with 915, and he needs 85 rushing yards to become the seventh Big South quarterback with 1,000 career rushing yards.

**YOU COMPLETE ME**

Coastal Carolina's **ALEX ROSS** set a school-record with 34 pass completions this past Saturday vs. Elon, while Monmouth QB **BRANDON HILL** had 33. It was the second time in Big South history that two quarterbacks completed at least 30 passes on the same day. On Sept. 15, 2012, Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** completed 34 passes at Montana, while Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** had 30 completions vs. Samford.

**QUADRUPLE FOR QUINN**

Coastal Carolina LB and Buck Buchanan Award candidate **QUINN BACKUS** has already forced four fumbles this season, tied for second-most in a season in League history. The record is five, established by Gardner-Webb's **MARIO WILLIAMS** in 2003 and tied by Coastal Carolina's **D.J. RICE** in 2007. Backus has a CCU-record seven career forced fumbles, tied with Liberty's **MANNY ROJAS** (2003-06) for second-most in the Conference record book. That record is eight by Williams and Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** (2004-07).

**HIGH RATE OF RETURN**

Coastal is 20-1 in its last 21 games when rushing for more than 200 yards, including 4-0 this season. The Chanticleers have rushed for more than 200 yards 65 times in their history, and are 60-5 ( =92.3) when reaching the 200-yard plateau. Carolina has rushed for 200-plus yards in 22 of Head Coach **JOE MOGLIA**'s 33 games as CCU's head coach, posting an 21-1 record in such games.

**WOODWORKING**

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** has rushed for a touchdown and passed for a score in the same game six times in his career, and the Flames are 4-2 in such contests -- winning the last four. Meanwhile, Woodrum is ninth in League history with 38 career touchdown passes and is ninth with 5,898 career passing yards -- 102 away from becoming the ninth Big South QB with 6,000.

**BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO ESPN3 THIS SATURDAY**

The Big South Conference will make its season debut on ESPN3 this Saturday with the first of eight exclusive "Game of the Week" broadcasts. E3 will carry the Charlotte at Gardner-Webb game live at 1:30pm with **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **RENALDO WYNN** (analyst) on the call from Boiling Springs. The first League game on ESPN3 will be Oct. 11 with the Coastal Carolina at Presbyterian College contest. The eight games will again utilize instant replay with assistance from DVSport.

**HOME COOKED MEAL**

Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK**, who missed two full games and 11 consecutive quarters earlier this season with an injury, appears to be returning to form as he has 15 catches for 162 yards and two scores since returning to action in Week 4. Cook has 141 career receptions and needs four more to move into the Big South's all-time Top 10. With 1,849 career receiving yards, Cook is 88 shy of cracking the Top 10 in that category. He is two TD grabs away from becoming the eighth player in the League record books with 20 in a career.

**THIS IS SERGEANT PETERSON**

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** leads the Big South and nation with 573 receiving yards and 114.6 receiving yards per game (third nationally). He is pacing ahead of the Conference single-season per game record of 108.1, which was established by **CHRIS SUMMERS** in 2010. Peterson is on pace to finish with 1,375 receiving yards this season, just off the Big South single-season mark of 1,388 by Stony Brook's **KEVIN NORRELL** in 2012.

**MOVING THE CHAINS**

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is tops in the Big South with 170.5 all-purpose yards per game, and already has two games with 200+ yards -- tied for seventh-most in a career in League history. Chaney is looking to become the first newcomer to lead the Conference in all-purpose yards since Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** in 2010.

**HEY YOU... I KNOW YOU, I KNOW YOU**

Richmond Spiders and former Liberty head coach **DANNY ROCCO** is facing his old team for the second time since taking over the UR program in 2012. Rocco, who is coaching against the Big South for the fifth time overall, is 4-1 against the Big South as Richmond's head coach, including 2-1 last year. Rocco spent six seasons in the Big South as the Flames' leader from 2006-11, and directed his teams to a 26-5 Conference record and 47-20 overall mark.

**BEATTY OR NOT, HERE HE COMES**

Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY**, who became the eighth player in Big South history with 6,000 career passing yards when he eclipsed the milestone vs. Wofford in Week 4, currently ranks fifth all-time with 6,432, and needs 259 passing yards to move into third-place. Beatty already ranks in the Conference's career Top 5 with 585 completions (3rd) and 946 pass attempts (4th). He needs 15 completions to become the second Big South quarterback with 600 in a career. Meanwhile, Beatty is among the League's all-time leaders in total offense for plays (5th - 1,122) and yardage (7th - 6,117).

