Ross was 29-of-43 passing for a career-high 351 yards with two touchdowns in leading Coastal Carolina to a 38-14 win at Gardner-Webb. His 29 completions were his second-most in a game, and 18 went for first downs. He also extended his multi-TD pass streak to five. Ross was 7-of-10 for 85 yards in the first quarter and 20-of-28 for 238 yards in the first half as CCU built a 28-14 lead. After being shut out in the third quarter, Ross led CCU to a 12-play, 77-yard TD drive to go up 35-14, by going 5-of-8 with a 22-yard TD pass. He finished the day with 366 yards of total offense, his fifth 300-yard game of the season and 10th of his career.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

AARON BROWN • LB • Junior

Brown led the Buccaneers with eight tackles (seven solo), including a tackle-for-loss of eight yards in CSU's 27-0 win at Monmouth. He was part of a defensive unit that limited the Hawks to 15 rushing yards and 112 yards of total offense -- the third-fewest allowed in a Big South game. The Hawks' lone trip into the red zone came in the fourth quarter off a blocked punt. The Buccaneers' shutout was their first since a 24-0 win over Coastal Carolina in 2008.

COASTAL GOING FOR A PERFECT 10

Coastal Carolina is the first team in Big South history to open the season 9-0 in back-to-back seasons, and is the third overall team to start the year 9-0. The Chanticleers join the 2006 Charleston Southern Buccaneers (9-0) and 2013 Chanticleers (9-0). Coastal Carolina, one of three remaining undefeated FCS programs, is looking to become the first Big South team to start 10-0. The Chants have tied the League mark for longest win streak in a single-season (9) and will attempt to become the first Conference member to win 10 games in consecutive seasons.

PRELUDE TO A CHAMPIONSHIP?

Coastal Carolina is 3-0 in Big South play for the second straight year and fifth time overall. It is the 17th time in League history that a member has opened 3-0 in Conference action -- which has occurred all 13 years of Big South football, and 14 of those squads went on to win/share the Big South Championship. The only teams not to win the League title after starting 3-0 was Liberty in 2011 (second-place) and Charleston Southern in 2013 (third-place).

COASTAL CAROLINA GARNERS BIG SOUTH'S HIGHEST RANKING

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 2 in this week's FCS Coaches poll -- the school's and Big South's highest-ever ranking. The Big South has had a football squad ranked for 47 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24). The Conference has had a Top 5 team in 14 of the last 19 rankings. Coastal Carolina is No. 3 in *The Sports Network* ranking this week. Meanwhile, all six Big South teams have either been ranked or received votes in one or both national polls at some point this season -- another League first.

CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE WON IN NOVEMBER

Six-time Big South football champion Coastal Carolina is 28-8 (=77.8) in its history in regular-season games in November. In fact, the Chanticleers are the only Big South member to win a game in November every season since 2003. In addition, six-time champ Liberty is 29-9 (=76.3 percent) since 2002 during the month of November.

30 FOR 30

What if I told you that Coastal Carolina has tied the Big South record for most consecutive 30 point games? The Chanticleers have matched the mark first set by Liberty from Sept. 29, 2007 to Sept. 6, 2008, and equaled by Stony Brook from Sept. 24, 2011 - Nov. 26, 2011. What if I also told you that Coastal Carolina head coach **JOE MOGLIA** will attempt to win his 30th game this coming Saturday, and join five other coaches in the Big South's 30-win club? Moglia's current winning percentage of 78.4 (29-8) is the highest in League history among coaches with a minimum of 35 games.

HANGING WITH HAGEN

Liberty All-American safety **JACOB HAGEN** is third all-time in Big South history with 12 career interceptions, and he is now just the second player in League annals to pick-off at least five passes in two different seasons, joining all-time interceptions leader **QUINTON TEAL** of Coastal Carolina. Hagen leads the Big South with five picks this season after having six INTs in 2013. His 214 career interception return yards trail only **KEON CUNNINGHAM** of Coastal Carolina, who had 225 from 2007-10. Hagen's 29 career passes defended (12 INT, 17 PBU) is tied for ninth in League history as well. Meanwhile, Hagen's 27-yard fumble return for a touchdown at North Carolina in Week 1 was his second career fumble return TD -- the first player in Big South history to return two fumbles for scores.

