Henderson had a career-high 10 receptions for 114 yards against Coastal Carolina. Nine of his 10 receptions gave Liberty first downs, with seven of those nine coming on third down situations. His first catch of the day set up the Flames' first field goal. Henderson later caught three passes during Liberty's second scoring drive that resulted in a field goal. He caught seven passes for at least 10 yards, with a long of 22.

Johnson tallied seven tackles (six solo) and two interceptions in Monmouth's victory over Gardner-Webb. In the third quarter he jumped a hitch near midfield and went 55 yards down the left sideline for a touchdown that would put the game away at 24-7. With five minutes remaining, Johnson had his second INT and returned it 16 yards to midfield. He was part of a defense that forced six turnovers in Monmouth's first-ever Big South victory.

Uzowihe blocked the potential game-winning 26-yard field goal as time expired to seal Liberty's 15-14 victory over Coastal Carolina. Uzowihe also contributed three tackles on defense, including his League-leading eighth sack of the year.

Masha led the Flames to their first-ever win over the No. 1 team in the country. In just his second career start, he earned his first win on 20-of-33 passing for 285 yards and a touchdown. BIG SOUTH SENDS TWO TO FCS PLAYOFFS FOR THE SECOND TIME

For the second time in the Big South's five-year AQ history, the Conference is sending two teams to the FCS Playoffs in the same season. Co-champion Liberty claimed the League's automatic bid for the first time, while co-champion Coastal Carolina received one of the 13 at-large berths and is the Conference's first-ever Top 8 seed, as the Chanticleers garnered the No. 7 seed and a first round bye. The Big South is 5-6 all-time in the postseason, and has had a team advance each of the past three years.

LIBERTY CLINCHES FIRST-EVER PLAYOFF BERTH AS BIG SOUTH'S AUTOMATIC BID RECIPIENT

Liberty is the Big South's automatic bid recipient to the 2014 FCS Playoffs, becoming the third different program in the League's five-year history of having the AQ to be the Big South's automatic representative. Liberty joins Coastal Carolina (2010, 2012, 2013) and Stony Brook (2011) as the League's all-time AQs.

COASTAL CAROLINA SCORES SECOND AT-LARGE BERTH

Coastal Carolina earned its second at-large berth to the FCS Playoffs and the Big South's third overall. The Chants were the Big South's first at-large playoff team in 2006, while Stony Brook was the second in 2012. Coastal is making its third consecutive postseason appearance and fifth overall -- the most in Big South history. Head coach **JOE MOGLIA** is the first Big South leader with three playoff appearances.

BIG SOUTH HAS CO-CHAMPIONS FOR THE FIFTH TIME IN SIX YEARS

Coastal Carolina and Liberty shared the Big South football championship with 4-1 League records, marking the fifth time in six seasons that the Conference has had co-champions in football. It is the seventh time in the League's 13-year football history that multiple champions have been crowned in a season. Liberty received the Big South's automatic bid to the playoffs based on the Flames' head-to-head win over Coastal Carolina in the regular-season finale.

SEVEN-UP

Coastal Carolina was the first team in Big South history to win seven Big South football championships when the Chanticleers clinched a share of the title during Week 12, and Liberty joined them atop the leaderboard with its seventh title as well. The Chanticleers have won titles in 2004, 2005 (shared), 2006, 2010 (shared), 2012 (shared), 2013 (shared) and 2014 (shared). Liberty's seven championships have come in 2007, 2008, 2009 (shared), 2010 (shared), 2012 (shared), 2013 (shared) and 2014 (shared).

PRELUDE TO A CHAMPIONSHIP

Coastal Carolina started League play at 4-0 -- the 13th overall 4-0 start in League history. Of the 13 times, 12 of those squads went on to win/share the Big South Championship. The only team not to win the League title after starting 4-0 was Liberty in 2011 (second-place).

