CHRISTIAN REYES • RB • Senior
Charleston Southern • Rogue River, Ore.

Reyes had a career-high 188 rushing yards and two touchdowns in the Buccaneers' 38-36 win at Liberty on Saturday. The senior had TD runs of 4 and 52 yards to set a CSU record with 16 career rushing touchdowns. Reyes carried 18 times and averaged 10.44 yards per carry. He also caught two passes for 44 yards to finish with 232 all-purpose yards. Reyes' 188 yards are the fifth-most in a single game in CSU history and he became the first Buc to pass the 2,000-yard mark for a career in the win.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

ISIAH LYNN • LB • R-Senior
Presbyterian College • Fort Lawn, S.C.

Lynn tallied seven tackles (five solo) with four tackles-for-loss and three sacks to help PC defeat Gardner-Webb in a defensive battle, 14-7. The redshirt-senior linebacker tied a PC Division I record with three sacks, one of which came on third down to force a punt that led to PC's second touchdown drive. In the second quarter, Lynn sacked quarterback Tyrell Maxwell on second down and stopped a rush on third down to force a field goal that PC blocked and returned for a touchdown. His four stops behind the line of scrimmage added up to 19 yards.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

ED BRITT • DB • Junior
Presbyterian College • Greensboro, N.C.

With 3:58 remaining in the second quarter of a scoreless game, Britt recovered a blocked field goal and returned it 80 yards for a touchdown to give PC a 7-0 lead over Gardner-Webb. It was the second-longest such return in Big South history. Britt also helped make a tackle on punt coverage in the second quarter to hold the Runnin' Bulldogs to a seven-yard return.

Bridges set career highs with 24 carries and 135 rushing yards in PC's 14-7 victory at Gardner-Webb. Bridges punched in a seven-yard touchdown with 9:09 left in the game on his fifth rush of a 10-play drive to give PC a 14-0 lead. The rookie also converted a third down with a nine-yard rush in the final seconds to seal PC's first winning season at the Division I level. He caught two passes for 23 yards to finish with a game-high 158 all-purpose yards.

CHAMPIONSHIP BAROMETER

The winner of the Coastal Carolina-Liberty meeting has won or shared the Big South football championship nine times out of 11 all-time match-ups. Coastal, which leads the series with Liberty, 6-5, has already clinched at least a share of the Big South championship and is seeking the outright crown on Saturday. COASTAL CLINCHES SHARE OF SEVENTH BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL TITLE

Coastal Carolina is 4-0 in the Big South for the first time since 2006 and just the third time overall. The Chanticleers have clinched at least a share of its seventh Big South football championship, as CCU can finish no worse than 4-1 in League play, which would tie Liberty at 4-1 in the standings should the Flames defeat the Chants this weekend.

FLAMES STILL ALIVE FOR AUTOMATIC BID

Liberty can lock up the Big South's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs with a victory Saturday at Coastal Carolina. In that scenario, the Flames and Chanticleers would share the League title with 4-1 records, with the Flames getting the AQ for their head-to-head victory over Coastal Carolina.

LOOK WHO IS NUMBER 1 - COASTAL CAROLINA GARNERS BIG SOUTH'S FIRST-EVER NO. 1 RANK

Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 1 in this week's FCS Coaches poll for the second consecutive week. It is the first time in the Conference's history that any athletic program has received a No. 1 national poll ranking. Coastal Carolina is No. 2 in *The Sports Network* ranking this week, as CCU collected 56 first-place votes and sits 77 points out of the top spot. The Big South has had a football squad ranked for 49 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24), and has had a Top 5 team in 16 of the last 21 rankings. Meanwhile, all six Big South teams have either been ranked or received votes in one or both national polls at some point this season -- another League first.

OCEAN'S ELEVEN

Coastal Carolina is the first team in Big South history to open the season 11-0, and is the first FCS program with 11 wins this season. Coastal Carolina, one of two remaining undefeated FCS programs, has set the League mark for longest win streak in a single-season (11) and is the first Conference member to win 11 regular-season games. CCU is also the first Big South program with at least 11 wins in consecutive seasons.

PRELUDE TO A CHAMPIONSHIP?


Coastal Carolina's 4-0 Big South record is the first 4-0 Conference start since 2012 and the 13th overall in League history. Of the now 13 times, 12 of those squads went on to win/share the Big South Championship. The only team not to win the League title after starting 4-0 was Liberty in 2011 (second-place).

