### CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**ALEX ROSS • QB • R-Junior**  
Coastal Carolina • Alpharetta, Ga.

Ross was 27-of-37 passing for a career-high 370 yards and rushed nine times for 56 yards and two scores in leading the Chanticleers to a 59-34 win at Charlotte. He played just three quarters and tied the school-record with 426 yards of total offense. Ross led scoring drives of 99 and 94 yards, and converted three 3rd-and-long situations that eventually resulted in points. On Coastal's third scoring drive, he had three rushes for 27 yards, followed by 3-of-3 passing for 47 yards on Coastal's fourth scoring drive. Ross started the third quarter with completions of 11 and 20 yards before running 41 yards for a touchdown. He was 6-of-6 passing for 75 yards in his final scoring drive of the day.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**GABE MIDDLEBROOK • LB • Senior**  
Charleston Southern • Charleston, S.C.

Middlebrook recorded five tackles, two tackles-for-loss, 1.5 sacks, a pass breakup and a quarterback hurry in Charleston Southern's 44-14 win over Gardner-Webb. His hit on GWU quarterback Lucas Beatty caused an interception that was returned for a score in the opening quarter. Middlebrook's sacks came on second down while his pass breakup prevented a first down.

**LOOK WHO IS NUMBER 1 - COASTAL CAROLINA GARNERS BIG SOUTH'S FIRST-EVER NO. 1 RANK**

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 1 in this week's FCS Coaches poll -- the school's and Big South's highest-ever ranking. It is the first time in the Conference's history that any athletic program has received a No. 1 national poll ranking. Coastal Carolina is No. 2 in *The Sports Network* ranking this week, and collected 55 first-place votes and sits 53 points out of the top spot. The Big South has had a football squad ranked for 48 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24), and has had a Top 5 team in 15 of the last 20 rankings. Meanwhile, all six Big South teams have either been ranked or received votes in one or both national polls at some point this season -- another League first.

**COASTAL SCORES PERFECT 10**

Coastal Carolina is the first team in Big South history to open the season 10-0, and is the first FCS program with 10 wins this season. Coastal Carolina, one of two remaining undefeated FCS programs, has set the League mark for longest win streak in a single-season (10) and is the first Conference member to win 10 games in consecutive seasons.

**PRELUDE TO A CHAMPIONSHIP?**

Coastal Carolina is 3-0 in Big South play for the second straight year and fifth time overall, while Liberty is 3-0 in Big South games for the first time since 2011 and sixth overall. It is the 17th and 18th time in League history that a member has opened 3-0 in Conference action -- which has occurred all 13 years of Big South football, and 14 of those squads went on to win/share the Big South Championship. The only teams not to win the League title after starting 3-0 was Liberty in 2011 (second-place) and Charleston Southern in 2013 (third-place).

**IT'S ACADEMIC**

A Big South-record nine student-athletes were voted Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District this season, bettering the previous mark of six. Each Big South football member had an honoree, led by Coastal Carolina (3 - **MO ASHLEY, CHAD HAMILTON, BRETT JOHNSON**), and followed by Liberty (2 - **MITCH HANSON, CHIMA UZOWIHE**), Charleston Southern (1 - **CHRISTIAN REYES**), Gardner-Webb (1 - **TYLER HOUGH-JENKINS**), Monmouth (1 - **JOE JOHNSON**) and Presbyterian (1 - **UGONNA AKOH**). All nine individuals advance to the Academic All-America ballot.

**30 FOR 30**

What if I told you that Coastal Carolina has set the Big South record for most consecutive 30 point games? The Chanticleers have scored 30 points in 10-straight games, breaking the old record of nine. What if I also told you that Coastal Carolina head coach **JOE MOGLIA** won his 30th game this past Saturday to become the sixth Big South coach in the League's 30-win club? Moglia's current winning percentage of 78.9 (30-8) is the highest in League history among coaches with a minimum of 35 games.

**MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR THIS ONE**

Coastal Carolina and Liberty will meet in the season-finale for the first time, as their Nov. 22 match-up in Conway will mark their 12th meeting. Coastal leads the series, 6-5, and the winner of the match-up has won or shared the Big South football Championship nine times. The Chanticleers won three-straight over Liberty from 2004-06 en route to three consecutive titles (two outright, one shared). The Flames were victorious from 2007-09 while winning three-straight Big South crowns (two outright, one shared). Coastal won last season's meeting and both teams shared the title in 2013, as well as 2010 and 2012.