DIALING LONG DISTANCE


Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** connected with TE **SETH CRANFILL** on a 75-yard pass play for a touchdown this past Saturday against Coastal Carolina, the longest pass reception by a tight end in Big South history. Cranfill's distance surpassed the previous record of 72 yards by Charleston Southern's **CLAYTON COFFMAN** from **COLLIN DRAFTS** against North Greenville on Sept. 30, 2006.

HOLIDAY ROAD

Coastal Carolina won its sixth consecutive road game with its 38-14 win at Gardner-Webb this past Saturday, establishing the Big South record for longest road win streak. The previous record was five, first set by Liberty (Oct. 20, 2007 - Oct. 4, 2008) and matched by Charleston Southern in 2013. Coastal's six road wins this year tie the Big South single-season mark established by CSU last season, and the Chants will attempt to become the first League member to win seven road games in a campaign Saturday at Charlotte.

THE FOUR HORSEMEN

Four Big South quarterbacks are averaging more than 200 passing yards per game -- Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** (257.6), Monmouth's **BRANDON HILL** (255.8), Coastal Carolina's **ALEX ROSS** (247.2) and Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** (216.9). If the quartet can maintain their respective averages, it would be the first time in Big South history that four quarterbacks averaged 200 yards per game in the same season. The current record is three, accomplished in 2006 and 2013.

WOODWORKING

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is fifth in League history with 47 career touchdown passes and is fourth with 6,865 career passing yards. He needs three TD scoring strikes to become the fourth player with 50 and 135 passing yards to become the fourth with 7,000. Meanwhile, he has rushed for a touchdown and passed for a score in the same game 10 times in his career -- including a League-high six times this season -- and the Flames are 7-3 in such contests (5-1 in 2014). Woodrum's eight rushing TDs this year are tied for fifth in a single-season in League history, while his 14 career rushing scores rank tied for sixth all-time.

CAKE ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is tied for second in Big South history with eight 3-touchdown pass games -- one away from tying the Big South career record. He is sixth in the Conference record books with 46 career TD passes. Ross, who became the seventh quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he reached the milestone in Week 6 at Furman, is seventh among the League's all-time quarterbacks with 1,101 rushing yards. Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** is sixth with 1,182. Meanwhile, Ross set a school-record with 426 yards of offense in Week 5 against Elon, tied for fourth-highest single-game total in Big South history (**LUCAS BEATTY** had 426 at VMI in Week 8). Ross has two career 400-yard games -- tied for second-most in League history, and 10 career games with at least 300, which is tied for third all-time.

SEVENTH HEAVEN

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** and Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** are the joint record-holder for the most 300-yard passing games in Big South history with seven each. Woodrum first broke the record when he moved past Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** and Beatty in Week 7. Beatty moved past Drafts with his 430-yard effort at VMI in Week 8. Woodrum has a League-high four 300-yard passing games this season, one shy of the Big South single-season mark of five established by Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** in 2006.

HENDERSON HOPING TO HOP TOWARDS HISTORY

Coastal Carolina RB **DE'ANGELO HENDERSON**, who matched the school record for most rushing yards through the first four games with 498, leads the Big South with 1,041 rushing yards. He has fallen behind former All-American teammate and current Baltimore Raven **LORENZO TALIAFERRO**'s school record pace, as Taliaferro had 1,251 yards after nine games in 2013 en route to a school-record 1,729. Below is a chart featuring Henderson, Taliaferro and Big South single-season rushing record holder **MIGUEL MAYSONET** after nine and 10 games. Henderson is currently on pace for 1,388 rushing yards, which would be sixth-most in a single-season in Big South history.

HOME COOKED MEAL

Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK**, who missed two full games and 11 consecutive quarters earlier this season with an injury, has returned to form as he has 44 catches for 614 yards and four scores since returning to action in Week 4. Cook is sixth all-time on the Big South's career receptions list with 170, and needs 14 to move into fifth. With 2,301 career receiving yards, he is seventh all-time in that category and 129 away from the sixth spot. Cook became the eighth player in the League record books with 20 career TD grabs during Week 8 and needs one to move into a tie for fifth. His 10 career 100-yard receiving games are tied for first in League history.