CHAMPIONSHIP BAROMETER

The winner of the Coastal Carolina-Liberty meeting has won or shared the Big South football championship 10 times out of 12 all-time match-ups. The series is now tied at 6-6, and below is a closer look at the series:

LIBERTY BECOMES SECOND BIG SOUTH MEMBER TO DEFEAT NATION'S NUMBER 1

Liberty's 15-14 win at previous No. 1/2 Coastal Carolina marked the second time in Big South history that a League member defeated the No. 1 ranked team in FCS. Coastal was the first in 2005 when the Chanticleers defeated No. 1 James Madison, 31-27 on Sept. 10. Liberty has now defeated a ranked Big South member for the fourth consecutive year, and a Big South member has knocked off a nationally-ranked Conference counterpart at least once in the past nine seasons.

HOUSE ARREST

Coastal Carolina's Big South-record tying 13-game home win streak came to end this past Saturday. The Chanticleers had matched the record first set by Stony Brook from Sept. 24, 2011 - Nov. 24, 2012.

COASTAL CAROLINA AND LIBERTY IN THE RANKINGS

The Big South has had a football squad ranked for 50 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 campaign (Oct. 24), and has two teams ranked at the same time for the fifth time this season. In fact, all six Big South teams have either been ranked or received votes in one or both national polls at some point in 2014 -- a League first. Coastal Carolina is ranked No. 6 in this week's FCS Coaches poll and is No. 6 in *The Sports Network* ranking this week. Liberty is No. 23 by the Coaches and No. 20 in the media poll. Coastal Carolina spent two weeks (Nov. 10-22) as the nation's No. 1 ranked team in the FCS Coaches poll -- the first time in the Conference's history that any athletic program has received a No. 1 national poll ranking.

HANGING WITH HAGEN

Liberty All-American safety **JACOB HAGEN** tied the Big South single-season interception record with his eight picks this year, matching **JOSH NORMAN**'s mark first set in 2009. Hagen is the first player in League annals to pick-off at least six passes in two different seasons, and is now second all-time in Big South history with 15 career interceptions -- two behind all-time leader **QUINTON TEAL** of Coastal Carolina. Hagen's 240 career interception return yards surpassed Coastal Carolina's **KEON CUNNINGHAM** for the most in League history, as Cunningham had 225 from 2007-10. Hagen's 34 career passes defended (15 INT, 19 PBU) is tied for sixth in League history as well. Meanwhile, Hagen's 27-yard fumble return for a touchdown at North Carolina in Week 1 was his second career fumble return TD -- becoming the first player in Big South history to return two fumbles for scores.

ROSS FOR MORE

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** tied the Big South record for most consecutive games with 300 yards of offense at four during Weeks 9-12. He matched former Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS**, who accomplished the feat in four consecutive games during the 2006 campaign. Ross has seven 300-yard offensive games this season, tied for the second-most in League history. He is now second all-time for most career games with 300 total offense yards with 12.

THIS IS SERGEANT PETERSON

Liberty WR **DARRIN PETERSON** is the Big South's all-time leader for most 100-yard receiving games, as he recorded his 11th such effort this past Saturday at Coastal Carolina. He entered the game in a four-way tie for the lead. Peterson's seven 100-yard receiving games this season matches the Big South single-season mark first set by Stony Brook's **KEVIN NORRELL** in 2012. Peterson leads the Big South with 1,214 receiving yards for an average of 101.2 receiving yards per game, and his yardage is the second-highest single-season total in Big South history -- behind Norrell's record of 1,388. Meanwhile, Peterson has three 10-catch games this season, tied for second-most by a Big South receiver in League history. Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE** owns that record with five in 2006.

30 FOR 30

What if I told you that Coastal Carolina set the Big South record for most consecutive 30 point games? The Chanticleers scored 30 points in 11-straight games to open the season, breaking the old record of nine. Coastal Carolina third-year head coach **JOE MOGLIA** is already sixth all-time in League history with 31 victories, and is the all-time winningest coach based on percentage (77.5, 31-9) with a minimum of 35 games.

MASH UNIT

Liberty redshirt-freshman QB **STEPHON MASHA** has performed admirably the past two weeks for injured **JOSH WOODRUM**. This past Saturday, he threw for 285 yards in leading Liberty to the FCS Playoffs with its 15-14 victory over Coastal Carolina. In Week 12 against Charleston Southern, Masha amassed 337 yards of offense while throwing four touchdown passes against the Bucs. It was the most total offensive yards by a Big South freshman since last season when PC's **HEYS MCMATH** had 347 against VMI on Oct. 19. Masha's four TD scoring strikes were the most by a frosh since CSU's **MALCOLM DIXON** had four against Presbyterian during his freshman season of 2010. Masha is the fourth Big South freshman QB with a 4-TD pass game.