**ABNAR THE ANCHOR**


Liberty RB **D.J. ABNAR** had 39 rushes this past Saturday against Monmouth, the second-most in a game in League history. He was one carry shy of matching the Big South single-game record of 40, which is held by former Flames' RB **EUGENE GOODMAN**, who had 40 rushing attempts against Hofstra on Nov. 22, 2003. Abnar, who leads the Big South with 207 carries this season, has averaged 30 rush attempts in the last four games.

**TREASURE CHEST**

Charleston Southern returned two of its four interceptions for touchdowns this past Saturday against Gardner-Webb, tying the Big South single-game record. The Bucs are the third team in League history -- and second this season -- with two INT scores in a game. Liberty first set the record at Charleston Southern on Oct. 22, 2011. Presbyterian accomplished the feat in Week 6 against Western Carolina.

**HOLDER HOLDS ON WHEN OTHERS CANNOT**

Coastal Carolina DL **RODERICK HOLDER** is the first player in Big South history to return two fumbles for touchdowns in the same season. Holder also joins Liberty's **JACOB HAGEN** as the only players in the League record books with two career fumble return TDs.

**CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE WON IN NOVEMBER**

Six-time Big South football champion Coastal Carolina is 29-8 ( =78.4) in its history in regular-season games in November. In fact, the Chanticleers are the only Big South member to win a game in November every season since 2003. In addition, six-time champ Liberty is 30-9 ( =76.9 percent) since 2002 during the month of November.

**HOLIDAY ROAD**

Coastal Carolina won its seventh consecutive road game with its 59-34 win at Charlotte this past Saturday, extending its Big South record for longest road win streak. The previous record was five, first set by Liberty (Oct. 20, 2007 - Oct. 4, 2008) and matched by Charleston Southern in 2013. Coastal's seven road wins this year are a Big South single-season record, breaking the hold mark of six established by CSU last season.

**2,000-YARD RUSHING ODYSSEY**

Charleston Southern RB **CHRISTIAN REYES** is 63 rushing yards away from becoming the 17th player in Big South history with 2,000 career rushing yards. Reyes is CSU's all-time rushing leader with 1,937, and he is tied for 10th in League annals with eight career 100-yard rushing games.

**THE FOUR HORSEMEN**

Four Big South quarterbacks are averaging more than 200 passing yards per game -- Coastal Carolina's **ALEX ROSS** (259.4) Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** (252.1), Monmouth's **BRANDON HILL** (248.3), and Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** (214.1). If the quartet can maintain their respective averages, it would be the first time in Big South history that four quarterbacks averaged 200 passing yards per game in the same season. The current record is three, accomplished in 2006 and 2013.

**WOODWORKING**

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is fourth in League history with 49 career touchdown passes and is third with 7,068 career passing yards. He needs one TD scoring strike to become the fourth player with 50. Meanwhile, he has rushed for a touchdown and passed for a score in the same game 10 times in his career -- including a League-high six times this season -- and the Flames are 7-3 in such contests (5-1 in 2014). Woodrum's eight rushing TDs this year are tied for fifth in a single-season in League history, while his 14 career rushing scores rank tied for sixth all-time.

**CAKE ROSS**

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** recorded his third career game with 400 yards of total offense this past Saturday with a school-record tying 426 at Charlotte. His three career 400 games has tied the Big South career mark first set by Liberty's **MIKE BROWN** (2008-11), and Ross now has 11 career games with at least 300, which is tied for second all-time with Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** (2003-06). Meanwhile, Ross is tied for second in Big South history with eight 3-touchdown pass games and is sixth in the Conference record books with 46 career TD passes. The seventh quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards (1,157), Ross is 26 rushing yards away from passing Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** (1,182) for sixth.

**SEVENTH HEAVEN**

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** and Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** are the joint record-holder for the most 300-yard passing games in Big South history with seven each. Woodrum first broke the record when he moved past Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** and Beatty in Week 7. Beatty moved past Drafts with his 430-yard effort at VMI in Week 8. Woodrum has a League-high four 300-yard passing games this season, one shy of the Big South single-season mark of five established by Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** in 2006.

**HENDERSON HOPING TO HOP TOWARDS HISTORY**

Coastal Carolina RB **DE'ANGELO HENDERSON**, who matched the school record for most rushing yards through the first four games with 498, leads the Big South with 1,095 rushing yards. He is currently on pace for 1,314 rushing yards, which would be seventh-most in a single-season in Big South history. Henderson is looking to become the second-straight Chanticleer and third overall to lead the Big South in rushing.

