Jordan averaged 22.5 points and 6.0 rebounds per game while shooting 62.5 percent (20-of-32) in two wins last week. She was also 3-of-4 (75.0%) from the line and 2-of-2 from three-point range. At Charleston Southern on Tuesday, Jordan was 10-of-16 (62.5%) from the floor for 20 points in a 71-62 victory. Against Winthrop on Saturday, she scored 25 points on 10-of-16 (62.5%) shooting with nine rebounds and two three-pointers to lead the Chanticleers to their first victory over the Eagles since the 2011-12 season.

Price shot 57.1 percent (12-of-21) from the field while averaging 17.0 points and 2.5 steals per game in two victories last week. She scored 16 points, made two three-pointers and added three steals in Campbell's 75-74 win against Gardner-Webb on Tuesday. With the Camels ahead by just one, Price drained a late three-pointer to help preserve the win. On Saturday against Radford, she scored 18 points on 6-of-10 (60.0%) shooting, pulled down five rebounds and recorded two steals in a 65-62 overtime victory. The 5-8 point guard scored three of the Camels' eight overtime points.

**CAMPBELL**

- Over the last three games, senior Summer Leverette has scored 41 of her 54 points (75.9 percent) in either the second half or overtime.
- Leverette has also scored a career-high 19 points in back-to-back games against Gardner-Webb and Radford.
- Campbell has an 8-0 record in 2014-15 when leading at the halftime break and a 7-0 mark when leading with four minutes to play.
- Counting its 65-62 overtime win over Radford, Campbell has won its last four overtime games, all of which have come inside Gore Arena.
- Campbell has won three straight games by five points or less for only the second time in program history. During the 1975-76 season, the Lady Camels defeated Duke (72-69), St. Augustine's (75-74) and UNC Pembroke (69-67) in consecutive games.
- Redshirt junior RaeChaun Edwards reached triple-digit assists for the second straight season and has 100 in 15 games this season.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

- Freshman guard Shauntavia Dobson scored a career-high 14 points against Liberty on Saturday afternoon. Dobson went on an 8-2 run against the Flames to end the second half and kept CSU in the running early shooting 4-of-11 from the floor in the game.
- Sophomore forward Tatum Jarvis connected on a season-high four three-pointers on Saturday against Liberty. It was the third time the forward had hit four triples on the season with the others coming against Campbell (12/13) and Montreat (12/16).
- Freshman guard Alecia Hardy scored a career-high 16 points on Tuesday night inside the Buc Dome against Coastal Carolina, hitting a career-high four three-pointers in the contest in the loss.
- The Bucs hit seven three-pointers in both games this past week against Coastal Carolina and Liberty. It was the fifth time this season CSU has hit seven or more triples in a game after leading the Big South last season with 7.27 three-pointers per game.
- Former CSU guard Erin Bratcher signed a professional contract this past week with TSV Krofdorf-Gleiberg in the Germany-Regionalliga League. Bratcher earned 2014 Big South Honorable Mention honors last season after averaging 12.7 points per game with 84 made three-pointers on the season to pace the Bucs in both categories last year.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

- The Chants (9-8, 3-5) snapped their six-game skid with a 2-0 week, winning at Charleston Southern on Tuesday before defeating visiting Winthrop on Saturday.
- AJ Jordan led Coastal averaging 22.5 points through the two contests. The senior guard went 10-16 from the field in both games for a 62.5 FG shooting percentage for the week. Jordan has now scored 20-plus points in each of her last three games, and four of her last five. Her first basket of the night at Charleston Southern put her at 10th place among Coastal's all-time career points leaders.
- Freshman guard Jas Adams averaged 13.5 points while making the first two starts of her career. Her 23 points against Winthrop were a career-high, as were her four made 3-pointers.
- Anna Vogt scored a career-high 21 points in Coastal's win at CSU, and averaged 17.0 points per game for the week. Against Winthrop, Vogt was one rebound short of getting her seventh double-double for the season.
- Ced Gibson averaged 10.5 points and hit 40.0 percent of her field goal attempts.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

- Went 0-2 with a loss at Campbell on Tuesday (75-74) and to UNC Asheville at home on Saturday (64-55).
- Trailed Campbell by 17 at halftime and cut the lead down to 2, on two different occasions.
- Had 13 turnovers in the first half and had only three in the 2nd half. Scored 53 points in the 2nd period.
- Against Asheville, had a tough time shooting. 6-29 (20.7%) in the first half and 9-30 (30.0%) in the 2nd half.

**HIGH POINT**

- High Point won 67-50 at UNC Asheville on Tuesday night to earn their fourth straight win.
- The Panthers and the Bulldogs went back and forth early before in the HPU went on an 11-2 run before the half to create separation.
- Redshirt-senior Stacia Robertson tallied 14 points, five rebounds, four blocks, three assists and three steals.
- Sophomore DeAnneisha Jackson came off of the bench and registered 13 points and seven rebounds while tying a career high with four blocked shots.
- HPU held UNC Asheville to 33 percent shooting and caused 20 turnovers as the defense has sparked the Panthers' run.