HOLDER HOLDS ON WHEN OTHERS CANNOT

Coastal Carolina DL **RODERICK HOLDER** is the first player in Big South history to return two fumbles for touchdowns in the same season. Holder also joins Liberty's **JACOB HAGEN** as the only players in the League record books with two career fumble return TDs.

HOLIDAY ROAD

Coastal Carolina won its seventh consecutive road game with its 59-34 win at Charlotte in Week 11, extending its Big South record for longest road win streak. The previous record was five, first set by Liberty (Oct. 20, 2007 - Oct. 4, 2008) and matched by Charleston Southern in 2013. Coastal's seven road wins this year are a Big South single-season record, breaking the old mark of six established by CSU last season.

SOLO ARTIST

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the Big South's all-time leader for solo tackles with 234 -- the only player in League history with 200 and currently 14th in FCS history. He broke the record during the Elon game in Week 5 with eight solo stops -- vaulting ahead of both Charleston Southern's **JADA ROSS** (195) and previous record holder **JUSTIN BETHEL** (Presbyterian - 199) for the top spot.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 109, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Coastal Carolina (43). Meanwhile, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 53, breaking its old mark of 45 (Sept. 23, 2006 - Sept. 18, 2010) in Week 5.

QUINN'S QUINTET

Coastal Carolina LB and Buck Buchanan Award candidate **QUINN BACKUS** has forced five fumbles this season, tied for the most in a season in League history. He joins Gardner-Webb's **MARIO WILLIAMS** (2003) and Coastal Carolina's **D.J. RICE** (2007) as the only players to force five fumbles in a season. Backus has a CCU-record eight career forced fumbles, which also ties the Big South career record held by Williams and Gardner-Webb's **BRIAN JOHNSTON** (2004-07). Backus is the FCS active career leader in forced fumbles and 21st in NCAA FCS history.

WOODWORKING

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** is fifth in League history with 49 career touchdown passes and is third with 7,068 career passing yards. He needs one TD scoring strike to become the fifth player with 50. Meanwhile, he has rushed for a touchdown and passed for a score in the same game 10 times in his career -- including a League-high six times this season -- and the Flames are 7-3 in such contests (5-1 in 2014). Woodrum's eight rushing TDs this year are tied for fifth in a single-season in League history, while his 14 career rushing scores rank tied for sixth all-time.

HIGH RATE OF RETURN

Coastal is 24-1 in its last 25 games when rushing for more than 200 yards, including 8-0 this season. The Chanticleers have rushed for more than 200 yards 69 times in their history, and are 64-5 (=92.8) when reaching the 200-yard plateau. Carolina has rushed for 200-plus yards in 26 of Head Coach **JOE MOGLIA**'s 40 games as CCU's head coach, posting an 25-1 record in such games.

LIBERTY COLLECTS BIG SOUTH'S FOURTH-EVER FBS WIN

The Big South Conference notched its fourth-ever win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 55-48 overtime win at Appalachian State in Week 7. The Big South's four wins have all come since 2010, and the Flames own two of those victories.

CAKE ROSS

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** recorded his third career game with 400 yards of total offense in Week 11 with a school-record tying 426 at Charlotte. His three career 400 games matches the Big South career mark first set by Liberty's **MIKE BROWN** (2008-11). Meanwhile, Ross posted his third 3-TD pass game of the season in Week 12 against Monmouth and the ninth of his career -- tied for the most in Big South history. He became the fourth QB in League history with 50 career TD passes when he reached the milestone in Week 13. The seventh quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards, Ross is fifth all-time with 1,283 and four rushing yards away from passing VMI's **KYLE HUGHES** (1,286) for fourth.

