Nunn averaged 13.0 points, 11.0 rebounds and 5.5 blocks per game in two wins last week. In a victory over first-place Liberty on Tuesday, she tied a season high with nine blocked shots, scored 11 points and chipped in eight rebounds and two steals. On Saturday against Presbyterian, Nunn recorded her eighth double-double of the season with 15 points and 14 rebounds. She shot 66.7 percent from the field (4-of-6) and blocked two shots.

Quevedo averaged 13.0 points, 3.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game while shooting 50 percent (10-of-20) from the floor in two victories last week. She scored a season-high 19 points on 8-of-13 shooting (61.5%) with five rebounds in a win at UNC Asheville on Tuesday. The 5-9 guard hit the go-ahead three-pointer with 2:14 remaining in the game to propel the Highlanders to the road victory. On Saturday against High Point, Quevedo delivered seven points, four assists and two steals in 13 minutes of action. The freshman assisted on Ayana Avery's game-winning three-pointer with 30 seconds to go in the contest.

CAMPBELL

- Campbell will aim for its second season sweep of Presbyterian in the all-time series on Tuesday night after winning in Buies Creek on Dec. 30. The Camels swept the Blue Hose during the 2011-12 season as well.
- Freshman Sarah Smith knocked down her first collegiate three-pointer and had a career-high five points at Liberty on Saturday.
- The Camels hold a 10-2 record when scoring 60 or more points in 2014-15.
- Redshirt junior RaeChyna Edwards continues to lead the Big South and is 12th nationally, averaging 6.5 assists per contest.
- Senior Kiera Gaines tallied her fourth double-double of the season and 18th of her career at Coastal Carolina with 12 points and 10 rebounds.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

- Tatum Jarvis continues to lead the Buccaneers on the season with 15 points against Presbyterian and 23 points on the road against Longwood
- Saturday against Longwood saw the second highest team shooting performance of the season as the Bucs hit 46.8% of their shots from the floor
- Alyssa Mann had 15 points and seven assists against the Lancers, while Alise Karlson (12) and Monique Maximilien (10) were also in double-digits
- Maximilien had a season-high three blocked shots on Tuesday against Presbyterian
- Jarvis leads the Bucs in scoring (12.4) on the season and has raised her average in conference play to 13.8 points per game
- Jarvis reached 500 career points on Saturday against Presbyterian. The sophomore forward has a career 10.6 scoring average per game

COASTAL CAROLINA

- Coastal Carolina moved to 10-9, 4-6 after splitting its pair of games last week. The Chants defeated Campbell 50-40 on Tuesday before falling 68-61 at UNC Asheville on Saturday.
- Ced Gibson led the Chants in scoring, averaging 12.5 points for the week. AJ Jordan and Jas Adams each averaged 11.5 points for the week, while Adams led the Chants shooting .533 through Coastal's two games.
- Anna Vogt's 13 points and 11 rebounds against Campbell was her seventh double-double of the season, matching the mark set by former Chants Angelica Henry (2013-14) and Sydnei Moss (2010-11).
- AJ Jordan needs just 13 more points to become Coastal's ninth all-time leading scorer.

GARDNER-WEBB

- Went 0-1 with a loss at High Point last Tuesday
- Had an early 14-3 lead, but HPU stormed back and would tie the game at 24 headed into half
- HPU shot 63.3% (19-30) from the field in the second half and a perfect 5-5 from behind the three-point arc
- Preseason Player of the Year Kaylah Keys was held to just four points in the 1st half, but exploded for 20 points in the 2nd half on 8-9 shooting and 4-4 from three.

HIGH POINT

- The Panthers opened last week's action with a come-from-behind 72-57 win in the Millis Center over Gardner-Webb.
- Sophomore Kaylah Keys led the comeback charge with 20 of her game-high 24 points coming in the second half when she hit all four of her 3-point attempts.
- HPU came close but a second comeback attempt fell short in a 61-58 loss at Radford.
- Redshirt-senior Stacia Robertson led the team with 14 points and 8 rebounds against the Highlanders.
- The Purple & White will play two Coastal Carolina (Tuesday at 7 p.m.) and Liberty (Saturday at 2 p.m.) at home this week. The team has won its last 14 games in the Millis Center.

LIBERTY

- Liberty saw its six-game winning streak halted at Winthrop on Tuesday but bounced back to extend its home winning streak to seven games with a Saturday win over Campbell.
- The Lady Flames have still only lost back-to-back Big South games once in Carey Green's 16 seasons as head coach.
- With one more victory, Liberty will notch its 16th straight season with 10 or more Big South wins.
- Karly Buer's first hoop against Campbell on Saturday enabled her to eclipse the 1,000-point mark for her collegiate career, including her time at Missouri State and Liberty.
- Ashley Rininger made 13 of her 14 field goal attempts against Campbell on Saturday, setting a program single-game field goal percentage record (92.9 percent).
- Katelyn Adams needs two rebounds to become the 26th Lady Flame ever to pull down 500 career boards. Teammates Ashley Rininger and Jasmine Gardner are already members of the 500-rebound club.