**HANGING WITH HAGEN**

Liberty All-American safety **JACOB HAGEN** is third all-time in Big South history with 12 career interceptions, and is just the second player in League annals to pick-off at least five passes in two different seasons, joining all-time interceptions leader **QUINTON TEAL** of Coastal Carolina. Hagen leads the Big South with five picks this season after having six INTs in 2013. His 214 career interception return yards trail only **KEON CUNNINGHAM** of Coastal Carolina, who had 225 from 2007-10. Hagen's 30 career passes defended (12 INT, 18 PBU) is tied for eighth in League history as well. Meanwhile, Hagen's 27-yard fumble return for a touchdown at North Carolina in Week 1 was his second career fumble return TD -- the first player in Big South history to return two fumbles for scores.

**BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL "GAME OF THE WEEK" ON ESPN3 CONTINUES THIS SATURDAY**

The Big South Conference's exclusive "Game of the Week" on ESPN3 continues this week with the Monmouth at Coastal Carolina game live at 3:00pm with **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **RENALDO WYNN** (analyst) on the call from Conway. The season package features eight games and utilizes instant replay assistance from DVSport.

**BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL ON AMERICAN SPORTS NETWORK RESUMES SATURDAY**

The Big South Conference is appearing on the new American Sports Network (ASN) the final five weeks of the regular-season, with the next broadcast being Saturday's Presbyterian at Gardner-Webb contest live from Boiling Springs at 12:00pm. **JEFF McCARRAGHER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) have the call. Big South football is appearing on ASN six times in 2014 -- five of them between Conference members, on affiliates and stations owned by Sinclair Broadcast Group. The six broadcasts push the League's overall package to a Big South-record 14 this season (12 League games). In addition, the final five weeks of the 2014 regular-season features two televised games each week.

**QUINN'S QUINTET**

Coastal Carolina LB and Buck Buchanan Award candidate **QUINN BACKUS** has forced five fumbles this season, tied for the most in a season in League history. He joins Gardner-Webb's **MARIO WILLIAMS** (2003) and Coastal Carolina's **D.J. RICE** (2007) as the only players to force five fumbles in a season. Backus has a CCU-record eight career forced fumbles, which also ties the Big South career record held by Williams and Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** (2004-07).

**PROTECTING THEIR HOUSE**

Coastal Carolina has the League's longest active home win streak at 12, tied for the second-longest home win streak in Big South history. It also ties the Chanticleers' record home win streak first established from Sept. 11, 2004 - Nov. 12, 2005. The Big South record is 13 consecutive home wins, set by Stony Brook from Sept. 24, 2011 - Nov. 24, 2012.

**CAN'T FUMBLE THIS NOTE**

Big South football members have returned seven fumbles for touchdowns this year, setting the Big South single-season record for most fumble return scores. The previous record was four in 2002, 2004, 2007, 2009 and 2011. A record four different teams -- Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina (3), Liberty (2), and Presbyterian -- have fumble return TDs this season. The previous best was three.

**RECORD-SETTING ROAD WARRIORS**

The Big South has collected 10 of its 22 non-conference FCS wins this season on the road -- breaking the League's regular-season record for most non-conference road victories (8 set in 2013), and surpassing the overall record of nine, which includes postseason wins. Coastal Carolina has five of the 10 wins this year. Meanwhile, every League member has won a road game this season -- a first in the Big South's football history.

**LIBERTY COLLECTS BIG SOUTH'S FOURTH-EVER FBS WIN**

The Big South Conference notched its fourth-ever win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 55-48 overtime win at Appalachian State in Week 7. The Big South's four wins have all come since 2010, and the Flames own two of those victories.

**THE HUBBARD IS NOT BARE**

Gardner-Webb kick returner **J.J. HUBBARD** is the Big South career leader for kickoff returns (103) and kickoff return touchdowns (3). He returned a kickoff 95 yards for a touchdown in Week 6 against Charlotte for his career record-tying third career kickoff return TD. Hubbard's 2,242 career kickoff return yards are second all-time. Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** is the all-time leader with 2,449.

**INSIDE THE TACKLE BOX**

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the active leading tackler in FCS with 391 career stops, which is a school record and second-most in League history. He is nine away from becoming just the second player in Big South annals with 400. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College's **DONELLE WILLIAMS** is 17th with 281, while Charleston Southern's **DEMARIS FREEMAN** (227), Liberty's **NICK SIGMON** (211) and Flames **JACOB HAGEN** (214) joined the Big South's 200-tackle club in recent weeks.