D.J. ABNAR, RUSH CHAIRMAN

Liberty RB **D.J. ABNAR** is the first player in Big South history with at least 35 rushing attempts in a game twice in the same season. He had 35 rushes this past Saturday at Coastal Carolina and 39 in Week 11 against Monmouth -- the second-most in a game in League history. Abnar leads the Big South with 254 carries this season, which is the fifth-most in a single-season in League history. He has 63 more rushing attempts than his closest competitor (191 - Coastal Carolina's **DE'ANGELO HENDERSON**).

INSIDE THE TACKLE BOX

Coastal Carolina senior LB **QUINN BACKUS** is second in Big South history with 423 career tackles, needing 31 to equal the current League mark of 454 by Charleston Southern's **JADA ROSS**. Backus is the leading active tackler in FCS and ranks 20th all-time in the subdivision. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College's **DONELLE WILLIAMS** is 15th in Big South history with 290 stops, while Charleston Southern's **DE-MARIS FREEMAN** (235), Liberty's **NICK SIGMON** (214), the Flames' **JACOB HAGEN** (229) and Coastal's **PERNELL WILLIAMS** (206) joined the Big South's 200-tackle club this season.

BIG JOHN STUD

Liberty kicker **JOHN LUNS福德** kicked a Big-South-record 60-yard field goal at the end of regulation to force overtime against nationally-ranked Richmond in Week 6. The first player in League history to attempt a field goal from that distance, Lunsford is the ninth different kicker in FCS history to make a field goal from 60+ yards, and the first in 14 years. His 60-yarder matched the third-longest made in terms of distance, behind 63 (three kickers) and 62 (two). Three other kickers have converted from 60 yards. Meanwhile, Lunsford has two additional Big South records: most 50-plus yard field goals in a season (3) and most 50-plus yard field goals in a career (6).

REAL ESTATE MOGULS

Coastal Carolina amassed a Big South season-high and school-record 690 yards of offense in Week 11 at Charlotte, the fourth-most in a game in League history. The Chanticleers finished five yards shy of the overall mark of 695 (Charleston Southern vs. West Virginia Wesleyan in 2005) and two yards behind the record against a Division I opponent (692 - Liberty at Presbyterian in 2012).

FIRE PROOF

Liberty held Gardner-Webb to minus-17 net rushing yards in Week 9, the fewest allowed in a conference game in Big South history and the fifth-lowest overall. The Flames limited the Runnin' Bulldogs to 56 yards of offense, tied for the lowest in a single-game in the League record books and the lowest in a conference contest.

HENDERSON HOPING TO HOP TOWARDS HISTORY

Coastal Carolina RB **DE'ANGELO HENDERSON**, who matched the school record for most rushing yards through the first four games with 498, leads the Big South with 1,257 rushing yards. If he can rush for his season average of 104.8 in the Chanticleers' playoff game, he would be at 1,362, which would be sixth-most in a single-season in Big South history. Henderson is looking to become the second-straight Chanticleer and third overall to lead the Big South in rushing.

SEVENTH HEAVEN

Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** and Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** are the joint record-holder for the most 300-yard passing games in Big South history with seven each. Woodrum first broke the record when he moved past Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** and Beatty in Week 7. Beatty moved past Drafts with his 430-yard effort at VMI in Week 8. Woodrum has a League-high four 300-yard passing games this season, one shy of the Big South single-season mark of five established by Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** in 2006.

THE FOUR HORSEMEN

Four Big South quarterbacks are averaging more than 200 passing yards per game -- Liberty's **JOSH WOODRUM** (252.1), Coastal Carolina's **ALEX ROSS** (251.8), Monmouth's **BRANDON HILL** (239.6), and Gardner-Webb's **LUCAS BEATTY** (213.7). If Woodrum and Ross can maintain their respective averages during the postseason, it would be the first time in Big South history that four quarterbacks averaged 200 passing yards per game in the same season. The current record is three, accomplished in 2006 and 2013.

ROSS A FINALIST FOR WALTER PAYTON AWARD

Coastal Carolina QB **ALEX ROSS** is an official finalist for the Walter Payton Award. For the second time in Big South history, two players opened the season as official candidates for the Walter Payton Award, as Ross and Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** were among the 20 candidates for the top individual award in FCS. In 2011, Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** and Flames' WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** opened the campaign among the initial candidates.

