Williams averaged 21.5 points, 8.5 rebounds, and 4.5 assists in two wins last week, while shooting 54.8 percent from the field (17-of-31) and 90.0 percent from the line (9-of-10). On Tuesday at Longwood, she recorded her ninth double-double of the season with 18 points and 12 rebounds, while chipping in six assists. In the victory against Charleston Southern on Saturday, Williams scored a season-high 25 points in just 28 minutes while going 9-of-14 from the floor (64.3%). She also pulled down five rebounds and dished out three assists.

CAMPBELL

- Campbell is 9-1 at home this season, its best record at home since beginning 10-0 during the 1997-98 season.
- Senior Summer Leverette notched a career-high 21 points and redshirt junior RaeChaun Edwards pulled down a career-high eight rebounds in the 68-56 win over Longwood.
- Senior Kiera Gaines broke the program's all-time blocked shots record with a block late in the first half against the Lancers. With two more in the second half, Gaines now has 97 for her career.
- Gaines also picked up her fifth double-double of the season with 11 points and 15 rebounds. It was her second games with 15+ rebounds this season.
- All 12 of Campbell's victories this season have come when recording the same number or more assists than their opponents.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

- Charleston Southern had four players score in double-digits led by Tatum Jarvis' 13 points as the Buccaneers snapped a 10-game losing streak with a 74-33 win over Columbia International.
- Rochelle Brophy had 10 points against the Rams as CSU shot 43.1% from the floor and held the 39-28 rebounding advantage over CIU.
- The second half of Big South Conference play opened up for CSU on Saturday with the Bucs falling to Winthrop 77-40 despite Brophy and Jarvis both being in double-digits with 10 points apiece.
- CSU went 1-of-16 from the three-point line against Winthrop, the first game of the season the Bucs failed to hit multiple three-pointers on the year.
- Tatum Jarvis has climbed to sixth in scoring in Big South Conference games as the sophomore forward is at 13.5 points per game. She is also seventh in three-pointers per game at 1.73 in conference play.

COASTAL CAROLINA

- The Chanticleers suffered two losses last week, falling 73-65 at High Point on Tuesday before coming up short against visiting Gardner-Webb on Saturday. Coastal has now lost its last three to Big South opponents.
- Freshman guard Jas Adams led the Chants, averaging 19.0 points and 5.5 rebounds while shooting 37.5 percent from the field and 81 percent from the line (17-21).
- AJ Jordan averaged 14 points, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals in Coastal's two games. The senior guard also shot 37.5 percent from the field.
- Anna Vogt had 15 points and 12 rebounds at High Point for her eighth double-double of the season. According to Coastal's accurate records (2000-01 - pres.) she is the first Chant to surpass seven in one season.
- Alexis Robinson averaged 10 points and 12 rebounds on the week.

GARDNER-WEBB

- First time since the 2010-11 season that GWU swept the season series with Coastal
- Against Radford, GWU played stout defense limiting Radford to just 7-31 from the field and took a 29-22 lead into the locker room. Radford regrouped at half and behind Ayana Avery's 16 points and 4-6 shooting from behind the three-point arc, Radford went on for the 59-49 victory.
- Olivia Parker led the Runnin' Bulldogs totaling 16 points and tying a career-high 16 rebounds
- Against the Chanticleers, GWU was prolific on the offensive end hitting 42.9% of its field goals and dishing out 19 assists on 27 field goals made.
- Gardner-Webb limited Coastal Carolina to just 1-11 from the three-point line and forced 22 turnovers by CCU. GWU cashed the 22 turnovers into 22 points.

HIGH POINT

- The Panthers split their two home games this week with a 73-65 win over Coastal Carolina on Tuesday before dropping Saturday's contest with Liberty 58-41.
- In falling to the Flames, HPU's 15-game winning streak was snapped. The team is 10-1 at home this season.
- Redshirt-senior Stacia Robertson posted two double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds against the Chanticleers and 11 points and 11 rebound against Liberty.
- Senior Latrice Phelps averaged nine points per contest this week while sophomore DeAnneisha Jackson averaged 8.5 ppg.
- Sophomore Kaylah Keys posted 17 points against Coastal Carolina while freshman Kat Harris tallied 10 off of the bench.

LIBERTY

- Liberty's 2-0 week improved the Lady Flames' Big South record to 11-1. The Lady Flames have now recorded double-digit conference victories for 16 consecutive seasons.
- On Saturday, Liberty completed its first two-game regular-season sweep of High Point since 2010-11 and snapped the Panthers' 15-game home winning streak.
- Monday's home game against Radford will be the 500th game of Carey Green's coaching career at Liberty. He enters the contest with a 372-127 record.
- This Saturday, the Lady Flames will shoot for their 44th straight win in the head-to-head series against Coastal Carolina.
- Liberty will play three games this week, giving Ashley Ringer an outside chance at reaching 1,000 career points. She needs 63 points to become the Lady Flames' 15th all-time 1,000-point scorer.