PROTECTING THEIR HOUSE

Coastal Carolina has the League's longest active home win streak at 12, tied for the second-longest home win streak in Big South history. It also ties the Chanticleers' record home win streak first established from Sept. 11, 2004 - Nov. 12, 2005. The Big South record is 13 consecutive home wins, set by Stony Brook from Sept. 24, 2011 - Nov. 24, 2012.

RECORD-SETTING ROAD WARRIORS

The Big South has collected nine of its 21 non-conference FCS wins this season on the road -- breaking the League's regular-season record for most non-conference road victories (8 set in 2013), and matching the overall record of nine, which includes postseason wins. Coastal Carolina has four of the nine wins this year. Meanwhile, every League member has won a road game this season -- a first in the Big South's football history.

LIBERTY COLLECTS BIG SOUTH'S FOURTH-EVER FBS WIN

The Big South Conference notched its fourth-ever win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 55-48 overtime win at Appalachian State in Week 7. The Big South's four wins have all come since 2010, and the Flames own two of those victories.

The Big South Conference's exclusive "Game of the Week" on ESPN3 continues this week with the Gardner-Webb at Charleston Southern game live at 11:00am with **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **RENALDO WYNN** (analyst) on the call from Charleston. The season package features eight games and utilizes instant replay assistance from DVSport.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL ON AMERICAN SPORTS NETWORK RESUMES SATURDAY

The Big South Conference is appearing on the new American Sports Network (ASN) the final five weeks of the regular-season, with the next broadcast being Saturday's Monmouth at Liberty contest live from Lynchburg at 3:30pm. **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) have the call. Big South football is appearing on ASN six times in 2014 -- five of them between Conference members, on affiliates and stations owned by Sinclair Broadcast Group. The six broadcasts push the League's overall package to a Big South-record 14 this season (12 League games). In addition, the final five weeks of the 2014 regular-season features two televised games each week.

THE HUBBARD IS NOT BARE

Gardner-Webb kick returner **J.J. HUBBARD** returned a kickoff 95 yards for a touchdown in Week 6 against Charlotte, his third career kickoff return TD. Hubbard now shares the Big South's all-time kickoff return record, joining Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** (2005-08), Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** (2007-10) and the Flames' **KEVIN FOGG** (2009-13). Meanwhile, Hubbard has 99 career kickoff returns -- second-most in League history and three from tying Stevenson's all-time record of 102. Hubbard's 2,194 career kickoff return yards are second all-time as well (Stevenson - 2,449).

INSIDE THE TACKLE BOX

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the active leading tackler in FCS with 386 career stops, which is a school record and second-most in League history. He is 14 away from becoming just the second player in Big South annals with 400. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College's **DONELLE WILLIAMS** is 19th with 271, while Charleston Southern's **DEMARIS FREEMAN** (221), Liberty's **NICK SIGMON** (208) and Flames **JACOB HAGEN** (204) joined the Big South's 200-tackle club in recent weeks.

HE CRAN CATCH

Gardner-Webb TE **SETH CRANFILL** is the Big South's all-time receptions leader among tight ends with 84 catches, as he became the all-time leader in Week 5 during The Citadel game. He broke the old mark of 65 that was established by former Coastal Carolina TE **DAVID DURAN** (2009-12). Cranfill's 858 career receiving yards are second-most among tight ends in League history behind Duran's 910. Cranfill caught two touchdown passes against Wofford in Week 4, which tied the Big South single-game record for TD receptions by a tight end.

THIS IS SERGEANT PETERSON

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** leads the Big South with 947 receiving yards for an average of 105.2 receiving yards per game. Peterson is on pace to finish with 1,263 receiving yards this season, which would be the second-highest single-season total in Big South history, and behind the record of 1,388 by Stony Brook's **KEVIN NORRELL** in 2012. Meanwhile, Peterson had 12 catches at Indiana State in Week 4 and 11 against Richmond in Week 5 to become the first Big South player with back-to-back 10 reception games since Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE** in 2006.