RECORD THREE PLAYERS ARE FINALISTS FOR BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD

A record three Big South players are among the 20 finalists for the Buck Buchanan Award, which honors the top defensive player in FCS. Coastal Carolina LB **QUINN BACKUS**, who finished seventh in the voting last year, headlines the Big South's trio. Joining him are Gardner-Webb DL **O.J. MAU** and Liberty DB **JACOB HAGEN**.

BASILE FINALIST FOR JERRY RICE AWARD

Monmouth freshman safety **MIKE BASILE** is a finalist for the 2014 Jerry Rice Award, which is awarded to the top freshman player in the country. Basile is the second Big South player to be a finalist for the Rice Award, joining Liberty QB **JOSH WOODRUM** (2012).

MOGLIA FINALIST FOR EDDIE ROBINSON AWARD

Coastal Carolina head coach **JOE MOGLIA** is one of 20 finalists for the Eddie Robinson Award, presented annually to the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) National Coach of the Year. This is the third time in Moglia's three-year tenure at Coastal Carolina he has been a finalist for the prestigious award.

BIG SOUTH SETS RECORD FOR MOST FCS WINS FOR SECOND-STRAIGHT YEAR

The Big South finished 22-5 in 27 regular-season games against FCS opponents this season, a Conference record for most wins against non-conference FCS foes. Last season, the Big South was an all-time best 16-9 in regular-season competition and 18-10 through the postseason.

CRAZY EIGHTS

For the second consecutive year, three Big South programs won eight games in the same season, as Coastal Carolina (11), Liberty (8) and Charleston Southern (8) turned in the trifecta. Five of the six Big South members finished with winning records this year -- the most teams to finish above .500 in the same campaign. The previous best was four in 2006, 2009 and 2013.

RECORD-SETTING ROAD WARRIORS

The Big South collected 10 of its 22 non-conference FCS wins this season on the road -- breaking the League's regular-season record for most non-conference road victories (8 set in 2013), and surpassing the overall record of nine, which includes postseason wins. Coastal Carolina has five of the 10 wins this year. Meanwhile, every League member won a road game this season -- a first in the Big South's football history.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL FIRST -- UNDEFEATED WEEK

The Big South Conference went 6-0 during Week 3, the first time in League history that every Conference member won its respective non-conference match-up in the same week. Four of the wins were against FCS foes -- the same total in Week 3 of the 2013 season. Five Big South members were above .500 after three games -- another League first.

ANOTHER LEAGUE FIRST -- THREE BIG SOUTH TEAMS RANKED

For the first time in Big South history, the Conference had three nationally-ranked programs in the same week, as the Sept. 22 FCS Coaches poll had Coastal Carolina at No. 3, Liberty at No. 23 and Charleston Southern at No. 25. It is the third time in League annals that three different members have been nationally-ranked in the same season.

ALL HANDS ON DECK

Every football member was at or above .500 from Week 5 thru Week 9 of the season, establishing the League record for the latest point in a season the Big South achieved this distinction. In fact, the Big South was the only FCS Conference to have every member with .500 or better winning percentages entering Week 10.

BIG SOUTH'S SEASON-ENDING TRADITION COMES TO AN END

For the first time in Big South history, a League member did not end the season with at least a four-game win streak. The previous such streaks were: 2002 - Gardner-Webb (8); 2003 - Liberty (4); 2004 - Coastal Carolina (8) and Liberty (4); 2005 - Charleston Southern (5); 2006 - Coastal Carolina (8); 2007 - Liberty (5); 2008 - Charleston Southern (4); 2009 - Charleston Southern (4); 2010 - Coastal Carolina (4); 2011 - Stony Brook (8); 2012 - Coastal Carolina (5); 2013 - Liberty (5).

CAN'T FUMBLE THIS NOTE

Big South football members have returned seven fumbles for touchdowns this year, setting the Big South single-season record for most fumble return scores. The previous record was four in 2002, 2004, 2007, 2009 and 2011. A record four different teams -- Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina (3), Liberty (2), and Presbyterian -- have fumble return TDs this season. The previous best was three.

2,000-YARD RUSHING ODYSSEY

Charleston Southern RB **CHRISTIAN REYES** concludes his career with a school-record 2,200 rushing yards, which ranks 14th all-time in League history. He became the 17th player in Big South history with 2,000 career rushing yards when he eclipsed the milestone in Week 12 at Liberty.