**LIBERTY**

- Liberty's 2-0 week gives the Lady Flames six consecutive victories overall, six straight home wins and 13 consecutive Big South regular-season triumphs.
- The Lady Flames are 53-6 all-time in South Carolina under head coach Carey Green, including 2-0 this season.
- Liberty made a season-best 11 three-pointers during Tuesday's 70-48 win over Longwood, falling just one triple shy of the program single-game record.

- On Saturday at Charleston Southern, the Lady Flames set season highs for points (86) and field goal percentage (58.6), improving to 97-1 under Carey Green when shooting 50 percent or better from the field.
- Karly Buer sits just six points shy of 1,000 for her collegiate career, including her time at Missouri State and Liberty.
- During Saturday's game at CSU, Jasmine Gardner became the 25th Lady Flame ever to grab 500 career rebounds. Teammate Katelyn Adams is 17 boards away from becoming No. 26 to do so.

**LONGWOOD**

- Longwood played two games this past week, as the Lancers fell at Liberty Tuesday, 70-48, before being outlasted at Presbyterian, 53-48, on Saturday.
- Raven Williams scored 18 points at Liberty, as the game marked the ninth time in the past 10 games the junior has scored 16 or more points in a game.
- Kyndal Skersick scored 15 points against Presbyterian Saturday, as she matched her career-high with five made triples.
- Longwood hit a season-best 11 three-point field goals in the loss at Presbyterian.
- Emily Nylen posted four blocks at Presbyterian in a career-best 18 minutes of action.

**PRESBYTERIAN**

- PC women's basketball went 1-0 on the week, holding off Longwood on Saturday for a 53-48 victory. Three Blue Hose scored double figures for the fourth time this season, led by freshman Cortney Storey's 11 points. The Blue Hose outrebounded Longwood 41-29 and outscored the Lancers 32-6 in the paint.
- PC's win Saturday gave them their second in a row, the third time this season they have accomplished that feat. The last came on November 29 and December 2 against SC State and Gardner-Webb. The Blue Hose can win their third straight for the first time this season with a home win over Charleston Southern on Tuesday night.
- Senior forward Noelle Carter played in her 100th career game on Saturday against Longwood, becoming the ninth player in PC's Division I history to hit the century mark. She also posted her 28th career block to tie for Dria David (2009-13) fifth in the school's Division I history.
- The Blue Hose boast the nation's third-ranked scoring defense entering the week, holding opponents to an average of 50.5 points per game. PC held Radford to 43 points on January 8 and Longwood to 48 points on Saturday.
- PC won its ninth game when holding its opponent to below 40 percent on Saturday, matching last year's total. The Blue Hose are 9-5 when limiting teams to under 40 percent shooting and 8-1 when outrebounding their opponent.
- The Blue Hose have scored a combined 72 points in the paint over the past two games against Coastal Carolina (40) and Longwood (32). PC has scored more than 30 only four times this season and 40 marks a season-high against Big South competition.

**RADFORD**

- Radford opened the week by toppling the defending Big South tournament champion, Winthrop, 55-47. The Eagles were held to 47 points, their second-lowest output of the season. Not even nonconference foes Tennessee, Ohio State or Auburn managed to keep Winthrop under that score.
- The Highlanders' five-game win streak ended on Saturday in Buies Creek, N.C., against Campbell. The Camels prevailed in the battle of two teams tied for third place in the Big South standings, 65-62, in overtime.
- Rebounding was a key factor in the game. Campbell outrebounded RU, 44-33. The Highlanders also committed 21 turnovers.
- Radford outshot the Camels (42.3%-38.7%) and dominated bench scoring (20-4).

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

- UNC Asheville ends a seven-game losing streak with a 64-55 win at Gardner-Webb. It marks the Bulldogs first win over the Runnin' Bulldogs in three seasons and first victory at Gardner-Webb since 2011.
- Shonese Jones scored 16 points in the win over Gardner-Webb.
- Chatori Major tied her career high in points with 15 at Gardner-Webb.
- Sophomore center KJ Weaver grabbed nine rebounds in both of Asheville's games last week.

**WINTHROP**

- Sophomore forward/guard Erica Williams recorded her 8th double-double of the season and 18th of her career with 16 points and 11 rebounds at Coastal Carolina last Saturday.
- Senior guard Samiya Wright moved into 10th place on the Winthrop career scoring list. She now has 1,180 points.
- Junior center Schaquilla Nunn recorded her seventh double-double of the season and 34th of her career with a 24-point, 16-rebound effort against Radford.
- Winthrop's current three-game losing streak is its longest since the 2011-12 season when the Eagles lost four straight.
- Winthrop will try to accomplish something it hasn't done since the 1995-96 season when the Eagles face Liberty Tuesday night—defeat the Flames two games in a row. Winthrop downed Liberty in their last meeting in the 2014 Big South Tournament semifinals.