TOO LEGIT TO BRITT

Presbyterian College CB **ED BRITT** is the first player in Big South history with return touchdowns of an interception, fumble and blocked field goal -- all of which have occurred this season. He had a 15-yard fumble return TD in Week 2 vs. Bluefield, followed by a 25-yard pick-six in Week 6 against Western Carolina. Britt's third return touchdown of the season was this past Saturday at Gardner-Webb when he scooped up **DaRON DICKEY**'s blocked field goal and raced 80 yards for a score. It was the second-longest such return in League history.

IT'S ACADEMIC

A Big South-record nine student-athletes were voted Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District this season, bettering the previous mark of six. Each Big South football member had an honoree, led by Coastal Carolina (3 - **MO ASHLEY, CHAD HAMILTON, BRETT JOHNSON**), and followed by Liberty (2 - **MITCH HANSON, CHIMA UZOWIHE**), Charleston Southern (1 - **CHRISTIAN REYES**), Gardner-Webb (1 - **TYLER HOUGH-JENKINS**), Monmouth (1 - **JOE JOHNSON**) and Presbyterian (1 - **UGONNA AKOH**). All nine individuals advance to the Academic All-America ballot.

CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE WON IN NOVEMBER

Seven-time Big South football champion Coastal Carolina is 30-8 (=78.9) in its history in regular-season games in November. In fact, the Chanticleers are the only Big South member to win a game in November every season since 2003. In addition, six-time champ Liberty is 30-10 (=75.0 percent) since 2002 during the month of November.

HANGING WITH HAGEN

Liberty All-American safety **JACOB HAGEN** has tied the Big South single-season interception record with his eight picks this year, matching **JOSH NORMAN**'s mark first set in 2009. Hagen is the first player in League annals to pick-off at least six passes in two different seasons, and is now second all-time in Big South history with 15 career interceptions -- two behind all-time leader **QUINTON TEAL** of Coastal Carolina. Hagen's 240 career interception return yards surpassed Coastal Carolina's **KEON CUNNINGHAM** for the most in League history, as Cunningham had 225 from 2007-10. Hagen's 34 career passes defended (15 INT, 19 PBU) is tied for sixth in League history as well. Meanwhile, Hagen's 27-yard fumble return for a touchdown at North Carolina in Week 1 was his second career fumble return TD -- becoming the first player in Big South history to return two fumbles for scores.

ROSS FOR MORE

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** has tied the Big South record for most consecutive games with 300 yards of offense at four. He has matched former Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS**, who accomplished the feat in four consecutive games during the 2006 campaign. Ross has seven 300-yard offensive games this season, tied for the second-most in League history. He is now second all-time for most career games with 300 total offense yards with 12.

MASH UNIT

Liberty redshirt-freshman QB **STEPHON MASHA** stepped in for an injured **JOSH WOODRUM** this past Saturday against Charleston Southern and amassed 337 yards of offense while throwing four touchdown passes against the Bucs. It was the most total offensive yards by a Big South freshman since last season when PC's **HEYS McMATH** had 347 against VMI on Oct. 19. Masha's four TD scoring strikes were the most by a frosh since CSU's **MALCOLM DIXON** had four against Presbyterian during his freshman season of 2010. Masha is the fourth Big South freshman QB with a 4-TD pass game.

2,000-YARD RUSHING ODYSSEY

Charleston Southern RB **CHRISTIAN REYES** became the 17th player in Big South history with 2,000 career rushing yards when he eclipsed the milestone this past Saturday at Liberty. Reyes' career total stands at 2,125, which ranks 16th in the Conference record books. He needs 90 rushing yards in the regular-season finale at Georgia to jump into 13th all-time.

30 FOR 30

What if I told you that Coastal Carolina has set the Big South record for most consecutive 30 point games? The Chanticleers have scored 30 points in 11-straight games, breaking the old record of nine. What if I also told you that Coastal Carolina head coach **JOE MOGLIA** won his 30th game in Week 11 to become the sixth Big South coach in the League's 30-win club? Moglia's current winning percentage of 79.5 (31-8) is the highest in League history among coaches with a minimum of 35 games.

TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern returned two of its four interceptions for touchdowns in Week 11 against Gardner-Webb, tying the Big South single-game record. The Bucs are the third team in League history -- and second this season -- with two INT scores in a game. Liberty first set the record at Charleston Southern on Oct. 22, 2011. Presbyterian accomplished the feat in Week 6 against Western Carolina.