HE CRAN CATCH

Gardner-Webb TE **SETH CRANFILL** concludes his career as the Big South's all-time receptions leader among tight ends with 90 catches. He became the all-time leader in Week 5 during The Citadel game when he broke the old mark of 65 that was established by former Coastal Carolina TE **DAVID DURAN** (2009-12). Cranfill's 909 career receiving yards are second-most among tight ends in League history behind Duran's 910. Cranfill caught two touchdown passes against Wofford in Week 4, which tied the Big South single-game record for TD receptions by a tight end.

TREASURE CHEST

Charleston Southern returned two of its four interceptions for touchdowns in Week 11 against Gardner-Webb, tying the Big South single-game record. The Bucs are the third team in League history -- and second this season -- with two INT scores in a game. Liberty first set the record at Charleston Southern on Oct. 22, 2011. Presbyterian accomplished the feat in Week 6 against Western Carolina.

TOO LEGIT TO BRITT

Presbyterian College CB **ED BRITT** is the first player in Big South history with return touchdowns of an interception, fumble and blocked field goal -- all of which have occurred this season. He had a 15-yard fumble return TD in Week 2 vs. Bluefield, followed by a 25-yard pick-six in Week 6 against Western Carolina. Britt's third return touchdown of the season was in Week 12 at Gardner-Webb when he scooped up **DaRON DICKEY**'s blocked field goal and raced 80 yards for a score. It was the second-longest such return in League history.

IT'S ACADEMIC

A Big South-record nine student-athletes were voted Capital One/CoSIDA Academic All-District this season, bettering the previous mark of six. Each Big South football member had an honoree, led by Coastal Carolina (3 - **MO ASHLEY, CHAD HAMILTON, BRETT JOHNSON**), and followed by Liberty (2 - **MITCH HANSON, CHIMA UZOWIHE**), Charleston Southern (1 - **CHRISTIAN REYES**), Gardner-Webb (1 - **TYLER HOUGH-JENKINS**), Monmouth (1 - **JOE JOHNSON**) and Presbyterian (1 - **UGONNA AKOH**). All nine individuals advanced to the Academic All-America ballot.

THE HUBBARD IS NOT BARE

Gardner-Webb kick returner **J.J. HUBBARD** ends his career as the Big South's all-time leader for kickoff returns (109) and kickoff return touchdowns (3). He returned a kickoff 95 yards for a touchdown in Week 6 against Charlotte for his career record-tying third career kickoff return TD. Hubbard's 2,351 career kickoff return yards are second all-time.

PRESBYTERIAN LATEST BIG SOUTH MEMBER WITH TWO WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS

Presbyterian College defeated its second nationally-ranked opponent this season with its 7-3 victory at No. 22/23 Charleston Southern in Week 8. It is sixth time in League history that a football member recorded two wins over ranked foes in the same season. PC is the fourth different member to achieve this feat, joining Coastal Carolina (three times), Liberty and Gardner-Webb. The Blue Hose downed then-No. 12/12 Furman, 10-7, in Week 3 for their first win over a nationally-ranked opponent since 2008 when PC downed No. 17 Liberty. Furman is the highest-ranked team that PC has defeated at the Division I level. Presbyterian's win over the Paladins marked the second-straight season the Big South has recorded a regular-season victory over a nationally-ranked non-conference FCS opponent, and the sixth different season overall in the Big South's 13-year football history.

DEFENSIVE MINDED

Presbyterian's 7-3 win over Charleston Southern in Week 8 set the League record for lowest scoring Conference game at 10 points. The previous combined low was 17 points, set by VMI (10) and Liberty (7) on Oct. 1, 2005, and matched by Gardner-Webb (10) and VMI (7) on Nov. 20, 2010. PC held the Buccaneers to their lowest point total since a shutout loss at Illinois on Sept. 15, 2012, and limited Charleston Southern to just three points in three trips to the red zone. PC also allowed 250 yards of offense, a season-low for the Buccaneers.

