Robertson stuffed the stat sheet in leading the Panthers to their first 2-0 start in Big South play since 2011-12 with wins over Longwood and Presbyterian. She averaged 10.5 points, 11.5 rebounds, 5.5 blocks, 5.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game last week while shooting 58.8 percent (10-17) from the floor. On Tuesday against Longwood, Robertson posted 10 points, seven rebounds, five assists, two steals and a career-high six blocks. She followed that up with 11 points, 16 rebounds, six assists, three steals and five blocks against PC.

Miles led the Blue Hose in scoring in each of their two games last week. In a win over Gardner-Webb on Tuesday, she scored 11 points while shooting 60 percent (3-5) from the floor, including 66.7 percent (2-3) from three-point range. On Saturday at conference-leading High Point, Miles made 4-of-6 (66.7%) three-pointers for 15 points and added three assists.

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CAMPBELL

- Despite three Lady Camels recording double-doubles and a 10-point comeback to close the game, Campbell fell to Winthrop Tuesday night, 61-59, at Winthrop Coliseum. After no double-doubles for any Lady Camel this season, sophomore Amanda Coffey and seniors Kiera Gaines and Summer Leverette each had double-digit points and rebounds.
- Coffey led CU with 19 points, tied for the game high, and added a career-high 11 rebounds with two blocks and steals. She was 8-for-14 from the field and 5-of-5 from three, in her fourth-straight game leading CU. She continues to lead the league, averaging 19.2 PPG.
- Gaines posted a game-high 14 rebounds with 15 points on 4-for-9 shooting, going 1-of-2 from beyond the arc and 6-for-8 from the charity stripe. She added two assists, a block, and a steal. She is third in the league with 10.3 RPG, and averages 12.8 PPG, one of only two players averaging a double-double in the BSC.
- Leverette earned her first career double-double with 11 points and a career-high 10 rebounds, shooting 4-for-9 from the floor, 1-for-2 from three, and 5-for-2 from the line.
- Redshirt junior RaeChaun Edwards leads the league with 6.33 assists per game.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

- Alise Karlson leads the Big South Conference in three-point shooting at 59.1% on the season.
- Karlson (11.6 ppg) and sophomore Tatum Jarvis (9.7 ppg) are both among the conference's leading scorers.
- Freshman guard Alecia Hardy led the Bucs in scoring for the first time of her collegiate career with eight points against Charlotte on Sunday.
- CSU is 2-0 on the season at home inside the Buc Dome, 0-4 on the road.
- The Bucs last home game came on November 17th. It will be 26 days on the road for CSU before they host Campbell on December 13th at home in their longest road trip of the season.
- Alise Karlson was leading the NCAA in three-point percentage last weekend and remains in the top 10 in the country at 59.1% on the season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

- Coastal split its pair of games last week, falling 90-56 at Furman on Wednesday night before downing Johnson & Wales 113-34 at home on Thursday.
- Thursday's win over J&W marked the second game this season that the Chanticleers have scored over 100 points. The only other time it happened for Coastal was the 1982-83 season.
- Coastal's 113 points against Johnson & Wales was the third-highest point total in program history, and the 79-point margin is the second-highest margin of victory behind the 89-point margin over Barber-Scotia earlier this season.
- Stephanie Isaacs led the Chants in scoring against both Furman and J&W, averaging 20 points per game. She has now led Coastal in scoring in three straight games.
- Alexis Robinson finished second in scoring for Coastal, averaging 14.5 points through the two games. AJ Jordan recorded 14 points in each.
- Coastal had six players with double-digit points against J&W, the most this season. Besides Isaacs, Robinson and Jordan, Anna Vogt, Jas Adams and Olivia Carlton scored in double-digits. Carlton's 11 points were a career high.

GARDNER-WEBB

- Opened up conference play with a 65-60 loss on Tuesday and fell 76-60 at UNC Greensboro on Friday.
- Presbyterian led wire-to-wire in the victory.
- Against UNCG, GWU held an 8 point halftime lead and got outscored 42-18 in the second half. Olivia Parker scored 15 points and grabbed 11 rebounds against UNCG for her third double-double of the season.

HIGH POINT

- The High Point women's basketball team went 2-0 in Big South action beating Longwood (81-60) and Presbyterian (54-49) inside the Millis Center this week.
- The 2-0 start to league play is the Panthers' first since they started 9-0 in the 2011-2012 season.
- After its 5-0 start at home, HPU has now won 10 straight home games. The streak is the program's third longest streak since it entered Div. I. The team is over halfway to equaling the longest such winning streak, which is 19 games from January, 2005 - February 2006.
- Stacia Robertson scored 21 points and pulled down 23 rebounds to average a double-double in the two league contests. She also added 11 blocks, 11 assists and five steals in the two games.
- Kaylah Keys led the Panthers in scoring in both games by posting 21 against Longwood and 18 versus Presbyterian. The sophomore hit nine 3-pointers as well and is now ninth in the nation in 3-point shots made per game.
- Stacia Robertson is ranked among the nation's leaders in steals (7th, 3.57), blocks (10th, 3.43) and field goal percentage (13th, .625).