PEGUES THE AREA

Gardner-Webb freshman LB **JEFFREY PEGUES** made 20 tackles at VMI in Week 8, the first Big South player with 20 tackles in a game since former Runnin' Bulldog LB **MARTY PATTERSON** had 20 stops against Charleston Southern on Oct. 29, 2011. Pegues is the second Big South freshman with 20 tackles in a game, as GWU's **MIKE PAVELKO** had a record 24 against VMI as a frosh in a triple-overtime victory on Oct. 22, 2005.

CAN'T FUMBLE THIS NOTE

Big South football members have returned six fumbles for touchdowns this year, setting the Big South single-season record for most fumble return scores. The previous record was four in 2002, 2004, 2007, 2009 and 2011. A record four different teams -- Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina (2), Liberty (2), and Presbyterian -- have fumble return TDs this season. The previous best was three.

MOVING THE CHAINS

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is tops in the Big South with 141.1 all-purpose yards per game, and already has two games with 200+ yards -- tied for seventh-most in a career in League history. Chaney is looking to become the first newcomer to lead the Conference in all-purpose yards since Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** in 2010.

QUADRUPLE FOR QUINN

Coastal Carolina LB and Buck Buchanan Award candidate **QUINN BACKUS** has forced four fumbles this season, tied for second-most in a season in League history. The record is five, established by Gardner-Webb's **MARIO WILLIAMS** in 2003 and tied by Coastal Carolina's **D.J. RICE** in 2007. Backus has a CCU-record seven career forced fumbles, tied with Liberty's **MANNY ROJAS** (2003-06) for second-most in the Conference record book. That record is eight by Williams and Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** (2004-07).

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal is 22-1 in its last 23 games when rushing for more than 200 yards, including 6-0 this season. The Chanticleers have rushed for more than 200 yards 67 times in their history, and are 62-5 (=92.5) when reaching the 200-yard plateau. Carolina has rushed for 200-plus yards in 24 of Head Coach **JOE MOGLIA**'s 37 games as CCU's head coach, posting an 23-1 record in such games.

BEATTY OR NOT, HERE HE COMES

Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** is second in Big South history with 7,563 career passing yards, 674 career completions and 1,097 attempts. Beatty ranks third among the active FCS career leaders in completions, as well as fifth in attempts and sixth in yardage. Meanwhile, he ranks among the Big South's all-time leaders in total offense yardage (5th - 7,278) and plays (3rd - 1,309).

SOLO ARTIST

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the Big South's all-time leader for solo tackles with 214 -- the only player in League history with 200. He broke the record during the Elon game in Week 5 with eight solo stops -- vaulting ahead of both Charleston Southern's **JADA ROSS** (195) and previous record holder **JUSTIN BETHEL** (Presbyterian - 199) for the top spot.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 106, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (40). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 50, breaking its old mark of 45 (Sept. 23, 2006 - Sept. 18, 2010) in Week 5.

KING OF THE HILL

Monmouth QB **BRANDON HILL**'s streak of seven consecutive 200-yard passing games ended this past Saturday against Charleston Southern -- the third-longest streak in Big South history. Earlier this season, Hill tied the League record for most consecutive multi-TD games at six, as he tossed 15 TD passes in that span. Hill is the fourth different QB to achieve the record, joining Stony Brook's **MICHAEL COULTER** (2009 - 12 TDs), Liberty's **MIKE BROWN** (2011 - 13 TDs) and Stony Brook's **KYLE ESSINGTON** (2011-12 - 13 TDs).

CATCHIN' CATRON

Coastal Carolina kicker **ALEX CATRON** is the seventh player in Big South history with 30 career field goals, as he reached the milestone this past Saturday at Gardner-Webb. He is the third Coastal kicker on the list, joining **JUSTIN DURHAM** (42, 2007-10) and **JOSH HOKE** (40, 2003-06).

BLUE HOSE SWARM

Presbyterian College returned two of its four interceptions for touchdowns in Week 6 against Western Carolina, tying the Big South single-game record. The Blue Hose are just the second team in League history with two INT scores in a game, matching the record first set by Liberty at Charleston Southern on Oct. 22, 2011. PC's four picks against WCU was its most since joining the Big South in 2008.

WOODRUM'S THREE-PEAT

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** threw three touchdowns in back-to-back games for the second time in his career. He is just the third quarterback in Big South history to accomplish the dual feat, joining Stony Brook's **KYLE ESSINGTON** (three times) and Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** (two). The record for most consecutive 3 TD pass games is three, set by Liberty's **MIKE BROWN** from Oct. 2-16, 2010.

