Robertson averaged 22.3 points, 9.0 rebounds, 4.3 blocks, 2.7 assists and 2.3 steals per game while shooting 27-of-31 (87.1%) from the floor in three wins last week. She was 9-of-10 (90%) for 21 points and added seven rebounds and three blocks against Campbell on Monday. At Charleston Southern on Thursday, Robertson was a perfect 8-of-8 from the field for 24 points, and chipped in six rebounds, five blocks, four steals and four assists. On Saturday, against third-place Winthrop, she poured in 22 points on 10-of-13 (76.9%) shooting with 14 rebounds, five blocks, four assists and two steals. Robertson crossed the 1,000-point plateau last week, becoming just the eighth member of the program's Division I 1,000-point club, and the 18th in the history of the program. The Player of the Week honor is her third this season.

White helped lead Radford to three wins last week, including two on the road. She averaged 12.0 points, 12.0 rebounds and 2.3 blocks per game, while shooting 61.5 percent (16-of-26) from the field. On Monday against Charleston Southern, White scored 12 points, pulled down nine rebounds and added two blocks and two steals. The 6-2 forward hauled in a career-high 16 rebounds at Presbyterian on Thursday, becoming the first Radford player to grab at least 15 boards in a game since Feb. 14, 2011. White concluded the week with a double-double on Saturday at Longwood, scoring 15 points with 11 rebounds, and rejected three shots. She has now earned three Freshman of the Week honors this season.

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CAMPBELL

- Senior Kiera Gaines posted her third double-double of the season with 14 points and 10 rebounds at High Point. Gaines also achieved the feat at Winthrop (15 points, 14 boards) and at Charleston Southern (17 points, 12 rebounds).
- With four blocks across this week's games, Gaines has matched Felecia Auri's all-time career record with 94 blocks, the most in Campbell history.
- Freshman Summer Price ran her double-digit scoring streak to three games with 17 points at High Point and 11 against UNC Asheville.
- Redshirt junior RaeChaun Edwards returned to the starting lineup and dished out eight assists for Campbell, her most against a Big South opponent this season, while committing just one turnover.
- The Lady Camels have trailed at halftime in each of their last four contests, but have come back to score victories in three of them, including overcoming a 13-point second-half deficit against the Bulldogs.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

- Charleston Southern continues to lead the Big South in steals per game at 10.93.
- The Buccaneers remain the league leader in turnover margin on the season at +1.93.
- Charleston Southern went 0-3 last week in Big South Conference play, falling at home to High Point and on the road at Radford and Gardner-Webb.
- Natasha Lebedeva scored a career-high 15 points in CSU's loss to the Highlanders. The senior from Moscow, Russia went 7-of-9 from the free throw line in leading the Bucs second half comeback attempt.
- Alyssa Mann scored a team-high 11 points and Christal Barnett had seven points, six rebounds and four steals off the bench for CSU in the Bucs loss to High Point.

COASTAL CAROLINA

- Coastal lost its trio of games last week, falling at Liberty before facing home defeats against Liberty, and in double overtime against Presbyterian. The Chants are now 7-8, 1-5, and have lost their past six.
- AJ Jordan had her best week of the season, averaging 24.7 points through the three games. After scoring 25 at Longwood and 13 against she Liberty, she ended the week with a career-high 36 points against PC, all of which came after being held scoreless in the first half.
- Ced Gibson averaged 15.0 points for the Chants, with her 17 points at Longwood marking her highest offensive output of the week. She also shot 40.0 percent from the floor, and 37.5 percent from beyond the arc.
- Anna Vogt averaged a double-double for the week, scoring 11.3 points per game while averaging 10.0 rebounds. Against PC, Vogt tallied 16 points and eight rebounds before fouling out. The junior forward shot 42.3 percent from the floor and 70.6 percent from the line.

GARDNER-WEBB

- Went 2-0 last week with wins at Winthrop on Monday and against Charleston Southern on Saturday.
- GWU went 17-36 from beyond the three-point arc and averaged 8.5 makes per game.
- Averaged 12.0 steals and 7.0 blocks in the two games last week.

HIGH POINT

- The Panthers went 3-0 on the week in conference play with home wins over Campbell and Winthrop and a road win at Charleston Southern.
- With the two home wins, HPU moved to 8-0 in the Millis Center this season and have won 13 straight at home dating back to Jan. 11, 2014.
- Redshirt-senior Stacia Robertson surpassed the 1,000-point mark for her career with 22 points in the win over Winthrop on Saturday.
- Stacia Robertson led HPU in scored 20-plus points in all three games to average 22.3 points per contest while shooting 27-of-31 (87 percent) from the floor during the week.
- Redshirt-senior Lindsay Puckett, senior Latrice Phelps and sophomore Kaylah Keys each had two double-digit scoring performances during the week's action.