LIBERTY

- Liberty's 72-63 win at Radford extended several streaks. The Lady Flames have now won three straight games overall, five straight Big South openers, seven straight games against in-state opponents and eight straight matchups with Radford.
- Karly Buer led all players with a season-high 26 points. Buer, who has scored in double figures in all seven of her games in a Liberty uniform, was one point

shy of her collegiate best of 27, set while at Missouri State.

- Simone Brown scored in double digits for the third straight game, finishing with 18 points. She made 10-10 from the foul line, becoming the first Lady Flame to make 10 or more free throws in a game without a miss since Avery Warley went 12-12 at Charleston Southern on Jan. 16, 2012.
- Radford outrebounded Liberty by 18 (47-29), becoming the first opposing team since Baylor on Nov. 26, 2010 to outrebound the Lady Flames by 10 or more boards.
- With two blocks on Saturday, Ashley Rininger now ranks No. 5 in program history with 96 career rejections.

LONGWOOD

- Longwood opened its conference slate Tuesday at High Point, falling to the Panthers, 81-60.
- In the game against High Point, Raven Williams (19) and Kyndal Skersick (18) finished with a season-high in points scored.
- On Saturday, Longwood fell at Virginia Tech, 74-42. Virginia Tech opened the contest on a 20-3 run in a span of 8:28.
- In the latest RPI rankings, Longwood is listed at No. 319, ahead of Big South members Campbell, UNC Asheville and Charleston Southern.
- Longwood plays the most games in the conference against teams from power conferences, as the Lancers have already played at Wake Forest, Florida and Virginia Tech, and will travel to Virginia and Clemson later this year.

PRESBYTERIAN

- Presbyterian College went 1-1 on the week, winning its Big South Conference opener over Gardner-Webb on Tuesday, 55-50, before dropping a close result at High Point on Saturday, 54-49. PC last started 4-4 in 2012-13, a season in which the Blue Hose went 19-12 and made their first Division I postseason appearance with a trip to the Women's Basketball Invitational.
- Freshman Janie Miles led PC in scoring for the first time in her career on Tuesday against Gardner-Webb, scoring 11 points in the win. She led the Blue Hose on Saturday as well, scoring 15 points thanks to four three-pointers. Miles played a combined 11 minutes over the season's first two games but has started the last five, logging 34 minutes against Gardner-Webb on Tuesday and 31 on Saturday at High Point.
- The Blue Hose boast the nation's second-ranked scoring defense through their first eight games, holding opponents to an average of 45.9 points per game.
- PC ranks second in the country in field goal percentage defense, holding opponents to 29.6 percent of their shots. PC has held all eight of its opponents to under 40 percent from the field this season after limiting High Point to a 36.1 percent clip (22-for-61) on Saturday.

RADFORD

- Radford dropped a pair of tough home decisions to William & Mary (71-81) and Liberty (63-72) last week.
- In both contests, the Highlanders erased large deficits and eventually gained the lead midway through the second half. However, in both games, that lead slipped away behind 12-0 runs by the opponent.
- A pair of freshmen led RU in scoring against the Tribe. Jayda Worthy netted a season-high 16 points on 6-of-10 shooting, while Janayla White posted her third double-double of the season (10 points, 11 rebounds).
- The Highlanders shot a season-high 50 percent from the floor and outrebounded William & Mary, 36-34.
- In Radford's Big South opener against Liberty, the Highlanders were able to establish a 49-45 lead with 10:13 to go, but the Flames rallied to down RU for the eighth consecutive time.
- RU outrebounded Liberty, 47-29. The Highlanders became the first team since Baylor (Nov. 26, 2010) to have at least a +10 rebounding margin against the Flames.

UNC ASHEVILLE

- The Bulldogs went 1-0 in league play for the second straight year with a 56-47 win over Charleston Southern.
- Jeanne Buckner grabbed 8 rebounds vs. Wofford and leads the Bulldogs in rebounding. She has led Asheville in rebounding in five of the last six games.
- The Bulldogs did not have the services of three starters against Wofford due to injuries.
- Senior guard Shonese Jones has 1,095 points and is tied for 11th place on Asheville's career scoring list.
- Freshman center Bronaza Fitzgerald scored a career-high 14 points vs. Wofford.

WINTHROP

- Sophomore point guard Aliyah Kilpatrick scored a team-high 16 points against Ohio State. During one stretch of the first half, she scored eight straight points as Winthrop held a 27-26 lead over the Buckeyes at halftime.
- Schaquilla Nunn has pulled down double digit rebounds in six of Winthrop's seven games. She has had three straight games with 10.
- Senior guard Samiya Wright needs two more points to take over 13th place on the Winthrop career scoring list. She now has 1,080 points.
- Winthrop is now 0-2 against Ohio State and 0-3 overall in games against the Big Ten.
- With the win over Campbell to begin conference play, Winthrop is now 14-14 all-time in Big South openers.