PITCH-AND-CATCH COMBO

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** became the first non-quarterback in Big South history to throw two touchdown passes in a game in Week 7 against Columbia. Chaney's first TD pass was to Hawks QB **BRANDON HILL** -- who became the first Big South QB with a TD reception since Liberty's **KYLE PAINTER** in 2002, and the second overall.

BIG SOUTH SETS RECORD FOR MOST FCS WINS FOR SECOND-STRAIGHT YEAR

The Big South is 21-5 through 26 games against FCS opponents, extending the Conference record for most wins against non-conference FCS foes. Last season, the Big South was an all-time best 16-9 in regular-season competition and 18-10 through the postseason. The Big South has one remaining non-conference FCS games in 2014 until the Playoffs.

TOP CHEFS

Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** set the Big South single-game receiving record with 251 yards at VMI in Week 8. The old record was 240 by Liberty's **CHRIS SUMMERS** against Stony Brook on Nov. 19, 2011. Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY**'s 430 passing yards against the Keydets broke the Big South single-game record of 419, which was set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** against Allen on Nov. 6, 2004. Beatty, who also tied the Big South single-game record with five TD passes, became just the second different Big South QB with 400 passing yards in a game.

BASILE NAMED TO JERRY RICE AWARD WATCH LIST

Monmouth freshman safety **MIKE BASILE** is among the candidates for the 2014 Jerry Rice Award, which is awarded to the top freshman player in the country. Basile is the second Big South player to be an official candidate for the Rice Award, joining Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** (2012).

BIG JOHN STUD

Liberty kicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** kicked a Big-South-record 60-yard field goal at the end of regulation to force overtime against nationally-ranked Richmond in Week 6. The first player in League history to attempt a field goal from that distance, Lunsford is the ninth different kicker in FCS history to make a field goal from 60+ yards, and the first in 14 years. His 60-yarder matched the third-longest made in terms of distance, behind 63 (three kickers) and 62 (two). Three other kickers have converted from 60 yards. Meanwhile, Lunsford's memorable kick gave him a Big South-record five career field goals from 50+ yards.

DEFENSIVE MINDED

Presbyterian's 7-3 win over Charleston Southern in Week 8 set the League record for lowest scoring Conference game at 10 points. The previous combined low was 17 points, set by VMI (10) and Liberty (7) on Oct. 1, 2005, and matched by Gardner-Webb (10) and VMI (7) on Nov. 20, 2010. PC held the Buccaneers to their lowest point total since a shutout loss at Illinois on Sept. 15, 2012, and limited Charleston Southern to just three points in three trips to the red zone. PC also allowed 250 yards of offense, a season-low for the Buccaneers.

MONMOUTH'S MONUMENTAL PASSING

Monmouth tied the Big South single-game record with six passing touchdowns in Week 7 vs. Columbia. The Hawks joined Charleston Southern (vs. North Greenville, 10-23-04) and Liberty (vs. St. Francis, Pa., 9-4-10) as the only Big South teams with six TDs passing in a game.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL FIRST -- UNDEFEATED WEEK

The Big South Conference went 6-0 during Week 3, the first time in League history that every Conference member won its respective non-conference match-up in the same week. Four of the wins were against FCS foes -- the same total in Week 3 of the 2013 season. Five Big South members were above .500 after three games -- another League first.

ANOTHER LEAGUE FIRST -- THREE BIG SOUTH TEAMS RANKED

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference had three nationally-ranked programs in the same week, as the Sept. 22 FCS Coaches poll had Coastal Carolina at No. 3, Liberty at No. 23 and Charleston Southern at No. 25. It is the third time in League annals that three different members have been nationally-ranked in the same season.

ALL HANDS ON DECK

Every football member was at or above .500 from Week 5 thru Week 9 of the season, establishing the League record for the latest the Big South achieved this distinction. In fact, the Big South was the only FCS Conference to have every member with .500 or better winning percentages entering Week 10.