LIBERTY

- Liberty extended several winning streaks last week. The Lady Flames have won four straight games overall, five straight home games and 43 consecutive matchups with Coastal Carolina. That is the second longest active streak against a single opponent in NCAA Division I women's basketball.
- The Lady Flames' 59-42 win over Presbyterian on Jan. 5 was Liberty's 250th victory at the Vines Center. The Lady Flames are 250-64 all-time at the facility.
- At 6-0, Liberty is off to its best Big South start since 2008-09. The Lady Flames have won 11 straight regular-season conference games dating back to last season.
- Liberty is 3-0 to start the month of January and is now 109-15 in January contests under head coach Carey Green.
- Karly Buer is 31 points shy of 1,000 for her collegiate career, including her time at Missouri State and Liberty.
- Katelyn Adams needs one more blocked shot to become the sixth Lady Flame ever with 100 career rejections.

LONGWOOD

- Longwood won its second game of the season Monday evening inside Willett Hall, defeating Coastal Carolina, 78-74. The Lancers had five players finish in double figures, led by Raven Williams with 18 points.
- The 18 points for Williams against Coastal Carolina was the eighth straight game she had scored in double figures. During the stretch, Williams was second in the league in scoring, averaging 17.5 points per game.
- Autumn Childress and Micaela Ellis each recorded season highs this week. Childress finished with 10 points and seven rebounds against Coastal Carolina, while Ellis posted 11 points against Radford.
- Longwood fell in its second game of the week, a 78-60 loss against Radford.
- Emily Nylen is ninth in the Big South, averaging 1.7 blocks per game in the conference.

PRESBYTERIAN

- PC went 1-2 last week, snapping a two-game losing streak to Liberty and Radford with an 84-78 double overtime win at Coastal Carolina on Saturday. The 84 points mark a new program high in a Big South game for the Blue Hose, breaking the previous record of 79 points set in a win against Charleston Southern (79-61) on Feb. 16, 2013.
- Saturday's win over Coastal Carolina marked PC's first overtime game of the season. The program has played one overtime game in each season since 2011 and boasts a 4-0 marker since then, with a 4-1 record in Big South overtime games. The team's last overtime loss came in a home 52-50 loss to Savannah State on January 12, 2011. PC has beaten Gardner-Webb (59-57, 2011-12), Campbell (68-62, 2012-13), Coastal Carolina (71-68, 2013-14) and Coastal Carolina (84-78, 2014-15) since that loss.
- Redshirt junior forward Keyonna Allen grabbed a team-leading eight rebounds on Thursday against Radford, passing Sherece Smith's (2010-14) career mark of 402 to take over fifth place in PC's Division I history. She next needs 26 to tie Chelsea Wright (2007-11) for fourth place.
- PC dished out 24 team assists in Saturday's win, the second-most in the program's Division I history and the most in a PC Big South Conference game. Freshman Courtney Storey led the team with a career-high eight assists, the sixth-most in a D-I game for PC and the second-most in a PC Big South game behind Dria David's 11 against Longwood on March 2, 2013.

RADFORD

- Radford extended its winning streak to four straight games, following wins over Charleston Southern (H), Presbyterian College (A) and Longwood (A). It's the longest winning streak for RU since Jan. 2013 when the team won five in a row.
- The Highlanders narrowly escaped a scrappy Charleston Southern squad on the strength of Ayana Avery's game-winning 3-pointer from the right wing with nine seconds remaining. It was Avery's third career game-winning shot (all 3-pointers).
- Against Presbyterian, which is the Big South leader in scoring defense and field goal percentage defense, the Highlanders' own defense stood out. RU held the Blue Hose to 21.1 percent shooting - its lowest of the season.
- Radford outrebounded PC and Longwood by double digits. The Highlanders, who lead the conference in rebounding margin in conference games, have outrebounded three of their six opponents in Big South play by double digits.
- RU used a 23-4 run to open the game against Longwood. The Highlanders finished with a season-high 78 points against the Lancers and won by a season-high 18 points.

UNC ASHEVILLE

- UNC Asheville has lost six straight games.
- Senior guard Shonese Jones has scored in double figures in three straight games and five of the last six contests. She is Asheville's leading scorer with a 10.6 average.
- Asheville has averaged 55.7 points in the last four games, scoring exactly 55 points in three different contests.
- The Bulldogs have 27 steals in the last three games.
- After Saturday's game at Gardner-Webb, the Bulldogs play six of their next eight games at Kimmel Arena.

WINTHROP

- Sophomore forward/guard Erica Williams recorded two more double doubles against Gardner-Webb and High Point—her 6th and 7th of the year and the 16th and 17th of her 47-game career.
- Williams scored in double figures in three games last week as she averaged 21.1 points to increase her season average to 16.1.
- Junior center Schaquilla Nunn recorded her sixth double-double of the season and 33rd of her career with a 18-point, 14-rebound effort against UNC Asheville.
- Nunn has moved up to 6th place on the Winthrop career rebounding list. She now has 727.
- Winthrop senior guard Samiya Wright moved into 11th place on the career scoring ladder with 1,153 career points and needs only 10 more to crack the top 10.
- Head coach Kevin Cook was presented his 100th career win in the victory over UNC Asheville. He has 53 at Winthrop in two-plus years and won 47 in four seasons at Gallaudet.