**HENDERSON HOPING TO HOP TOWARDS HISTORY**

Coastal Carolina RB **DE'ANGELO HENDERSON** rushed for 498 yards through the Chanticleers' first four games, matching the school record for most rushing yards through Coastal's first four contests of a season that was established by **AUNDRES PERKINS** in the program's inaugural season of 2003. Henderson's season total stands at 564, but has fallen behind former All-American teammate and current Baltimore Raven **LORENZO TALIAFERRO**'s school record pace, as Taliaferro had 691 yards after five games in 2013 en route to a school-record 1,729. Below is a chart featuring Henderson, Taliaferro and Big South single-season rushing record holder **MIGUEL MAYSONET** after five and six games.

**50-50 PROPOSITION**

Liberty placekicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** kicked a Big South-record 57-yard field goal against Bryant in Week 4. The distance surpassed the previous long of 53 yards, which was first set by VMI's **MATT SHARPE** in 2003 and tied by Keydet kicker **BARRETT WAY** in 2004. Lunsford converted his fourth career field goal from 50+ yards, tied for the most in Big South history with Flames' kicker **MATT BEVINS** (2008-11).

**BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL DEBUTS ON AMERICAN SPORTS NETWORK**

The Big South Conference made its season debut on the new American Sports Network (ASN) this past Saturday with the Elon at Coastal Carolina game. The next broadcast is the Oct. 25 Charleston Southern at Coastal Carolina contest live from Conway at 3:30pm. Big South football will appear on ASN six times in 2014 -- five of them between Conference members, on affiliates and stations owned by Sinclair Broadcast Group. The six broadcasts push the League's overall package to a Big South-record 14 this season (12 League games). In addition, the final five weeks of the 2014 regular-season will now feature two televised games each week.

**BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL FIRST -- UNDEFEATED WEEK**

The Big South Conference went 6-0 during Week 3, the first time in League history that every Conference member won its respective non-conference match-up in the same week. Four of the wins were against FCS foes -- the same total in Week 3 of the 2013 season. Five Big South members were above .500 after three games -- another League first.

**ANOTHER LEAGUE FIRST -- THREE BIG SOUTH TEAMS RANKED**

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference had three nationally-ranked programs in the same week, as the Sept. 22 FCS Coaches poll had Coastal Carolina at No. 3, Liberty at No. 23 and Charleston Southern at No. 25. It is the third time in League annals that three different members have been nationally-ranked in the same season.

**PRESBYTERIAN KNOCKS OFF NATIONALLY-RANKED FURMAN**

The Presbyterian College Blue Hose defeated No. 12/12 Furman, 10-7, in Week 3 for their first win over a nationally-ranked opponent since 2008 when PC downed No. 17 Liberty. Furman is now the highest-ranked team that PC has defeated at the Division I level. Presbyterian's win over the Paladins marked the second-straight season the Big South has recorded a regular-season victory over a nationally-ranked non-conference FCS opponent, and the sixth different season overall in the Big South's 13-year football history.

**FLAMES WIN BIG SOUTH'S MOST RECENT CLASH OF THE TITANS**

Then No. 24-Liberty defeated then-No. 25 Bryant, 38-21, in Week 4 to improve the Big South to 7-8 all-time in games involving a ranked Big South member against a ranked non-conference opponent -- including 4-4 during the regular-season. Five of the eight losses have been by seven points-or-less.

**HE'S GOT THE WILL**

Presbyterian College redshirt-junior LB **DONELLE WILLIAMS** recorded his 10th career 10-tackle game in Week 1 with 12 stops at Northern Illinois. Williams, who has played 29 career games, has averaged 8.07 tackles per game in his career -- one of 11 players in Big South history to average 8.00 tackles per game. Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS** owns a per game average of 8.49 (365 in 43) -- the eighth-highest average in the record books.

**HAMMING IT UP**

Charleston Southern's **DARIUS HAMMOND** returned a punt 74 yards for a touchdown vs. The Citadel in Week 4. It was the first punt return TD by a Buccaneer since **CHARLES JAMES** did it against Wesley College on Oct. 1, 2011. Hammond's 74-yard return is the longest in school history and is tied for ninth-longest in Big South history.

**BLOUNT FORCE**

Gardner-Webb RB **JUANNE BLOUNT** needs 47 rushing yards to move into the Big South's all-time Top 10. He enters this week with 2,309 career yards (most among active players) and 12th in League history, behind Coastal Carolina's **AUNDRES PERKINS** (11th - 2,343) and Stony Brook's **EDWIN GOWINS** (10th - 2,355). Blount is looking to become the only GWU player among the Conference's Top 10 all-time rushers.

**LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION!!**

Charleston Southern and Presbyterian College both added lights to their football stadiums during the offseason. CSU won its first-ever home night game in Week 1 and finished 4-0 in its home night games this season. PC was victorious in its two night games at Bailey Memorial Stadium this year. The Blue Hose played under the lights at home for the first time since Oct. 27, 1990 against Wingate at Old Bailey Stadium. PC lost that game, 33-22.

**CALL HIM MR. FUMBLEROOSKIE**

Liberty's **JACOB HAGEN** returned a fumble 27 yards for a touchdown at North Carolina in Week 1 -- his second career fumble return TD. He is now the first player in Big South history to return two fumbles for scores. Hagen's first career fumble return TD was a 44-yard return vs. Stony Brook in 2012.

**RETURN TO SENDER**

Coastal Carolina's **DEVIN BROWN** returned a kickoff 99 yards for a touchdown at North Carolina A&T in Week 2, tied for the second-longest kickoff return in League history. It was Brown's second career kickoff return TD, and he is now one of seven players in the Big South record books with multiple kickoff return touchdowns. The record for most career kickoff return TDs is three, held by Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** (2005-08), Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** (2007-10) and Liberty's **KEVIN FOGG** (2009-13).

**LaQUA MAYES HAYES**

Presbyterian RB **LaQUA MAYES** broke through for a 92-yard touchdown run against Bluefield in Week 2, establishing the record for longest rush from scrimmage in Big South football history. The previous record was 86 yards set by former Coastal Carolina FB and current Carolina Panther **MIKE TOLBERT** against VMI on Oct. 27, 2007.

**ELIMINATING THE MIDDLE MAN**

Charleston Southern LB **GABE MIDDLEBROOK** returned a fumble 85 yards for a touchdown in the Buccaneers' Week 1 win over Point. It is the fourth-longest fumble return in Big South history, and the longest in the League since Presbyterian's **BRANDON LESTON** had a 91-yard fumble return against Georgia Tech in 2012. Middlebrook's fumble return is the longest by a CSU player during the Big South's football era (since 2002). The previous longest was a 77-yard fumble return for a TD by **JADA ROSS** against Gardner-Webb in 2007.

**BIG BLUE**

Presbyterian College amassed 678 yards of offense against Bluefield in Week 2, the fifth-highest single-game total in League history. The Blue Hose finished with 523 rushing yards against the Rams -- the second-most single-game total in the Conference record books. PC averaged 9.69 yards per play and 8.44 yards per rush in the victory.

**FANNING THE FLAMES**

Liberty set a Big South single-game record for yards per play with its 16.03 average against Brevard in Week 3. The Flames gained 625 yards on just 39 offensive plays, smashing the previous record of 10.66 (Stony Brook vs. Pace - Sept. 8, 2012). Liberty averaged 12.96 yards per rush (23 for 298) against the Tornados, breaking the League single-game mark of 11.79 yards per carry that was established by Coastal Carolina in 2006 at VMI (28 for 330).

**ROSS, COOK ON INITIAL WALTER PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST**

For the second time in Big South history, two players opened the season as official candidates for the Walter Payton Award, as Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** and Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** are among the initial 20 candidates for the top individual award in FCS. In 2011, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** and Flames' WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** opened the campaign among the initial candidates.

**RECORD THREE PLAYERS ON BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD WATCH LIST**

A record three Big South players are among the initial 20 candidates for the Buck Buchanan Award, which honors the top defensive player in FCS. Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS**, who finished seventh in the voting last year, headlines the Big South's trio. Joining him are Gardner-Webb DL **O.J. MAU** and Liberty DB **JACOB HAGEN**. The Big South is tied with the Big Sky Conference for the most Buchanan Award candidates.

**TWO-POINT CONVERSION**

The Big South Conference is one of two FCS Conferences (Big Sky) to have two teams -- Coastal Carolina and Gardner-Webb -- with both a Walter Payton and Buck Buchanan Award candidate.

**MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR THIS ONE**

Coastal Carolina and Liberty will meet in the season-finale for the first time, as their Nov. 22 match-up in Conway will mark their 12th meeting. Coastal leads the series, 6-5, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship nine times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Coastal won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2013, as well as 2010 and 2012.

**WELCOME MAT**

**MONMOUTH UNIVERSITY** is in its first year as an associate member in 2014. Next season, start-up program **KENNESAW STATE UNIVERSITY** begins play and associate membership in the Big South, returning the League to seven football members.