LONGWOOD

- Longwood concluded its first half of conference play with a 79-71 victory over Charleston Southern Saturday afternoon at Willett Hall
- Against the Buccaneers, Longwood's Raven Williams had her second double-double of the season with 19 points and 10 assists. The game marks the fourth time this season that Williams reached the 19-point plateau

- Brenna Robbins and Emily Nylen each finished with a career-high in points for Longwood. Robbins posted 14 points to mark the second straight game she finished with career marks, while Nylen notched 14 points, including 8-of-9 from the charity stripe
- With her 10 points Saturday against Charleston Southern, Kyndal Skersick notched her fourth straight game in double figures
- Longwood continues to shoot the ball well from beyond the arc, as the Lancers rank first in the Big South

PRESBYTERIAN

- PC went 1-1 on the week, topping Charleston Southern on Tuesday in a 71-40 win before falling to Winthrop on Saturday, 54-51. PC's 31-point margin of victory over the Bucs matched a school record for the largest margin of victory in a Big South game, tying a 71-40 win over UNC Asheville on February 2, 2013. The team's loss on Saturday at Winthrop also matched the smallest margin of defeat to the Eagles in program history, matching a 71-68 loss on February 9, 1981.
- Keyonna Allen scored 17 points against Charleston Southern and 12 against Winthrop. She has scored in double figures nine times this season and needs to break the 10-point plateau against Campbell on Tuesday to tie her longest double-figures streak of the season at three games, set against Allen, Western Carolina and Xavier.
- PC led at halftime and outshot Winthrop on Saturday, 42.3 percent to 36.0 percent, in the team's three-point loss. The Blue Hose enter the week now 9-2 when leading at the break, 3-1 when shooting 40 percent and 10-6 when they hold their foe to less than 40 percent (out of 19 games). The loss also marked only the team's second in the state of North Carolina (8-2) and when playing on Saturday (6-2).
- The Blue Hose scored 40 points in the paint against Charleston Southern on Tuesday, the team's third straight game with at least 32 interior points before Saturday's loss at Winthrop. PC scored a combined 112 points in the paint in three straight against Coastal Carolina (40), Longwood (32) and Charleston Southern (40). PC scored more than 30 only four prior times this season and 40 marks a season-high against Big South competition.
- Head coach Ronny Fisher needs one more win for his 74th career victory, which would tie both Randy Randall (1977-84) and Byron Rucker (1984-89) in second in Presbyterian College history. Beth Couture holds the record, with 238 wins amassed from 1989 to 2002.

RADFORD

- Radford, which has won seven of its last eight games, climbed into solo third place in the Big South standings following its two wins over UNC Asheville and High Point.
- The Highlanders' margin of victory last week was only 2.5 points. They defeated UNC Asheville by two points (67-65) and High Point by three points (61-58).
- Against the Bulldogs, freshman Claudia Quevedo dropped in a season-high 19 points on 8-of-13 shooting. She showed no signs of nerves down the stretch, hitting the go-ahead 3-pointer with 2:14 remaining to give the Highlanders a 65-63 advantage. It was the second time of the season Quevedo led RU in scoring.
- On Saturday against the Panthers, Radford shot 53.8 percent (7-13) from 3-point range to defeat HPU, which entered the game tied for first place in the conference standings with Liberty.
- High Point was held to 31.1 percent shooting, which was below their 42.8 percent average entering the game.
- Radford recorded a season-high 11 blocks against the Panthers, which were only three blocks away from tying the Dedmon Center record.

UNC ASHEVILLE

- UNC Asheville has won two of its last three games
- The Bulldogs defeated Coastal Carolina 68-61 on Saturday, giving the Bulldogs their first win over the Chanticleers since 2012.
- The win over Coastal Carolina drew 1,581 fans, a new record for an Asheville home game.
- Shonese Jones moved into 7th place on Asheville's career scoring list as she now has 1,241 points.
- The Bulldogs game with PC on Saturday will be on ESPN3.

WINTHROP

- Winthrop's 63-58 win over Liberty on Jan. 20 marked the first time since 1995-96 that the Eagles have beaten the Flames in successive games. Winthrop downed Liberty in the 2014 Big South Tournament semifinals.
- Junior center Schaquelle Nunn recorded her 8th double-double of the season and 35th of her career with a 15-point, 14-rebound performance against PC on Jan. 24.
- Sophomore forward Erica Williams scored 23 points and grabbed 9 rebounds against Liberty and connected on 9 of 14 field goals.
- Both Nunn and Williams are tied for 34th in the NCAA for double-doubles this season with eight.
- In Big South games only, both Nunn and Williams are the only players in the league who are averaging double-doubles in points and rebounds. Nunn is the only player to average a double-double for all games.
- As a team, Winthrop ranks 15th in the nation for blocked shots with 5.8 per game.