**HE CRAN CATCH**

Gardner-Webb TE **SETH CRANFILL** is the Big South's all-time receptions leader among tight ends with 86 catches, as he became the all-time leader in Week 5 during The Citadel game. He broke the old mark of 65 that was established by former Coastal Carolina TE **DAVID DURAN** (2009-12). Cranfill's 873 career receiving yards are second-most among tight ends in League history behind Duran's 910. Cranfill caught two touchdown passes against Wofford in Week 4, which tied the Big South single-game record for TD receptions by a tight end.

**BIG SOUTH SETS RECORD FOR MOST FCS WINS FOR SECOND-STRAIGHT YEAR**

The Big South finished 22-5 in 27 regular-season games against FCS opponents this season, a Conference record for most wins against non-conference FCS foes. Last season, the Big South was an all-time best 16-9 in regular-season competition and 18-10 through the postseason.

**HIGH RATE OF RETURN**

Coastal is 23-1 in its last 24 games when rushing for more than 200 yards, including 7-0 this season. The Chanticleers have rushed for more than 200 yards 68 times in their history, and are 63-5 (-92.6) when reaching the 200-yard plateau. Carolina has rushed for 200-plus yards in 25 of Head Coach **JOE MOGLIA**'s 38 games as CCU's head coach, posting an 24-1 record in such games.

**BEATTY OR NOT, HERE HE COMES**

Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** is second in Big South history with 7,752 career passing yards, 690 career completions and 1,127 attempts. Beatty ranks fourth among the active FCS career leaders in completions, as well as fifth in attempts and sixth in yardage. Meanwhile, he ranks among the Big South's all-time leaders in total offense yardage (5th - 7,476) and plays (3rd - 1,349).

**SOLO ARTIST**

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the Big South's all-time leader for solo tackles with 218 -- the only player in League history with 200. He broke the record during the Elon game in Week 5 with eight solo stops -- vaulting ahead of both Charleston Southern's **JADA ROSS** (195) and previous record holder **JUSTIN BETHEL** (Presbyterian - 199) for the top spot.

**HOME COOKED MEAL**

Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** is sixth all-time on the Big South's career receptions list with 175, and needs nine to move into fifth. With 2,331 career receiving yards, he is seventh all-time in that category and 99 away from the sixth spot. Cook became the eighth player in the League record books with 20 career TD grabs during Week 8 and needs one to move into a tie for fifth. His 10 career 100-yard receiving games are tied for first in League history.

**POINT OF ORDER**

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 107, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (41). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 51, breaking its old mark of 45 (Sept. 23, 2006 - Sept. 18, 2010) in Week 5.

**KING OF THE HILL**

Monmouth QB **BRANDON HILL**'s streak of seven consecutive 200-yard passing games ended in Week 10 against Charleston Southern -- the third-longest streak in Big South history. Earlier this season, Hill tied the League record for most consecutive multi-TD games at six, as he tossed 15 TD passes in that span. Hill is the fourth different QB to achieve the record, joining Stony Brook's **MICHAEL COULTER** (2009 - 12 TDs), Liberty's **MIKE BROWN** (2011 - 13 TDs) and Stony Brook's **KYLE ESSINGTON** (2011-12 - 13 TDs).

**CATCHIN' CATRON**

Coastal Carolina kicker **ALEX CATRON** is the seventh player in Big South history with 30 career field goals, as he reached the milestone in Week 10 at Gardner-Webb. He is the third Coastal kicker on the list, joining **JUSTIN DURHAM** (42, 2007-10) and **JOSH HOKE** (40, 2003-06).

**WOODRUM'S THREE-PEAT**

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** threw three touchdowns in back-to-back games for the second time in his career. He is just the third quarterback in Big South history to accomplish the dual feat, joining Stony Brook's **KYLE ESSINGTON** (three times) and Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** (two). The record for most consecutive 3 TD pass games is three, set by Liberty's **MIKE BROWN** from Oct. 2-16, 2010.

**PITCH-AND-CATCH COMBO**

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** became the first non-quarterback in Big South history to throw two touchdown passes in a game in Week 7 against Columbia. Chaney's first TD pass was to Hawks QB **BRANDON HILL** -- who became the first Big South QB with a TD reception since Liberty's **KYLE PAINTER** in 2002, and the second overall.

