Gaines averaged 13.0 points, 7.0 rebounds, 5.0 steals and 4.5 assists per game in two victories last week. At UNC Asheville on Tuesday, she scored six of Campbell's final 11 points and dished out an assist on another late basket to help close out the 56-51 win. On Saturday against High Point, Gaines scored 11 points, grabbed nine rebounds, dished out seven assists and recorded seven steals in a three-point victory. She blocked the Panthers' last-second three-point attempt to preserve the win, her second block in the final minute of the contest. Gaines was 10-of-12 (83.3%) from the free throw line last week.

Storey scored 17.5 points per game last week while shooting 65.0 percent (13-of-20) from the field and 85.7 percent (6-of-7) from three-point range. In a win on Tuesday over Coastal Carolina, she set the school Division I record with 27 points, the most for any PC player in a game since 2006. Storey was 10-of-11 (90.9%) from the field and 4-of-4 from behind the arc. She poured in 19 points in the first half on 8-of-9 shooting.

**CAMPBELL**

- Campbell maintained its perfect record at home in conference play this season by moving to 8-0 after Saturday's 64-61 win over High Point. The Lady Camels are 12-1 overall in home contests in 2014-15.
- Four of Campbell's seven wins against in-state foes this season have come against Big South opponents (twice over UNC Asheville, Gardner-Webb and High Point).
- All 16 of Campbell's victories this season have come when recording the same number or more assists than its opponents.
- With six assists against High Point, redshirt junior RaeChaun Edwards moved into a tie for sixth place on Campbell's all-time career assists list. Her 363 career helpers are tied with Tonisha Baker in the record books.
- Campbell has won nine straight games when it scores 60 or more points and is 14-2 in such games this season.
- Holding a halftime lead has been a key sign of the Lady Camels' success this season; the team is a perfect 13-0 in games where it holds a lead heading into the locker room.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

- Charleston Southern went 0-2 on the past week falling at home to Gardner-Webb on Tuesday and Radford on Saturday
- The Buccaneers were led by Tatum Jarvis' 16 points against the Runnin' Bulldogs as the sophomore forward connected on a career-high five three-pointers on the night
- Alyssa Mann tied a season-high with 17 points from the floor against Radford on Saturday afternoon, connecting on 6-of-17 from the floor to lead the Bucs
- Shauntavia Dobson tied a career-high with 13 points against the Highlanders, going 4-of-5 from the floor and 4-of-6 from the free throw line
- Monique Maximilien led the Bucs with 17 rebounds on the week with nine against Gardner-Webb and eight against Radford

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

- The Chanticleers started last week with a 78-56 defeat at Presbyterian, marking their sixth straight loss to match the longest losing streak under second-year coach Jaida Williams.
- Coastal then ended the week with a 75-44 victory at home over Longwood to break the streak. It was the second 30-plus point margin of victory against a Big South opponent this season, and second-largest margin of victory over a conference opponent in the regular season.
- For the first time all season the Chanticleers ended the week shooting 100.0 percent from the free throw line, knocking down all 19 attempts.
- AJ Jordan led the Chants averaging 16 points while shooting .500 from the field and going a perfect 6-6 from the line. The senior guard also averaged 5.0 rebounds per game.
- Anna Vogt averaged 14.0 points, including a game-high of 20 in the win over Longwood. Vogt was also a perfect 6-6 from the line.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

- Gardner-Webb went 2-0 this past week, with a 62-56 victory at Charleston Southern on Tuesday, and 75-62 victory on Saturday afternoon in Paul Porter Arena over Winthrop.
- Both victories for GWU, completed the season-sweeps of both CSU and Winthrop.
- Jessica Heilig recorded her 1,000th career point at CSU, when she scored a layup with 42 seconds left.
- Against the Buccaneers, Candace Brown scored a game-high 16 points and hauled down 11 boards, while Olivia Parker notched her third straight double-double with 15 points and a career-high 17 rebounds.
- The Runnin' Bulldogs would trail by as much as 10 with 12:51 remaining in the second half, but utilized a 15-0 run, to complete the season-sweep of CSU with a 61-56 victory. GWU played great defense in the second half, limiting Charleston Southern to just 22.5% from the field.

**HIGH POINT**

- The Panthers took two setbacks in the Big South's battle for this week falling 91-74 at Winthrop on Tuesday before dropping a heartbreaker 64-61 at Campbell.
- High Point was led by redshirt-senior Stacia Robertson who posted 19 points and eight rebounds at Winthrop before tallying 20 points and 20 rebounds at Campbell.
- She is the first Panther to collect at least 20 points and 20 rebounds in a single game since Cheyenne Parker had 34 points and 20 rebounds at Longwood on Feb. 7, 2013.
- In the contest at Winthrop senior Latrice Phelps had a career high in points with 25 while adding 10 rebounds for her first double-double of the year.
- The Panthers streak of 38 league games without consecutive losses was snapped on Saturday.