MOVING THE CHAINS

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** is tops in the Big South with 135.1 all-purpose yards per game, and had two games with 200+ yards -- tied for seventh-most in a career in League history. Chaney is on pace to become the first newcomer to lead the Conference in all-purpose yards since Stony Brook's **BROCK JACKOLSKI** in 2010.

BEATTY ON IT

Gardner-Webb QB **LUCAS BEATTY** finished his career second in Big South history with 8,175 career passing yards, 737 career completions and 1,209 attempts. He also ranks among the Big South's all-time leaders in total offense yardage (4th - 7,892) and plays (2nd - 1,453).

HOME COOKED MEAL

Gardner-Webb WR **KENNY COOK** ends his time in the Big South tied for third all-time on the Big South's career receptions list with 188, as well as sixth in League history with 2,432 career receiving yards. Cook became the eighth player in the League record books with 20 career TD grabs during Week 8 and his 21 career touchdown receptions are tied for fifth. His 10 career 100-yard receiving games are tied for second-most in League history.

PITCH-AND-CATCH COMBO

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** became the first non-quarterback in Big South history to throw two touchdown passes in a game in Week 7 against Columbia. Chaney's first TD pass was to Hawks QB **BRANDON HILL** -- who became the first Big South QB with a TD reception since Liberty's **KYLE PAINTER** in 2002, and the second overall.

* Charleston Southern won eight games in consecutive seasons for the first time in program history. Head Coach **JAMEY CHADWELL** is 18-7 (=72.0) at CSU and has defeated every Big South opponent in his first two seasons.

* The Bucs' 18 wins are the most in program history over two seasons.

* Since a 15-game losing streak that ended in 2012, CSU is 23-10 (=69.7 winning percentage).

* RB **CHRISTIAN REYES** scored the Bucs' lone touchdown at Georgia to give him 17 career rushing TDs and 2,200 career yards – both CSU records.

* The Bucs went 7-0 this season when scoring first (1-4 when the opposition scored first).

* CSU finished Big South play at 3-2 for the second-straight season, posting back-to-back winning seasons in Conference play for the second time in school history.

* OL **CLAYTON TRUITT** made his 45th career start against Georgia and played in his 47th game, both of which are CSU career records.

* Charleston Southern set a school record for a Big South game with 576 yards of total offense and 359 rushing yards in Week 12 at Liberty.

* The Bucs' 576 yards of total offense in Week 12 is the fifth-highest in school history and the second-most against a Division I opponent.

* Coastal Carolina will host the winner of Richmond/Morgan State in the second round of the FCS Playoffs. The Chants are 0-1 against the Spiders and have never faced the Bears.

* The Chanticleers are 3-4 all-time in the FCS Playoffs, including 1-1 at home.

* Coastal lost for just the third time at home in the **JOE MOGLIA** era this past Saturday (14-3) and are 51-17 (=75.0) all-time in Brooke Stadium.

* LB **QUINN BACKUS** is the first player in Big South history to lead the League in tackles for three consecutive seasons. He just needs six more stops to own CCU's top three spots for tackles in a season. His 109 this season ranks tied for 4th in the school record book.

* With two sacks versus Liberty (one by Backus and one by **RODERICK HOLDER**), Coastal Carolina set a school single-season record with 28 sacks .

* QB **ALEX ROSS** broke his own CCU and Big South season record for completions with 238. He also became the school's all-time leader in completions, now with 496.

* RB **DE'ANGELO HENDERSON** has run the ball six times on fourth down this season and scored four TDs, while getting a first down five times. He has scored a TD in all 12 games this year.

* WR **BRUCE MAPP** is third on the CCU single-season list for receiving yards (819), while WR **JOHN ISRAEL** is fifth (715) and WR **TYRELL BLANKS** eighth (611).

* Gardner-Webb suffered its first winless Big South season, and finished with fewer than two League-wins for the first time since the Conference's inception in 2002.

* GWU went winless in conference play for the first time since going 0-7 in the Division II South Atlantic Conference in 1993 (1-9 overall record that season).

* QB **LUCAS BEATTY** moved into second-place in school history in passing yardage, passing Hall of Famer and 2002 Big South Player of the Year **JEREMY MARTIN** in the process. Beatty finished his career with 8,175 yards and 42 touchdowns through the air, and set career-highs in attempts (388), completions (234), yardage (2,564) and touchdowns (16) in 2014.