**THIS IS SERGEANT PETERSON**

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** leads the Big South with 978 receiving yards for an average of 97.8 receiving yards per game. Peterson is on pace to finish with 1,174 receiving yards this season, which would be the second-highest single-season total in Big South history, and behind the record of 1,388 by Stony Brook's **KEVIN NORRELL** in 2012. Meanwhile, Peterson had 12 catches at Indiana State in Week 4 and 11 against Richmond in Week 5 to become the first Big South player with back-to-back 10 reception games since Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE** in 2006.

**REAL ESTATE MOGULS**

Coastal Carolina amassed a Big South season-high and school-record 690 yards of offense this past Saturday at Charlotte, the fourth-most in a game in League history. The Chanticleers finished five yards shy of the overall mark of 695 (Charleston Southern vs. West Virginia Wesleyan in 2005) and two yards behind the record against a Division I opponent (692 - Liberty at Presbyterian in 2012).

**PEGUES THE AREA**

Gardner-Webb freshman LB **JEFFREY PEGUES** made 20 tackles at VMI in Week 8, the first Big South player with 20 tackles in a game since former Runnin' Bulldog LB **MARTY PATTERSON** had 20 stops against Charleston Southern on Oct. 29, 2011. Pegues is the second Big South freshman with 20 tackles in a game, as GWU's **MIKE PAVELKO** had a record 24 against VMI as a frosh in a triple-overtime victory on Oct. 22, 2005.

**TOP CHEFS**

Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** set the Big South single-game receiving record with 251 yards at VMI in Week 8. The old record was 240 by Liberty's **CHRIS SUMMERS** against Stony Brook on Nov. 19, 2011. Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY**'s 430 passing yards against the Keydets broke the Big South single-game record of 419, which was set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** against Allen on Nov. 6, 2004. Beatty, who also tied the Big South single-game record with five TD passes, became just the second different Big South QB with 400 passing yards in a game.

**MOVING THE CHAINS**

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is tops in the Big South with 139.3 all-purpose yards per game, and already has two games with 200+ yards -- tied for seventh-most in a career in League history. Chaney is looking to become the first newcomer to lead the Conference in all-purpose yards since Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** in 2010.

**BIG JOHN STUD**

Liberty kicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** kicked a Big-South-record 60-yard field goal at the end of regulation to force overtime against nationally-ranked Richmond in Week 6. The first player in League history to attempt a field goal from that distance, Lunsford is the ninth different kicker in FCS history to make a field goal from 60+ yards, and the first in 14 years. His 60-yarder matched the third-longest made in terms of distance, behind 63 (three kickers) and 62 (two). Three other kickers have converted from 60 yards. Meanwhile, Lunsford's memorable kick gave him a Big South-record five career field goals from 50+ yards.

**DEFENSIVE MINDED**

Presbyterian's 7-3 win over Charleston Southern in Week 8 set the League record for lowest scoring Conference game at 10 points. The previous combined low was 17 points, set by VMI (10) and Liberty (7) on Oct. 1, 2005, and matched by Gardner-Webb (10) and VMI (7) on Nov. 20, 2010. PC held the Buccaneers to their lowest point total since a shutout loss at Illinois on Sept. 15, 2012, and limited Charleston Southern to just three points in three trips to the red zone. PC also allowed 250 yards of offense, a season-low for the Buccaneers.

**MONMOUTH'S MONUMENTAL PASSING**

Monmouth tied the Big South single-game record with six passing touchdowns in Week 7 vs. Columbia. The Hawks joined Charleston Southern (vs. North Greenville, 10-23-04) and Liberty (vs. St. Francis, Pa., 9-4-10) as the only Big South teams with six TDs passing in a game.

**BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL FIRST -- UNDEFEATED WEEK**

The Big South Conference went 6-0 during Week 3, the first time in League history that every Conference member won its respective non-conference match-up in the same week. Four of the wins were against FCS foes -- the same total in Week 3 of the 2013 season. Five Big South members were above .500 after three games -- another League first.

**ANOTHER LEAGUE FIRST -- THREE BIG SOUTH TEAMS RANKED**

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference had three nationally-ranked programs in the same week, as the Sept. 22 FCS Coaches poll had Coastal Carolina at No. 3, Liberty at No. 23 and Charleston Southern at No. 25. It is the third time in League annals that three different members have been nationally-ranked in the same season.

**ALL HANDS ON DECK**

Every football member was at or above .500 from Week 5 thru Week 9 of the season, establishing the League record for the latest point in a season the Big South achieved this distinction. In fact, the Big South was the only FCS Conference to have every member with .500 or better winning percentages entering Week 10.