HOLDER HOLDS ON WHEN OTHERS CANNOT

Coastal Carolina DL **RODERICK HOLDER** is the first player in Big South history to return two fumbles for touchdowns in the same season. Holder also joins Liberty's **JACOB HAGEN** as the only players in the League record books with two career fumble return TDs.

HOLIDAY ROAD

Coastal Carolina won its seventh consecutive road game with its 59-34 win at Charlotte in Week 11, extending its Big South record for longest road win streak. The previous record was five, first set by Liberty (Oct. 20, 2007 - Oct. 4, 2008) and matched by Charleston Southern in 2013. Coastal's seven road wins this year are a Big South single-season record, breaking the hold mark of six established by CSU last season.

BIG SOUTH SETS RECORD FOR MOST FCS WINS FOR SECOND-STRAIGHT YEAR

The Big South finished 22-5 in 27 regular-season games against FCS opponents this season, a Conference record for most wins against non-conference FCS foes. Last season, the Big South was an all-time best 16-9 in regular-season competition and 18-10 through the postseason.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL "GAME OF THE WEEK" ON ESPN3 CONCLUDES THIS SATURDAY

The Big South Conference's exclusive "Game of the Week" on ESPN3 concludes this week with the Liberty at Coastal Carolina game live at 1:00pm with **MIKE HOGWOOD** (play-by-play) and **RENALDO WYNN** (analyst) on the call from Conway. The season package featured eight games and utilized instant replay assistance from DVSPORT.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL ON AMERICAN SPORTS NETWORK CONCLUDES SATURDAY

The Big South Conference appeared on the new American Sports Network (ASN) the final five weeks of the regular-season, with the final broadcast being Saturday's Gardner-Webb at Monmouth contest live from West Long Branch at 12:00pm. **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **NATE ROSS** (analyst) have the call. Big South football appeared on ASN six times in 2014 -- five of them between Conference members, on affiliates and stations owned by Sinclair Broadcast Group. The six broadcasts pushed the League's overall package to a Big South-record 14 this season (12 League games). In addition, the final five weeks of the 2014 regular-season featured two televised games each week.

QUINN'S QUINTET

Coastal Carolina LB and Buck Buchanan Award candidate **QUINN BACKUS** has forced five fumbles this season, tied for the most in a season in League history. He joins Gardner-Webb's **MARIO WILLIAMS** (2003) and Coastal Carolina's **D.J. RICE** (2007) as the only players to force five fumbles in a season. Backus has a CCU-record eight career forced fumbles, which also ties the Big South career record held by Williams and Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** (2004-07). Backus is the FCS active career leader in forced fumbles and tied for 20th in NCAA FCS history.

PROTECTING THEIR HOUSE

Coastal Carolina has the League's longest active home win streak at 13, tied for the longest home win streak in Big South history. The Chanticleers matched the record of 13 consecutive home wins first set by Stony Brook from Sept. 24, 2011 - Nov. 24, 2012. Coastal will have an opportunity to set the record this Saturday.

CAN'T FUMBLE THIS NOTE

Big South football members have returned seven fumbles for touchdowns this year, setting the Big South single-season record for most fumble return scores. The previous record was four in 2002, 2004, 2007, 2009 and 2011. A record four different teams -- Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina (3), Liberty (2), and Presbyterian -- have fumble return TDs this season. The previous best was three.

RECORD-SETTING ROAD WARRIORS

The Big South has collected 10 of its 22 non-conference FCS wins this season on the road -- breaking the League's regular-season record for most non-conference road victories (8 set in 2013), and surpassing the overall record of nine, which includes postseason wins. Coastal Carolina has five of the 10 wins this year. Meanwhile, every League member has won a road game this season -- a first in the Big South's football history.

LIBERTY COLLECTS BIG SOUTH'S FOURTH-EVER FBS WIN

The Big South Conference notched its fourth-ever win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 55-48 overtime win at Appalachian State in Week 7. The Big South's four wins have all come since 2010, and the Flames own two of those victories.

THE HUBBARD IS NOT BARE

Gardner-Webb kick returner **J.J. HUBBARD** is the Big South career leader for kickoff returns (106) and kickoff return touchdowns (3). He returned a kickoff 95 yards for a touchdown in Week 6 against Charlotte for his career record-tying third career kickoff return TD. Hubbard's 2,301 career kickoff return yards are second all-time. Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** is the all-time leader with 2,449.