* The Runnin' Bulldogs tied the Big South record and ranked No. 120 of 121 teams with 55 sacks allowed in 2014 -- 21 sacks more than the previous school mark for a single season.

* WR **KENNY COOK** wrapped his career with the most catches in GWU history over a three season career (188) and set a school record for receptions per game for his career (5.7 per game) .

* TE **MIKE ESTES** has 52 career catches for 686 yards and three scores in 24 career games. His yardage is already third-most among tight ends in League history.

* LB **AARON COOK** finished with a career-high 92 total hits and tied for the Big South lead with 13.0 TFL in his first season as a starter.

* James Madison is the third-most frequently played opponent in Liberty's football history (Charleston Southern - 22; Gardner-Webb 21).

* The Flames have posted back-to-back 8 win seasons for the first time since 2007 through 2010 (8-10-8-8).

* Liberty is now 15-49 all-time versus ranked opponents. The Coastal win marked Liberty's fourth against a nationally ranked team under Head Coach **TURNER GILL** (4-7).

* LB **NICK NEWMAN** led the Flames in tackles with nine stops at CCU, his fourth game this year with eight or more tackles.

* RB **D. J. ABNAR**'s 1,116 rushing yards are the most by a Liberty back since **RASHAD JENNINGS** finished his senior year with 1,500 rushing yards (eighth-highest total in program history).

* DL **CHIMA UZOWIHE** recorded his Big South-leading eighth sack of the year and now is tied for fourth in program history and second in Big South history with 17.0 career sacks.

* Uzowihe blocked his second field goal of the year (also blocked a field goal attempt against Richmond), becoming the fourth player in program history with two blocked field goals in a season.

* The Hawks earned their first-ver Big South victory with its 31-15 win over Gardner-Webb. Monmouth finished its first season in the Big South at 1-4 -- the first time the Hawks posted a sub-.500 record in conference play since 2010.

* Monmouth set a school record with 322 points in 2014. The previous record for points scored was 303, done in 1998 (10 games) and 2013 (12 games).

* The Hawks finished the season 5-0 when leading at halftime. MU had a 17-7 lead over GWU after two quarters.

* **JAKE MAURO** converted a fake punt for 76 yards and a touchdown that changed the momentum of the game and gave MU a 17-0 lead midway through the fourth quarter.

* QB **BRANDON HILL**'s 19 touchdown passes is tied for second-most in school history with himself (2013). His 2,396 yards and 201 completions are also second-most all-time in program annals.

* **DARNELL LESLIE** led the Hawks with three sacks against GWU. He also had six tackles and a forced fumble in the contest. Leslie led the Hawks in TFL with 12.5, which was third in the Big South.

* Freshman **MIKE BASILE** had a career-high 10 tackles (one for loss) and an interception against GWU.

* Presbyterian College concluded the regular-season with its 14-7 victory at Gardner-Webb. PC's 2015 opener will be Sept. 5 at Miami (Ohio).

* PC finished with its first winning season since 2007 when the Blue Hose were also 6-5.

* The season finale victory matched the program's most Big South wins in a season (3 in 2011), and is the school's first winning Conference season since joining the Big South.

* LB **ISAIAH LYNN** tied a PC Division I record with three sacks against Gardner-Webb, part of a defensive unit that tallied seven on the day -- the second-most in PC's Division I history. The team also posted 10 tackles for loss, the fourth-most in its Division I era.

* R-Freshman RB **DARRELL BRIDGES** rushed 24 times for 135 yards and the deciding touchdown at GWU, all career-highs for the rookie. Bridges also set a career long with a 55-yard rush, and had two receptions for 23 yards for 158 yards on the day.

* PC's defense set school Division I records in nearly every category, including opponent touchdowns (36) and opponent total offense per game (378.5 yards). Against FCS competition (7 games), PC allowed just 15.9 points and 310.0 total offense yards per game.

* WR **TOBI ANTIGHA** had five catches at Gardner-Webb to push his career total to 117 -- the most on PC's Division I list. He surpassed the previous record of 114 held by **TERRANCE BUTLER**.