**ROSS, COOK ON WALTER PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST**

For the second time in Big South history, two players opened the season as official candidates for the Walter Payton Award, as Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** and Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** remain among the 20 candidates for the top individual award in FCS. In 2011, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** and Flames' WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** opened the campaign among the initial candidates.

**RECORD THREE PLAYERS ON BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD WATCH LIST**

A record three Big South players remain among the 20 candidates for the Buck Buchanan Award, which honors the top defensive player in FCS. Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS**, who finished seventh in the voting last year, headlines the Big South's trio. Joining him are Gardner-Webb DL **O.J. MAU** and Liberty DB **JACOB HAGEN**.

**BASILE NAMED TO JERRY RICE AWARD WATCH LIST**

Monmouth freshman safety **MIKE BASILE** is among the candidates for the 2014 Jerry Rice Award, which is awarded to the top freshman player in the country. Basile is the second Big South player to be an official candidate for the Rice Award, joining Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** (2012).

**DIALING LONG DISTANCE**

Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** connected with TE **SETH CRANFILL** on a 75-yard pass play for a touchdown in Week 10 against Coastal Carolina, the longest pass reception by a tight end in Big South history. Cranfill's distance surpassed the previous record of 72 yards by Charleston Southern's **CLAYTON COFFMAN** from **COLLIN DRAFTS** against North Greenville on Sept. 30, 2006.

**FIRE PROOF**

Liberty held Gardner-Webb to minus-17 net rushing yards in Week 9, the fewest allowed in a conference games in Big South history and the fifth-lowest overall. The Flames limited the Runnin' Bulldogs to 56 yards of offense, tied for the lowest in a single-game in the League record books and the lowest in a conference contest.

**PRESBYTERIAN LATEST BIG SOUTH MEMBER WITH TWO WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS**

Presbyterian College defeated its second nationally-ranked opponent this season with its 7-3 victory at No. 22/23 Charleston Southern in Week 8. It is sixth time in League history that a football member recorded two wins over ranked foes in the same season. PC is the fourth different member to achieve this feat, joining Coastal Carolina (three times), Liberty and Gardner-Webb. The Blue Hose downed then-No. 12/12 Furman, 10-7, in Week 3 for their first win over a nationally-ranked opponent since 2008 when PC downed No. 17 Liberty. Furman is now the highest-ranked team that PC has defeated at the Division I level. Presbyterian's win over the Paladins marked the second-straight season the Big South has recorded a regular-season victory over a nationally-ranked non-conference FCS opponent, and the sixth different season overall in the Big South's 13-year football history.

**LaQUA MAYES HAYES**

Presbyterian RB **LaQUA MAYES** broke through for a 92-yard touchdown run against Bluefield in Week 2, establishing the record for longest rush from scrimmage in Big South football history. The previous record was 86 yards set by former Coastal Carolina FB and current Carolina Panther **MIKE TOLBERT** against VMI on Oct. 27, 2007.

**FLAMES WIN BIG SOUTH'S MOST RECENT CLASH OF THE TITANS**

Then No. 24-Liberty defeated then-No. 25 Bryant, 38-21, in Week 4 to improve the Big South to 7-8 all-time in games involving a ranked Big South member against a ranked non-conference opponent -- including 4-4 during the regular-season. Five of the eight losses have been by seven points-or-less.

**ELIMINATING THE MIDDLE MAN**

Charleston Southern LB **GABE MIDDLEBROOK** returned a fumble 85 yards for a touchdown in the Buccaneers' Week 1 win over Point. It is the fourth-longest fumble return in Big South history, and the longest in the League since Presbyterian's **BRANDON LESTON** had a 91-yard fumble return against Georgia Tech in 2012. Middlebrook's fumble return is the longest by a CSU player during the Big South's football era (since 2002). The previous longest was a 77-yard fumble return for a TD by **JADA ROSS** against Gardner-Webb in 2007.

**FANNING THE FLAMES**

Liberty set a Big South single-game record for yards per play with its 16.03 average against Brevard in Week 3. The Flames gained 625 yards on just 39 offensive plays, smashing the previous record of 10.66 (Stony Brook vs. Pace - Sept. 8, 2012). Liberty averaged 12.96 yards per rush (23 for 298) against the Tornados, breaking the League single-game mark of 11.79 yards per carry that was established by Coastal Carolina in 2006 at VMI (28 for 330).