INSIDE THE TACKLE BOX

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** became the second player in Big South history with 400 career tackles when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday against Monmouth. He is the second-leading active tackler in FCS with 403 career stops, which is a school record and second-most in League history. He is five away from entering the FCS Top 25 all-time tacklers. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College's **DONELLE WILLIAMS** is 15th in Big South history with 290 stops, while Charleston Southern's **DEMARIS FREEMAN** (230), Liberty's **NICK SIGMON** (214) and Flames **JACOB HAGEN** (224) joined the Big South's 200-tackle club in recent weeks.

CATCHIN' CATRON

Coastal Carolina kicker **ALEX CATRON** is the seventh player in Big South history with 30 career field goals, as he reached the milestone in Week 10 at Gardner-Webb. He is the third Coastal kicker on the list, joining **JUSTIN DURHAM** (42, 2007-10) and **JOSH HOKE** (40, 2003-06).

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal is 24-1 in its last 25 games when rushing for more than 200 yards, including 8-0 this season. The Chanticleers have rushed for more than 200 yards 69 times in their history, and are 64-5 (-92.8) when reaching the 200-yard plateau. Carolina has rushed for 200-plus yards in 26 of Head Coach **JOE MOGLIA**'s 39 games as CCU's head coach, posting an 25-1 record in such games.

BEATTY OR NOT, HERE HE COMES

Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** is second in Big South history with 7,918 career passing yards, 705 career completions and 1,156 attempts. Beatty ranks third among the active FCS career leaders in completions, as well as fifth in attempts and seventh in yardage. Meanwhile, he ranks among the Big South's all-time leaders in total offense yardage (5th - 7,627) and plays (2nd - 1,386).

SOLO ARTIST

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the Big South's all-time leader for solo tackles with 221 -- the only player in League history with 200. He broke the record during the Elon game in Week 5 with eight solo stops -- vaulting ahead of both Charleston Southern's **JADA ROSS** (195) and previous record holder **JUSTIN BETHEL** (Presbyterian - 199) for the top spot.

HOME COOKED MEAL

Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** is sixth all-time on the Big South's career receptions list with 180, and needs four to move into fifth. With 2,355 career receiving yards, he is seventh all-time in that category and 75 away from the sixth spot. Cook became the eighth player in the League record books with 20 career TD grabs during Week 8 and his 21 career touchdown receptions are tied for fifth. His 10 career 100-yard receiving games are tied for first in League history.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 108, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (42). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 52, breaking its old mark of 45 (Sept. 23, 2006 - Sept. 18, 2010) in Week 5.

PITCH-AND-CATCH COMBO

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** became the first non-quarterback in Big South history to throw two touchdown passes in a game in Week 7 against Columbia. Chaney's first TD pass was to Hawks QB **BRANDON HILL** -- who became the first Big South QB with a TD reception since Liberty's **KYLE PAINTER** in 2002, and the second overall.

THIS IS SERGEANT PETERSON

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** leads the Big South with 1,101 receiving yards for an average of 100.1 receiving yards per game. Peterson's yardage is the second-highest single-season total in Big South history, and behind the record of 1,388 by Stony Brook's **KEVIN NORRELL** in 2012. Meanwhile, Peterson has three 10-catch games this season, tied for second-most by a Big South receiver in League history. Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE** owns that record with five in 2006. Peterson's 10 career 100-yard receiving games are tied for first in League history.

HE CRAN CATCH

Gardner-Webb TE **SETH CRANFILL** is the Big South's all-time receptions leader among tight ends with 87 catches, as he became the all-time leader in Week 5 during The Citadel game. He broke the old mark of 65 that was established by former Coastal Carolina TE **DAVID DURAN** (2009-12). Cranfill's 890 career receiving yards are second-most among tight ends in League history behind Duran's 910. Cranfill caught two touchdown passes against Wofford in Week 4, which tied the Big South single-game record for TD receptions by a tight end.

WOODWORKING

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is fourth in League history with 49 career touchdown passes and is third-with 7,068 career passing yards. He needs one TD scoring strike to become the fourth player with 50. Meanwhile, he has rushed for a touchdown and passed for a score in the same game 10 times in his career -- including a League-high six times this season -- and the Flames are 7-3 in such contests (5-1 in 2014). Woodrum's eight rushing TDs this year are tied for fifth in a single-season in League history, while his 14 career rushing scores rank tied for sixth all-time.