**LIBERTY**

- Liberty's 63-41 win at Presbyterian on Saturday extended the Lady Flames' winning streak to a season-high seven games.
- The Lady Flames' next victory will clinch the No. 1 seed for the Big South Women's Basketball Championship and at least a share of their 15th regular-season title in the last 18 seasons.
- Liberty also needs one more win to notch its eighth straight 20-win season and equal the Big South record for conference victories in a single season

(16).

- After shooting 51 percent during Saturday's win at PC, Liberty is now 99-1 under head coach Carey Green when making at least half of its field goals.
- Redshirt junior Ashley Rininger enters the week needing 15 points to become the 15th 1,000-point scorer in program history.
- Jennifer Fairfax has owned the program record for most consecutive free throws made (22) since 1991. Two Lady Flames are right on her tail, as Karly Buer has hit 21 straight foul shots and Jaymee Fisher-Davis has made 20 in a row, entering this week's games.

**LONGWOOD**

- Longwood dropped a pair of road games Tuesday at Radford, 55-45, and Saturday at Coastal Carolina, 75-44.
- The game at Coastal marked Longwood's fourth straight road contest.
- Longwood will conclude the regular season with two of its last three games at home inside Willett Hall. The Lancers will host Liberty Tuesday, before hosting Presbyterian Saturday.
- Raven Williams is the only player in conference play to rank among the top six in points, assists, steals and minutes played.
- Against Coastal Carolina, Longwood was held to just five three point field goals. The five treys were the fewest since UNC Asheville held the Lancers to four triples Dec. 14 inside Willett Hall.

**PRESBYTERIAN**

- Presbyterian went 1-1 on the week, rolling past Coastal Carolina on Tuesday, 78-56, before falling to Liberty on Saturday, 63-41. The team's Tuesday win over Coastal Carolina gave PC its first season sweep over a Big South opponent this season and surpassed last season's win total of 12.
- Freshman Cortney Storey scored 27 points against Coastal Carolina on Tuesday, setting a new PC Division I record in the process. She eclipsed the previous best of 26 (set in 2008 and 2012) and her 27 points marked the most in a game for PC since 2006. Storey's 10 field goals also tied a school Division I record, shared by four others, and her .909 field goal percentage tied the best-ever mark (minimum of eight) that Keyonna Allen set against High Point on February 5.
- PC enters the week (with one more home game on February 28) with an 11-2 record at the Templeton Center and 8-2 in the Big South. The Blue Hose hold opponents to 33.1 percent shooting at the Templeton Center and average a rebounding margin of +7.3. The team has maintained a winning record at home in each of the last three seasons, beginning in 2011-12.
- PC has played seven players this season in their first season of collegiate basketball. Those seven (Janie Miles, Allie Wagner, Cortney Storey, Tia Mason, Elizabeth Landers, Jameka Braden and Kendra Talley) have contributed 52.5 percent of the team's points, 36.2 percent of the team's rebounds and 48.6 percent of the team's minutes.

**RADFORD**

- Radford, which has won 12 of its last 14 games, climbed to No. 2 in the Big South standings last week.
- Four regular-season games remain on the Highlanders' schedule, with three of those coming against teams ranked Nos. 3-5 in the league standings.
- RU notched its 12th conference win of the season at Charleston Southern, Saturday. Twelve wins tie for the most in a single season in program history.
- Radford built comfortable leads in both games last week before having to hold on down the stretch.
- Junior guard Aisha Foy made 12 of 14 free throws against the Buccaneers, including 10 in a row during the closing stages of a 64-57 road win.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

- The Bulldogs played just once and lost a close 56-51 decision to Campbell on Tuesday
- Asheville plays twice this week as it travels to High Point Tuesday night and hosts Gardner-Webb in its final home game of the year Saturday at 2 p.m.
- Shonese Jones tied her season-high in scoring with 20 points against Campbell
- The Bulldogs have out-rebounded four of their last five opponents
- Four of Asheville's last five losses have come by five points or less
- Jeannie Buckner grabbed 12 rebounds against Campbell

**WINTHROP**

- Aliyah Kilpatrick recorded her first career double-double with 20 points and 11 rebounds to lead Winthrop past High Point. The 20 points equals the second highest single game total of her career.
- Schaquilla Nunn needs 45 more rebounds to become Winthrop's career leader. Ashley Fann now holds the record with 894. Nunn enters the week with 850.
- Nunn took over 14th place on the Big South career rebound list. She enters this week with 850 rebounds.
- Nunn recorded her 11th double-double of the season with 18 points and 12 rebounds against High Point. It was the 38th of her career.
- Freshman Ezinne Mbamalu gave the Eagles a big first half lift in the Gardner-Webb game as she replaced Nunn who was whistled for her second foul just 80 seconds into the game. Mbamalu responded with 10 points and 5 rebounds in the first half.