THREE-AND-OUT

Coastal Carolina became the first team in Big South history to hold three consecutive opponents to three points-or-less, as the Chanticleers limited three opponents to a field goal each during Weeks 3-5 while outscoring the opposition, 109-9. The Chants have matched the League record for most times allowing no more than three points (three times), joining Charleston Southern (2002) and Liberty (2006, 2008).

FIRE PROOF

Liberty held Gardner-Webb to minus-17 net rushing yards in Week 9, the fewest allowed in a conference games in Big South history and the fifth-lowest overall. The Flames limited the Runnin' Bulldogs to 56 yards of offense, tied for the lowest in a single-game in the League record books and the lowest in a conference contest.

PRESBYTERIAN LATEST BIG SOUTH MEMBER WITH TWO WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS

Presbyterian College defeated its second nationally-ranked opponent this season with its 7-3 victory at No. 22/23 Charleston Southern in Week 8. It is sixth time in League history that a football member recorded two wins over ranked foes in the same season. PC is the fourth different member to achieve this feat, joining Coastal Carolina (three times), Liberty and Gardner-Webb. The Blue Hose downed then-No. 12/12 Furman, 10-7, in Week 3 for their first win over a nationally-ranked opponent since 2008 when PC downed No. 17 Liberty. Furman is now the highest-ranked team that PC has defeated at the Division I level. Presbyterian's win over the Paladins marked the second-straight season the Big South has recorded a regular-season victory over a nationally-ranked non-conference FCS opponent, and the sixth different season overall in the Big South's 13-year football history.

LaQUA MAYES HAYES

Presbyterian RB **LaQUA MAYES** broke through for a 92-yard touchdown run against Bluefield in Week 2, establishing the record for longest rush from scrimmage in Big South football history. The previous record was 86 yards set by former Coastal Carolina FB and current Carolina Panther **MIKE TOLBERT** against VMI on Oct. 27, 2007.

FLAMES WIN BIG SOUTH'S MOST RECENT CLASH OF THE TITANS

Then No. 24-Liberty defeated then-No. 25 Bryant, 38-21, in Week 4 to improve the Big South to 7-8 all-time in games involving a ranked Big South member against a ranked non-conference opponent -- including 4-4 during the regular-season. Five of the eight losses have been by seven points-or-less.

ELIMINATING THE MIDDLE MAN

Charleston Southern LB **GABE MIDDLEBROOK** returned a fumble 85 yards for a touchdown in the Buccaneers' Week 1 win over Point. It is the fourth-longest fumble return in Big South history, and the longest in the League since Presbyterian's **BRANDON LESTON** had a 91-yard fumble return against Georgia Tech in 2012. Middlebrook's fumble return is the longest by a CSU player during the Big South's football era (since 2002). The previous longest was a 77-yard fumble return for a TD by **JADA ROSS** against Gardner-Webb in 2007.

FANNING THE FLAMES

Liberty set a Big South single-game record for yards per play with its 16.03 average against Brevard in Week 3. The Flames gained 625 yards on just 39 offensive plays, smashing the previous record of 10.66 (Stony Brook vs. Pace - Sept. 8, 2012). Liberty averaged 12.96 yards per rush (23 for 298) against the Tornados, breaking the League single-game mark of 11.79 yards per carry that was established by Coastal Carolina in 2006 at VMI (28 for 330).

ROSS, COOK ON INITIAL WALTER PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST

For the second time in Big South history, two players opened the season as official candidates for the Walter Payton Award, as Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** and Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** are among the initial 20 candidates for the top individual award in FCS. In 2011, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** and Flames' WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** opened the campaign among the initial candidates.

RECORD THREE PLAYERS ON BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD WATCH LIST

A record three Big South players are among the initial 20 candidates for the Buck Buchanan Award, which honors the top defensive player in FCS. Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS**, who finished seventh in the voting last year, headlines the Big South's trio. Joining him are Gardner-Webb DL **O.J. MAU** and Liberty DB **JACOB HAGEN**. The Big South is tied with the Big Sky Conference for the most Buchanan Award candidates.

MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR THIS ONE

Coastal Carolina and Liberty will meet in the season-finale for the first time, as their Nov. 22 match-up in Conway will mark their 12th meeting. Coastal leads the series, 6-5, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship nine times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Coastal won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2013, as well as 2010 and 2012.