THE FOUR HORSEMEN

Four Big South quarterbacks are averaging more than 200 passing yards per game -- Coastal Carolina's **ALEX ROSS** (259.1) Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** (252.1), Monmouth's **BRANDON HILL** (248.3), and Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** (209.7). If the quartet can maintain their respective averages, it would be the first time in Big South history that four quarterbacks averaged 200 passing yards per game in the same season. The current record is three, accomplished in 2006 and 2013.

CAKE ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** recorded his third career game with 400 yards of total offense in Week 11 with a school-record tying 426 at Charlotte. His three career 400 games matches the Big South career mark first set by Liberty's **MIKE BROWN** (2008-11). Meanwhile, Ross posted his third 3-TD pass game of the season this past Saturday against Monmouth and the ninth of his career -- tied for the most in Big South history. He also moved into a tie for fourth with his 49 career TD passes. The seventh quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards, Ross is sixth all-time with 1,223 and 40 rushing yards away from passing Charleston Southern's **MALCOLM DIXON** (1,262) for fifth.

SEVENTH HEAVEN

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** and Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** are the joint record-holder for the most 300-yard passing games in Big South history with seven each. Woodrum first broke the record when he moved past Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** and Beatty in Week 7. Beatty moved past Drafts with his 430-yard effort at VMI in Week 8. Woodrum has a League-high four 300-yard passing games this season, one shy of the Big South single-season mark of five established by Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** in 2006.

HENDERSON HOPING TO HOP TOWARDS HISTORY

Coastal Carolina RB **DE'ANGELO HENDERSON**, who matched the school record for most rushing yards through the first four games with 498, leads the Big South with 1,205 rushing yards. He is currently on pace for 1,314 rushing yards, which would be seventh-most in a single-season in Big South history. Henderson is looking to become the second-straight Chanticleer and third overall to lead the Big South in rushing.

ABNAR THE ANCHOR

Liberty RB **D.J. ABNAR** had 39 rushes in Week 11 against Monmouth, the second-most in a game in League history. He was one carry shy of matching the Big South single-game record of 40, which is held by former Flames' RB **EUGENE GOODMAN**, who had 40 rushing attempts against Hofstra on Nov. 22, 2003. Abnar leads the Big South with 219 carries this season -- 10th-most in a single-season in League history -- and has 37 more rushing attempts than his closest competitor.

REAL ESTATE MOGULS

Coastal Carolina amassed a Big South season-high and school-record 690 yards of offense in Week 11 at Charlotte, the fourth-most in a game in League history. The Chanticleers finished five yards shy of the overall mark of 695 (Charleston Southern vs. West Virginia Wesleyan in 2005) and two yards behind the record against a Division I opponent (692 - Liberty at Presbyterian in 2012).

MOVING THE CHAINS

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is tops in the Big South with 135.7 all-purpose yards per game, and already has two games with 200+ yards -- tied for seventh-most in a career in League history. Chaney is looking to become the first newcomer to lead the Conference in all-purpose yards since Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** in 2010.

BIG JOHN STUD

Liberty kicker **JOHN LUNSFORD** kicked a Big-South-record 60-yard field goal at the end of regulation to force overtime against nationally-ranked Richmond in Week 6. The first player in League history to attempt a field goal from that distance, Lunsford is the ninth different kicker in FCS history to make a field goal from 60+ yards, and the first in 14 years. His 60-yarder matched the third-longest made in terms of distance, behind 63 (three kickers) and 62 (two). Three other kickers have converted from 60 yards. Meanwhile, Lunsford has two additional Big South records: most 50-plus yard field goals in a season (3) and most 50-plus yard field goals in a career (6).

PEGUES THE AREA

Gardner-Webb freshman LB **JEFFREY PEGUES** made 20 tackles at VMI in Week 8, the first Big South player with 20 tackles in a game since former Runnin' Bulldog LB **MARTY PATTERSON** had 20 stops against Charleston Southern on Oct. 29, 2011. Pegues is the second Big South freshman with 20 tackles in a game, as GWU's **MIKE PAVELKO** had a record 24 against VMI as a frosh in a triple-overtime victory on Oct. 22, 2005.