- The Lady Flames will look to continue their trend of playing well down the stretch run of the season under Carey Green. Liberty is 103-10 in February during Green's tenure.

LONGWOOD

- College Sports Madness named Raven Williams the Big South Player of the Week Monday following her 19-point and 10-assist game against Charleston Southern Saturday, Jan. 24.
- Brenna Robbins scored in double figures in three straight games for the first time in her career prior to Longwood's loss at Campbell. Robbins scored 12 points against Presbyterian on Jan. 17, before scoring 14 points against Charleston Southern on Jan. 24. Finally, Robbins poured in 17 points in the Lancers one-point loss to Winthrop.
- Throughout conference play, Raven Williams is the only player in the Big South in the top five in points and assists. Against Big South opponents, the junior guard is averaging 15.3 points per game to rank third in the league, while also averaging 3.75 assists which is also third.
- The Lancers rank first among teams in the Big South this season with 6.52 three-pointers made per game.

PRESBYTERIAN

- Presbyterian College went 1-1 on the week, smothering Campbell in a 51-42 win on Tuesday before falling to UNC Asheville on Saturday, 59-46. One more win would equal last season's win total, with 12.
- Head coach Ronny Fisher, in his seventh season at the helm, moved into sole possession of second place in PC history on Tuesday with his 74th career victory. He passed Randy Randall (1977-84) and Byron Rucker (1984-89) with 73 wins. Beth Couture holds the record, with 238 wins amassed from 1989 to 2002.
- The Blue Hose went 16-for-20 from the free-throw line in Tuesday's win over Campbell, shooting a season-high 80.0 percent. Rebecca Walker went a career-high 5-for-5 and made two in the final minute to seal the win. Aianna Kelly also shot a perfect 4-for-4.
- Redshirt junior forward Keyonna Allen has hit double figures in her last four games, scoring 17 points against Charleston Southern, 12 against Winthrop, 15 against Campbell and 13 at UNC Asheville on Saturday. She has scored in double figures 11 times this season and leads the team with 9.9 points and ranks second with 6.0 rebounds per game. Out of 21 games, she has led the team in points eight times, rebounds nine times, blocks seven times and steals seven times. The redshirt junior enters the week with a career shooting percentage of 48.9 percent.

RADFORD

- Radford, which has won eight of its last nine games, maintained its position at third place in the Big South standings following its 59-49 win over Gardner-Webb, Tuesday night, inside the Dedmon Center.
- The win marked just the second regular-season sweep of the Runnin' Bulldogs in program history.
- RU dialed up a season-high 10 3-pointers against GWU, which were one shy of tying the Dedmon Center record of 11.
- Gardner-Webb became the Highlanders' ninth straight opponent to shoot below 40 percent for the game.
- Radford recorded eight blocks against the Runnin' Bulldogs. In the Highlanders' previous two games, they have racked up a combined 19 blocks.

UNC ASHEVILLE

- UNC Asheville has won three of its last five games after defeating PC on Saturday, 59-46. Asheville out-rebounded PC 41-23 to help get the win.
- Brittany Gwyn scored a season-high 17 points and had seven assists in a narrow 62-58 loss at Liberty
- Senior guard Tacey Trammell sparked the Bulldogs win over PC with three straight 3-pointers midway through the second half.
- Senior guard Shonese Jones leads Asheville with an 11.0 average.

WINTHROP

- Nunn surpassed 800 rebounds and now has 812 for her career to go along with 849 points and puts her on track to become the first 1,000-point and 1,000-rebound player (men or women) in Winthrop history.
- Winthrop extended its winning streak to a season-best four in a row with the two wins last week.
- Junior center Schaquilla Nunn recorded her 9th double-double of the season and 36th of her career with a 14-point, 17-rebound performance against Longwood. The 17 rebounds equals her career high which she has accomplished twice previously.
- Nunn is 7th in the nation and first in the conference for blocked shots with 3.95 per game.
- Sophomore forward Erica Williams scored 43 points, grabbed 17 rebounds connected on 17 of 31 FGs and 9 of 10 FTs in two games. She recorded her 9th double-double with 18 points and 12 rebounds at Longwood.
- Williams upped her scoring average to 16.3 points in all games to take over the Big South lead.
- Both Nunn and Williams are tied for 31st in the NCAA for double-doubles this season with nine.
- As a team, Winthrop ranks 14th in the nation for blocked shots with 5.8 per game.