TOP CHEFS

Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** set the Big South single-game receiving record with 251 yards at VMI in Week 8. The old record was 240 by Liberty's **CHRIS SUMMERS** against Stony Brook on Nov. 19, 2011. Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY**'s 430 passing yards against the Keydets broke the Big South single-game record of 419, which was set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** against Allen on Nov. 6, 2004. Beatty, who also tied the Big South single-game record with five TD passes, became just the second different Big South QB with 400 passing yards in a game.

ROSS, COOK ON WALTER PAYTON AWARD WATCH LIST

For the second time in Big South history, two players opened the season as official candidates for the Walter Payton Award, as Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** and Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** were among the 20 candidates for the top individual award in FCS. In 2011, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** and Flames' WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** opened the campaign among the initial candidates.

RECORD THREE PLAYERS ON BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD WATCH LIST

A record three Big South players remain among the 20 candidates for the Buck Buchanan Award, which honors the top defensive player in FCS. Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS**, who finished seventh in the voting last year, headlines the Big South's trio. Joining him are Gardner-Webb DL **O.J. MAU** and Liberty DB **JACOB HAGEN**.

BASILE NAMED TO JERRY RICE AWARD WATCH LIST

Monmouth freshman safety **MIKE BASILE** is among the candidates for the 2014 Jerry Rice Award, which is awarded to the top freshman player in the country. Basile is the second Big South player to be an official candidate for the Rice Award, joining Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** (2012).

DIALING LONG DISTANCE

Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** connected with TE **SETH CRANFILL** on a 75-yard pass play for a touchdown in Week 10 against Coastal Carolina, the longest pass reception by a tight end in Big South history. Cranfill's distance surpassed the previous record of 72 yards by Charleston Southern's **CLAYTON COFFMAN** from **COLLIN DRAFTS** against North Greenville on Sept. 30, 2006.

FIRE PROOF

Liberty held Gardner-Webb to minus-17 net rushing yards in Week 9, the fewest allowed in a conference games in Big South history and the fifth-lowest overall. The Flames limited the Runnin' Bulldogs to 56 yards of offense, tied for the lowest in a single-game in the League record books and the lowest in a conference contest.

PRESBYTERIAN LATEST BIG SOUTH MEMBER WITH TWO WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS

Presbyterian College defeated its second nationally-ranked opponent this season with its 7-3 victory at No. 22/23 Charleston Southern in Week 8. It is sixth time in League history that a football member recorded two wins over ranked foes in the same season. PC is the fourth different member to achieve this feat, joining Coastal Carolina (three times), Liberty and Gardner-Webb. The Blue Hose downed then-No. 12/12 Furman, 10-7, in Week 3 for their first win over a nationally-ranked opponent since 2008 when PC downed No. 17 Liberty. Furman is the highest-ranked team that PC has defeated at the Division I level. Presbyterian's win over the Paladins marked the second-straight season the Big South has recorded a regular-season victory over a nationally-ranked non-conference FCS opponent, and the sixth different season overall in the Big South's 13-year football history.

DEFENSIVE MINDED

Presbyterian's 7-3 win over Charleston Southern in Week 8 set the League record for lowest scoring Conference game at 10 points. The previous combined low was 17 points, set by VMI (10) and Liberty (7) on Oct. 1, 2005, and matched by Gardner-Webb (10) and VMI (7) on Nov. 20, 2010. PC held the Buccaneers to their lowest point total since a shutout loss at Illinois on Sept. 15, 2012, and limited Charleston Southern to just three points in three trips to the red zone. PC also allowed 250 yards of offense, a season-low for the Buccaneers.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL FIRST -- UNDEFEATED WEEK

The Big South Conference went 6-0 during Week 3, the first time in League history that every Conference member won its respective non-conference match-up in the same week. Four of the wins were against FCS foes -- the same total in Week 3 of the 2013 season. Five Big South members were above .500 after three games -- another League first.

ANOTHER LEAGUE FIRST -- THREE BIG SOUTH TEAMS RANKED

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference had three nationally-ranked programs in the same week, as the Sept. 22 FCS Coaches poll had Coastal Carolina at No. 3, Liberty at No. 23 and Charleston Southern at No. 25. It is the third time in League annals that three different members have been nationally-ranked in the same season.

ALL HANDS ON DECK

Every football member was at or above .500 from Week 5 thru Week 9 of the season, establishing the League record for the latest point in a season the Big South achieved this distinction. In fact, the Big South was the only FCS Conference to have every member with .500 or better winning percentages entering Week 10.
